Welcome To Tonight's Game

GOOD EVENING and welcome to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this UHlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against Fairford Town. A warm welcome to all our visitors who have made the journey from Fairford, we hope you enjoy your short stay with us this evening and we wish you a safe journey home.

Fairford currently sit 13th in the table having won six of their 16 league games to date. Whilst they have won six games they have only actually beaten four sides having done the league double already over both Tuffley Rovers and Lydney Town, the other two victories having come away at Bradford Town and at home to Chipping Sodbury Town.

Last season both tonight's sides won on their opponents ground, Bassett winning 2-0 at Fairford in October thanks to goals from Matt Bennett and Gio Wrona and Fairford winning here at the Sustain Stadium in February thanks to a very late goal. Fairford have the better record in games between the sides since we joined the Hellenic League, with 12 wins to our nine but hopefully we can erode that differential here tonight.

I understand we were not at our best last Saturday at Wellington in the FA Vase but all that really matters is that we went into the hat for the Third Round draw for the second season running. The draw was made on Monday and we will be home to fellow Hellenic League side Corsham Town. A preview of the tie is included on the next page of tonight's programme. At the time of writing steps are being taken to move the game to the Friday night to avoid clashing with a possible Round of 16 World Cup game that could involve England. The Tuffley Rovers game would also then need to be moved. Hopefully we will be able to confirm in next Tuesday's programme what the position is with regard to dates and kick-off times for both games.

The Development Team's fantastic unbeaten run under new manager Mark Simpkins

continued last Saturday with a 4-2 home win over Melksham Town Reserves to close the gap to the top six sides and extend that unbeaten run to ten games. With Melksham under new management and with some new signings on show it was a lot tougher game than some had been expecting. It was 1-1 at half time but a stern half time team talk seemed to do the trick and three good goals in the second half secured all three points. This week the Development team are away to Frome Collegians looking to avenge the 4-1 defeat they suffered on the opening day of the season here at the Sustain Stadium.

The Women's side were without a game on Sunday and return to action this Sunday when they make the short journey to Purton in the Wiltshire Women's County Cup. Purton are flying in the Wiltshire League and despite being two leagues lower will be stiff opposition for Bassett on Sunday. They have conceded just two goals in nine games whilst scoring 45 at the other end. The goals conceded came in a 3-2 win over Salisbury, one of the two sides Bassett have beaten this season (we won 3-0), so hopefully the Women's side can pick up another cup win this weekend but know they will need to be at their best to do so.

Finally, the club were deeply saddened to hear of the passing of Wiltshire Senior League Fixture Secretary Phil Cook after a short illness. Phil was a dedicated, much liked and highly respected individual who provided immense service to football in Wiltshire, having been Fixtures Secretary on the County's Senior League for 45 years. All the thoughts of everyone at Royal Wootton Bassett Town are with his wife and family at this sad time.

Enjoy tonight's game and hopefully we will be celebrating a big crowd and a win against our rivals from just over the border in Gloucestershire.

ISUZU FA VASE THIRD ROUND: BASSETT TO HOST CORSHAM IN WILTSHIRE DERBY

Royal Wootton Bassett Town have been handed a mouth-watering home derby fixture against Wiltshire and Hellenic League Premier Division rivals Corsham Town in the Isuzu FA Vase third round.

The tie is currently scheduled to take place at the Sustain Stadium on Saturday 3 December. Full details, including kick off time and admission prices, will be confirmed in due course.

On top of being a derby encounter, there will be extra spice added to the match given that both teams will be aiming to write club history, with neither Bassett nor Corsham having ever advanced beyond the Vase third round before.

Indeed, for both clubs this season is only the second occasion in which they have reached this stage.

For Bassett, it will be a welcome first home fixture in the competition after wins on the road against Bridport (5-3) and then Wellington (2-2, 5-4 on penalties).

While Sam Collier's side enjoyed an exemption to the first round, Corsham have already faced four fixtures in the Vase this season, recording three wins away from home during their impressive run.

