# **Welcome To Today's Game**

### **Welcome to Denham United Ladies**

Welcome to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Second Qualifying Round FA Cup fixture against Denham United Ladies, who visit the Gerard Buxton Ground for the very first time. A special warm welcome to the players, officials and spectators from Denham United who have made the long journey to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground today from Uxbridge. We hope you enjoy your short stay with us this afternoon and we wish you a safe journey home.

Denham United are now at the same level in the Women's National League System as Royal Wootton Bassett Town, playing in the London & South East Regional Women's League but they have previously played in The FA's National Women's League. They have had a mixed start to the current season winning just one of their four league games to date and currently sit second from bottom in their league but visit us here today with a good record in this competition which is highlighted later in today's programme.

### Today's Referee

It is also a warm welcome today to the three match officials and in particular young referee Rhiannon Stevens who made a name for herself recently whilst referring an Under 18 Floodlit game in the Wiltshire Senior League at Calne Town. With one of the visiting players from New College suffering a neck injury in the 80th minute of the game and, with concerns about moving the player, an ambulance was called and the match abandoned. Unfortunately the paramedics did not arrive until 3.10am due to their resources being stretched on a busy night for the ambulance service, some six hours after the original call had been made during which time the New College coach Richard Dent was having to hold the players head still and talking to him to keep him awake. Rhiannon and her mother also remained with the player until the ambulance arrived. After being taken into the ambulance the player was checked over and thankfully there was no major injury. Rhiannon and the player's coach Richard Dent certainly went above and beyond on a difficult evening for all concerned.

### **Match Day Programme**

This is the first Ladies' programme of the current season. Unfortunately it was not possible to produce a programme for the first two league games due mainly to time constraints with First Team programmes. We have already had to produce more programmes this season than the whole of last season and we are only just into October and in the Hellenic League it is mandatory that a programme has to be produced. This coupled with media duties I have with the Wiltshire Senior League meant something had to give. Hopefully it will be possible to continue with programmes for home games from now on but it will depend on getting opponents information on and contributions from within the Ladies Section for each game. All contributions for the programme will be gratefully received.

### Season So Far

The Ladies side have made a decent start to the season so far with two wins from their opening three games. Hopefully that will continue here today in this most prestigious of competitions. Details of all our previous results and team line-ups in the Women's FA Cup games are included in today's programme. Interesting to note that Sam Wood played in the first game in the FA Cup back in 2012 and could feature again today.

Welcome to today's Vitality FA cup 2nd Qualifier game, this competition has given me a great memory, our first ever win in this competition way back in 2013/14 season, a home win over Cheltenham Civil Service. Not only did I have the pleasure of being the manager that day but witnessed a fabulous 30 yard free kick from my own daughter

to thank Mark Ellis who helped start the Wildcats three years ago. He was the person who applied for the funding from the Wiltshire County FA and from the funding we were able to provide free football sessions for girls. From these sessions we have now created two teams at U10 (pictured left) & U12 level (pictured below) and both sides are playing competitive matches this season. All the girls in these teams have come from the Wildcat sessions and both squads have over 14+ players that are all registered to play on Saturday mornings in the county league.



We are still continuing to grow as a section with plans in the pipeline to set up a new U8 team later next month. It is hoped some of the girls from our U10 & 12 teams will be present at the game today as mascot's.

I wish to extend a warm welcome to the staff, players and supporters from Denham United Ladies and hope they enjoy their small stay at the GBSG.

# **From The Dugout**

I would like to extend a warm welcome to Denham United Ladies FC for today's 2nd Qualifying Round match in the Vitality Women's FA Cup.

When I was appointed as Ladies Manager in

November 2020, it was mentioned to me that I would have to write programme notes for all of our Home fixtures. Little did I know that nearly a year has gone by, and today,. These are my first programme notes!"

Covid reared its head during preseason training, we only managed to play 4 friendlies, winning 2, 1 loss and 1 draw. My intention was to have double that number, but two words that we have become use to 'self isolation', was still on the Agenda. I felt we were a little 'under cooked', but injuries to key players were also a factor, but we did finally arrive at our first League game on the 5th September in reasonable shape, only for Covid to strike again, and the game was postponed, I feel that might not be the only time that happens this season.

We started our season a week later, when Middlezoy Ladies were the visitors. After a shaky 10 minute spell at the start of the game, we ran out comfortable winners, 5-1. Next up were our 'bogey' team, Illminster Town, who are tipped for promotion this season. I was really pleased how we played for an hour or so, that players sticking to the game plan, but to win the game I needed to make a change and take a chance, which unfortunately resulted in a 4-0 defeat.

