Good afternoon and finally welcome back to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground after what has been a very long road trip for the Ladies side. Five consecutive away trips (it would have been six if last week's game had not been postponed), some down to deepest Cornwall, unfortunately saw just one win from the five games.

The solitary victory in that sequence of away games came at Bideford where we secured a big win against a struggling side. The run of away games started with narrow defeats to both Forest Green Rovers and St Austell, the latter seeing the points stolen by a late rally from our opponents with us having led 4-1. These two defeats were followed by a 4-0 defeat at Sherbourne. I understand that the Sherbourne result does not reflect the performance on the day from the Ladies and it does seem that we have been without much luck on our travels. final away game was against today's opponents where Torquay avenged the three heavy defeats they suffered at our hands in Season 2019-20 with a 5-0 win. Match reports from all five away games last home game Sherbourne Town are included in today's programme.

Today's opponents Torquay are having an excellent season and currently sit top of the table on goal difference from Sherbourne Town with both having just four games to play. They have clearly turned things round after struggling at the bottom of the table in the two Covid impacted seasons prior to this one. Whilst they currently sit top of the table, Ilminster Town in third place and fourth placed St Austell are both unbeaten and remain the favourites for the title as both have games in hand on the top two. However, we can be sure that Torquay will be aiming to maintain their title

aspirations here this afternoon and we will need to be at our best if we are to get anything out of the game, particularly given Torquay are unbeaten away from home this season

I must apologise that today's programme is only available online. For the first time in close to 20 years of preparing the Match Day programmes for the club, due to a number of other distractions in the week, I forgot to send anything to the printers on Wednesday. It was only when the Club Chairman asked on Friday if it needed picking up that I remembered that one was needed. It had been part completed but unfortunately, I failed to complete it by the latest possible time it would have needed to go to the printers hence just the online version is available for this game.

With a potential short term return to work for myself looking likely, alongside my Wiltshire Senior League duties, thankfully there are just a few more programmes needed for the First Team and just the one more for the Ladies now this season. After so long doing the programmes, it is also probably time to consider looking to see if anyone else is interested in helping out with a view to eventually taking over the programmes, to provide a fresh approach to their production. If there is anyone out there who is interested in either taking over next season or assisting with the preparation of Match Day programmes in some way next season, please get in touch.

We hope you enjoy today's game and, whilst a stiff challenge, it would be good if the Ladies could become the first side this season to win at home in the league against Torquay United.

Under 18s clinch runners-up in Wiltshire League Floodlit Division



Congratulations to Royal Wootton Bassett Town Under 18s who clinched runners-up spot in the Wiltshire League Floodlit Division! Bassett secured second place with a come-from-behind victory against Pewsey Vale in their final league game of the season at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground.

Needing a win to make certain that they could not be caught by third place Melksham Town, Bassett endured a nervy opening 45 minutes. While the first half ended goalless, the tension was ratcheted up early in the second period when visitors Pewsey - who had held Nick Warren's side to a 3-3 draw when they met earlier in the season - took the lead, Thomas Holdstock firing in after good build up play down the left.

But Bassett produced the required response. Joey Warren hit a shot into the bottom corner of the net from the edge of the box to equalise. Warren then created what turned out to be the winning goal, his powerful run through midfield initiating a move that eventually saw the ball fall to Kevin Prouse on the edge of the six-yard box and the side's leading scorer steered home for his ninth of the season. The result ensured Bassett did not finish an excellent season empty-handed.

With their 2-0 victory against Radstock Town on Thursday, Devizes Town claimed top spot. And the title ultimately came down to Devizes' 4-0 triumph against Bassett at the end of January - a result that left Bassett needing to win out at the same time as hoping their rivals slipped up elsewhere if they were to finish in first.

Last week's narrow 2-1 defeat away against Calne Town in their penultimate fixture then as good as extinguished those hopes - and also endangered Bassett's chances of finishing second.

Victory against Pewsey was therefore required to ensure Melksham were unable to have the opportunity to pip them as the best of the rest. With the pressure on though, Bassett delivered.

In achieving runners-up spot, the team become the fifth Bassett side to claim Floodlit League honours. Alongside the 2010-11 champions, Bassett previously finished as runners-up in 2005-06, 2011-12 and 2015-16. Congratulations, again, to the team on an excellent season and outstanding achievement.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town Ladies' latest fixture in their seemingly interminable run of away fixtures saw them suffer a heavy 5-0 defeat against Torquay United Women

Bassett's hopes of taking anything from the game - and closing the gap between themselves and the Gulls in the South West Regional Women's Football League Premier Division - we're all but extinguished before the interval as Torquay raced into a 4-0 half time lead.

While Bassett fared better after the restart, they were unable to grab a consolation with Torquay eventually rounding off the scoring.

On target for the hosts were Ellie Bishop (2), Katie Barriball, Bethany Everson and Esme Kilburn-Thompson.

Bassett's run of six straight away games to start the calendar year finally ends next week when the side travel to Middlezoy Rovers - team Graham Fletcher's side will be hoping to beat for the second time this season.

