Men's First Team Bassett Bulletin Welcome To Today's Game

GOOD AFTERNOON

welcome to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Uhlsport Hellenic League fixture against Corsham Town. A warm welcome to all our visitors who have made the short journey from Corsham, we hope you enjoy your short stay with us this afternoon and we wish you a safe journey home.

To all our players, committee members, volunteers, sponsors and spectators I hope you all had a wonderful Christmas and that Santa brought you what you asked for. Hopefully he will also deliver for Sam and the lads here today.

Today represents our first league fixture in Christmas week for five years, the last time we had games in Christmas week was way back in Season 2017-18 when we played Highmoor Ibis on Saturday 23rd December and then near neighbours Highworth Town on Boxing Day.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town and Corsham Town met for the second time this season at the beginning of the month in the FA Vase in a tight contest that saw penalties needed to decide who progressed to the next round. Unfortunately for us we were on the wrong side of the shootout result and it is Corsham who will now meet Deal Town at home on 14th January 2023. Corsham has also won the first league meeting between the sides this season, winning 1-0 at the Southbank Ground.

Corsham's only game since that last meeting between the sides in the FA Vase was in the Wiltshire Premier Shield where they were beaten 3-1 by Salisbury FC. At the time of writing these notes they sit sixth in the league table with games in hand over all the five teams above them. They have lost just two of the sixteen league games played so far this season.

Whilst over the years our record against Corsham Town is a decent one that is not the case in recent meetings, with just one win in the last six games for us. Both meetings between the two sides this season have had elements of controversy in them with us having had a player sent off on both occasions. Hopefully that trend will not continue here this afternoon and the game will be played in the right spirit worthy of the time of the year.

For all of Royal Wootton Bassett Town's teams, the start to the 2022-23 season has been an especially busy one with games coming thick and fast. For most sides, there's at least a chance over the Christmas period to have a well-earned rest - though not for the Men's First Team who will look to maintain their strong start with two home fixtures starting here today and on 2 January when they play league leaders Malvern Town.

Media Officer Stuart Smedley has reflected on the first half of the season for all of our teams, which for a number of teams has been a successful campaign so far - with plenty of work for all to do, and no room for complacency, in 2023. Today's programme includes a review for each of our various sections across the programme.

Over the past couple of campaigns, Royal Wootton Bassett Town's Men's First Team could justifiably have been criticised as being cup specialists and league underachievers. So far this season, however, things have been different with Sam Collier's side enjoying the team's best start to a Hellenic League Premier Division while also performing well again on the cup front.

As far as the First Team are concerned, Bassett find themselves inside the top half in eighth place at Christmas and are well placed to push for the club's highest ever finish at this level. Highlights of the campaign so far include the league double over Bradford Town - including a stunning 5-0 away win - and the trio of impressive come from behind home draws against title-chasing Cribbs and the muchfancied Westfield and Worcester Raiders. Indeed, Sam and his side have been so competitive that all five league defeats suffered so far have come by just a single goal, including away against promotion challengers Malvern Town.

Bassett's record could be even better given the throwaway home loss against Wantage Town and the draws against the likes of Chipping Sodbury Town, Lydney Town and Fairford Town where we perhaps should have taken all three points. But having played 29 games in all competitions in a frenetic opening few months, it's been mightily impressive how rare off days have been

In national cup action. Bassett can again look back on a successful year. In the Emirates FA Cup. Bassett saw off Windsor 2-0 in an Extra Preliminary Round replay before impressively taking down Reading City 3-1 in the Preliminary Round and then pushing Southern League outfit Paulton Rovers close in a 4-2 First Qualifying Round defeat. Meanwhile, in the Isuzu FA Vase, last year's record breaking run enabled Bassett to avoid the lottery of the qualifying rounds. Dramatic away wins at Bridport (5-3) and Wellington (5-4 on penálties after a 2-2 draw) meant Bassett reached the Third Round again. There, Sam and the lads suffered an agonising loss on penalties against today's opponents Corsham Town after a tense 0-0 draw. Bassett will look back on that afternoon with a sense of what could have been, as a place in the last 32 - and a first appearance in a nonregionalised round - was firmly within Bassett's reach. At least Bassett should benefit from another exemption to the First Round next season.

