Welcome To Today's Game

Welcome to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this South West Regional Women's Football League fixture against Bishops Lydeard, who visit the Gerard Buxton Ground for the very first time. The two sides have met on just the one occasion previously, that fixture coming last season when we travelled to Bishops Lydeard and returned with a point following a 2-2 draw. A brief report on that game from last season is included in today's programme.

A warm welcome to all the players, management and supporters who have made the long journey from Bishops Lydeard today, we hope they enjoy their short stay with us this afternoon and we wish them a safe journey home.

Bishops Lydeard have lost both games in the league so far but we should not read too much into that with the defeats coming against league leaders St Austell who have won all four of their games to date and a much improved Torquay United who are also unbeaten in their opening four games. having won two and drawn two. Bishops Lydeard picked up their first win of the season last week, beating a Frampton Rangers side who are currently top of the South West Regional Northern Division having won all three of their league games to date. We will certainly need to all be at our best today if we are to secure a third league win of the season here today.

Last Week

Well that for us is the FA Cup over for another season as, not for the first time, we went out in our first game of the season in the competition. Whilst it is great to take part in this prestigious national competition, at the end of the day we have no change of winning it or getting close to playing any of the big clubs given the way

competition isstructured. Furthermore, unlike the men's equivalent, the rewards for taking part are currently nowhere near as lucrative for non-league sides. Our prize money for losing last week was £115 with the winners getting £450. Compare this to the men's equivalent where, depending on how you look at it given that the structure of the Ladies competition leads to fewer rounds, the equivalent round prize money in the men's competition for winning sides is either £5,625 or £3,375 and for losing sides either £1,875 or £1,125. Whilst sponsors for the two competitions will be a factor in the differing amounts available, hopefully over time there will be a convergence. It would also be good to see an improved structure within the Ladies competition that allows more teams from lower levels to have the chance to get through to play the big guns. At the moment they do not come in until the Fourth Round Proper (unlike the men's where it is the Third Round) and only when the other sides have been whittled down to just 20 teams across the country.

Having gone out of the FA Cup we can now concentrate on doing well in the league in what hopefully will be our first full and completed season at this level.

It is a busy period here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for the Ladies as, after today, we are home to Swindon Supermarine in the Wiltshire Senior Cup before meeting what looks to be a much improved Torquay United side in the league the following week.

Enjoy the game and hopefully another win for the Ladies.

Opponents In Focus

From the Club's website.....

Bishops Lydeard Association Football Club is an FA Charter Standard Community Club, that has a well-established youth section, senior section and girls/women's section with over 350 participants. The football club playing fields and clubhouse are located in the rural village of Bishops Lydeard, five miles north-west of Taunton, Somerset.

The club is over 100 years old and has recently developed into one of the largest clubs in the South West. Having played at various venues in the village is now firmly entrenched at Darby Way. Due to the growth of the club, youth, ladies, and extra men's sides, we had to expand our facilities in 1999 and now play on Morris Meadow, kindly rented to us by Mr. Morris. This is the field beside the main pitch. We also use the adjoining field, Glanfield Meadow — named after Mr. Glanfield who kindly sold us the land when he stepped away from farming.

In 1998 the adult and youth section joined forces to become one club. This held many advantages which you will see today when visiting the club. What was once a couple of men's sides, and an odd youth team run by an adult for the village kids has developed into football for the community at all ages and genders.

The senior side of the club has a very successful Ladies section which has been led by Julie Bowker since it was formed in 2001. We now have two ladies teams; the Firsts playing in the South West Women's Football League and the reserves in Somerset County Women's League. The adult men's teams are headed by the First team who play in the Somerset Senior Premier League; there is also a Reserve Team in the First Division of the Taunton & District Saturday Football League, and a newly formed Colts team

that play in Division 5 of the same league. The club has always looked to innovate; it was the first club in Somerset to achieve the FA Community Charter Status and has maintained this status since it was won in 2002. Being an FA Charter Standard Club means we have to maintain standards, both on and off the field. All coaches must take an FA Level 1 Coaching Course, a Children's Workshop (so they can be aware of, and identify, any child abuse taking place), and an FA First Aid qualification, plus they must all undergo a CRC check. This is all for the benefit of the young players in the club, to assist in their development and personal well-being. We also have a Club Welfare Officer. Mel Brown, who is responsible for liaising with the Somerset FA Welfare Officer, and ensuring best practice within the club.

