# Men's First Team Bassett Bulletin

## Welcome To Tonight's Game

**GOOD EVENING** and welcome to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Wiseman Lighting Floodlit Cup game against Mangotsfield United. A warm welcome to all our visitors who have made the journey down the M4 from Bristol, we hope you enjoy your short stay with us this evening and we wish you a safe journey home.

Well the FA Vase dream is over for another season but Sam and the lads can be proud of yet another excellent cup run in this prestigious competition. To lose on penalties is cruel at any time and, whilst we have been on the right side of a few spot kick competitions in recent seasons, on this occasion it was not to be. Corsham are a very good side and it was always going to be a tough game but once again a match between the sides had an element of controversy in it with a second sending off for us this season in games against Corsham.

The very professional looking post match interviews from the Corsham manager Kieron Baggs always give me a chuckle as he looks from side to side as if he is worried about being abducted by aliens or the police are after him. His comment about the "slope" on our pitch in his interview on Saturday made me laugh even more than normal. I guess if you move your head that much in interviews you get dizzy and every pitch must look like it has a slope on it! After two close games with Corsham already this season we can expect another one on Boxing Day in a couple of weeks' time.

Back to tonight's game, this is the third time we have played Mangotsfield this season. The first ever meeting between the two sides was on the opening day of the season when on a Tuesday night in front of a bumper crowd of 192 we won by a solitary goal from Alfie Presley.

The return fixture in the league was another midweek fixture and goals from Tommy Ouldrige and Jack Hobson-McVeigh saw us secure a narrow 2-1 win to complete a league double over Mangotsfield.

After spending the previous 22 seasons in the Southern League Mangotsfield were hoping to bounce back at the first attempt but things have not gone to plan and are currently struggling at the wrong end of the table in 18th place with five wins from their opening 19 league games. Whilst they have struggled in the league they have performed better in cup competitions. In the FA Vase they secured 2-0 wins over both Abingdon United and Crediton United to make it through to the Second Round Proper but were eventually eliminated by

Clevedon Town, going down 4-0. They made it through to the Second Round of the Wiseman Lighting Cup with a narrow 1-0 away win against FC Stratford to set up tonight's contest.

Although this cup competition is often not one that club's prioritise it is perhaps the one for us that now offers the best chance of honours now that we exited the FA Vase and the Wiltshire Premier Shield. Already through to the last eight are Calne Town, Longlevens, Malvern, Pershore Town, Wantage Town and Westfields, and the winner from tonight's game and the game between Kidlington Res and Bradford Town will joined these six sides in the quarter finals. A kind draw that avoids Malvern could well see the winner of tonight's game make it through to the semi-final and just one game away from a final.

After tonight's game the first team are away this coming Saturday against Longlevens. We anticipate that the following Saturday will see us in Bluefin Insurance Cup action but at the time of writing we have no idea of who are Second Round opponents will be. With the Development Team set to be at home that Saturday and with confirmation from Wembley in writing that league fixtures in the Wiltshire Senior League take priority over that cup competition given the need to have Step 6 promotion candidates clarified by the cut-off date, there may need to be some interesting discussions with Mr King.

The Development Team were without a game on Saturday due to the FA Vase fixture but return to action on Saturday when they host Pewsey Vale here at the Sustain Stadium.

The Women's side were back in action on Sunday but again suffered another defeat in the league going down 3-0 to high flying Sherbourne Town. Although ultimately falling to a convincing sounding 3-0 defeat, Royal Wootton Bassett Town were left cursing their luck come full time of a match in which Bassett merited much, much more than they came away with. Simon Harrison's side hit the woodwork three times in their latest defeat - a result that means the team stay bottom of the South West Regional Women's Football League Premier Division, but one which could well have been very different had Bassett got the rub of the green. Bassett's performance was certainly deserving of more.

Enjoy tonight's game and hopefully a safe passage for Sam and the lads into the last 8 of this cup competition.

# Last Meeting at Sustain Stadium

## RWBTFC V MANGOTSFIELD UTD

**Tuesday 2nd August 2022**

### **Royal Wootton Bassett Town 1 Mangotsfield United 0**

Opening day success has been rare for Royal Wootton Bassett Town in recent seasons. But Sam Collier's side made sure they were quick off the mark to start the 2022-23 Hellenic League Premier Division campaign as an impressive performance helped Bassett to a narrow 1-0 victory against Mangotsfield United.