After a 3-1 home triumph against Cove in the first qualifying round, the Quarrymen triumphed 6-5 on penalties following a 2-2 second qualifying round draw away at Brislington. They then saw off a second Western League side, thumping Keynsham Town 4-0 in the first round. On Saturday, Kieran Baggs' men were 3-1 winners in their second round fixture against fellow Hellenic Premier outfit Roman Glass St George.

Corsham last made it to the third round in 2006-07, recording wins against Harefield United and Amesbury Town before a loss away at Bideford. Since losing in the first round in 2007-08 and prior to this season, Corsham fell into a Vase rut, going beyond

the qualifying round stages just twice (where they were eliminated in the first round) in 14 Vase participations.

Corsham have more than made up for that recent dearth of Vase success this season though with a record-equaling run – and they'll no doubt be aiming to extend it further when they make the short trip to Bassett.

Like their visitors to be, Bassett have only found themselves in the third round once before too – that coming last season when the team were beaten 3-1 at home by Hamworthy United.

With club history again on the line, Collier and his side will be hoping to avoid a similar fate this time. Meanwhile, Bassett will be hoping to reverse a recent run that has seen Corsham win all three league meetings played between the teams since the Quarrymen joined the Hellenic League last season.

A win for Bassett will be their first against Corsham since a 2-1 triumph in the 2008-09 Wiltshire Senior Cup.

It promises to be a cracking tie – we look forward to hosting Corsham and hope to see a good crowd at the Sustain Stadium.

Opponents History

FAIRFORD TOWN

Fairford Town Football Club is a football club based in Fairford, Gloucestershire, England. Affiliated to the Gloucestershire County Football Association, they are currently members of the Hellenic League Premier Division and play at Cinder Lane.

The club was established in 1891 and prior to World War II they played in the Cirencester and District League. After the war they switched to the Swindon & District League, going on to win the Premier Division title and Advertiser Cup double in both 1964–65 and 1968–69. In 1970 the club moved up to Division One of the Hellenic League. In their first season in the league, the club finished third, missing out on promotion on goal average, also losing in the Division One Cup final. The following season they were placed in Division One A as league expansion led to there being two Division Ones. The club went on to win the title and the Division One Challenge Shield, earning

promotion to the Premier Division.

At the end of the 1973–74 season Fairford were relegated to Division One. However, after finishing as Division One runners-up in 1975–76, they were promoted back to the Premier Division. They finished as runners-up in 1978–79, also winning the Premier Division Cup. They were runners-up again the following season, which also saw them win the Gloucestershire Challenge Trophy. The club finished as Premier Division runners-up for a third time in 1990–91 and won the Gloucestershire Challenge Trophy again in 1998–99. They remained in the Premier Division until finishing second-from-bottom of the division in 2011–12 season, after which they were relegated to Division One West. In 2016–17 the club won Division One West, earning promotion back to the Premier Division.

Below par Bassett suffer late derby defeat

**Royal Wootton Bassett Town 20
Fairford Town 1**

Despite a disappointing performance that lacked any semblance of imagination or creativity, Royal Wootton Bassett Town appeared to be on course to claim a valuable point in their derby fixture against Fairford Town. Having got to the 90 minute mark with the game still goalless, all Bassett had to do to get something from the game was to see out injury time.

However, they failed that task. A combination of sloppiness in possession and slack defending allowed Fairford to launch a late counter from which they claimed a late, late penalty. And the Reds' leadings marksman Ross Langworthy - who had failed to find his range from open play up to that point - made no mistake from the spot, sending Eddie Cavanagh the wrong way to secure his side victory.

It was a three points that Fairford no doubt deserved. Were it not for the woodwork and some wasteful finishing, they would have been comfortably ahead at half time. Meanwhile, only once was their 'keeper Ben Mitchell called into serious action as he did enough to deny Sam Packer shortly before Fairford grabbed their winner.

