Welcome

Good afternoon and welcome to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Uhlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against Tuffley Rovers. It is a warm welcome to the management, players and supporters who have made the short journey across the border from Gloucester for today's game. We trust you will enjoy your short stay with us this afternoon and we wish you all a safe journey home.

After losing 12 games on the spin, Tuffley have been showing much improvement in recent weeks and their last seven games have seen a couple of wins, a draw and with all the defeats being by a single goal margin only, including games against the likes of Westbury United and Westfields who are still challenging for honours at the top end of the table. It was a close game in the first meeting between the sides, we took all three points thanks to an Adam Corcoran goal in a 1-0 win.

After the disappointment of the last home game against Fairford Town where we went down to a last minute penalty it was a return to winning ways last Saturday away at near neighbours Calne Town. The match against Fairford Town was totally spoilt by the horrendous win that Storm Eunice brought to the county. It was one of the worst games of football I think I have ever witnessed and on the balance of play Fairford probably deserved the win as we were certainly not at our best that day.

The win at Calne continued our good record this season against sides below us in the table. So far 27 of our 42 points have come in games against the sides below us in the table and we have not lost to any of them. Hopefully that trend will continue this afternoon with Tuffley below us in the table. With both Shrivenham and Calne Town to play again at home hopefully we can pick up six points from those two games as well, improving what is not a good home record this season. Again of our 42 points , 24 have come away from the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground, with just 18 being accumulated on home soil. It seems that visiting teams like playing on our smooth playing surface!

After today we play our final two away games of the season, a midweek trip to high flying Westbury United being followed by a trip to Longlevens. We then finish our league campaign with three home games against Calne Town, Shrivenham and Corsham Town. The Calne game is scheduled for 15th March and we then have a month's break from league action until Easter weekend when we have the Shrivenham game on Good Friday and the Corsham game on Easter Sunday.

Development Side

The Development Side had a good 3-1 home win last week against a decent Corsham Town Development side last week to keep the pressure on Pewsey Vale. They have another tough looking game today when they travel to Trowbridge Town looking to complete a league double having won 1-0 at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground last month. With Trowbridge's pitch being notoriously wet, hopefully the work they did last summer will allow the game to go ahead.

Ladies Side

The Ladies were beaten by top of the table Torquay Utd on Sunday and have another difficult looking game this coming Sunday when they host AFC St Austell in what is their last home league game of the season. The first match between the two sides served up a nine goal thriller and with ST Austell one of two unbeaten sides in the league another tough match is in prospect for the Ladies this weekend.

Enjoy the game this afternoon and hopefully three points for the Bassett.

Opponents History



Founded by the late Donald E Hall 1929, the club's Headquarters were in a former railway carriage, which served as Mr Hall's Boot and Shoe repair shop

on the Stroud Road at Tuffley in the City of Gloucester.

The Club started its playing life in the North Gloucestershire League, before a move across to the Stroud & District League, which eventually led to promotion to the Gloucestershire Northern Senior League. Securing the Champions title in 1987-88 meant Rovers gained promotion to the Gloucestershire County League for the first time. After two seasons of consolidation the Club won the County Title in 1990-1991. their League application to join the Hellenic League was successful and they were accepted into Hellenic Division One.

Progress continued, as in 1992-1993 Rovers completed a League/Cup Double. After that promotion the club regularly finished in the top half of the Premier Division of the Hellenic League, and in 1998/1999 Rovers won the Norman Matthew's Floodlit Cup, defeating Carterton Town in the final.

The Club continued to thrive in the Hellenic League and managed to win the Floodlit Cup again in the 2002/2003 season, defeating Brackley Town over two legs in the final. However, the ever changing ground grading requirements, if the club was to remain in the Hellenic League, and the financial strain these improvements imposed on the club, forced Tufflev Rovers to make the decision to withdraw from the Hellenic League in 2005 and settle for local football in Gloucestershire. returning to the Gloucestershire Northern Senior League.

After a difficult start Rovers were crowned champions of Division Two of the Northern Senior League in the 2005/2006 season and were promoted to Division One. Another slow start followed in 2006/07, before the team put together a consistent run and managed to claim the league title, as well as win the GFA Senior Amateur Cup and reach the final of the Reg Davis Memorial League Cup.

A return to the Gloucestershire County League followed and the club finished a very creditable 4th place (2007/8) but the summer of 2008 saw a number of senior players retire. Over the next few years, the side secured several top six finishes, before the 2012/13 season marked a significant for the improvement club. After challenging for league championship honours all season, the club couldn't quite maintain the form to secure the title. ultimately finishing second. However, this was enough to gain promotion to the Hellenic League Division One (West) for the 2013/14 season.

On their return to the Hellenic League, The Rovers saw a season that witnessed some turmoil – including the departure of manager, Doug Foxwell – to record a decent sixth place finish and some good cup results.

Warren Evans came in as manager in 2014 and secured a Runners-up spot which was enough to see the club promoted back into the Hellenic League Premier Division, ten years after withdrawing from the division.

Evans departed after a difficult first season in the Premier Division and the club only avoided relegation on administrative grounds. Mark Pritchett. was then appointed as manager in June 2016 and he took the club to a secure 10th place finish and an appearance in the Supplementary Cup Final. A second successive 10th place finished followed in 2017/18, before a 15th place in 2018/19, the last completed season with the two following seasons curtailed by Covid-19.