Last Sunday, saw the first long trip of the season, when we visited Marine Academy Plymouth, who play at Ivybridge Town FC, a really nice ground. Playing on the front foot, and being more positive, I was really

pleased with the way the players acquitted themselves against a good opponent. Despite going a goal behind, we continued to pass and move the ball really well and deserved to be level at half time. Having been involved in football for a long time now, sometimes you need a bit of luck during a game, and we had our fair share on Sunday. But when you ride your luck, we started to believe that we could win the game, the players were excellent, and we won the games with an 83rd minute winner from Hannah Gulliver. 6 points for 3 games is very pleasing.

I currently have 22 players in my squad, the mix is very good, and I was particularly pleased that the majority of the players from the previous two truncated seasons, remain with the Club, and I have supplemented that group with some very good Under 18's.

I like my team to play football the correct way, our passing and movement is getting better with every game we play, but as we all know, Football Managers are never satisfied, so we will continue to work hard at training, and get better and better. The group is full of very talented players, I hope we can produce a strong display this afternoon.

I would like to place on record my thanks to the Head of Women's Football at the Club, Bryan Wood, who has been a massive help to me. My two coaches, Samantha Wood and Martin Peters, your expertise, knowledge and help is much appreciated by myself and the players, I believe this group can continue to improve, play good football, and most importantly, enjoy playing and competing in this wonderful game.

# **Opponents In Focus**



Today we face tough opposition in the Second Qualifying Round of the FA Cup form of Denham United Ladies. Based in Buckinghamshire, they are the largest female club in the South

East of England with Ladies sides from Under 9 through to the senior side.

Their senior team ply their trade in the London and South East Regional Women's League Premier Division - at Step Five of the women's football pyramid, the same level as Bassett. They have been at step five since the 2019-20 season, having previously played at a higher level in the Women's National League Division One South East.

Denham United Ladies have significant recent pedigree In the Women's FA Cup too. In the 2010-11, 2011-12 and 2013-14

editions they reached the Second Round, losing to Charlton Athletic, Tottenham Hotspur and Lewes respectively. More recently, in 2015-16 and 2016-17 they exited in the final Fourth Qualifying round.

Last season Denham United Ladies Women's started in the FAPreliminary Round, defeating Queens Park Rangers on penalties and then beating Ascot United in the next round before falling to a 1-0 loss against Maidenhead United in the Second Qualifying Round.

### **South West Regional Women's Premier**

The constitution for the 2021-22 South West Regional Women's Football League Premier Division was announced following the league's Annual General Meeting, which was held on Monday 28 June.

Entering our third season in the division, Royal Wootton Bassett Town Ladies will be hoping to finally complete a first full season at the fifth tier of women's football after the Coronavirus pandemic curtailed both the 2019-20 and 2020-21 campaigns.

Bassett will be facing nine other teams in 2021-22, with the division having grown in size by one side as a result of restructuring in the women's game during the summer months.

Entering the division for the coming season are AFC St Austell, Sherborne Town and Forest Green Rovers. St Austell and Sherborne have been elevated from the South West Regional League Western Division, while Forest Green have been promoted from the Eastern division.

Brislington were scheduled to be in the league ,moving down into the South West Regional League, having most recently having played in the FA Women's National League Division One South West, but they have subsequently withdrawn from the league. Moving in the opposite direction are Portishead Town, whose application for upwards movement was successful.

Meanwhile, Callington Town have withdrawn from the division with the manager and players having left en masse to join Liskeard Athletic FC (see later notes).

Whilst Callington Town and Portishead were strong sides it certainly looks to once again be a tough division with the new sides coming into the division.

Elsewhere in the South West Regional Women's Football League, as part of the F's upward movement exercise, the league received eight applications from Tier 7 clubs looking to join the league and all were successful. The new sides joining the league are Saltash United and Helston Ladies from Cornwall, Liverton United and Ottery St Mary from Devon, Bristol Rovers from Gloucestershire, Warminster Town Ladies from Wiltshire, and Keynsham Town and Paulton Rovers from Somerset.

The league said a sad farewell after many years with the league to Plympton Ladies, Swindon Town Spitfires, Pen-Mill Ladies, St Agnes Ladies and Callington Town Ladies.

With the ladies from Callington Town having moved en masse to form a new team within the existing structure of Liskeard Athletic FC, under the FA competition rules the league applied to the FA for Liskeard Athletic to be allowed to play at more or less the level the players were at previously. This application was successful in that they have been placed at Tier 6 and will play within the Western Division next season.

# **Ladies Match Reports**