For Bassett, the result is a deeply disappointing one. Starting the day four points behind Fairford with two games in hand, the match was a golden opportunity to acquire the upper hand over their rivals - who Sam Collier's side had beaten 2-0 away from home - as they jostle for position in mid-table. Now though Bassett's deficit is stretched to seven points - and with Roman Glass St George beating Brimscombe and Thrupp, any hopes of a top half finish now appear to be over.

Battling for a place in the top ten may not exactly be the most thrilling of targets at this time of the season. But with that to aim for as well as league double over local rivals, this was a contest that required a performance far better than the one that was delivered.

Bassett started reasonably well, despite having to play into a fierce first half wind. Indeed, John Mills' fourth minute effort that he sent narrowly over was the only opportunity of note in the game's opening quarter.

But the match quickly descended into a scrappy battle. And it was one that Fairford gained the upper hand in as their three man midfield crowded out Bassett's hopes of playing through the lines. As a result Bassett were unable to sustain possession for any meaningful periods.

Playing with the wind behind them also meant Fairford enjoyed territorial advantage. And that should really have yielded at least one goal.

For the final twenty minutes of the half, they had Bassett on the ropes. Somehow, however, a goal was not forthcoming. An unmarked Langworthy fluffed his lines as he dragged wide from twelve yards after a square ball from Ian Herring. Danny Gudger then raced onto a Langworthy flick on only to be denied by a point blank parry from an alert Cavanagh.

Fairford had their best opportunity eight minutes before the break. A Bassett corner came to nothing and after Gio Wrona was dispossessed on the edge of the box a ball over the top set free Langworthy, who comfortably had beaten Dave Bampton for pace. Clean through on goal, the forward sought to slot the ball into the bottom corner only to see his effort come back off the post.

A minute later, it was Gudger's turn to be inches away from opening the scoring but he could only steer into the side netting after being picked out by Peare's defence splitting pass. Langworthy then had another half chance. Seizing on a Cavanagh fumble following Ian Herring's delivery into the box, the forward sought to guide home from an angle but - like Gudger - could only pick out the side netting.

Having dodged those bullets, Bassett kept Fairford at bay for the majority of the second half. Not that that led to the hosts exerting any pressure of their own. Having already lost Tommy Ouldrige to injury after just 20 minutes, the withdrawal of Bailey Gallagher early in the second period meant Bassett lacked any real presence out wide, while Fairford's strength in numbers meant they continued to hold the upper hand in the middle of the park.

The game did open up somewhat as it entered the final ten minutes. Langworthy continued to have a frustrating day as he failed to locate the target after receiving Harvey Skurek's pass inside from the left wing. Bassett then almost went ahead with just three minutes to go when Packer met a Mills flick on from Macauley Dodson's cross with a diving header that a diving Mitchell managed to hold onto.

Still, despite those opportunities, the game seemed destined to finish goalless. That was until Fairford seized upon Wrona's loose pass and launched a break. Substitutes Tom Gollodge and Mason Thompson linked up down the right, with the latter narrowly beating the offside trap before crossing into the box. Will Davidson initially controlled the ball, but the defender dwelt too long before attempting to clear. By that point Langworthy had been able to nip in front of the defender and was clumsily brought down. The forward duly dusted himself off and - putting behind his earlier woes - confidently swept the spot kick home.

It was a painful way for Bassett to lose - but the result, a disappointing and frustrating one from the hosts' perspectives, was a fair reflection of the game.

Man of the match: Eddie Cavanagh - the 'keeper could do little to keep out the penalty but produced Bassett's standout individual moment of the match with his fine reflex save to keep out Danny Gudger.