Elsewhere, Bassett also lost on penalties against Mangotsfield United in the Wiseman Lighting Hellenic League Floodlit Cup, missing out on a Quarter Final place. With a First Round loss in the Wiltshire Premier Shield, that means - outside of the league - Bassett now have an interest in just the Bluefin Sports Challenge Cup, where they will host Shrivenham in the Second round on 10 January.

As this is the last home game of 2022 I will end these programme notes wishing everyone best wishes for a happy and prosperous New Year in 2023

Enjoy today's game and hopefully three vital points against one of the top sides in the division.

Opponents History CORSHAM TOWN

The earliest record found of Corsham Football Club is 1878 with the club becoming affiliated to the Football Association in 1893. Over the years, the team has often been referred to as the Quarrymen due to the high level of quarrying in and around Corsham.

In March 1894, the first Wiltshire Football League was formed with the original member clubs being Bradford, Calne, Chippenham, Corsham, Southbroom (Devizes), Melksham, Trowbridge Town, and Warminster. At the end of the 1894/95 season Corsham would be the inaugural champions, winning the league on goal average over Southbroom, helped by an emphatic 17 - 1 win over Calne in their final game.

Promotion was achieved to the Western League at the end of the 1997/98 season after winning the county league by goal difference from Devizes Town Reserves.

Ground improvements continued under the chairmanship of Colin Hudd, floodlights were installed in 2001, a 112 spectator stand erected and hard standing laid around the pitch perimeter.

2006/07 season saw Corsham Town winning the Western League Premier Division, which was hotly contested by many teams.

including Bridgwater Town and Frome Town. The club also added a third successive Wiltshire Senior Cup victory, again over local rivals Melksham Town.


Due to the Covid pandemic the 2019/20 season was declared null and void by the Football Association on 26th March 2020.

Justin Flowers and his backroom staff parted with the club at the end of the null and void 2019/20 season and moved across to Malmesbury Victoria.

The 2020/21 season saw Keiran Baggs becoming the new manager with Gary Higdon as his assistant. Unfortunately, after 10 league games the 2020/21 was curtailed by the FA due to the Covid pandemic.

Despite the last two seasons being affected by Covid, the FA went ahead with planned restructuring of the Non-League Pyramid. The results from 2019/20 & 2021/21 were combined and this meant that Corsham Town finished in a position for upward movement.

The club took this upward movement to Step 5 with a lateral movement in the Hellenic League Premier Division.

RWBTFC v CORSHAM TOWN

Saturday 6th March 1999 Simon Heads For Final

Wootton Bassett Town 2 Corsham Town 1

From The Evening Advertiser, Tuesday March 8th 1999

Wootton Bassett reached the final of the Wilts Senior Cup beating Corsham Town 2-1 in an exciting semi-final played at Chippenham Town's ground.

Corsham had the edge for the first 20 minutes and Bassett were forced to defend for long periods. However as the game progressed Bassett came more into the game and 10 minutes before the break following a good move Jeremy Newton cut inside the Corsham defence to score.

Three minutes later Corsham were on level terms when a free kick from the edge of the area was well stopped by Bassett keeper Tom Fuller but the ball ran free for Rob Humphries to score from the rebound.

After the break Corsham once again had the better of the opening session, Fuller making several good saves in the Bassett goal.

Ten minutes from time Wootton Bassett snatched the winner when a long throw was flicked on for Simon Green to score with a looping header over the Corsham keeper.

Internal Club Match Report on this game (author not known)

Bassett took a while to settle into this Senior Cup Semi Final and it was Western League side Corsham Town who had the best of the encounter for the first 25 minutes. When Bassett finally started to get their game together Micky Goodwin was the first to almost score when after 27 minutes he attempted to chip the Corsham keeper but only narrowly missed the target. On the half hour, Richard Merchant narrowly missed with

a good effort. With 10 minutes of the half remaining Jeremy Newton, who up until then had been somewhat subdued, collected the ball just over the halfway line, attacked the defenders and unleashed a powerful drive which beat the Corsham keeper to give Bassett a 1-0 lead. Bassett had defended well to keep Corsham at bay but with 3 minutes of the half remaining, Corsham equalised from a free kick from just outside the penalty area.

