Welcome To Tonight's Game

GOOD AFTERNOON and welcome to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this final First Team home league fixture against near neighbours Shrevenham. It has personally been a very tough week with the sad passing of my father and the last thing I really wanted to do since Sunday was prepare a programme. However, my Dad instilled a strong work ethic in me and he would have wanted me not to let anyone down, so I have made sure this edition has been completed, although it is not the usual extensive end-of-season edition. Thank you to all who have passed on their condolences since Sunday it has helped the family a lot to come to terms with our loss.

Turning today's game which will hopefully attract a large Bank Holiday crowd, it is a warm welcome to all who have made the short journey across Swindon from Shrevenham and we trust you will enjoy your short stay with us this afternoon and wish you a safe journey home.

The two sides met in midweek in a close encounter which saw today's visitors edge it with the only goal of the game. In a typical local derby encounter I understand there was limited quality on the night but plenty of endeavour, with the game decided by the narrowest of margins and seeing one player from each side dismissed.

Tonight's visitors will include a number of players who have worn the blue and yellow of Royal Wootton Bassett Town in recent seasons and a particularly warm welcome back to the Sustain Stadium to Macauley Dodson, Josh Elms, Callum Parsons and Mani Roper, who I understand is currently player-manager at Shrevenham. This is our third meeting of the season having earlier defeated Shrevenham in the Bluefin Insurance Cup back in January. After our loss in midweek it is now eight wins to Bassett and seven to Shrevenham with two draws in the 17 games that have gone the distance between the two sides. Shrevenham currently sit in 14th place in the table and

their win in midweek was their first in seven games.

The loss in midweek was a blow to our efforts to finish in the Top Six but we must look to bounce back and take maximum points from our final two games and hope that Westfields and Roman Glass St George drop points in their final two games, noting both still have to play Corsham Town.

Looking at our other sides the Dev Team saw their game frustratingly postponed last Saturday due to a waterlogged pitch following heavy rain all week but were back in action in midweek against one of the two sides challenging for the title, Trowbridge Town. In an entertaining games the Dev team pushed Trowbridge all the way but fell to a 2-0 defeat with a goal in each half. They are now without a win in their last five games and could do with taking a few points from their final five games to make sure of safety.

The Women's side were once again without a game on Sunday.

The end-of-season programme normally contains a long list of thank-you's but given this week's events I have not had time to add the extra pages that would normally go into this edition. However, I will just say a big thank you to everyone who has helped the club in some way or other this season, which with the cold weather in December and then the wet weather in March has placed extra pressure on the volunteer base and will continue to do so until the season can be finally signed off. You know who you are and your contributions are invaluable in making this club what it is. With the First Team set to finish in its highest position ever in its history with a possible cup final to come it will certainly be looked back on as a successful season on the pitch.

Enjoy the game and hopefully Bassett will avenge that midweek defeat at the hands of Shrevenham.

SAM COLLIER TALKING TO



Royal Wootton Bassett Town boss Sam Collier described defender Louis Spalding after his brace helped his side claim an important 3-1 Hellenic Premier league victory over Tuffley Rovers on Tuesday night, writes George Nash.

Spalding, predominantly a left-back, scored either side of a Matt Bennett header to secure a comfortable win on the road against the strugglers from Gloucestershire.

It takes Spalding's remarkable goal scoring tally to nine this season, and with five games still left to play, his manager believes he has every chance of making it to double figures.

"I've got no more words for Louis," said Collier.

"He has been outstanding for us this year, on and off the pitch. He's a great lad to have around and a great one to work with.

"He said to me a while ago he was going to get to 10 goals and I thought 'steady on' but he's on nine already so he's well on course for that. Having Louis this year has been a breath of fresh air."

Spalding's eye for goal in midweek comes after Bassett were on the wrong end of a 3-1 scoreline last weekend, where they were beaten by title favourites Cribbs.

But Collier was always adamant his side would bounce back after defeat, as they have done on numerous occasions this term.