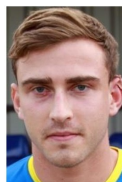

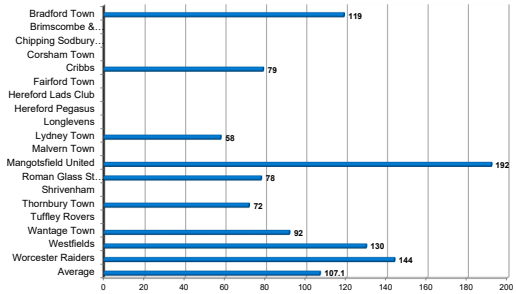

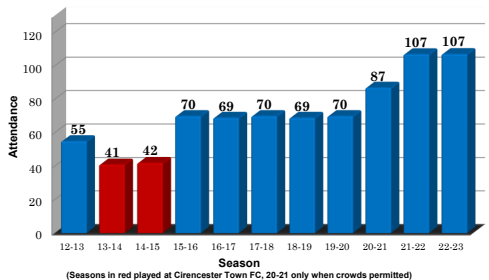

Comeback kings spot on in Vase nailbiters

**Wellington 2
Royal Wootton Bassett Town 2**

(Bassett win 5-4 on penalties)

In reaching the FA Vase third round last season, Royal Wootton Bassett Town were record-breakers. Now, after a late equaliser and a 5-4 win on penalties away at Wellington, that mark has quickly been equalled.

Bassett's shootout victory capped the end to an enthralling, old-fashioned cup tie. In many respects, it was an unfair way for a winner and loser to be determined. But that is football – and both sides can ultimately be proud of the part they played in a game that had plenty to offer the lively crowd that gathered in south Somerset.

Yet again this season, Sam Collier's side were forced to overcome adversity – in the form of injuries and a deficit. But the team's character, drive and never give up attitude pulled them through and ultimately delivered another fine Vase triumph.

Bassett did lead after Tommy Ouldrige curled a fine effort from an acute angle into the top right corner after Rhys Talmash had done brilliantly to fend off the attention of Jason Quick and feed Alfie Presley, whose shot was parried into Ouldrige's path by Harley Wilkinson.

By half time, however, Wellington were in front, with Bassett also forced into an early change as captain Ouldrige was forced to withdraw.

The home side reacted strongly to going behind – and shortly after Jake Quick flicked a header wide from an Eli Collins cross, they found an equaliser.

After Miles Quick's low ball in from the left, Kelson Pollard struck a fierce drive that smashed into Dave Bampton at point blank range. The loose ball then fell to Henry Woodward who arrowed into the bottom right corner from the edge of the area, leaving Matt Crowther no chance.

Bassett then spurned a pair of quality chances.

On the half hour mark, Talmash latched onto a delicate Matt Jones free kick delivery and, with Wilkinson drawn to the post, cut the ball back across the six only to see no teammate gambling to be in position to apply what would have been a tap in finish.

Eight minutes later, Talmash found himself one-on-one with Wilkinson after substitute Bailey Gallagher's block set him free, but the forward could only shoot straight at the home shotstopper.

While Bassett were wasteful, Wellington proved to be clinical. On the stroke of half time, Jack Bown-Porter launched a long throw from the right side into the box and with only his side's third shot of the match, Jake Quick registered his team's second goal as he produced a fine snap finish on the turn into the top corner.

Given Bassett had been playing up the significant slope, being 2-1 behind at the break was not necessarily the worst position to be in at the interval. But Bassett boss Collier was deeply unsatisfied with the way his team had been playing, launching into a fierce half time team talk.

His strong words did provoke a reaction as Bassett enjoyed the majority of possession throughout the second half. But, frustratingly, they found themselves unable to find the needed break through.

A great early chance fell to an unmarked Jones as he got on the end of a teasing Louis Spalding cross only to head wide at the near post.

Wellington were now content to sit deep, but they did have a pair of half chances with Woodward forcing Crowther into a jumping save and Jake Quick steering narrowly wide with a speculative shot from the edge of the area after a quick Bown-Porter throw.

However, play was largely centred at the other end of the pitch. But an equaliser seemed as though it was going to elude Bassett, who thus seemed on course to exit the competition as Wellington – partly through winding down the clock at every possible opportunity, but primarily thanks to their watertight defensive play – soaked up the significant pressure they found themselves under.

Eventually though, with nine minutes remaining Bassett got the breakthrough they needed and which their perseverance deserved.

Exploiting space in the left channel, the ball was worked out to Jones who fizzed in a low delivery across the six-yard box, which home defender Jason Quick – under pressure from emergency centre forward Landon Golding – bundled into his own net.

