Men's First Team Bassett Bulletin Welcome To Today's Game

GOOD AFTERNOON and welcome

to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this FA Vase fixture against Corsham Town. A warm welcome to all our visitors who have made the short journey from Corsham, we hope you enjoy your short stay with us this afternoon and we wish you a safe journey home.

When you play in these National competitions you always really want to play teams from different leagues, especially when you get into these later rounds. With just Corsham Town and Cribbs in the 12 teams in our zone in the draw, the odds of getting such a draw looked good but unfortunately the balls did not fall our way and we drew a fellow Uhlsport Hellenic League side. At least we have the consolation of being at home.

Corsham Town have made another good start to the season and currently sit in sixth place in the league table with games in hand over all the five teams above them. They have lost just two of the sixteen league games played so far this season.

Whilst over the years our record against Corsham Town is a decent one that is not the case in recent meetings, with just one win in the last five games for us. We come into today's game having lost three in a row a run we will be hoping to end here this afternoon. The meeting between the two sides earlier in the season was a feisty affair, as is often the case in games between near neighbours, Corsham winning by a solitary Callum Demkiv goal.

On top of being a Wiltshire derby encounter, there will be extra spice added to the match today given that both teams will be aiming to write club history, with neither Bassett nor Corsham having ever advanced beyond the Vase third round before. Indeed, for both clubs this season is only the second occasion in which they have reached this stage. For Bassett, it is a welcome first home fixture in the competition after wins on the road against Bridport (5-3) and then Wellington (2-2, 5-4 on penalties).

While Sam Collier's side enjoyed an exemption to the first round, Corsham have already faced four fixtures in the Vase this season, recording three wins away from home during their impressive run. After a 3-1 home triumph against Cove in the first qualifying round, the Quarrymen triumphed 6-5 on penalties following a 2-2 second qualifying round draw away at Bristington. They then saw off a second Western League side, thumping Keynsham Town 4-0 in the first round. Kieran Baggs' men

were then 3-1 winners in their second round fixture against fellow Hellenic Premier outfit Roman Glass St George.

Corsham last made it to the third round in 2006-07, recording wins against Harefield United and Amesbury Town before a loss away at Bideford. Since losing in the first round in 2007-08 and prior to this season, Corsham fell into a Vase rut, going beyond the qualifying round stages just twice (where they were eliminated in the first round) in 14 Vase participations. Corsham have more than made up for that recent dearth of Vase success this season though with a record-equalling run – and they'll no doubt be aiming to extend it further when they make the short trip to Bassett.

Like their visitors to be, Bassett have only found themselves in the third round once before too — that coming last season when the team were beaten 3-1 at home by Hamworthy United. With club history again on the line, Collier and his side will be hoping to avoid a similar fate this time.

Looking at our other sides, the Development Team bounced back from the previous week's defeat with a comfortable 5-1 home win over Ludgershall Sports in the Fountain Trophies Cup last Saturday. A brief summary of the game is included in tonight's programme. They will be home again in the next round with Melksham Town Reserves scheduled to visit the Sustain Stadium next month. The impact of the Hellenic League fixture scheduling and the multiple home cup draws for the First Team means that 11 of the Development Team's remaining 15 fixtures (possibly more if they progress further in the cup) will be at home!

The Women's side were winners against Purton in their last game in the Wiltshire County Cup and managed to avoid Swindon Town in the semi-final draw and will be home to Durrington with the game scheduled for 15th January. They now need to start turning their cup form into league points as they seek to climb away from the bottom of the table. Last week saw the Under 18 side produce a much improved second half performance to beat AFC Aldermaston 4-2. Hopefully by the time you read these notes they will have continued their unbeaten start to the season and progressed to the Second Round of the League Cup.

Enjoy today's game and hopefully a safe passage for Sam and the lads into the last 32 of this prestigious national competition.

Fairford Town manager Jamie Reid lamented his team's attitude as his side fell to a heavy 4-1 defeat to Thornbury Town in the Hellenic Premier Division on Tuesday night, writes George Nash.

Reid's side were convincingly beaten in Gloucestershire on a miserable evening where the Fairford boss brought into question the application of his players.

"The lads on Tuesday just didn't turn up at all," said Reid.

"It was cold, it was wet, there was no atmosphere and I just didn't feel like any of them wanted to be there.

"When you go into games like that, you need to match their desire and their effort. It's the old clichés of earning the right to play and we just didn't do that at all.

