# **Last Meeting**

#### Sunday 23 October 2022 Torquay United 5 Royal W. Bassett Town 2

Royal Wootton Bassett Town's hopes of reaching the Vitality Women's FA Cup first round proper were dashed as Torquay United triumphed 5-2 in the teams' third qualifying round tie in Devon.

While Torquay had been better of the two sides during the first half, they were only able to go into the break with a slender 2-1 lead. However, Torquay registered three goals in a fifteen minute second half spell to put themselves in an unassailable position, with Bassett only able to muster a last minute consolation.

In a battle between South West Regional Women's Football League Premier Division rivals, Torquay struck first, taking a third minute lead courtesy of Tracey Cross' looping effort after Ocean Latto had delivered a corner into the box. Bassett struck back midway through the half as

Holly Baker produced a composed finish after breaking into the box. Parity wouldn't last long though as a one-two with Cross opened up space for winger Mia Preston, who coolly slotted home beyond Millie Powell. The score remained that way until the hour mark when Latto smashed a stunning strike into the top corner from distance to make it 3-1.

That strike seemed to break Bassett's spirits - and two further goals quickly followed, both of which were scored by Ellie Bishop.

Bishop's first of the match came after she raced onto Kiara Robins' ball over the top and arrowed a shot across Powell and into the opposite corner. She then latched onto another through ball before calmly lifting over an onrushing Powell. Summer signing Chantelle Church was able to net her first goal in competitive football for Bassett in injury time - but it was too little, too late after Torquay's decisive three goal flurry.in the mix for one of the top placings in the division.

# Today's Opponents

# **TORQUAY UNITED**

Torquay United Football Club men's side was originally formed in 1899. After first joining the East Devon League in 1900, the club then went on to join the Torquay & District League, becoming champions of that league in 1909. Encouraged by Plymouth Argyle and Exeter City turning professional, the people of Torquay were eager for United to join forces with the town's two other prominent football teams. Babbacombe and Ellacombe. with a view to creating a third professional club within Devon. Although Babbacombe rejected the idea of a merger, Torquay United and Ellacombe agreed to pool their resources and formed Torquay Town in 1910. Town won the Devon Senior Cup in their first season and became champions of the Plymouth & District League the following vear.

Despite a fierce rivalry existing between Torquay Town and Babbacombe, the two clubs were finally amalgamated in 1921 and the newly combined team reverted to the name of Torquay United and were admitted into the Western League. After one season in the Western League, United joined the Southern League and, after becoming champions of the Western Section, were elected into the Football League at the expense of Aberdare Athletic in 1927.

Torquay United remained in the Football League up until the end of the 2006-07 Season when they were relegated to the Conference League. During the time in the Football League, other than Devon county cup competitions, honours were limited. In Season 1956-57 they finished as runners-up to Ipswich Town on goal average in Division 3 South, the closest they had come to a league title whilst in the Football League. The team generally spent their time in the bottom division of the Football League but did have a few season's in the third tier of the league. The club fell out of the Football League after finishing bottom of the re-branded League 2 at the end of 2006-07 when they were relegated to the Football Conference.

On this occasion they were to spend just two

seasons in non-league football as they secured promotion back to the Football League after finishing 4th and defeating Cambridge United in the Conference play-off final. They were to spend five seasons back in the football League but were relegated back to the Conference at the end of Season 2013-14 after again finishing bottom. Things were to get worse though as they were relegated down to National League South at the end of Season 2017-18. However, under the management of Gary Johnson they bounced back straight away winning the National League South title by 10 points over runners-up Woking to secure their first league title of any kind since 1926-27 at the end of last season.

They are now playing in the top tier of non-league football and will be keen to regain that Football League status as soon as possible.

Torquay United have run a women's side for a number of seasons now and we have been able to trace statistical information regarding their record since Season 2013-14. That specific season was a successful one for the Ladies Section of the club as they won the South West Regional Women's League Western Division 1 title losing just one league game all season to gain promotion to the Premier Division. They have remained in the Premier Division ever since securing a third place finish in their first season, Season 2014 -15 and again in Season 2017-18. The two Covid impacted seasons saw them struggle and in both seasons were bottom of the table when the seasons were brought to a premature end.

In complete contrast to those two difficult seasons last season were challenging for honours at the top end of the table and eventually finished in fourth spot with ten wins from their 18 games in the league, suffering just three defeats all season. If they could have turned the five games they drew into victories they would have been champions and will no doubt be looking to carry on that form this coming season.

**Torquay Utd Wins** 

There have been five previous meetings between Royal Wootton Bassett Town and Torquay United, four in the league and one in the FA Cup. The sides met three times in Season 2019-20 with Bassett winning all three but it was a different story last season when Torquay United did the double over Bassett in the league.

