Finally I am delighted to announce that Martin Peters has also stayed to be a part of the coaching team and will continue to help develop the goal keepers.

A warm welcome to today's visitors, Sherborne Town, who finished 3<sup>rd</sup> in the league last season, and will no doubt be a tough opponent today. Sherborne won their opening game of the campaign beating Torquay United 3-0, so we are expecting to face another big challenge today from our Dorset counterparts.

This season sees several changes to the coaching staff. Stalwarts, Sam and Martin remain with the team as first team coach and goalkeeping coach respectively. We have retained most of the squad from last season, which is really pleasing. We have also managed to capture the signings of several exciting young players plus a couple of talented experienced players which will help strengthen the squad further and ensure that we are prepared for the future. There is a good buzz around the team, and I am excited about this season.

Our opening fixture of the season against Bristol Rovers was one of the craziest games I've been involved with. After going 2-0 up we were disappointed to end up on the wrong side of a ten-goal thriller. However, the game did show us that there is still plenty to work on and we will be looking to strengthen these areas as soon as possible to get those vital first points on the board.



## Today's Opponents History

## **SHERBORNE TOWN**

Sherbourne Town Ladies were formed as recently as 2018 and are part of the Sherbourne Town Football Club that has been in existence since 1894. The men's side started life in the local Dorset Leagues but were promoted to the Toolstation Western League at the end of the 2005-6 Season where they have remained ever since. They have had two spells in the Premier Division but were relegated at the end of the 2016-17 Season and have remained in Division 1 ever since but are doing well this season and could well be promoted back to the Premier Division at the end of this season.

The Ladies side have been a very successful side from their very first season, that season saw them crowned champions of the Dorset Women's League winning all 18 of their league fixtures to finish some 17 points ahead of their nearest challengers Merley Cobham Sports Youth Ladies.

The league title success saw them promoted to the South West Regional Women's League Eastern Division and they were once again having a successful season before

Covid brought that season to a premature end with Sherbourne top of the table with just one defeat in their opening nine games.

The following season saw them moved across to the Western Division and once again they started the season well. They won both the league games they played and also progressed a couple of rounds in the FA Cup before eventually going out to Premier Division side Portishead Town. With Covid once again bringing the season to an early end with Sherbourne having had two successful, albeit shortened seasons, in the second tier of the South West Regional Women's League they successfully applied to be promoted to the Premier Division of the South West Regional Women's League. That confident application has well and truly vindicated as they finished the season in third spot after leading the division at the rurn of the year. In the end they finished just four points behind champions St Austell and were the only side to inflict defeat on St Austell all season winning at home against the champions 3-2.

## Previous Encounters

## **RWBT FC v SHERBORNE TOWN**







There have been just the two previous meetings between Royal Wootton Bassett Town and Sherborne Town, both taking place last season and both taking place in January of this year.

The first encounter was here at the Gerard Buxton Ground where the two sides produced an entertaining 3-3 draw with Libby Davies scoring all three of our goals that afternoon. This was an excellent point for Bassett as Sherborne were sat top of the table at this point in time.

The return game at the end of the month was not such a good afternoon for Bassett as we went down 4-0. While the final score line hinted at a gulf in quality between the teams, Bassett competed well for the majority of the match against their hosts. But three late goals and a fine display from home 'keeper Emily Hall ultimately sealed a comfortable triumph for Sherborne.

The crucial moment of the game arrived late in the first half as Bassett only half-cleared from a corner and Tegen Standen drove home from the edge of the area for the opening goal.

Prior to that, little separated the teams. Bassett, led in attack by the always dangerous Libby Davies, threatened on a number of occasions but lacked the final touch in front of goal and were unable to find a way past Hall.

That continued to be the case early in the second half, with Bassett delivering the reaction manager Graham Fletcher demanded from his side after going behind.

The visitors thus hosts remained alive for much of the contest. Ultimately though, Sherborne took advantage of Bassett's attempts to get back into the match, with Ali Shepherd-Scott, Jamie Bland and Gemma Mountain all finding the net as time wound down.

Bassett hold leaders Sherborne in six qoal thriller

High-scoring, closely fought thrillers have been the order of the day throughout the 2021-22 season for Royal Wootton Bassett Town Ladies. And their return to action following the Christmas break was no different as Bassett shared six goals with current South West Regional Women's Football League Premier Division leaders Sherborne Town in another goalfest.