He said: "Saturday was a tricky one. We went there with key players missing so it was always going to be tough. They're flying and desperate for the title.

"But many times this year we've bounced back and away to Tuffley with bare bones on a difficult pitch, we were convincing. It was game over after 50 minutes."

Going into the final stretch of the season, Bassett are still in the running for what would be an impressive top six finish.

However, lying in wait for Collier's men on Saturday is a trip to Roman Glass St George, a team currently occupying fifth spot and one the Bassett manager believes should be challenging at the top end of the table.

"I watched them a couple of weeks ago and with the players they've got I think they're underachieving at this level," said Collier.

"I think they should be competing in the top two or three.

"We're in a slightly different situation where we're competing against some big teams in this league. So it's going to be a huge task. It's a 4G pitch as well which I know doesn't always suit some of our lads that aren't used to it.

"But we've got five games to go and we just want to get as many points on the board as possible."

CLUB HISTORY

Shrevenham Football Club was formed in 1900 and just eight years later the infant club became one of the founder members of the North Berks League. Success in the early years was hard to find however, after winning the Second Division crown at the end of the 1994-95 campaign, two Division One Championships were to follow - in 1997-98 - a season which also included the club winning the Charity Shield, and again in 2000-01, which after completing the required ground improvements, saw the club promoted to UHlsport Hellenic League Division One West at the second time of asking.

With our inaugural Hellenic League season ending with a creditable twelfth placed finish, a period of building began and after gaining some stability in the league, a further title winning season followed in 2004-05 gaining the club promotion to the Hellenic Premier Division after we won the league by a single point in what was unarguably, at the time, the most amazing season the club had ever experienced. A club record breaking eighth place finish was recorded in 2007-08, however a gradual decline began and despite avoiding relegation after finishing bottom of the table in 2012-13, just two seasons later relegation was confirmed after a nineteenth placed finish and a decade of Hellenic Premier League football brought a tough era to an end.

Two seasons of mid-table mediocrity ensued, however the club appointed a new Chairman ahead of the 2017-18 campaign and the introduction of a new management team soon followed as the club began rebuilding its ambitions and the bid to return to the Hellenic Premier Division. That goal was achieved at the first attempt as an amazing 12-game unbeaten run to the end of the campaign, found the club in second place and in an exciting final day which saw promotion rivals Easington Sports in third place, needing a result at home and Shrivy without a fixture, Sports suffered the heartache of defeat against a midtable Letcombe side, and Shrivy clung on to gain promotion.

The rebuilding was set to continue, however pre-Christmas the club looked odds on favourites to be fighting relegation, before an amazing turn of fortune saw the side go on a seventeen-game unbeaten run, during which time they picked up fifteen wins and two draws, and catapulted the club up to a new record finish of fifth, come the end of the season. 2019-20 saw the side in 4th position in the standings when the season was curtailed early due to the Covid-19 pandemic and the off season saw manager Gareth Davies step down in order to take a break from the game and Chris Hurley was appointed as his successor shortly before the season was due to start.

With a makeshift squad, the club endured a difficult start but despite being in bottom spot by the time the season came to a halt due to the Covid pandemic, new faces had begun to arrive and things were looking up once again, however by the time pre-season arrived a lack of First XI players at the opening training session brought back memories of the previous campaign, and in a bid to continue moving forwards, Chris Hurley saw his time at Barrington Park come to a close. The club have now recruited the management duo of Robin Broadbank and Daniel Broadbank for the 2021-22.

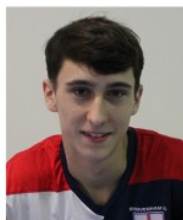

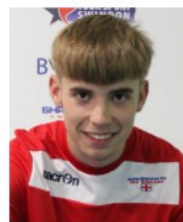

Bluefin Sports Challenge Cup

Royal Wootton Bassett Town edged out Shrivenham by the odd goal in three to advance to the last sixteen of the Bluefin Sports Challenge Cup following a closely fought derby contest.