The first ever meeting was in the FA Cup in Season 2019-20 when Royal Wootton Bassett Town Ladies' continued their fine start to that season as they stuck eight goals without reply past Torquay to march into the Women's FA Cup Second Qualifying Round. Maddy Elliott, Hannah Gulliver and Hayley Huckin all notched twice that day with further goals from Lisa Coe and Grace Eagles, while the team's stingy defence recorded a fourth consecutive clean sheet

The sides met in the league the following month down in Torquay and after a couple of defeats in their previous two games Royal Wootton Bassett Town Ladies got back to winning ways with a comprehensive 7-0 victory. James Goddard and Jonny House's side picked up from where they had left off in the FA Cup clash as they netted a half dozen times in a dominant first half display, while six different scorers were on target. Longserving midfielder Amber Egerton got the ball rolling on the quarter hour mark. The lead was doubled three minutes later when Torquay 'keeper Neave Gosling's clearance picked out Bassett's Lisa Coe, and she smashed into the net from twenty yards. Coe turned provider for her team's third as she played a ball over the top of the defence that Lauren Kayll latched onto before coolly slotting into the bottom corner. And three quickly became four when Kayll crossed for Hayley Huckin to guide home her ninth of the campaign. Grace Eagles produced a fine solo effort to make it five, taking on four Torquay defenders before calmly placing beyond Gosling. Bassett's sixth then arrived in first half stoppage time. Kayll whipped in a cross that Gosling was unable to claim and Egerton took full advantage, beating teammate Huckin to the ball to smash into the empty net for her second. Bassett took their foot of the gas in the second half scoring just one more, Huckin and Withers combined well, with the latter crossing into the box where Aly Lyons was on hand to slot into the back of the net.

The return match in January once again saw Bassett keep a clean sheet as they hit five goals without reply at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground. Both Hayley Huckin and Grace Eagles bagged a brace and captain Laura Jefferies also netted in the 5-0 win. It was a different story when the sides met last season with Torquay being a much stronger and organised side than two seasons earlier. The first meeting saw Torquay hit five goals past Bassett and Bassett had nothing to show for that afternoon's effort. The sides met again two weeks later at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground and, despite a better showing. Bassett fell to a 3-1 defeat against a Torquay United side who were still in the mix for honours. Libby Davies with the Bassett goal that afternoon and there is a brief match report on that game elsewhere in today's programme. This season Torquay knocked us out of the FA Cup - see match report on Page 7.

Despite playing with home advantage for the first time in seven weeks, Royal Wootton Bassett Town Ladies were unable to snap out of their second half skid as they fell to a 3 -1 defeat against South West Regional Women's Football League Premier Division title chasers Torquay United.

Bassett weren't helped by the fact the fact late withdrawals due to illness and injury left them facing their opponents with a bare eleven. And although they put up a good fight against opponents who had beaten them 5-0 in Devon just a fortnight ago, Torquay proved too strong.

The visitors led 2-0 at half time courtesy of goals from Tracey Cross and Beth Everson. Ellie Bishop then gave Torquay an unassailable 3-0 in the second half, with Libby Davies' 35th league goal of the campaign proving no more than a consolation goal.

The result continues a run that has seen Bassett collect just four points from the seven games they have played since the turn of the year. That record stands in stark contrast to the haul of points collected from their opening nine league matches, which had seen Bassett seemingly put themselves in the mix for one of the top placings in the division.

First, Ellie Hayward scored to halve Durrington's deficit going into half time. Dani Burgess and Sophie Taylor then turned the game on its head in the second half, giving

the visitors a 3-2 lead that they held late into the game.

However, with the clock ticking down defender Winstone snatched a vital equaliser that kept Bassett's hopes alives.

With the scores level at full time, that meant the lottery of penalties though. But Bassett held their nerve in the shootout.

Despite facing the disadvantage of kicking second, Bassett took the lead after the second round of kicks. Emma Sykes and Gulliver were spot on for Bassett, with Durrington's second penalty being placed over the bar.

Millie Powell then kept out Durrington's third penalty, but Bassett were unable to extend their advantage further as Megan Young saw her effort saved.

Durrington scored their final two penalties, with Nia Davies converting in between for Bassett.

That left Winstone with the chance to settle the tie, and she duly delivered to give Bassett - still without a win in the league - a shot at silverware.

Bassett's final opponents are still unknown after the other semi final between Swindon Supermarine and Warminster Town was postponed.

But one thing is certain - in what has been a difficult season, Bassett will have all the motivation in the world to claim the cup.

# Bassett Rusty After Long Break and Defeated in Local Derby

# Royal Wootton Bassett Town 1 Malvern Town 1

A rusty performance on Royal Wootton Bassett Town Development's return to action ended in a 2-1 home defeat against Calne Town Reserves.

Calne made the short journey along the A3102 looking to complete a league double having won 2-0 at Bremhill View back in August - and they deservedly completed it despite winning by the narrowest of margins and a somewhat fortunate late escape.

Calne started much the brighter of the two sides and were rewarded with a goal 18 minutes in when a free kick to the far post was headed back across goal and an unmarked Ben Wootten made no mistake with a free header to put his side ahead.

Calne continued to have more of the play as the home side looked like a side who had not played for a month, although that was an issue that both sides faced ahead of the game.

Calne continued to create the better chances and went close when Eddie Summers outpaced a very static home back line but saw his shot well saved by keeper Jack Rae.

Rae was called into action again two minutes from half time, the young keeper saving a Stuart Windsor shot from point blank range to keep the scores level.

There was still time for another Calne chance though, Summers seeing a shot from the edge of the box come back off the crossbar as it remained all level at the break mainly thanks to Rae's performance in the home side's goal.

Bassett upped their game in the second half,

and it remained tight with both sides pushing for the three points.

When a home side attack broke down on the edge of their opponents' box, a long ball out of defence once again was not dealt with by Bassett's static backline and it saw Summers completely in the clear and he made no mistake, firing past Rae to make it 2-1 to Calne.

With time running out the home side were given a golden chance to take a share of the points when a second handball incident in the box saw another penalty awarded. Having put one away earlier, Lance left this one to Mesas, but unfortunately his spot kick was fired high and wide.

It was therefore Calne who took all three points to complete a league double over their near neighbours. The result also puts Calne five points ahead of Bassett, having played two games more - a much more comfortable cushion than that with which they started the day.