Corsham again had the best of the spoils in the opening minutes of the second half and it needed a first class point blank save from the somewhat 'lardy' Tom Fuller in the Bassett goal after 3 minutes to keep Bassett in the game and from that point it was an evenly contested half which was delicately poised and some resolute and at times desperate defending by both sides ensured the scores remained level with extra time looking a distinct probability. With 12 minutes of the game remaining and following some extended Bassett pressure, Simon Green headed the ball home following a corner to give Bassett a 2-1 lead. Although Corsham responded well they were not able to break down the Bassett defence in which skipper Simon Green was outstanding. With 3 minutes remaining, further pressure from Bassett earned them a free kick 25 yards from goal and Paul Harper's well-placed kick was tipped over the bar by the Corsham keeper.

Not a classic game but on the day Bassett did enough to ensure they secured a place in the County Cup final.

Corsham won 4-3 pens

For the second season in a row Royal Wootton Bassett Town suffered a heartbreaking defeat in the FA Vase third round.

While a narrow 3-1 loss against Hamworthy United ended last year's record breaking run, the manner of defeat in this season's record equalling journey was more painful as Sam Collier's side lost 4-3 on penalties to Corsham Town after having pushed their Wiltshire and Hellenic League rivals all the way in a tense 90 minutes of football that ended goalless.

Knowing they were in for a battle against powerful, strong opponents, Collier set his side up in a relatively defensive formation. Wanting to keep things tight at the back, those tactics were executed diligently and paid off during the opening period which - for the most part - passed without any significant action in front of goal.

The game finally started to open up in the final stages of the half though, with the first proper chance falling to the visitors' Ryan Bath, who sliced wide of the mark after a free kick fell to him in the box.

Mark Cooper then hooked just off target following Nathan Davis' long throw, while at the other end Jack Hobson-McVeigh came close, steering a low effort inches wide of the left post after Alfie Presley's low corner bounced around in the box.

Corsham soon had the best opportunity of the game so far in stoppage time following a slip from 'keeper Matt Crowther after he had came out of his area to try and deal with a ball over the top. But, first, a sliding tackle from Chris Taylor then a block from Adam Corcoran and, finally, a parry from Crowther saved Bassett from going into the break a

goal down as the visitors were unable to take advantage of having multiple bites at the cherry.

As tense and tight as the opening half was, the second was more open.

Again, however, neither team was able to make the decisive breakthrough.

Three minutes after the restart Dan Demkiv steered across the face of goal from a tight angle following a square ball into the six yard box from his brother Callum after Corsham were able to break the Bassett offside trap.

Shortly after, an unmarked Dan Demkiv headed wide from a Davis delivery before Bath went close again with an effort from the edge of the box that was inches wide of the post.

Both sides were at this point getting desperate as it appeared one goal would perhaps be enough to decide the tie.

Bassett had their best spell of the game around the hour mark as Matt Bennett skewed a glancing header wide from twelve yards following Louis Spalding's teasing cross. A defensive lapse then presented Alfie Presley with a golden opportunity as he found space between the centre halves to receive Tommy Ouldridge's weighted delivery from the right, but a slip when he just had the 'keeper to beat put paid to his hopes of opening the scoring.

At the other end, Bassett survived a pair of goalmouth scrambles - the first following a corner, the second from a right-wing cross to the near post.

A Matt Jones corner almost saw Bassett snatch a goal. Sam Jepson came off his line to claim and came up empty-handed, allowing Luke Whelan to redirect the ball to the far post with the 'keeper stranded. However, Corcoran could only head over.

Corsham then could have snatched a winner on the break when Matt Jenkins was played in behind the defence, but a great recovery run from Jowan Partridge applied enough pressure to force the visitors' substitute to skew wide when he probably should have done better.

Although play continued to go from end to end, that would be the final real opportunity in front of goal - but it wasn't to be the last moment of drama in normal time as Golding received a controversial red card following an altercation in the visitors' box.

There wasn't enough time for that numerical disadvantage to do Bassett any harm though as the referee soon blew the final whistle.

That meant penalties. But, unlike away at Wellington in the previous round, Bassett would not come out on top.

Bassett went first with Taylor finding the net, the ball just squeezing past Jepson who guessed correctly. Matt Swann then levelled before what proved to be a decisive second and third round of kicks. Partridge - superb at centre half and Bassett's man of the match - saw his effort saved by Jepson. And although Crowther kept out Davis' subsequent effort, Jepson gave his side the advantage as he denied Spalding.

