Men's First Team Bassett Bulletin Welcome To Today's Game

GOOD AFTERNOON and welcome to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Uhlsport Hellenic League fixture against league leaders Malvern Town. It is a warm welcome to all who have made the journey down from Worcestershire and we trust you will enjoy your short stay with us this afternoon.

This is the third time that Malvern have visited us here at the Sustain Stadium, the two sides having met for the first time in the Floodlit Cup back in Season 2019-20 when Malvern progressed to the next round of the competition courtesy of a 3-1 win. We were well beaten in the first league meeting here going down 5-2 . We avenged that defeat in Malvern's last visit, the 2-1 win at the end of January being our first win of calendar year 2022. Malvern went on to finish in 3rd spot in the table in what was their first season in the Premier Division of the Uhlsport Hellenic League.

They are doing even better this season and sat top of the table at the time of writing these notes with 17 wins and just two defeats from their opening 22 league fixtures.

Due to Christmas print deadlines these programme notes are having to be written before the games on Boxing Day and apologies for the statistics not being up to date and also an element of repetition from the Corsham programme. However, this programme is officially the quickest ever thrown together in my around 20 years of producing the programme, completed in the space of just 2.5 hours on Thursday morning before Christmas, whilst suffering with a bad case of man-flu I might add!

Malvern continue to attract big crowds and look set for promotion to Step Four of the National League System at the end of the season. When the two sides met earlier in the season we put in an excellent performance losing by a solitary goal and Sam will be hoping for another good

performance from the lads this afternoon as we look to become the third side to defeat Malvern this season, the two defeats coming at the hands of Hereford Pegasus and Wantage Town, both away from home.

Media Officer Stuart Smedley has reflected on the first half of the season for all of our teams, which for a number of teams has been a successful campaign so far - with plenty of work for all to do, and no room for complacency, in 2023. Today's programme includes a review for each of our various sections across the programme.

Over the past couple of campaigns, Royal Wootton Bassett Town's Men's First Team could justifiably have been criticised as being cup specialists and league underachievers. So far this season, however, things have been different with Sam Collier's side enjoying the team's best start to a Hellenic League Premier Division while also performing well again on the cup front.

As far as the First Team are concerned, Bassett find themselves inside the top half in eighth place at Christmas and are well placed to push for the club's highest ever finish at this level. Highlights of the campaign so far include the league double over Bradford Town - including a stunning 5-0 away win - and the trio of impressive come from behind home draws against title-chasing Cribbs and the much-fancied Westfield and Worcester Raiders. Indeed, Sam and his side have been so competitive that all five league defeats suffered so far have come by just a single goal, including away against promotion challengers Malvern Town.

Bassett's record could be even better given the throwaway home loss against Wantage Town and the draws against the likes of Chipping Sodbury Town, Lydney Town and Fairford Town where we perhaps should have taken all three points. But having played 29 games in all competitions in a frenetic opening few months, it's been mightily impressive how rare off days have been.

In national cup action, Bassett can again look back on a successful year. In the Emirates FA Cup, Bassett saw off Windsor 2-0 in an Extra Preliminary Round replay before impressively taking down Reading City 3-1 in the Preliminary Round and then pushing Southern League outfit Paulton Rovers close in a 4-2 First Qualifying Round defeat. Meanwhile, in the Isuzu FA Vase, last year's record breaking run enabled Bassett to avoid the lottery of the qualifying rounds. Dramatic away wins at Bridport (5-3) and Wellington (5-4 on penalties after a 2-2 draw) meant Bassett reached the Third Round again.

There, Sam and the lads suffered an agonising loss on penalties against today's opponents Corsham Town after a tense 0-0 draw. Bassett will look back on that afternoon with a sense of what could have been, as a place in the last 32 - and a first appearance in a non-regionalised round - was firmly within Bassett's reach. At least Bassett

should benefit from another exemption to the First Round next season.

Elsewhere, Bassett also lost on penalties against Mangotsfield United in the Wiseman Lighting Hellenic League Floodlit Cup, missing out on a Quarter Final place. With a First Round loss in the Wiltshire Premier Shield, that means - outside of the league Bassett now have an interest in just the Bluefin Sports Challenge Cup, where they will host Shrivenham in the Second round on 10 January.

As this is our first home game of 2023 I will end these programme notes wishing everyone best wishes for a happy and prosperous New Year in 2023.

Enjoy today's game and hopefully three vital points against one of the top sides in the division.

