Opponents History CHIPPING SODBURY TOWN

In the summer of 1959 Cliff Phelps brought football back to Chipping Sodbury after a 6-year absence. In the initial 59/60 Season they entered a senior team into the Dursley & Wotton League. The following season they joined the Bristol & District League and throughout the 1960s remained in Division 3.

The 1970s began with relegation after finishing bottom of Div 3 and the slump continued in 71/72 when finishing bottom of Div 4. Season 76/77 promotion back to Div 4 after finishing 3rd. Season 78/79 saw them go one better as they finished second in Div 4. To finish the decade off and celebrate 20 years of the club's rebirth, they won the Div 3 title.

The good form continued in the 1980s, a 4th place saw promotion to the Bristol & District League Div 1 and by the end of Season 80/81, they had gained promotion to the Senior Division. The first Senior season saw a mid-table finish, bettered the following year by a 3rd place finish. Unfortunately, in 85/86 they were relegated back to Div 1, where they remained until finishing second in 88/89.

The 1990s kicked off with a 3rd place finish and promotion to the Bristol Premier Combination Div 1. The early 90s saw a new clubhouse and changing rooms built with help from players and committee members. A 4th place finish in 92/93, and the winning of the Premier Cup, was the clubs best season so far. They were to remain in Div 1 until the end of the 1990s, when they were promoted to the Premier Division.

After 3 seasons in the Premier, they were relegated at the end of 2001/02 but 05/06 saw them win the Division 1 title and promotion back to the Premier Division. 2007/08 was another successful season, when they won the Premier Division title and promotion to the Glos. County League. The first season in the County League unfortunately saw the team finish bottom but they escaped relegation.

The 2010s have been the most successful period in the club's history although it did not look that way as the decade started. After a 3rd place finish

in the County League in 10/11, two disappointing bottom place finishes followed. However, the appointment of Karl Reese as manager for 14/15 sent the club on an upward trajectory. In his first season a 3rd place finish saw them promoted to the Western League, a league they had last graced in 1952. They then won the Western League Div 1 title at the first attempt. A 13th place finish in 16/17, their first season in the Western Premier, also saw a first venture in the FA Vase. Reese had left prior to the start of the 17/18 Season club along with a number of key players but the club achieved another 13th place finish and a first venture in the FA Cup which saw them defeat Brackley Town Saints before losing to Bishops Cleeve. Season 18/19 saw another good run in the FA Cup as they overcame two Hellenic sides before being knocked out by Bristol Manor Farm. A 10th place finish was their highest ever finish in the pyramid.

An eventual summer of 2019 saw the club successfully appeal a sideways move to the Hellenic League, although they eventually become part of the Hellenic once the NLS restructuring was implemented. 2019-20 saw them remain in the Western Premier but the uncertainty of which league they would be playing in, unsettled the players and several departed along with the manager. At the time that Covid-19 struck and brought the season to a premature end they sat 4th from bottom with just 6 wins from their 28 games.

Season 20/21 saw them in the Hellenic League with a familiar face in the Chipping Sodbury Town dugout, as former Royal Wootton Bassett Town manager takes over the reins at Chipping Sodbury. It was to be a tough inaugural season for Roberts at his new club and his side sat bottom of the table at the time the season was brought to a premature end. They fared slightly better last season eventually finishing third from bottom. This season has again seen them struggle with Roberts departing mid-season to be replaced by James Mapstone. Results have picked up under Mapstone as Chipping Sodbury Town look to retain their place in the Premier Division for another season.

2 RWBTFC Wins 2 Draws

Chipping Sodbury Wins

Royal Wootton Bassett Town have met Chipping Sodbury Town four times with Bassett yet to taste defeat against today's opponents. All four games against Chipping Sodbury were when former Bassett manager Jeff Roberts was at the helm at Chipping Sodbury.

The first game was in the Extra Preliminary Round of the FA Cup back in Season 20-21 at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground. It was tight affair that finished all square at 2-2, TJ Bohane scoring both Bassett goals with the second one coming from the penalty spot. penalty shoot out saw confidently put Bassett in front. Harrison Ellis then pulled off a fine save to keep out Chipping Sodbury's opening spot kick. Alex Dinsmore and Chris Taylor then both kept their cool to keep the hosts on track before Aaron Stevens - one of a number of the visiting team with ties to Bassett - blazed his spot kick over the bar. That left Sam Ockwell needing to score to send Bassett through and he delivered to send Bassett into the next round.

With Chipping Sodbury moving across to the Hellenic League from the Western League the following season the two clubs met in the league for the first time. The first meeting was again at the Gerrard Buxton Sports Ground and as with that first encounter it finished all square at 2-2 at the end of 90 minutes. On target for Bassett were Macauley Dodson and Tom Moore.

The return game at Chipping Sodbury Town was four days before Christmas and another close encounter ensued. Bailey Gallagher's

fourth minute goal proved enough for Royal Wootton Bassett Town. In a game of little real quality, Gallagher produced a cool finish after racing onto a ball over the top and outpacing the home defence.