The visiting Mangos, newly relegated to the Hellenic League after more than two decades at Southern League level, were an unknown quantity for Bassett going into the match. But given the club's pedigree, there was a solid expectation that they would be a strong, competitive side.

That proved to be the case - particularly in the latter stages of the opening half when Mangotsfield really came to the fore.



But Bassett stood firm against their visitors. And Alfie Presley's composed finish ten minutes into the second half ultimately proved enough to ensure that the hosts took all three points from an intriguing contest.

Bassett started the match with intent but, aside from a penalty appeal that was turned down, failed to really test Ashley Clarke in the Mangotsfield goal. The home side's best chance of the half then came around the half hour mark when Presley skewed wide as Bassett countered following a defensive lapse.

By this point though it was Mangotsfield who were in the ascendancy, with the visitors having already seen a deflected effort graze the woodwork. Moments after Presley's miss, they were almost ahead too as a stunning volleyed effort seemed as though it was destined to open the scoring, but Bassett 'keeper Matt Crowther pulled off an outstanding acrobatic save to tip the ball around the post.

Going into half time goalless with both teams having enjoyed spells of pressure, the game was finely poised.

And it's outcome would soon be decided.

Ten minutes after the restart, an incisive Bassett break had the Mangotsfield backline on their heels. It did initially appear as though the attack would be snuffed out as imposing centre half Michael Grist went to ground to challenge Bailey Gallagher inside the visitors' penalty area following Tommy Ouldrige's dangerous diagonal pass. However, fortunately for Bassett, the ball fell into Gallagher's feet and, with Clarke drawn from his line, he squared for Presley to slot home.



Bassett now had the wind in their sails, but a second goal was not forthcoming. That made for a somewhat nervy finish to the match. However, with Collier's side defensively sound, Mangotsfield were unable to fashion anything of note despite the extra men they were throwing forward.

# Opponents History

## MANGOTSFIELD UNITED



The 2022/23 season will be Mangotsfield's first season playing at step 5 following 22 seasons as a Southern League club, which includes the voided 2019/20 and 20/21 seasons. After thirteen seasons in the "Pitchin In" Southern Football League Division One South previously finishing 9th in 2009/10, 3rd in 2010/11, (but losing the play-off semi-final, 1-3 to Frome Town), 14th in 2011/12, 13th in 2012/13, 11th in 2013/14, 10th in 2014/15, 14th in 2015/16, 8th in 2016/17, & 16th in both 2017/18 and 2018/19, following the 2 year "Covid gap" Mangotsfield finished 18th (out of 19 teams) in 2021/22 and were automatically relegated into the Hellenic League Premier Division.

There has been football in the village since 1888 and four years later, Mangotsfield FC became a founder member of the Bristol & District League (later to become the Western Football League in 1895) but the club folded after 10 years. From 1898 until the 1950s, Mangotsfield FC was disbanded and subsequently reformed on several occasions. In January 1951, the parent club dispensed with the Reserve X1 for financial reasons leaving many local players without a team to play for. These players decided to form a new club in the village and at the start of the 1951-52 season, the newly-established Mangotsfield United FC was entered into the Bristol & District League, Division VII. They achieved five successive promotions and gained entry to the Bristol & District Premier Combination in 1957. The club remained there until 1972-73, when it was accepted in to the Western League.

The Club became established in the Western League during the 1970's and despite being relegated to the first division in 1981-82, "The Field", as they were affectionately known, bounced straight back the following season and under the guidance of the charismatic Ralph Miller, who as Chairman, undertook the task of improving the ground and its facilities, became a force in the Premier, mainly featuring in the leading positions.

In 1991, the club, managed by Harold Jarman and assisted by Terry Rowles, achieved regional glory by taking the (then) Great Mills League Premier Division title, ahead of runners-up Torrington. Disappointingly, they were denied promotion to the Southern League as the ground failed to meet the grading requirements and there followed several lean seasons as the team disbanded. Under newly-elected Chairman Richard Davis, however, off the pitch, things were improving.