Opponents History MALVERN TOWN



Club The was established in 1946 as Barnard's Football Green Club. They joined the Worcester League, where they played until moving up to the Worcestershire Combination

1955, going on to win the league at the first attempt.

The club also won the Worcestershire Junior Cup and retained the trophy for the next two seasons, before winning it again in 1961-62.

In 1967 the Worcestershire Combination was renamed the Midland Combination. The club won the inaugural Worcestershire Urn in 1973-74, before retaining it for the next two seasons; they also finished as runners-up in the Midland Combination in 1973-74.

In 1979 Malvern transferred to the Premier Division of the West Midlands (Regional) League and although they finished bottom of the division in 1982-83, the club avoided being relegated. However, they were relegated to Division One at the end of the 1991-92 season.

Despite only finishing ninth in Division One in 1993-94, the club were promoted back to the Premier Division. In 2003-04 they won the Premier Division title, earning promotion to the Midland Alliance.

A third place finish in the Alliance in 2005-06 saw the club promoted to Division One Midlands of the Southern League. The club finished bottom of Division One Midlands in 2008-09 and were relegated ack to the Midland Alliance. Two seasons later they finished bottom of the Midland Alliance and were relegated to the Premier Division of the

West Midlands (Regional) League.

They lifted the Worcestershire Senior Urn for the ninth time in 2018-19 and finished in the top five for five consecutive seasons.

The summer of 2019 saw the association with the West Midlands (Regional) League come to an end as the club were moved across to the Hellenic League Division One West

It was during the first half of the 2019-20 season that Project 2020 finally came to fruition with significant developments made to the club's facilities and infrastructure, including a new state-of-the art 3G playing surface and new dressing rooms.

An FA Vase tie against Loughborough University in November 2019 signalled the first game at the revamped stadium and with home crowds regularly topping the 200-mark, the team marched to the top of the table until the campaign was declared null-and-void in March 2020 amidst the Covid-19 outbreak.

The 2020-21 season also saw the club sitting deservedly at the top of the table when the season was curtailed due to Covid-19. However, in 2021, it was confirmed that the club would be promoted into the Premier Division.

The club also enjoyed another exciting adventure in the FA Vase, beating higher level Rothwell Corinthians and Sporting Khalsa long the way before narrowly losing out to Congleton Town in the Fourth Round.

The club continues to embrace the local community, and with Project 2022 full steam ahead for the development of a Community Hib, Malvern Town look forward to what the future holds in store.

RWBTFC v MALVERN TOWN

Saturday 16th October 2021

Malvern Town 5 Royal Wootton Bassett Town 2 Uhlsport Hellenic League Premier

Royal Wootton Bassett Town's winless Hellenic League Premier Division run stretched to eight games as they fell to a heavy 5-2 defeat away against third place Malyern Town.

Bassett found themselves two goals down at the break before a quickfire second half double increased their deficit further. While Alan Griffin pulled one back from the penalty spot, Malvern added a fifth before Griffin headed in a late consolation deep in stoppage time.

Given Bassett's recent form and the fact they were facing the division's leading scorers on their own patch, a long, trying afternoon was a strong possibility. And so it proved.

Bassett found themselves a goal down after just nine minutes as a good spell of possession from Malvern culminated in Matt Turner teeing up Dave Reynolds, who fired home an emphatic opener.

The hosts' relentless, heavy pressing proved tough to deal with. That, coupled with Malvern's quality when on the ball, then contributed towards keeping 'keeper Eddie Cavanagh a busy man.

Bassett were forced to clear off the line on the quarter hour mark as the ball broke free following an aerial duel between Cavanagh and Reynolds.

A steady stream of pressure from Malvern followed, and the 'keeper pulled off a trio of fine saves to initially keep Bassett's deficit to a minimum. He first kept out Nathan Chowns Higgs' glancing header before ensuring James Febery's header did not creep over the line and denying Joe Bates from a free kick.

However, there was little he could do three minutes before the interval when Bates cut inside the wing and fired beyond the 'keeper for Malvern's second.

The past couple of games have seen Malvern surrender leads of two goals or more. Yet there was to be no three-peat.

Within a quarter of an hour of the restart they were four in front. Both Matt Turner and Harry Clark had come close to extending Malvern's advantage before the inevitable third arrived courtesy of Joe Bullock who weighted a fine chip over Cavanagh and into the net on 55 minutes.