The two teams met at the same stage of the competition last season with Bassett securing a comfortable 3-0 victory.

While the outcome of the match was the same on this occasion, their second round meeting this year was a much tighter affair.

The horrible conditions that the teams played during the first half contributed towards that, with both teams struggling to produce much quality in a goalless opening period.

There were one or two openings for both sides. For Bassett, Jon Beeden narrowly missed the target from a Jack Hobson-McVeigh corner, while a defence splitting pass was put through for Steve Robertson but he was unable to latch onto the ball. At the other end, Callum Parson was able to work his way into a prominent position in the dying stages of the half, but Adam Corcoran was able to produce a good block to prevent that situation from becoming more dangerous.

The game finally picked up shortly after the restart. Bassett made an energetic start to the second half and were moving the ball around with purpose. A goal appeared to be on the cards and it came in the form of Matt Jones' fine 30-yard free kick that, with the help of the wind, he whipped into the top left corner.



However, Shrivenham responded almost immediately and, capitalising on a defensive lapse, Josh McGrory beat Matt Crowther with a precise, well-taken finish from the edge of the area.

Bassett made three quick substitutions, with Sam Collier introducing Matt Bennett, Scott Chilcott and Charlie McCrae, and these helped the hosts get back on the front foot.

And Bassett were able to convert the pressure they were able to exert into what proved to be the winning goal. Left back Louis Spalding had been Bassett's best player on the night - and it was fitting that the goal fell to him. He charged down the wing, played a neat one-two with Bennett to open up space and cut inside before slotting a right-foot finish into the bottom corner.

Even though there was still a good quarter of an hour of the game to play plus stoppage time, that proved to be the last real action of the match as Bassett safely saw the game out.

Bassett Surge Past Sods Royal Wootton Bassett Town 4 Chipping Sodbury Town 1

Royal Wootton Bassett Town got back to winning ways in the Hellenic League Premier Division with a convincing and comfortable 4-1 home triumph against relegation-threatened Chipping Sodbury Town.

Sam Collier's side made sure that there was to be no repeat of their disappointing draw away at Chipping Sodbury way back in August, with three first half goals giving Bassett an unassailable lead.

Louis Spalding opened the scoring on the 20 minute mark, the full back netting his seventh of the campaign - an impressive haul for a defender - as he tapped in after Kai Robinson had flicked on Matt Jones' free kick into the box.

Soon after Bailey Gallagher doubled Bassett's lead as the winger scored for the third game in a row. Racing onto a Jones through ball, Gallagher rounded the 'keeper before slotting into an empty net.

Jones then made it 3-0 shortly before half time, producing a similar goal to Gallagher's after a Jack Hobson-McVeigh pass. That was Jones' eleventh goal of the season - and first since mid-February.

While no doubt delighted to see his side more or less put the game to bed before the interval, Bassett boss Collier may have felt his team could have been further ahead following a half in which they had the visitors on the ropes.



Dropping down a gear while cruising, it then seemed as though the second half would end without the score being added to.

That was before Sean McSherry pulled one back for Chipping Sodbury, heading in unmarked from a corner.

A comeback was not a realistic prospect though. And Bassett ultimately restored their three-goal advantage in stoppage time when Under 18s star Flynn Walters (pictured below with Griff) bagged his maiden goal for the Men's First Team, coolly finishing off after Alan Griffin - played in by Chris Taylor - unselfishly squared to the youngster.

With Westfields falling to defeat at Fairford Town, the victory pulls Bassett within four points of the new occupants of sixth place with two games in hand.

Realistically, whether Bassett will finish in such a position will largely be determined by two of their next three league fixtures with away visits to title favourites Cribbs and Roman Glass St George, who now sit in fifth.

But by comfortably seeing off Chipping Sodbury, Collier and his side got the job done against a team that, based on league position, they were clear favourites to beat - something they also need to do against Tuffley Rovers, Shrivenham and Longlevens as a fine season - Bassett's best in the Hellenic Premier - nears its conclusion.