The momentum was now fully with Bassett, but more late pressure failed to yield a

winner, forcing penalties.

Wellington won the toss and were first up, but Stefan Phillips rattled the post. Matt Jones then sent Wilkinson the wrong way to put Bassett in front – and it was an advantage they would not relinquish.

With Sam Towler and Miles Quick scoring Wellington's second and third spot kicks, Talmash and Chris Taylor both had Wilkinson guessing wrong to make it 3-2. Bown-Porter then made it three in a row for the hosts before there were nervous gasps when Wilkinson got a hand on Spalding's penalty, but the ball squeezed in to keep Bassett ahead going into the fifth round of the shootout.

Collins scored to keep Wellington alive. However, Golding was calmness personified, confidently sweeping home to send Bassett through.

Man of the match: Kai Robinson – the midfielder put in a super shift, battling away for the entire 90 minutes. Wellington made it tough for Bassett, but Robinson's energy and pressing were vital, especially in the second half as his side sought to get back on level terms.



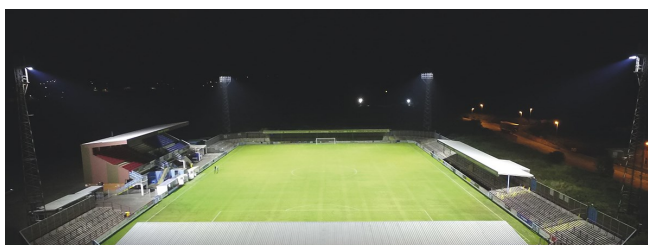

There are goals and there are Goals. Those shots, screamers, headers, volleys, even tap-ins and the somehow-bundled-over-the-lines that will be forever remembered.

Sometimes it's by an individual fanbase, where a goal and its scorer are immortalised in club history and legend.

Just think back to the weekend just gone in the FA Cup. Alvechurch's Danny Waldron scoring twice as they beat Cheltenham Town in the first round, or Gold Omatayo's towering header as King's Lynn Town dumped out Doncaster Rovers.

Or how about Joe Hanks' audacious backheel that saw Chippenham Town past League One Lincoln City.

On the other end of a result were South Shields, their fine efforts against Forest Green Rovers finally ended in the last seconds by Connor Whickham's incredible lob from the halfway line.

In their own way, those goals will also be immortalised in FA Cup history – just like Sean Raggett's header for Lincoln City when the Imps knocked out Burnley on their way to the quarter-finals, Scott Rendell scoring for Luton against Norwich City, Matt Hanlon's Sutton strike or Tim Buzaglo's Woking hat-trick heroics over West Brom.

It's what makes the competition at these early stages special. Players catapulted into the

spotlight for producing something on the big stage, often in the biggest game of their lives.

Of course, different goals will have more meaning to some than others. That's the nature of football.

But the majority of us will also have those favourite goals scored for clubs we have no such attachment too – or moments that are instantly recognisable.

Even those of us who were still to land on this planet, Ronnie Radford's goal for Hereford United against Newcastle United is surely one of, if not the, most iconic goal in the FA Cup.

It transcends Hereford's history. It was poignant his sad death came in the week that the Bulls played Portsmouth on live TV to get the first round proper underway.

The fans unveiled a banner featuring the commentary words that accompanied the goal, former team-mates spoke of their memories and manager Josh Gowling was one of many others to pay tributes to not only a club great, but a player who made his mark on the beautiful game.

Newcastle United, forever associated with the Hereford humbling, tweeted out their own message of condolence. After all, it wasn't just a goal.

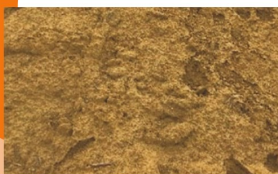

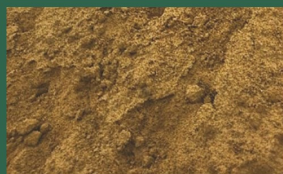