That game also serves as an opportunity to restore some confidence ahead of home fixtures with Torquay and their fellow high-flyers AFC St Austell to finish the season.

While only truly outplayed in their trip to Torquay, Bassett's road odyssey has been a trying one, yielding just three points - in a series of fixtures that has seen Bassett slip into mid-table.

The goal now will be to finish on a highand ensure the team's first completed season at step five of the women's football pyramid ends with a top half finish.

Opponents History

Torquay United Football Club men's side was originally formed in 1899. After first joining the East Devon League in 1900, the club then went on to join the Torquay & District League, becoming champions of that league in 1909. Encouraged by Plymouth Argyle and Exeter City turning professional, the people of Torquay were eager for United to join forces with the town's two other prominent football teams. Babbacombe and Ellacombe, with a view to creating a third professional club within Devon. Although Babbacombe rejected the idea of a merger, Torquay United and Ellacombe agreed to pool their resources and formed Torquay Town in 1910. Town won the Devon Senior Cup in their first season and became champions of the Plymouth & District League the following vear.

Despite a fierce rivalry existing between Torquay Town and Babbacombe, the two clubs were finally amalgamated in 1921 and the newly combined team reverted to the name of Torquay United and were admitted into the Western League. After one season in the Western League, United joined the Southern League and, after becoming champions of the Western Section, were elected into the Football League at the expense of Aberdare Athletic in 1927

Torquay United remained in the Football League up until the end of the 2006-07 Season when they were relegated to the Conference League. During the time in the Football League, other than Devon county cup competitions, honours were limited. In Season 1956-57 they finished as runners-up to Ipswich Town on goal average in Division 3 South, the closest they had come to a league title whilst in the Football League. The team generally spent their time in the bottom division of the Football League but did have a few season's in the third tier of the league. The club fell out of the Football League after finishing bottom

of the re-branded League 2 at the end of 2006-07 when they were relegated to the Football Conference.

On this occasion they were to spend just two seasons in non-league football as they secured promotion back to the Football League after finishing 4th and defeating Cambridge United in the Conference playoff final. They were to spend five seasons back in the football League but were relegated back to the Conference at the end of Season 2013-14 after again finishing bottom. Things were to get worse though as they were relegated down to National League South at the end of Season 2017-18. However, under the management of Gary Johnson they bounced back straight away winning the National League South title by 10 points over runners-up Woking to secure their first league title of any kind since 1926-27 at the end of last season.

They are now playing in the top tier of non-league football and will be keen to regain that Football League status as soon as possible.

Torquay United have run a women's side for a number of seasons now and we have been able to trace statistical information regarding their record since Season 2013-14. That specific season was a successful one for the Ladies Section of the club as they won the South West Regional Women's League Western Division 1 title losing just one league game all season to gain promotion to the Premier Division. They have remained in the Premier Division ever since securing a third place finish in their first season, Season 2014-15 and again in Season 2017-18. The two Covid impacted seasons saw them struggle and in both seasons were bottom of the table when the seasons were brought to a premature end. In complete contrast to those two difficult seasons the current season sees them top of the league and challenging for the league title.

Ladies Match Report

High-scoring, closely fought thrillers have been the order of the day throughout the 2021-22 season for Royal Wootton Bassett Town Ladies. And their return to action following the Christmas break was no different as Bassett shared six goals with current South West Regional Women's Football League Premier Division leaders Sherborne Town in another goalfest.

The first ever competitive meeting between the teams was a hugely entertaining see-saw battle. Bassett twice went ahead only to be pegged back by Sherborne. The visitors then earned their first lead of the afternoon, but were unable to hold on for the win as Bassett snatched a late equaliser.

Both teams will feel as though they could have taken victory. However, Bassett will perhaps be the ones kicking themselves the most as they passed up an opportunity to pull within three points of their opponents with a game in hand still to play. Instead, they remain six points behind Sherborne, dropping a place to fourth after Torquay United's big victory

against Middlezoy Rovers.

Bassett found themselves in front shortly before the 20 minute mark as Libby Davies grabbed the first of what would ultimately be another hat trick - her fifth of the season. She owed a great debt to the work of teammates Holly Baker and Hayley Huckin, whose great build up play set the forward up.

Sherborne got back on terms ten minutes before the break though as the visitors seized possession in midfield and a quick break ended in Ali Scott-Sheppard producing a fine finish as she spotted Bassett 'keeper Millie Powell off her line.

The game's next goal arrived on the hour as Huckin and Lani Dickinson linked up well, with the latter threading a precise pass to Davies, who rounded Emily Hall before slotting home.

However, Bassett's second lead of the day did not last long as Sherborne's Gemma Mountain punished the hosts for their sloppy play.

Mountain netted again late on to put Sherborne in pole position. But Bassett were quick to react and Davies (pictured below) made sure her side went home with a share of the spoils, scoring her third after latching onto captain Laura Jefferies' through ball.