Four minutes later, Chowns Higgs got in on the act. Picking up a half-cleared corner, he proceeded to curl home a fine strike from just outside the area.

Bassett were able to pull one back when Griffin slotted home a penalty after Bailey Gallagher had been fouled by Phil Harris.

Yet that goal offered only short term relief as Malvern reasserted themselves.

Bassett's resistance was then broken again on 88 minutes as Reynolds grabbed his second and Malvern's fifth of the game after good build up play from winger Harry Clark.

Griffin then headed home his second in the fourth minute of injury time. But this offered little succour to Bassett who were already well beaten.





Last Meeting at Sustain Stadium RWBTFC V MALVERN TOWN

Royal Wootton Bassett Town 2 Malvern Town 1

Royal Wootton Bassett Town recorded arguably their most impressive league win of the season as Sam Collier's side defeated promotion chasing Malvern Town 2-1.

A far cry from the 5-2 reverse suffered at the hands of the Hillsiders in the teams' October meeting in Worcestershire, Bassett defended resolutely throughout against the Hellenic League Premier Division's leading scorers. That meant Chris Taylor's early penalty and Sam Packer's second half poacher's finish ultimately proved enough for Bassett to claim all three points.

Given Malvern's potent attack and with the visitors seeking to bring to an end a run of indifferent form that had seen them win just once in the previous six, Bassett knew that they would have to be at their best to take anything from the game. And Collier's troops duly delivered.

The defence, unsurprisingly, was tested early and often. But they stood firm to frustrate Malvern. Meanwhile, in attack Bassett made the most of the opportunities they were able to create.

Indeed, Bassett unsettled their opponents early, taking the lead after just seven minutes. Sam Morris was tripped as he broke into the box, and his central midfield partner Taylor coolly sent 'keeper Keiron Blackburn the wrong way from the spot.

After the teams exchanged chances, with Packer skewing wide for Bassett and Ben Hayes blazing over for Malvern, the visitors began to seize the upper hand.

Controlling play, they sought to grind Bassett down in search of an equaliser. Try as they might though, Malvern's pressure appeared as though it was going to be in vain as half time neared. Their best chance fell to Dave Reynolds who squeezed a free kick narrowly wide of the post while Matt Turner had a shot from inside the area deflected over.

However, with less than three minutes to go until the interval, Malvern finally equalised. It

was a rather cheap goal for Bassett to concede too. After a Lewis Platt header bounced off the bar, Cavanagh appeared to be in a good position to punch away the danger. But the 'keeper went for finesse over power in his attempt to clear and the ball dropped for Turner who stabbed in with a simple, gift-wrapped finish.

Arriving on the verge of the half time, the equalising goal must have given Bassett a sense of déjà vu as last week's visit to Westfields – Malvern's fellow rivals for promotion – had seen Bassett go ahead early only to concede not long before the break.

In that contest, Bassett were second best after the restart, going on to lose 3-1. There was to be no repeat this time though.

Malvern continued to threaten. Shortly after play resumed a Reynolds free kick deflected off the Bassett wall, with this redirecting the ball in the opposite direction and narrowly wide of the upright. The visitors then believed they should have had a penalty as Joe Bates went to ground as he sought to make a run to meet the resulting corner. Kyonn Evans also had a chance but was unable to shoot on target as the hosts remained resolute at the back.

Bassett then struck what proved to be the decisive blow on the hour mark. The tricky Packer drew a foul in the right corner and from the resulting free kick, which was fizzed across the face of the six-yard box by John Mills, he stole in at the far post, ghosting past his marker to guide home a fine first time finish.

Behind again, Malvern failed to muster a response. Adam Sauntson saw two opportunities go begging, while, sandwiched between those, Evans had the ball in the net only for an offside flag to chalk it off.

After Reynolds failed to locate the target with ten minutes remaining, Bassett broke up the other end and almost sealed the match, only for Blackburn to deny substitute Alfie Presley. Still in the match thanks to that save, Malvern continued to exert pressure on Bassett. And with time winding down, they earned a free kick in a dangerous position, but Cavanagh produced an excellent save of his own to tip over from Joe Bullock's free kick and help preserve a fine victory.

Judge sentences Bassett to narrow defeat

Malvern Town 1 Royal Wootton Bassett Town 0 Uhlsport Hellenic League Premier

Royal Wootton Bassett Town pushed Hellenic League Premier Division leaders Malvern Town all the way, but ultimately succumbed to a 1-0 defeat courtesy of a Sam Judge goal on the stroke of half time.