Matt Groves put Corsham ahead - and it was a lead his side would not surrender. Hobson-McVeigh and Presley scored to make sure it came down to the last penalty. However Leon Greenland and - with the deciding spot kick - Dan Demkiv converted, meaning it was Corsham who were the side writing history as they advanced to the fourth round for the first time.

It was a superb effort from start to finish from Bassett - but ultimately it wasn't to be.

Penalties are a cruel way to lose. However, Bassett can take heart from a gutsy display - and another successful run in the Vase.



Just days after losing on penalties in the FA Vase, Royal Wootton Bassett Town suffered the exact same fate in the Wiseman Lighting Floodlit Cup as Sam Collier's side were eliminated in their round of sixteen tie against Mangotsfield United.

After a rather lifeless ninety minutes of football ended goalless, the visitors triumphed 4-2 in the shootout to book their place in the quarter finals and end what was arguably Bassett's best opportunity to claim silverware this season.

Illness and injury forced Sam Collier into multiple changes for the contest, and both the Bassett boss and his assistant manager Alan Griffin - named as substitutes - found themselves on the pitch before the end of the game.

Indeed, Griffin would be Bassett's first penalty taker but failed to convert. Jon Beeden and Matt Jones did find the net before Jack Hobson-McVeigh missed Bassett's fourth penalty. Mangotsfield were three for three by that point and remained perfect to claim the win with their fourth kick.

Bassett now retain an interest in just one cup competition - that being the Bluefin Sports Hellenic League Challenge Cup in which they will host Shrivenham in the second round in mid -January.

Gallagher slides away winner as Bassett record rare Wantage victory

Wantage Town 0 Royal Wootton Bassett Town 1

Bailey Gallagher scored the only goal of the game as Royal Wootton Bassett Town recorded a vital - and rare - victory away against Wantage Town.

Bassett's record against the Alfredians is a miserable one, with 23 previous Hellenic League meetings yielding just four wins and nineteen defeats - including a dramatic 3-2 loss back in September when Wantage came from 2 -0 down to claim all three points at the Sustain Stadium.

This time, however, it was a different story as a gutsy display in difficult conditions from Sam Collier's side saw Bassett keep a clean sheet and snatch an all-important winner.

Making the result more impressive was that Bassett were much changed too as a consequence of injuries and illness: Jadyn Mundle was drafted in at the last minute to make his debut in goal, Jon Beeden made his first start in a long time, while Bassett operated without a natural centre forward. Still though they managed to prevail.

The heavy rain that had followed the recent cold snap had made the Alfredian Park pitch boggy and heavy, and resulted in a tricky first half as Bassett also played against the slope.

Wantage thus had Bassett under significant pressure throughout the opening period, earning numerous free kicks in dangerous positions and throwing a number of dangerous balls into the box. But fantastic defending from the visitors - led by Beeden and Adam Corcoran - meant that they got through the opening 45 minutes unscathed, with Wantage

failing to convert the significant possession and territorial advantage they had into any serious opportunities.

Going down the slope after the restart, Bassett were finally able to exert some control over the game, with this allowing midfield playmakers Chris Taylor, Tommy Ouldridge and Jack Hobson-McVeigh to get on the ball far more.

And eventually that led to the crucial moment in the game. Gallagher had started as a substitute and only been brought on with 25 minutes remaining. But it was an impact substitution from Collier, with the Bassett boss playing his cards right. By introducing Gallagher's fresh legs and skill, it gave Wantage - starting to tire something else to think about.

The move for the goal started with Alfie Presley holding the ball up well and, after a quick turn, he played in a pass over the top for Gallagher to run onto. Gallagher still had a defender in the form of Michael Miller to beat, but he turned his former teammate inside out before shifting the ball onto his left foot and producing a composed finish beyond home 'keeper James Foster.

Having fallen behind, Wantage sought desperately to get back onto level terms. But Bassett defended diligently, successfully seeing off the pressure the hosts exerted, including successive corners in the final moments of the match.

The result means Bassett move up to eighth in the Hellenic League Premier Division - where they will sit at Christmas, three points ahead of tenth place Wantage who have played three games more.

