We have not been able to trace any information on the games that were played last season in the Western Counties Floodlight Youth League as the league declared their season "Null and Void" and all results from games actually played have been wiped from FA Full-Time.

FA Youth Cup Facts

- A total of **610** clubs across the country have entered this season's FA Youth Cup.
- The current holders of the cup are **Aston Villa** who beat Liverpool 2-1 in last season's final.
- ♦ Manchester United have won the cup the most times (10 times winners), followed by Chelsea (9), Arsenal (7), Liverpool (4), Aston Villa (4), Manchester City (3), West Ham United (3), Everton (3), Tottenham Hotspur (3) and Ipswich Town (3).
- Swindon made the final in 1964 losing 5-2 on aggregate to Manchester United. **Don Rogers** scored the goal in the first leg that put Swindon ahead at the County Ground before **George Best** equalised for United. The game at the County Ground was played in front of 17,000 fans. United won the second leg 4-1.
- Premier Division and Championship clubs are exempt until Round 3. Swindon Down and other League 1 and League 2 clubs are exempt until Round 2 and you would need to win four qualifying rounds to have a chance of meeting them.