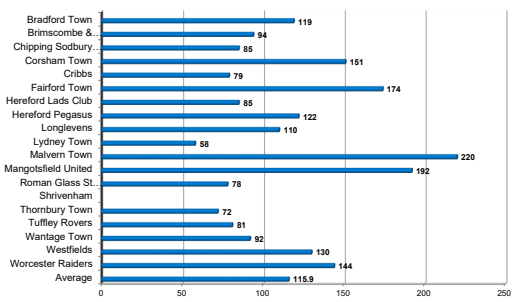

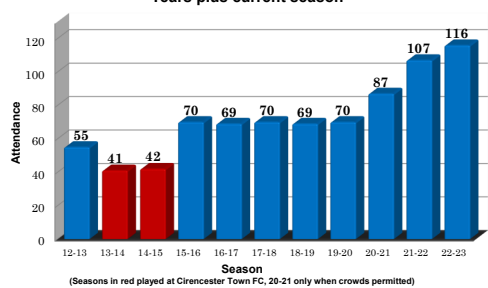

A lively start to the game for Tuffley saw Yesh Lomotey shoot narrowly wide from the edge of the box before Dan Lander's header was cleared off the line.

But Bassett soon settled with Bailey Gallagher failing to find the target from a promising position and Alfie Presley forcing home 'keeper Luke Marchant into a safe with his feet.

Eventually, by the 15th minute, Bassett were ahead when Spalding cut inside at the far post before firing past Marchant.

While Warren Mann - making his 500th Tuffley appearance - forced Matt Crowther into action a few minutes later, the goal turned momentum in Bassett's favour.

Tuffley were now on the ropes and, after Presley forced a corner, Bennett flicked in a near post header to double Bassett lead ten minutes before half time.

It was then 3-0 shortly after the restart as Spalding grabbed his second of the game with a deflected strike.



That seemed to be game over. But, desperate to avoid relegation, Tuffley started to kick into gear. A low Mark Pritchett free kick forced Crowther into another save, before a corner saw a trio of efforts blocked thanks to some last ditch defending.

The hosts then finally pulled one back when a short corner routine caught Bassett out and Pritchett headed in.

However that was to be all Rovers could muster. Ryan Dobbins had their best chance to truly make a game of it but failed to locate the target after a powerful run.

Instead, the hosts had 'keeper Marchant to thank that they didn't concede a fourth as he tipped over from substitute Sonny James

volley in the last minute of normal time.

The result moves Bassett within two points of sixth place Westfields with a game in hand still to play.

Secure a positive result in Saturday's challenging fixture away at Roman Glass St George, and that position will very much still be in play for Sam Collier's side as the season nears its conclusion.

NON-LEAGUE PLAYER CONTRACTS



EVERY SO often in Non-League football something will spark a new major talking point. Last week it was the revelation from the PFA warning players about changes to player contracts from July 1 that they say they can't support. However, the PFA don't have an agreement in place to represent Non-League footballers.

In case you missed it, here's the rundown. The FA is introducing a document that National League System clubs wanting to place players on contract must now sign. It comes into effect this summer, specifically from July 1. Minimum conditions will apply to all new contracts, as well as renewed ones – including extensions. In a statement, the FA explained it has updated the arrangement 'to better reflect current employment legislation and to provide each party with greater certainty.'

The NLP understands that the existing contract, which has been used for some time, no longer complies with UK employment law. Lawyers hired by the game's governing body, in addition to others consulted for a second and separate opinion, both concluded that it needed amending to protect against legal challenges. The big focus has been on injured players. Under the new contract, if a player suffers an injury while playing, they will only receive their full wages for 12 weeks at Step 1, and six weeks if playing at Step 2 or below. If the player is still ill or injured after this initial period on full wages, the club can reduce their wages to Statutory Sick Pay – a little over £99 per week – until they are fit again.