The first ever competitive meeting between the teams was a hugely entertaining see-saw battle. Bassett twice went ahead only to be pegged back by Sherborne. The visitors then earned their first lead of the afternoon, but were unable to hold on for the win as Bassett snatched a late equaliser.

Both teams will feel as though they could have taken victory. However, Bassett will perhaps be the ones kicking themselves the most as they passed up an opportunity to pull within three points of their opponents with a game in hand still to play. Instead, they remain six points behind Sherborne, dropping a place to fourth after Torquay United's big victory against Middlezoy Rovers

Bassett found themselves in front shortly before the 20 minute mark as Libby Davies grabbed the first of what would ultimately be another hat trick - her fifth of the season. She owed a great debt to the work of teammates Holly Baker and Hayley Huckin, whose great build up play set the forward up.

Sherborne got back on terms ten minutes before the break though as the visitors seized possession in midfield and a quick break ended in Ali Scott-Sheppard producing a fine finish as she spotted Bassett 'keeper Millie Powell off her line.

The game's next goal arrived on the hour as Huckin and Lani Dickinson linked up well, with the latter threading a precise pass to Davies, who rounded Emily Hall before slotting home. However, Bassett's second lead of the day did not last long as Sherborne's Gemma Mountain punished the hosts for their sloppy play.

Mountain netted again late on to put Sherborne in pole position. But Bassett were quick to react and Davies made sure her side went home with a share of the spoils, scoring her third after latching onto captain Laura Jefferies' through ball.

## Women's Euros

## WHEN FOOTBALL CAME HOME

It's crazy to think back to the 6th July, at a sell out Old Trafford, that England would ever win the tournament after that nervy first performance, one that even the players would agree with. But little did we know, the legacy was only just beginning.

A year later than planned, due to the pandemic, England and the followers of women's football were eagerly anticipating the start of a European tournament, one that was due to be hosted on home soil in stadiums up and down the country. Like me, many people began to buy their tickets nice and early which led to a sell out final before a ball was even kicked. This shows the growth of women's football in England over the last several years. It was set to be a tournament that would smash all records with record attendances expected at the games and record viewings on TV, after the BBC made every match available to watch on TV or their interactive player.

England sailed through the group stage, scoring 14 goals and conceding 0, this included an 8-0 win over (on paper) a strong Norway side and a 5-0 win over local nation, Northern Ireland. A game my dad and I were fortunate to attend, and England certainly lifted the roof off St Mary's that evening. The atmosphere was electric and the nation were beginning to get behind the team and were ready to roar us on in the quarter final.

This (other than times in the final) was the most nervous I'd felt during the tournament because I'd seen Spain play in the Arnold Clark Cup back in February and knew they were a strong unit that contained a bunch of talented players. Despite losing the newly

crowned UEFA Women's Player of the Year 21/22, Alexia Putellas at the start of the tournament due to a torn ACL, they would still prove to be difficult to break down. Goals from Toone in normal time and Stanway in extra time secured our place in the semi finals, after having to endure those nervy extra 30 minutes.

I remember this being a big turning point in the competition as although I'd 'bigged up' the tournament within my school, I remember going into work the next day talking to people who I classed as those who 'didn't usually watch football' about the match. It turns out a lot more people were watching. I thought to myself 'Wow, this could be huge for the game if England were to go the whole way'. The following began to grow, the national newspapers and the media were interested and everywhere you went, you'd hear people talking about the Lionesses and how well they were progressing!

Into the semi final we went, against the second ranked team in the world, Sweden. After a very nervy 20 miutess, England found their form and hit the back of the net four times, including that audacious back heel from Alessia Russo (although I felt she should have scored moments beforehand). Me, along with the rest of the country, ascended into absolute chaos. The scenes of Sweet Caroline echoing around Bramall Lane. Was this to be the year? Was this to be the year England finally brought football home? And how convenient that if it was, they'd have to beat their old rivals Germany.

Sunday 31st July 2022, the day where myself and 87,191 people made the long trip to the national stadium to watch the European Women's Final 2022. The excitement and the buzz around Wembley and along Wembley Way before the match was amazing and I was starting to believe that this really could be our day.

The sea of England flags, shirts and hats filled Wembley and the concourse as they were preparing for kick off.

The game was a tight affair until Ella Toone latched onto a brilliant ball from Kiera Walsh (one of the stars of the tournament in my opinion). She looped the ball up and over the keeper and I don't know what it felt like watching it on TV, but my god in the stadium it seemed to take forever to hit the back of the net

## Cue the MADNESS! Cue the NOISE! Cue the EXCITEMENT!!!

That WAS IT!!