Terry Rowles returned to manage the club himself in 1995 and kept them in the spotlight by consistently finishing in the top three/four in the Great Mills/Screwfix League and an appearance in the FA Vase semi-final (losing to Clitheroe), but their ambitions of promotion and Southern League football were always thwarted by the continual success of Taunton and Tiverton Town. It was considered very important to

establish a sound working base, improve ground facilities and secure a long-term tenure on their Cossham Street ground.

In earlier years, the Roger Pullin / Richard Davis partnership had seen many improvements take place, with the installation of Conference-style floodlights and at the end of the 2003/04 season, the Cossham Street end of the ground was covered, together with new toilet blocks and social club improvements. Ex player Andy Black returned to the club as Manager in 1999 and guided the club to promotion to the Dr. Martens Southern League and three successful campaigns. The 2003/04 campaign did not go too well and just before Christmas, Black was replaced by Martyn Grimshaw. Towards the end of the campaign, Nigel Webb came in as his Assistant, but the club could only finish in 13th place, which was not high enough for the planned re-structuring of the Pyramid.

The Management duo made promotion their priority in 2004/05 and the club headed the table for most of the campaign, eventually taking the Division One West title with a 21 match unbeaten run. After 28 seasons at Western League level, the club had spent just five campaigns at Southern League level before reaching the Premier Division. In April/May 2005, Roger Pullin left the club and Mike Richardson took over as Chairman, with a new Board. As detailed at the start of this article Mangotsfield enjoyed life in the Southern League finishing most season's around mid table, but had struggled financially during the last few years.

Sometimes now referred to as "The Mangos", the 2020/21 campaign, started with Glyn Ashton, at the helm. He had previously been in charge of the U18s Floodlit Youth side, but took over as temporary Manager in 2019/20, after the sudden departure of Manager Ollie Price, and bought in almost his entire U18s squad. Glyn Ashton returned to his role of managing the U18/Reserve team for the 2021/22 season as Ray Johnston, along with assistant Terry Moore, took over the first team management role but Glyn returned to the hot seat following the departure of Ray and Terry following some disappointing performances and results. The club, however, were unable to "avoid the drop" finishing in 18th place in a league of 19 teams.

The summer of 2021/22 has been a busy one for the club as Chairman Mike Richardson has been replaced by Steve Brown, a new committee has been formed, and with a new commercial team in place the club are about to enter an exciting new era in it's history. A new management team, headed by John Allen, previously of toolstation outfit Keynsham Town, will be in charge for the coming season. A mix of experienced players, that John has bought in, along with the young players already at Mangotsfield should produce a team capable of competing well at this new level. The resurrection of the reserves team and introduction of an "A" side will also help to raise the profile of the club and give players the chance to progress.

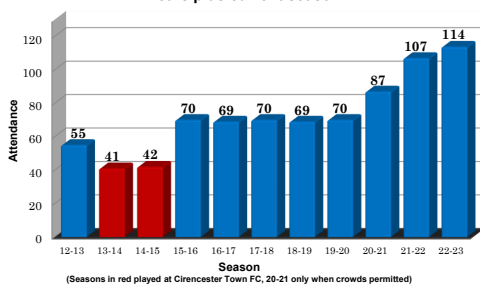

# Match Report 22-23

## MEN'S FIRST TEAM

**Saturday 3rd December 2022**

### **Royal Wootton Bassett Town 0 Corsham Town 0**

**Corsham won 4-3 pens**

For the second season in a row Royal Wootton Bassett Town suffered a heartbreaking defeat in the FA Vase third round.

While a narrow 3-1 loss against Hamworthy United ended last year's record breaking run, the manner of defeat in this season's record equalling journey was more painful as Sam Collier's side lost 4-3 on penalties to Corsham Town after having pushed their Wiltshire and Hellenic League rivals all the way in a tense 90 minutes of football that ended goalless.

Knowing they were in for a battle against powerful, strong opponents, Collier set his side up in a relatively defensive formation. Wanting to keep things tight at the back, those tactics were executed diligently and paid off during the opening period which - for the most part - passed without any significant action in front of goal.

