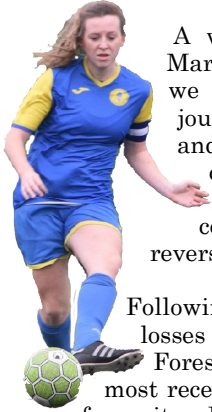

# Opponents History

Marine Academy Plymouth Ladies were formed at the start of the decade and are now well established in the South West Regional Women's Football League.

They are part of a chartered standard club that was awarded the South West charter standard club of the year for 2013 for its structure off the pitch and opportunities on it and has since been awarded community club status from the FA one of the few Devon clubs to achieve this status. The club has a thriving youth section.

The Ladies side started life in the South West Regional Women's Football League in Division 1 West and, after finishing as runners-up in Season 2013-14, they went one better the following season, winning the league and gaining promotion to the Premier Division at the same time. They have remained in the Premier Division ever since and have also been close to achieving promotion to the next level of the Women's Football pyramid, having finished as runners-up for three consecutive

seasons.

In Season 2018-19 they slipped to fourth place, their lowest ever finish and all in all they have an extremely impressive record in the Premier Division seasons that have been completed. Whilst the first of the two Covid interrupted seasons saw them near the bottom of the table, when last season was curtailed they sat top of the table with a 100% winning record from their three league games played. Overall their record in the Premier Division sees them winning 63.5% of their league fixtures in the top division.

Marine Academy Ladies have in their ranks one of the most prolific goal scorers in the league. Samantha Drewery has finished top scorer for MAP in seven of the last eight seasons and it could possibly have been longer as we have only been able to trace records from Season 2013-14 onwards. In the period since that 2013-14 Season Samantha has scored over 200 goals.

A late winner from Hannah Gulliver (pictured below) saw Royal Wootton Bassett Town Ladies snatch all three points against Marine Academy Plymouth as they came from behind to triumph 2-1 in a closely fought contest in Devon.

Bassett made it hard for themselves as their hosts created a string of chances throughout the second half, none of which they were able to convert. Having weathered that storm, Gulliver then rounded off a counter attack to seal her side's second win of the season.

The visitors did start the afternoon well enough, but they found themselves behind early on. With Bassett unable to clear from a corner, Sam Matters headed home at the far post for Marine Academy, the forward having expertly slipped away from her marker.

Bassett responded well though and were soon on level terms as Maddy Elliott found Libby Davies, who turned well before slotting past the onrushing 'keeper for her fourth of the still young season.

Davies and forward partner Poppy Wannell then had good opportunities to put Bassett ahead before half time but were unable to convert.

The hosts came out strongest following the restart and proved a constant threat. Bassett didn't help themselves as they struggled to clear their lines and maintain meaningful possession higher up the pitch. Yet, to their fortune, Marine Academy's profligacy in front of goal meant the scores remained level.

That was until seven minutes to go when Bassett broke from midfield. The ball was worked to Davies, who ventured forward before playing a dangerous cross into the box which Gulliver tucked away.

With their first lead of the afternoon, Bassett made sure it was one that they would keep hold of as they efficiently managed the remainder of the game to seal a hard earned three points.

However, Bassett were on level terms shortly after. Laura Jefferies swung in a trademark towering free kick from the left side and leading scorer Libby Davies flicked home a header into the bottom right corner.

The opening period delivered no further goals. But after the restart it did not take long for the floodgates to open.

Bassett were the side to strike first. After controlling a Jefferies free kick on the edge of the area, Davies twisted and turned as she sought to fashion space to shoot. As she did so, Rovers' captain Hattie Jones aimed to win the ball back but her tackle



served only to find a gap in her side's defence, allowing Amber Egerton to run in to pounce on the loose ball and fire home.

The visitors were then gifted an equaliser. Bassett failed to clear their lines and the ball fell to Jones, whose 25 yard shot slipped through the hands of 'keeper Millie Powell.

Two minutes later the visitors were ahead as Rucker raced onto a hopeful punt upfield, outmuscled Olivia Owenson and coolly slotted into the corner.

Trailing for a second time, Bassett were able to make it 3-3 with 25 minutes to go as Davies met a Jefferies free kick with another fine glancing header that nestled into the corner.

That meant a grandstand finish was on the cards. Unfortunately for Bassett though, it was the visitors who would strike two decisive blows.

Jones restored her side's lead with her second of the afternoon, scoring with a snap shot after Charlie Rowlands' low corner broke to her.

Hitchcox then sealed the win. Rowlands' slide rule pass split the Bassett defence and her strike partner latched onto the through ball before rounding an onrushing Powell and calmly slotting into the net from a tight angle.