The final game of the week was on Wednesday night and it saw **Roman Glass St George** defeat **Calne Town** 3-1.



First Team Match Report

Saturday 26th February 2022 Calne Town 1 Royal Wootton Bassett Town 2

Royal Wootton Bassett Town's performance may have been one that merited few points for style, but Sam Collier's side ensured they returned to winning ways as goals either side of half time from John Mills and Alfie Presley saw Bassett grind out a 2-1 victory away against local rivals Calne Town.

With their hosts battling for survival in the Hellenic League Premier Division and Bassett's form wavering after frustrating recent results against Hallen and Fairford Town, this was a derby contest that was always set to be a battle. And so it proved as two teams separated by just over ten miles met for the first time in a league fixture since the 1985-86 season.

It was Calne who would strike first blood in the contest as Jamie Walters found a way past Eddie Cavanagh.

And while Bassett were enjoying more of the ball, it appeared as though Calne would take their lead into the break.

That was until the visitors fashioned an equaliser with two minutes remaining in the

half. Cutting in from the left side, Mills found himself with room to shoot and his powerful drive from just outside the area picked up a deflection off Jordan Kirk that left home 'keeper Bailey Leach a helpless bystander as the ball flew into the corner of the net.

Bassett then struck what proved to be the winner in the early stages of the second period. As Calne sought to play out from the back, Leach hit a stray pass that fell straight into the feet of Presley, who, from a tricky position, smashed a shot straight back past the 'keeper and into the net.

That goal, Presley's second since returning to the club, proved all that Bassett needed to record their 12th league win of the campaign.

Although the win does not change Bassett's position in the table, results elsewhere means that Bassett can climb two places to eleventh should they win the games in hand over Fairford and Hereford Lads Club that they possess.

The points dropped in the past two games do mean Bassett are playing catch up.

But with six league games left to go, including four home matches - among them the return fixture against Calne, there's still more to play for than just pride.





STORMS Dudley, Eunice and Franklin may have proved profitable for, say, fencers or roofers but certainly not for cash-strapped Non-League football clubs. Five full days of heavy rain, high winds and even snow left Britain battered and bruised last week with a trial of destruction in its wake. Naturally, the fixture list was decimated up and down the country, while some clubs were left counting the cost of extensive damage caused to grounds and clubhouses.

Perhaps the hardest hit, once again, were Tadcaster Albion. For the fourth time in seven years, the adjacent River Wharfe burst its banks with such ferocity that it took down most of the steel barrier on the far side of the Brewers' Ings Lane ground, opening the floodgates for around 1.5 metres of water. This comes as a huge kick in the teeth for the North Yorkshire club who have played an integral part in the town's Tadcaster Flood Alleviation Scheme which was formed following the devastation of the floods in 2015.

The clubhouse at Ings Lane was raised to prevent a repeat and that seemed to do the trick when floods struck again in 2020 and 2021. Not this time though with water ingress expected through the floorboards. As a result, Taddy are now back in limbo with the Environment Agency yet to sanction vital repair works before their next home game against Stocksbridge Park Steels on March 5.

Another club who suffered a repeat deluge were Barton Rovers, who were hit by the effects of a major storm for the second time in five years. In February 2017, the Southern League Division One Central side's Sharpenhoe Road home was battered by Storm Doris which sent a floodlight pylon crashing through the main stand, leaving Barton with a £9,000 repair bill. Last Friday, Storm Eunice blew the stand down again along with the club's TV tower. It is estimated that repairs this time round could cost the club around £20,000.

Basford United's Greenwich Avenue stadium suffered extensive wind damage last Friday,

leaving them with an estimated repair bill of $\pounds 10,000$. Stands and turnstiles were damaged, with one roof destroyed, while exterior fences came down and gas, electricity and water supplies were disrupted.

Perhaps the most harrowing sight of the weekend was the metal roof of the stand at Pagham FC being wrapped around a parked van in a nearby road with the entire structure ripped from its hinges.

Trees at Egham Town's Runnymede Stadium were felled and a stand destroyed, causing the postponement of their home game against Southall, while the away team's dugout at Hartley Wintney flipped over the pitchside hoardings and onto its roof as their Green Lane ground was also hit.

Meanwhile, Potters Bar Town have set up a GoFundMe page in order to help the club meet ground grading regulations, following extensive storm damage. А similar fundraising effort in March 2019 raised £5,000 towards the £50,000 improvement costs as the club just about made the deadline to maintain their Step 3 status. But 70pmh winds on Friday blew one of the new stands completely on its back, causing much damage, as well as to the Water Irrigation Canons, the Home Dugout and a Storage Unit.

"Today, as a Community Club, we encourage the youth and contribute to the good health and comfort of those watching," chairman Peter Waller said.

"With more than 50 years at the club, we are devastated, after all the effort that went in three years ago. We can raise some of the cost, but we need to ask for help. Please support us if you can."

All this acts as a timely reminder as to the challenges that exist when running a Non-League football club and just how vulnerable they can be. In times like this, communities are at their strongest, rallying together in support of a vital asset. It shows nothing should ever be taken for granted.