The game finally started to open up in the final stages of the half though, with the first proper chance falling to the visitors' Ryan Bath, who sliced wide of the mark after a free kick fell to him in the box.

Mark Cooper then hooked just off target following Nathan Davis' long throw, while at the other end Jack Hobson-McVeigh came close, steering a low effort inches wide of the left post after Alfie Presley's low corner bounced around in the box.

Corsham soon had the best opportunity of the game so far in stoppage time following a slip from 'keeper Matt Crowther after he had came out of his area to try and deal with a ball over the top. But, first, a sliding tackle from Chris Taylor then a block from Adam Corcoran and, finally, a parry from Crowther saved Bassett from going into the break a

goal down as the visitors were unable to take advantage of having multiple bites at the cherry.

As tense and tight as the opening half was, the second was more open.

Again, however, neither team was able to make the decisive breakthrough.

Three minutes after the restart Dan Demkiv steered across the face of goal from a tight angle following a square ball into the six yard box from his brother Callum after Corsham were able to break the Bassett offside trap.

Shortly after, an unmarked Dan Demkiv headed wide from a Davis delivery before Bath went close again with an effort from the edge of the box that was inches wide of the post.

Both sides were at this point getting desperate as it appeared one goal would perhaps be enough to decide the tie.

Bassett had their best spell of the game around the hour mark as Matt Bennett skewed a glancing header wide from twelve yards following Louis Spalding's teasing cross. A defensive lapse then presented Alfie Presley with a golden opportunity as he found space between the centre halves to receive Tommy Ouldrige's weighted delivery from the right, but a slip when he just had the 'keeper to beat put paid to his hopes of opening the scoring.

At the other end, Bassett survived a pair of goalmouth scrambles - the first following a corner, the second from a right-wing cross to the near post.

A Matt Jones corner almost saw Bassett snatch a goal. Sam Jepson came off his line to claim and came up empty-handed, allowing Luke Whelan to redirect the ball to the far post with the 'keeper stranded. However, Corcoran could only head over.

Corsham then could have snatched a winner on the break when Matt Jenkins was played in behind the defence, but a great recovery run from Jowan Partridge applied enough pressure to force the visitors' substitute to skew wide when he probably should have done better.

Although play continued to go from end to end, that would be the final real opportunity in front of goal - but it wasn't to be the last moment of drama in normal time as Golding received a controversial red card following an altercation in the visitors' box.

There wasn't enough time for that numerical disadvantage to do Bassett any harm though as the referee soon blew the final whistle.

That meant penalties. But, unlike away at Wellington in the previous round, Bassett would not come out on top.

Bassett went first with Taylor finding the net, the ball just squeezing past Jepson who guessed correctly. Matt Swann then levelled before what proved to be a decisive second and third round of kicks.

Partridge - superb at centre half and Bassett's man of the match - saw his effort saved by Jepson. And although Crowther kept out Davis' subsequent effort, Jepson gave his side the advantage as he denied Spalding.

Matt Groves put Corsham ahead - and it was a lead his side would not surrender. Hobson-McVeigh and Presley scored to make sure it came down to the last penalty. However Leon Greenland and - with the deciding spot kick - Dan Demkiv converted, meaning it was Corsham who were the side writing history as they advanced to the fourth round for the first time.

It was a superb effort from start to finish from Bassett - but ultimately it wasn't to be.

Penalties are a cruel way to lose. However, Bassett can take heart from a gutsy display - and another successful run in the Vase.

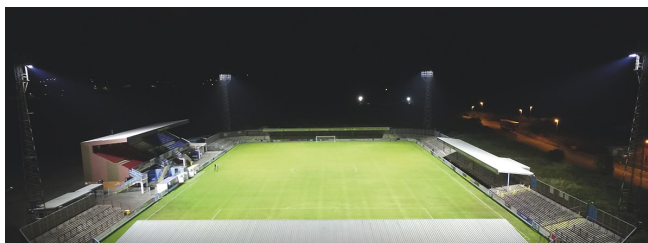

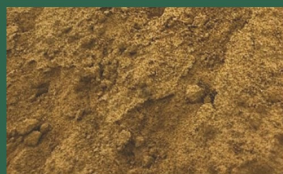
