# Welcome

Good afternoon and welcome to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this UHlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against Malvern Town. It is a warm welcome to all who have made the journey down from Worcestershire and we trust you will enjoy your short stay with us this afternoon.

This is the second time that Malvern have visited us here at the GBSG, the two sides having met for the first time in the Floodlit Cup back in Season 2019-20 when Malvern progressed to the next round of the competition courtesy of a 3-1 win. A brief report of that game is included in today's programme as well as the match report from the game at Malvern in the league this season. We were well beaten that afternoon in October, going down 5-2 and Sam and the lads will be keen to put on a much better showing against one of the challengers for honours this afternoon. Malvern currently sit in seventh spot five points behind second placed Bradford Town.

This is Malvern's first season in the Premier Division of the UHlsport Hellenic League after they had been sat at the top of Division One West at the end of both the two covid curtailed seasons. They have done well in their first season and have been attracting some very large crowds all season, including a crowd of 232 for our own game at their ground. They are certainly geared up for football at a higher level in future seasons.

It was disappointing to see the re-arranged game against Shrivenham abandoned on Tuesday night due to the fog but, having seen the coverage on Your Sport Swindon, the referee really had no choice even though they were just 14 minutes left. The one blessing is that it probably means that when we combine the gate for the third attempt to play the game with Tuesday's game we might get close to the figure that would have attended the Christmas Bank Holiday Monday game had it taken place.

Every cloud has a silver lining and all that. To be leading 2-0 and to have victory stolen from, us especially given their call-off of the original game, was irritating and it means this one game will now need a 3rd programme. If the UHlsport Hellenic League cup goes ahead they will be in our group so that will be four Shrivenham programmes in a season.

After the disappointment of Tuesday night hopefully this afternoon will see us return to winning ways although we know we will need to be at our best this afternoon if we are to get anything out of the game today.

## **Development Side**

The Development Side will continue their quest for the Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League title this afternoon when they make the short journey to the Weir Field in Wroughton to play an in-form Wroughton side managed by our former player Ben Jarrett. Hopefully today will see a double with both our sides winning.

## **Veterans' Over 35s Side**

Having reached the final of the Wiltshire Veterans' County Cup last week, the Veterans' Over 35s were back in action on Wednesday night against Swindon Rovers and maintained top spot after a 2-0 win over Swindon Rovers. The Ladies side suffered another defeat in the South West Regional Women's League Premier Division on Sunday, losing to Forest Green Rovers for the second time this season. The Ladies will look to bounce back tomorrow when they make the long journey to St Austell for the second away game in a sequence of six games on the road.

# Club News

## Youth Section Round-up Sunday 16th January 2022

It was a winning weekend for Royal Wootton Bassett Town's youth sides as six of nine teams engaged in competitive action emerged victorious.

One of the most impressive wins belonged to the Under 14 Yellows who triumphed 4-1 away against Wroughton Youth Blue – a side they had lost 8-4 to earlier this season. Goals from Owen Godwin, Danny Harris, Jack Kersie and Harry Lawrie helped Bassett to their win.

The Yellows now have just one game left this season. And they will be looking to cap off a campaign in which they have shown great improvement with victory. After losing their first six games, the Yellows have since won three and drawn one of their last seven fixtures – a run that has seen them bridge the gap to the mid-table teams in North Wilts League Division Four.

All teams involved in battles for honours triumphed this weekend too.

The Under 13 Blues remain top in Division One after a routine 10-2 victory against Purton Youth Spartans. 5-1 winners against the same side last week, the scoreline doubled this time around as Sonny Parmaku scored a hat trick, Phanuel Asenso registered a brace and Karol Czekanski, Indy Iles-Jones, Liam Lye-Owens, Rhys Poulton and Bryan Wilson all got in on the act.

A thumping 6-2 home win against Ferndale Rodbourne kept the Under 15 Blues hot on the tails of Division Two leaders Malmesbury Youth. Beau Hicks led the way with a hat trick for Bassett while Edward Greenouff, Finley Hyde and Samuel Smith chipped in to complete the scoring.