The Hillsiders - who along with Cribbs - have now started to open up a gap on the chasing pack, which still includes Bassett. But they were forced to work hard for their latest victory, with Sam Collier's coming close to taking something from a closely fought contest.

The match would ultimately be decided two minutes before the interval when Judge was quickest to react after Bassett 'keeper Matt Crowther was unable to corral Dave Reynolds' low cross into the box.

Outside of that, Malvern did - on balance - have the better of the game's opportunities. But Bassett, who were thumped 5-1 on their visit to Worcestershire last season, were not without threat and showed their hosts how much they have improved.

Indeed, Bassett had the first opening of the game when, in the fourth minute, Alfie Presley snatched at a shot from inside the area, hitting wide of the post.

Malvern had a spell on top midway through the half, but were unable to find a way past Crowther who twice tipped away, first from a Lewis Platt shot which, coming through a crowd of players, the 'keeper was only able to see late, and then from a Reynolds header following a Phil Harris cross.

But, with Presley seeing another chance deflected wide, the game appeared to be headed into the break with the scores still level. However, an opportunistic Judge pounced to put Malvern in front.

Facing the league leaders, falling behind may in recent times have served to dent Bassett's self belief. Not this season though - and Bassett returned from the break recharged, beginning the second half with purpose.

And the visitors came close to equalising shortly after the restart when half time substitution Matt Bennett burst free and rounded Keiron Blackburn. But the angle proved to be too acute, with sufficient Malvern defenders tracking back to snuff out the danger.

For the majority of the time remaining, the best either side could do was to create a string of half chances.

The best opening fell to Malvern's Lewis Spurrier, but he was unable to put the ball away after Crowther failed to hold a powerful Reynolds drive. The hosts also saw a late goal ruled out for a foul on the Bassett 'keeper after a corner had been swung into the box.

With time winding down though, Bassett started to throw men forwards. And it almost paid dividends as sub Jed Afenyo saw a firm drive well kept out by Blackburn. Bassett then won a stoppage time corner and sent everyone upincluding Crowther - to attack. The ball fell to the 'keeper but he was just unable to steer into the net past his opposite number as Malvern hung on to win..



Just days after losing on penalties in the FA Vase, Royal Wootton Bassett Town suffered the exact same fate in the Wiseman Lighting Floodlit Cup as Sam Collier's side were eliminated in their round of sixteen tie against Mangotsfield United.

After a rather lifeless ninety minutes of football ended goalless, the visitors triumphed 4-2 in the shootout to book their place in the quarter finals and end what was arguably Bassett's best opportunity to claim silverware this season.

Illness and injury forced Sam Collier into multiple changes for the contest, and both the Bassett boss and his assistant manager Alan Griffin - named as substitutes - found themselves on the pitch before the end of the game.

Indeed, Griffin would be Bassett's first penalty taker but failed to convert. Jon Beeden and Matt Jones did find the net before Jack Hobson-McVeigh missed Bassett's fourth penalty. Mangotsfield were three for three by that point and remained perfect to claim the win with their fourth kick.

Bassett now retain an interest in just one cup competition - that being the Bluefin Sports Hellenic League Challenge Cup in which they will host Shrivenham in the second round in mid -January.

Gallagher slides away winner as Bassett record rare Wantage victory

Wantage Town 0 Royal Wootton Bassett Town 1

Bailey Gallagher scored the only goal of the game as Royal Wootton Bassett Town recorded a vital - and rare - victory away against Wantage Town.

Bassett's record against the Alfredians is a miserable one, with 23 previous Hellenic League meetings yielding just four wins and nineteen defeats - including a dramatic 3-2 loss back in September when Wantage came from 2 -0 down to claim all three points at the Sustain Stadium.

This time, however, it was a different story as a gutsy display in difficult conditions from Sam Collier's side saw Bassett keep a clean sheet and snatch an all-important winner.

Making the result more impressive was that Bassett were much changed too as a consequence of injuries and illness: Jadyn Mundle was drafted in at the last minute to make his debut in goal, Jon Beeden made his first start in a long time, while Bassett operated without a natural centre forward. Still though they managed to prevail.

The heavy rain that had followed the recent cold snap had made the Alfredian Park pitch boggy and heavy, and resulted in a tricky first half as Bassett also played against the slope.