In 2008 the clubs dream of developing an all-purpose club house to replace its 'Shack' was made reality when Iain Hunter formally announced that he had achieved the funding required to start the build after 5 years of meetings, fund raising and form filling. In January 2009 the whole club celebrated along with Iain when the then England Under 21 coach Stuart Pearce arrived at the club to formally cut the ribbon. This could not have been achieved without the club joining together as one. Over the period many an event was put on and enjoyed by the club members. Like all good TEAMS everybody pulled together with one objective, achieve the dream.

To coincide with the club house the committee made a decision to become a Community Interest Company. Why, to protect the assets for the future. The CIC prevents anyone from taking over the club and walking away with the money, instead any profits would have to be reinvested back into the club to provide suitable alternative facilities.

Opponents In Focus

This was key to the future as the club not only owned a half a million pound facility, it also owns land prime for development on the edge of the village green belt.

With increased ongoing expenses, rates, insurance, utilities, kit, training fees, coach qualifications, and so on, we needed to start to supplement what the players pay for membership. A fundraising committee was introduced! This committee still exists today and has one simple objective – 'Organise fundraising events to join the parents of the players to the club'. Annual events are published in our Club Handbook, please come along, bring your friends and enjoy the fun whilst supporting your club.

The philosophy of the club is to provide a safe and fun environment for the youth to train, practice, express themselves and play football. The same principle is applied to the adult section with one overriding difference — push players to play at the highest level they can. This will mean that BLAFC will ultimately lose players to a higher standard of football until we can match the level, something that is a constant topic of conversation on a Saturday afternoon between those who come and support.

Finally, BLAFC operate a strict code of conduct within the grounds of the club, there is a A frame as you walk towards the club house that details what we expect from everyone visiting BLAFC.

The hosts got back on level terms shortly after the restart as Berry tucked home from Amber Guy-Kemp's through ball.

But with no further scoring, Bassett ensured they ended a difficult week on a positive note.

It was goals galore in the Vitality Women's FA Cup at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground. Yet for Royal Wootton Bassett Town, there was unfortunately to be no glory.

Bassett wound up on the losing end of a thrilling second qualifying round tie as visitors Denham United held on to claim a 5-4 triumph.

A superb advert for women's football, the back-and-forth contest twice saw Denham threaten to runaway with the tie only for Bassett to storm back into contention. But, having once recovered from two goals down to get onto level terms, they came up just short in their attempt to do so a second time and ultimately missed out on forcing the game to penalties.

That meant elimination at the earliest opportunity for the second season running. But this was a display that showed the kind of spirit and determination that will serve Bassett well for the remainder of the season.

Denham raced into an early two goal advantage, both goals stemming from corners. The first saw Bianca Cuzuban convert in conventional fashion as she tapped in from the initial delivery into the box. Shortly after, Bassett thought they had cleared from another set piece delivery. But the ball fell to Kodi Spencer whose stunning long range strike sailed in. Bassett were able to halve their deficit on the half hour mark when Holly Baker (pictured) steered in after Amber Egerton flicked on a Laura Jefferies delivery.



But Denham soon made it 3-1 through debutant Daisy Baronowski, whose ball into the box from the deep skidded off the slick surface and bounced in over Bassett 'keeper Alice Farnell.

Just as the visitors had done in the opening half, Bassett stormed out of the blocks following the restart. Egerton headed in from a Jefferies corner to make it 3-2. Moments later Libby Davies raced onto a through ball played into the left channel before cutting inside and producing a neat finish low into the corner to equalise.

However, Denham restored their lead ten minutes later as Jo Torr netted as another set piece – this time a free kick – caused Bassett problems. Millie Congerton then grabbed their fifth as time began to wind down.

There was still enough left on the clock for Bassett to threaten another comeback though.

And captain Jefferies - a player who has featured in every game Bassett have ever played in the Women's FA Cup - lobbed the visiting 'keeper with a trademark, towering 30-yard free kick.