Also keeping up with the sides immediately above them were the Under

12 Blues. In Division Three they saw off Marlborough Youth Lightning 7-2. Six different scorers found the net, Harry Scott doing so twice with Theo Box, Mason Brooks, Connor Iles, Kyle Lillis and Jude Turnbull adding one each.

The win lifts Bassett into fourth above Marlborough and to within four points of second place Croft Junior Red (who have played three games more) and three points of third place Wims 11 Foothills (who have played one game more).

After suffering defeat last week, it was back to winning ways for the Under 13 Yellows, currently second in Division Four, as they won 2-0 away against Devizes Town Youth Titans. Fynn Crone scored for Bassett to help them on their way to all three points.

The Under 16 Yellows moved up to third in Division Three with a 4-2 win away against Northside Athletic. Their leading trio of scorers Patrick Otoo-Mensah (2), Ewan Painter and Lewis Taylor were all on target to seal an important win.

In Division One, the Under 16 Blues sealed victory by an identical score away at Malmesbury Youth. Rhys Matthew Westlake (2), Samuel Case and Maxime Fiddes netted to make it consecutive wins and lift Bassett into fourth place.

Elsewhere, both Under 18s sides fell to narrow defeats. Sebastian Smith was on target for the Under 18 Blues as they lost by the odd goal in three away against Lambourn Sports. Meanwhile, the Yellows were unable to close the gap to third place FC Calne Youth Hurricanes who triumphed 2-0 in their fixture.

On Saturday the Under 12 Girls were beaten 6-0 away at third place Castle Combe Colts Jets.

## 10 September 2019 Floodlit Cup Royal W. Bassett Town 1 Malvern Town 3

Royal Wootton Bassett Town were eliminated in the first round of the Banbury Litho Floodlit Cup after a 3-1 defeat against Malvern Town.

The Floodlit Cup is often seen by managers within the Hellenic League as something of an unwelcome distraction. After the disappointing start Royal Wootton Bassett Town have endured to their 2019-20 season, the competition arguably took on a different edge, a possible route to salvage some confidence with a league win still elusive.

However, that was not to be as Sam Collier's side were eliminated by Malvern Town, the Division One West newcomers - who, unlike Bassett, have hit the ground running - running out deserved 3-1 winners.

They made a quick start, going ahead after six minutes as George Hayes curled a left footed shot from outside the area beyond the reach of Declan Lehmann.

Bassett levelled shortly before half time though, Melksham Town loanee Andy Sandell producing a cool turn before producing a composed side-foot finish.

Malvern almost restored their lead in the opening minute of the second half, but Matthew Turner was denied by Lehmann before the resulting corner led to a chance that was cleared off the line.

However, Ethan Moran eventually put them ahead with a fine individual effort, twisting his way through the Bassett defence before finding the far corner.

Youngster Morgan Skidmore then made certain of the outcome in the game's final minute (see later for report on last meeting between the sides).



# Opponents History



The Club was established in 1946 as Barnard's Green Football Club. They joined the Worcester League, where they played until moving up

to the Worcestershire Combination in 1955, going on to win the league at the first attempt.

The club also won the Worcestershire Junior Cup and retained the trophy for the next two seasons, before winning it again in 1961-62.

In 1967 the Worcestershire Combination was renamed the Midland Combination. The club won the inaugural Worcestershire Urn in 1973-74, before retaining it for the next two seasons; they also finished as runners-up in the Midland Combination in 1973-74.

In 1979 Malvern transferred to the Premier Division of the West Midlands (Regional) League and although they finished bottom of the division in 1982-83, the club avoided being relegated. However, they were relegated to Division One at the end of the 1991-92 season.

Despite only finishing ninth in Division One in 1993-94, the club were promoted back to the Premier Division. In 2003-04 they won the Premier Division title, earning promotion to the Midland Alliance.