Wantage thus had Bassett under significant pressure throughout the opening period, earning numerous free kicks in dangerous positions and throwing a number of dangerous balls into the box. But fantastic defending from the visitors - led by Beeden and Adam Corcoran - meant that they got through the opening 45 minutes unscathed, with Wantage

failing to convert the significant possession and territorial advantage they had into any serious opportunities.

Going down the slope after the restart, Bassett were finally able to exert some control over the game, with this allowing midfield playmakers Chris Taylor, Tommy Ouldridge and Jack Hobson-McVeigh to get on the ball far more.

And eventually that led to the crucial moment in the game. Gallagher had started as a substitute and only been brought on with 25 minutes remaining. But it was an impact substitution from Collier, with the Bassett boss playing his cards right. By introducing Gallagher's fresh legs and skill, it gave Wantage - starting to tire something else to think about.

The move for the goal started with Alfie Presley holding the ball up well and, after a quick turn, he played in a pass over the top for Gallagher to run onto. Gallagher still had a defender in the form of Michael Miller to beat, but he turned his former teammate inside out before shifting the ball onto his left foot and producing a composed finish beyond home 'keeper James Foster.

Having fallen behind, Wantage sought desperately to get back onto level terms. But Bassett defended diligently, successfully seeing off the pressure the hosts exerted, including successive corners in the final moments of the match.

The result means Bassett move up to eighth in the Hellenic League Premier Division - where they will sit at Christmas, three points ahead of tenth place Wantage who have played three games more.

While Bassett's recent form has been solid with impressive league draws against high-flying Westfields and Worcester Raiders as well as consecutive clean sheets in their two most recent cup fixtures, the lack of a league win since a 2-1 triumph against Bradford Town on 18 October had put the team in danger of dropping into the bottom half.

Now though, there is some breathing room albeit with plenty of work still to do in order to secure a first ever top half finish at Step Five.

EACH WEEK we are kindly invited onto Tim Fuell's Non-League Show where we talk about all the latest goings-on around the game.

Most episodes this season we have got onto the managerial merry-go-round. It certainly seems to be spinning at all levels this season with dug-out changes aplenty. Sometimes it can be hard to keep up with all the ins and outs!

Chairman Steve Taylor said: "If Coxy can transfer his playing success to managerial success then we will be extremely happy."

He certainly experienced the highs and lows in his first game at the helm as the Lancers came from two goals behind to win 3-2 with Reece Hallard's game-winning double coming on 83 and 90 minutes.

And that feeling is probably why they do it!



Season 2022-23 Youth Section CHRISTMAS 2022 REPORT CARD

Four youth sides added their names to the honours board in 2021-22 - and a half dozen are in a good position at Christmas to achieve just the same at the end of this season.

Most notable of all has been the outstanding performance of the Under 18s. Runners-up in the Wiltshire League Floodlit Division last year, the team are again playing at a high standard. And at the halfway point of the season, Nick Warren's side are still unbeaten, winning seven and drawing two of their opening nine fixtures. They do sit second - a point behind Kintbury Rangers. But the title seems to be a two- rather than three-horse race this time around, while Bassett can lay claim to a minor psychological advantage over Kintbury having won the first meeting between the teams 3-1. There is still a long way to go and plenty of points to play for but the Under 18 Floodlit side are firmly in the mix for the title.

In the North Wilts League, the Under 14 Blue (Division One), 13 Blue (Division Two), 15 Yellow (Division Four), 14 Yellow (Division Four), 13 Yellow (Division Four) and 12 Yellow (Division Five) teams have all enjoyed strong

starts and find themselves well positioned for a tilt at either a first or second place finish.

The Under 14 Blues also have their eyes on cup glory, having reached the last eight of both the Wiltshire County Cup and North Wilts League Cup.

Elsewhere at competitive age groups, the Under 16 Blues have found the going tough in North Wilts League Division One, but still enjoyed decent cup runs as they reached the League Cup quarter finals and County Cup third round.

In Division One, the Under 12 Blues find themselves safely in mid-table. Meanwhile, the first part of the season has been trickier for the Under 18 Blue, 18 Yellow and 13 Girls teams but there is still plenty of football left to play and time for them to make their mark.

At the non-competitive age groups it has been enjoyable to see the continued progress made by Bassett's teams - nine ranging from Under 7s to Under 11s in the North Wilts League and the Under 8, 9 and 11 Girls sides in the Wiltshire County Women's and Girls' League.