On balance, Bassett had the better of the remaining opportunities in the game but were unable to extend their advantage. Adam Corcoran and John Mills saw shots saved by Archie Watts before the interval. Following the restart, Bassett 'keeper Eddie Cavanagh was forced to make a reflex save to turn a low shot around the post on the hour. At the other end, Gallagher and Will Davidson both went close but were unable to locate the target. With Chipping Sodbury still in the contest as time wound down, it made for a nervy final ten minutes as the hosts sought to snatch something from the game. But Bassett saw out the fixture, surviving two late scares as, first, Chipping Sodbury breached the visiting defence only for the resulting shot to be placed wide before a last minute scramble in the box resulted in another effort that was narrowly off target.

The final meeting between the two sides was at the start of this season and in yet another close encounter the sides had to settle for a point apiece as it finished 1-1, Jack Hobson-McVeigh scoring an 89th minute equaliser with a free-kick which took a deflection on the way into the net. Bassett had been reduced to ten men late on as Macauley Dodson was given his marching orders for a second yellow but somehow Bassett dug deep to find that equaliser and return with a point.

He skipped past an onrushing Langley, but that narrowed his angle further. Yet the impressive youngster was somehow able to steer the ball into the net from the acutest of angles with his right foot.

That lead would not last long though.

Kye Simpson hit the post moments after Moore's opener, before the Sods pulled level on the stroke of half time through Lewis Bezer following a neat move.

They then went ahead ten minutes into the second half when Simpson converted from an Aysa Corrick cross.

Try as they might, Bassett did not look as though they would equalise. That was until defender Dodson rose to meet fellow full back McIntosh's perfect late delivery.

In contrast, Melksham have been made to sweat in all three of their games. After a 3-1 second round win over Westbury United, Melksham edged out Cricklade Town 1-0 before triumphing 5-4 on penalties against last year's winners Bradford following a 1-1 draw.

It's set up to be another entertaining final – here's hoping this will be the year Bassett get their hands on the cup.

THE NON-LEAGUE PAPER

LAST week, Paul Fairclough unveiled an England C squad with a difference for this month's clash with Wales C at Altrincham's Moss Lane.

Mindful of the time of year and the pressures that come with the business end of the season at either end of the table, the wily Young Lions chief has opted to select one player from each of the 24 National League clubs, plus Worthing goalkeeper Harrison Male.

It's a strategy which tells you all you need to know about the 73-year-old who is now in his 21st year in charge of the Young Lions.

Looking to avenge a humbling 4-0 defeat to the same opposition 12 months ago, Fairclough could have been well forgiven for raiding big guns Wrexham and Notts County for their finest English talent in a bid to settle the score.

This way, however, the former Barnet and Stevenage coach has shown equal respect to all quarters ahead of the final quarter of the season, but can integrate a new, dynamic squad for the future. while keeping the club bosses on side.

But try naming a National League team without an abundance of talented players these days. Fairclough's provisional 25-man squad – which will be reduced to 16 this week - is jam-packed full of the top performers at Step 1 this season and offers plenty of hope for redemption on Tuesday March 21.

Only one of the 25 have been capped by the Young Lions before, Solihull Moors midfielder Joe Sbarra, while the average age has dropped to 23, from 27 this time last year. The squad also includes Notts County's 33-goal striker Macaulay Langstaff who, aged 26, is the oldest member of the party.

"It's the first time I've selected a squad on this basis," Fairclough told The NLP. "I've been doing this for 21 years and I know the pressures on clubs at this time of year, no matter how high in the pyramid they are.

"I'm mindful that this is a tremendously important time of the season so I've decided to select just the one player from each Nation[1]al League team so no manager is affected more than any other.

"It will make team bonding more necessary within the squad, but that is what England C is all about. It helps form friends for life. I know players still close friends 20 years later, that bond stays with you."

The shelving of the International Challenge Trophy in 2017 has led to many questioning the future of the England C team, especially in these post-Covid

times where finances at the Football Association threw the team's mere existence into doubt. But you try telling any of the 16 players who take to the field at the J Davidson Stadium next Tuesday that earning an England C international cap means nothing.

In the 21 years Fairclough and his backroom team have taken over the reins, no fewer than 200 players have gone to play in the Football League or higher. One of them, Ethan Pinnock, scored for Brentford against Fulham in the Premier League on Monday night. And I wouldn't mind waging you that every single one of the 200+ will point to their England C experience as pivotal to their success.

"It was a highlight of my career and an indication to me that I was doing the right things and to stick with it," Aaron McLean, the former Grays Athletic and Aldershot Town striker who won five England C caps before going on to play for Hull City in the Premier League, told The NLP last year.

"There were periods after I'd dropped out of the League [with Leyton Orient] and I questioned whether or not football would be what I would do or did I need to consider a different path.

"There's no better stage to really show people what you can do with the best players at that level. "I couldn't believe how good the set-up was. You go back to your club and you feel 10ft tall. It massively helped me.


"My school - Robert Clack in Dagenham – have my Premier League shirt up alongside my England C shirt. It shows where I was, playing Non-League and representing my country, and the springboard to move up the Pyramid and end up playing in the Premier League. England C is such an important team."

And then there's Fairclough himself. At 73, he's as motivated as ever to give these players that springboard for success – and then there's his personal pride as well.

"I woke up today and that result last March still hurts deeply," Fairclough added. "This is an important game for us. There is no such things as a friendly, we are playing or pride and for a trophy against a Wales team with a tremendous manager, experienced backroom team and quality players.

"It's going to be tough, but we believe we have a squad to overcome those challenges."