A third place finish in the Alliance in 2005-06 saw the club promoted to Division One Midlands of the Southern League. The club finished bottom of Division One Midlands in 2008-09 and were relegated back to the Midland Alliance. Two seasons later they finished bottom of the Midland Alliance and were relegated to the Premier Division of the West Midlands (Regional) League.

They lifted the Worcestershire Senior Urn for the ninth time in 2018-19 and finished in the top five for five consecutive seasons.

The summer of 2019 saw the association with the West Midlands (Regional) League come to an end as the club were moved across to the Hellenic League Division One West.

It was during the first half of the 2019-20 season that Project 2020 finally came to fruition with significant developments made to the club's facilities and infrastructure, including a new state-of-the-art 3G playing surface and new dressing rooms.

An FA Vase tie against Loughborough University in November 2019 signalled the first game at the revamped stadium and with home crowds regularly topping the 200-mark, the team marched to the top of the table until the campaign was declared null-and-void in March 2020 amidst the Covid-19 outbreak.

The 2020-21 season also saw the club sitting deservedly at the top of the table when the season was curtailed due to Covid-19. However, in 2021, it was confirmed that the club would be promoted into the Premier Division.

The club also enjoyed another exciting adventure in the FA Vase, beating higher level Rothwell Corinthians and Sporting Khalsa long the way before narrowly losing out to Congleton Town in the Fourth Round.

The club continues to embrace the local community, and with Project 2022 full steam ahead for the development of a Community Hib, Malvern Town look forward to what the future holds in store.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town's winless Hellenic League Premier Division run stretched to eight games as they fell to a heavy 5-2 defeat away against third place Malvern Town.

Bassett found themselves two goals down at the break before a quickfire second half double increased their deficit further. While Alan Griffin pulled one back from the penalty spot, Malvern added a fifth before Griffin headed in a late consolation deep in stoppage time.

Given Bassett's recent form and the fact they were facing the division's leading scorers on their own patch, a long, trying afternoon was a strong possibility. And so it proved.

Bassett found themselves a goal down after just nine minutes as a good spell of possession from Malvern culminated in Matt Turner teeing up Dave Reynolds, who fired home an emphatic opener.

The hosts' relentless, heavy pressing proved tough to deal with. That, coupled with Malvern's quality when on the ball, then contributed towards keeping 'keeper Eddie Cavanagh a busy man.

Bassett were forced to clear off the line on the quarter hour mark as the ball broke free following an aerial duel between Cavanagh and Reynolds.

A steady stream of pressure from Malvern followed, and the 'keeper pulled off a trio of fine saves to initially keep Bassett's deficit to a minimum. He first kept out Nathan Chowns Higgs' glancing header before ensuring James Febery's header did not creep over the line and denying Joe Bates from a free kick.

However, there was little he could do three

minutes before the interval when Bates cut inside the wing and fired beyond the 'keeper for Malvern's second.

The past couple of games have seen Malvern surrender leads of two goals or more. Yet there was to be no three-peat.

Within a quarter of an hour of the restart they were four in front. Both Matt Turner and Harry Clark had come close to extending Malvern's advantage before the inevitable third arrived courtesy of Joe Bullock who weighted a fine chip over Cavanagh and into the net on 55 minutes.

Four minutes later, Chowns Higgs got in on the act. Picking up a half-cleared corner, he proceeded to curl home a fine strike from just outside the area.

Bassett were able to pull one back when Griffin slotted home a penalty after Bailey Gallagher had been fouled by Phil Harris.

Yet that goal offered only short term relief as Malvern reasserted themselves.

Bassett's resistance was then broken again on 88 minutes as Reynolds grabbed his second and Malvern's fifth of the game after good build up play from winger Harry Clark.

Griffin then headed home his second in the fourth minute of injury time. But this offered little succour to Bassett who were already well beaten.