In addition, a contract can be terminated, with three months' notice, if in the opinion of a club-instructed medic the player is unable to play for a period of four months. Every contracted player will also be entitled to receive holiday pay, awarded pro-rata if they are not engaged for a full calendar year. Those on a 39-week deal would be entitled the equivalent of four weeks' leave. A lot of the focus has been on the injury aspect of the new contract. A reminder, clubs must conform to the minimum standards when they sign a player on contract. However, they can offer to continue paying players in full if they sustain an injury – much as they do now. For that to happen, players 'opt in' to the arrangement by ticking a box. Macclesfield, on course to be promoted to the Northern Premier League's top flight this season, have already said they will do exactly that.

Boreham Wood have expressed support for players too and it will be interesting to see how the game reacts as time goes on.

National League players have quickly mobilised, impressively so. Yeovil Town captain Josh Staunton gathered the 24 Step 1 captains into a WhatsApp group and they've released a statement calling for talks on the situation. Their stance has garnered support from their peers and, on social media, fans seem to have their backs. Staunton told us: "In the League we'd have the PFA. Unfortunately we don't have anyone so we had to make sure we had togetherness or else it would get dismissed really quickly and we'd be bowing down to something we don't believe in. Ultimately, as a person, you have to stand up for what you believe in, don't you?"

So, what are the likely consequences? One immediate and obvious impact is on clubs' wage bills – well, those with contracted players who are now entitled to holiday pay. The more players they have on deals, the more money they must find. It remains to be seen if that leads to fewer contracts being offered.

Ironically, should that happen, there would be an increase in non-contract players who have even fewer rights and benefits. Competitions that make up the National League System, together with the Professional Footballers' Association (PFA) and the Football Supporters' Association (FSA), were consulted by the governing body on the changes. It means officials have been able to warn clubs they were coming, and to prepare. Northern Premier League chairman Mark Harris has urged clubs to think carefully before deciding how they will adjust to changes in the contracts. He said: "We can help by passing on information, but we can't give legal advice. Like any businesses, clubs have to seek their own. And that's how it should be; every player is different, and so is every negotiation."

"The PFA was closely involved in discussions up to the point of launch, and it's since made its position clear."

"It remains to be seen how many clubs use the discretion they have to go above and beyond the minimum standards attached to the new contract."

It seems this story will run for a while yet.

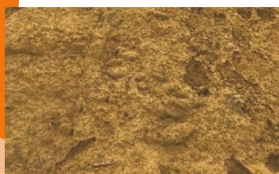

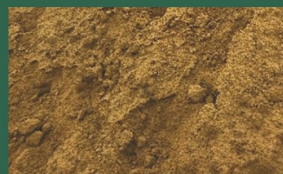

The visitors were nonetheless in a commanding position when the interval arrived with Roman Glass not even able to muster a shot on target in the opening period.

The hosts made four changes at half time as they desperately sought to turn things around, and they did have Bassett - who were somewhat slow out of the blocks - under pressure early on. However, despite enjoying most of the early second half possession, that did not translate into any clear cut chances for the Bristolians.

And Bassett were able to then catch Roman Glass on the break, a counter attack ending with the relentless Gallagher being felled in the box. Matt Jones stepped up to take the penalty and he emphatically smashed home from the spot to put the visitors in an unassailable position.

Roman Glass did grab a goal late on, when Liam Gilchrist produced a tidy finish following a neat one-two. That was a mere consolation though, with his side well beaten.

With Westfields inactive, Collier and his team now sit sixth. With three games to go - all against sides lower down the table - Bassett are just two points behind Roman Glass, whose final series of games includes tough away trips against Worcester Raiders and Corsham Town.

Bassett are guaranteed their highest ever league finish and have more than exceeded their record Hellenic Premier points.

If they can grab fifth place (and also reach the Bluefin Sports Challenge Cup final), that would represent a phenomenal achievement in an already outstanding campaign.