While Bassett's recent form has been solid with impressive league draws against high-flying Westfields and Worcester Raiders as well as consecutive clean sheets in their two most recent cup fixtures, the lack of a league win since a 2-1 triumph against Bradford Town on 18 October had put the team in danger of dropping into the bottom half.

Now though, there is some breathing room albeit with plenty of work still to do in order to secure a first ever top half finish at Step Five.

POSTPONEMENTS



ORGANISING a game of football, at any level, is no easy task.

From ground staff to safety officers, from stewards to caterers, these people – volunteers more often than not – play a vital role in the day -to-day running of a matchday to ensure a safe and welcoming environment for all those who click through the turnstiles. But there is one thing that even these superheroes just can not control – the weather!

As I'm sure you are all well aware, temperatures this week plummeted to 12-year lows in some parts of the UK, putting all best-laid plans into jeopardy. The now obligatory winter footage of groundsmen and women up and down the country braving the big freeze to sweep snow off the pitch swamped social media, while fans too leant a helping hand. At Macclesfield, for example, early morning pleas from the club to join in the clean-up operation and ensure their game with Ramsbottom United went ahead were answered by a large pool of their loyal fanbase and they certainly played their part in a 4-0 win.

But, unfortunately, these things don't always go quite to plan and when Jack Frost does decide to play havoc with the football calendar things can get, well, a little bit ice-cold. Let's start with AFC Rushden & Diamonds, for example, after players, staff, officials and fans were left "furious" after their Southern League Premier Central match at Needham Market was called off just 40 minutes before kick-off, ensuring a wasted 174-mile round trip. Later that evening, Needham Market said in a statement: "The football club would like to put on record it's sincere apologies to everyone connected to our opponents ĂFC Rushden ጼ Diamonds. Needham Market players and staff, and supporters of both teams who arrived for the 1:00pm kick off.

"Upon the match officials arrival they carried out a pitch inspection but despite much deliberation they agreed to postpone the match at 12:15pm. "No further comment will be made by the Football Club surrounding the issue."

And it wasn't just AFC Rushden & Diamonds left with a bitter pill to swallow. Hendon, too, were left aggrieved after travelling two-and-a-half hours to Yate Town – on a coach costing over £1,000 - only for the game to be called off shortly after their arrival. To make matters worse for the Greens, Yate's Lodge Road pitch had reportedly passed a 10am inspection carried out by the referee's assistant.

Furious Hendon boss Lee Allinson tweeted at the time: "Arrived at Yate, two-and-a-half hours on a coach, game off! Shambles, nowhere near playable."

And it was the same also for Hendon's league rivals Winchester City, who suffered the same fate of a late postponement on their arrival at Poole Town's Black Gold Stadium.

Sadly, this is nothing new in Non-League football. While 90 per cent of postponements are announced in good time to prevent the visiting team from travelling unnecessarily, there will always be occasions where it's difficult to avoid. I do feel, though, that in an era where we can send a man to the moon and launch the worldwide web then surely a protocol can be put in place to prevent this from continuously happening?


Safety of the players can never be compromised when it comes to frozen pitches – and if last-minute calls suggest that a pitch may be 50/50 playable, then I would argue that it's not. But is there the slightest possibility that the Football Association and/or individual leagues, can sit down and devise a routine inspection system – taking into account the distance travelled by the visiting team – where calls must be made before a certain time by local officials to clear the situation of any such doubt?

No-one wants any frosty atmospheres at Christmas.

There is possible cup success to look forward to as well, with Bassett hosting County League Durrington in the Wiltshire County Women's Cup semi final (scheduled for 15 January) after wins over Salisbury and Purton. The winners will face either Warminster Town or Swindon Supermarine in the final.

Four youth sides added their names to the honours board in 2021-22 - and a half dozen are in a good position at Christmas to achieve just the same at the end of this season.

Most notable of all has been the outstanding performance of the Under 18s. Runners-up in the Wiltshire League Floodlit Division last year, the team are again playing at a high standard. And at the halfway point of the season, Nick Warren's side are still unbeaten, winning seven and drawing two of their opening nine fixtures. They do sit second - a point behind Kintbury Rangers. But the title seems to be a two- rather than three-horse race this time around, while Bassett can lay claim to a minor psychological advantage over Kintbury having won the first meeting between the teams 3-1. There is still a long way to go and plenty of points to play for but the Under 18 Floodlit side are firmly in the mix for the title.