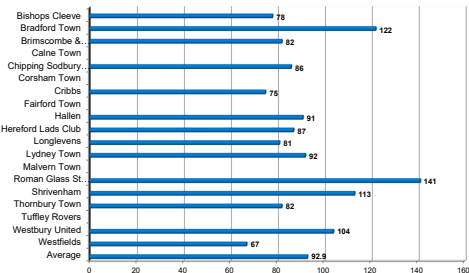

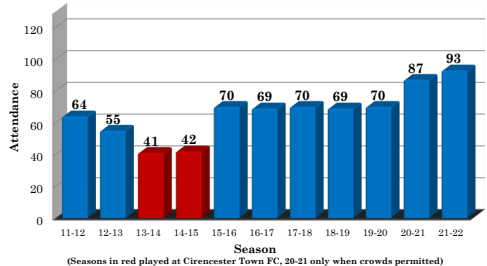

ESSENTIAL READING FOR FOLLOWERS OF THE NATIONAL GAME

THE PHRASE ‘magic of the cup’ is synonymous with the FA Cup’s early rounds but in recent weeks it has been used alongside the FA Trophy.

The competition for the top four tiers of Non-League football is now entering the last 16 and those clubs will be starting to dream of the Wembley final in May.

While some National League sides may devalue the Trophy in place of league success and promotion to the Football League, the knock-out competition, which has been played since 1969, provides a valuable opportunity to lower-league clubs.

Just look what it meant for Needham Market last weekend winning a dramatic penalty shootout 8-7 at top-flight Yeovil Town, who have created plenty of their own cup history. Market boss Kevin Horlock described it as a ‘special day’ for the Step 3 side.

Elsewhere, Cheshunt, also playing at the same level as Needham, won 3-0 at National League South club St Albans City while Morpeth Town came out on the right side of a seven-goal thriller against Step 2 Boston United, winning 4-3. Tonbridge Angels upset National League King’s Lynn Town too.

And it’s not even the victories that can provide memories. Larkhall Athletic, of the Southern League Division One South, enjoyed a trip to National League high-flyers Stockport County on Saturday.

It was the furthest the club had been in the competition and they made sure to make the most of it by staying over on the Friday night AND Saturday to enjoy themselves post-match. The Larks supporters travelled well too with 169 in attendance at Edgeley Park.

Larkhall manager Ollie Price, no stranger to a big cup tie having played against Norwich City in a televised FA Cup first round game for Paulton Rovers, told The NLP of the club’s excitement before the Stockport fixture. “It’s an absolutely incredible draw, it’ll be a fantastic day for the club and everyone connected,” he said. “This is what it’s all about. I know they say the magic of the FA Cup but this is the magic of the Trophy!”

The FA Trophy is made extra special by the FA’s persistence to play the final at Wembley on Non-League Finals Day, also featuring the FA Vase which always delivers a brilliant spectacle – the last six finals have produced 24 goals between them!

Some supporters may say the final should be held at a smaller, more intimate ground but speak to any manager or player and they will say they want to be walking out under the arch.

We’ve been treated to so many great finals over the years, not least most recently when Step 3 Hornchurch beat Hereford. It’s given many clubs from the same level hope they can go all the way too.

Brackley Town’s penalty victory over Bromley was also dramatic, so too was North Ferriby United’s upset of Wrexham in 2015. The memories go on and on.

So, the Trophy is still special, still ‘magic’ and it was a pleasure to have Needham Market’s upset taking centre-stage on our front page last weekend – sorry Yeovil fans, you had your turn last month in the FA Cup!

# First Team Match Report

**Royal Wootton Bassett Town 2**

**Abandoned on 76 mins, fog**

## **Uhlsport Hellenic Premier Division**

Two first half John Mills goals and a seemingly commanding advantage going into the game's final quarter of an hour counted for nothing as Royal Wootton Bassett Town's home derby against Shrivenham was abandoned due to fog.

It's the second time in a matter of weeks that Sam Collier's side have been frustrated in their desire to face Shrivenham – a team they are vying to complete a league double over and with which they are jockeying for position in the middle of the Hellenic League Premier Division pack.

Covid cases in the away camp had previously scuppered the prospects of the game being played on 27 December, its original date. Now, after being shoehorned into a midweek slot in mid-January despite requests for a more supporter friendly date to be chosen (the fixture is after all one between local rivals with Bassett having missed out on the above-average gate that a Christmas fixture would certainly have attracted), a new place in the teams' schedules will again have to be found.

When that date eventually arrives – and here's hoping that when it comes there won't be any more issues affecting the ability of the game to be played – Bassett will be aiming to recreate the position they found themselves in prior to the referee halting proceedings.

Bassett's performance had by no means been a perfect one. Indeed, it was rather scruffy and they were fortunate not to have conceded at least once. Yet, a combination of Mills' ruthlessness in front of goal and

their visitors' profligacy meant that it was enough to have staked out a clear lead by half time - and one that the hosts did not appear likely to relinquish.

Shrivenham had made the better start on the night, though were unable to make anything of the chances they were able to muster.

With Eddie Cavanagh hesitating to come off his line to collect a hopeful ball over the top, away forward Shane Hibbert had the best early opening as he crept in to lift an attempted lob over the 'keeper, but his effort lacked the required power and direction, allowing Macaulay Dodson to calmly avert the danger.

Bassett did eventually liven up and it took a save with the feet from visiting shotstopper James Foster to keep out a Sam Packer header from John Mills' weighted corner.

Back at the other end, after Bassett failed to clear the lines the experienced Jonny Davoile unlocked the home defence with a perfectly placed through ball for Hibbert. But the forward again fluffed his lines when presented with just Cavanagh to beat, skewing a rushed shot wide of the left post.

Then with eight minutes to go before the break, Bassett were ahead. The goal came out of nothing, but was the product of two moments of quality. First, Adam Corcoran rose on the halfway line to meet a Foster clearance with a powerful header. Placed behind the Shrivenham backline, it was put in a perfect position for Mills to run onto and the forward took one touch before lifting a deft right footed lob over the advancing 'keeper.



The visitors should really have been back on level terms immediately from the restart though. Slack defending allowed the Bassett backline to be beaten by a ball over the top and an unmarked Hibbert was presented with his third golden opportunity of the half. However, he shot straight at Cavanagh from the edge of the box. After the rebound came straight back at him, Hibbert had a second bite at the cherry. This time he cut past the 'keeper, but pressure from Dodson deflected his weak follow up wide of the upright.

Having survived that let off, Bassett soon doubled their advantage. Packer slipped a pass to Mills on the left edge of the box and the forward cut inside his marker before squeezing a powerful low drive from twelve yards between the legs of an unsighted Foster.

By this point of the game, a mist had

already descended. But that appeared to have lifted when the teams were back out for the second half.

In front of goal there was little of note after the restart. The most notable action of a scrappy, untidy period occurred when the visitors' manager Dan Broadbank was sent off for his reaction to a firm, but seemingly fair Will Davidson challenge.

The pea souper soon returned and, at least for those watching, it became impossible to tell what was going on. Subsequently, a temporary suspension of play – in the seemingly futile hope that the fog would somehow lift – then became an abandonment with fourteen minutes to go.

The match will therefore have to be replayed. Here's hoping it will be third time lucky when that comes around.

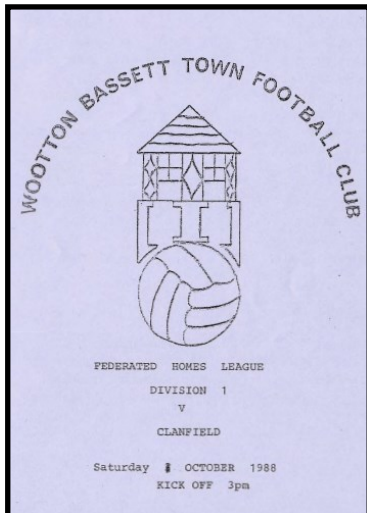