"There was zero effort and zero quality from my players and we got what we deserved."

The loss brings an end to a good recent run of results for Reid's men, after an impressive 3-0 win over Bradford Town was backed up with a 2-2 stalemate against local rivals Royal Wootton Bassett Town last Friday.

Reid's side put themselves in a commanding position at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground as Danny Gudger and Robbie James put them two goals to the good at the break.

But Bassett, who have made a habit of coming from behind in recent weeks, fought back with a brace from substitute Matt Bennett earning Sam Collier's men a share of the spoils.

And Reid was quick to offer an honest assessment of the game, admitting that a draw was an accurate reflection of the contest.

"I thought we were quite lucky to get the two goals but it was great to go into half-time 2-0 up. "In fairness I felt they did deserve to get something out of the game. If we'd had got that third goal early in the second half it might have been a different story but we didn't.

"They had their spell and they scored at the right time. And I think a draw was a fair result in the end."

The Bassett boss, however, was buoyed by his team's ability to come from behind and

believes they could have nicked all three points at the death.

"We started really well but then got sloppy with it," said Collier. "We knew the way they were going to cause us problems from set pieces and that's exactly what happened.

"Words were said at half-time and we knew we had to be better. We made some changes and got back into the game at 2-2. I think if we'd played another five minutes we probably would have won it"

Speaking about the importance of having players who can come off the bench and positively impact the game, Collier added: "It's absolutely massive.

"We spoke after the game about the importance of having a squad. If you want to be in the top six of this league then you've got to have good subs and we've got that at the moment.

"We've had a few seven day approaches from clubs for certain players but they've committed to us. So hopefully we can keep the group together because that is so important, especially when you go behind in games."

Opponents History CORSHAM TOWN

The earliest record found of Corsham Football Club is 1878 with the club becoming affiliated to the Football Association in 1893. Over the years, the team has often been referred to as the Quarrymen due to the high level of quarrying in and around Corsham.

In March 1894, the first Wiltshire Football League was formed with the original member clubs being Bradford, Calne, Chippenham, Corsham, Southbroom (Devizes), Melksham, Trowbridge Town, and Warminster. At the end of the 1894/95 season Corsham would be the inaugural champions, winning the league on goal average over Southbroom, helped by an emphatic 17 - 1 win over Calne in their final game.

Promotion was achieved to the Western League at the end of the 1997/98 season after winning the county league by goal difference from Devizes Town Reserves.

Ground improvements continued under the chairmanship of Colin Hudd, floodlights were installed in 2001, a 112 spectator stand erected and hard standing laid around the pitch perimeter.

2006/07 season saw Corsham Town winning the Western League Premier Division, which was hotly contested by many teams,

including Bridgwater Town and Frome Town. The club also added a third successive Wiltshire Senior Cup victory, again over local rivals Melksham Town.


Due to the Covid pandemic the 2019/20 season was declared null and void by the Football Association on 26th March 2020.

Justin Flowers and his backroom staff parted with the club at the end of the null and void 2019/20 season and moved across to Malmesbury Victoria.

The 2020/21 season saw Keiran Baggs becoming the new manager with Gary Higdon as his assistant. Unfortunately, after 10 league games the 2020/21 was curtailed by the FA due to the Covid pandemic.

Despite the last two seasons being affected by Covid, the FA went ahead with planned restructuring of the Non-League Pyramid. The results from 2019/20 & 2021/21 were combined and this meant that Corsham Town finished in a position for upward movement.

The club took this upward movement to Step 5 with a lateral movement into the Hellenic League Premier Division, finishing in a creditable fifth spot.

Davis Double Sees Season End in Defeat Royal Wootton Bassett Town 0 Corsham Town 2

Royal Wootton Bassett Town's 2021-22 Hellenic League Premier Division campaign ended in defeat as Nathan Davis' first half double decided a closely fought encounter in Corsham Town' favour in a game played in front of a bumper Easter Sunday crowd.

341 spectators – Bassett's largest crowd of the season – packed the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for a fixture played as part of the league's annual ground hopper weekend. And while the contest ended in a 2-0 win for the visitors from west Wiltshire, Sam Collier's side can at least be satisfied with the performance they put in, particularly with the game being played less than 48 hours since their derby triumph against Shrivenham.

It was certainly a much closer affair than that between the teams in November, but ultimately Corsham claimed a season double over Bassett courtesy of Davis' brace with both goals scored in the final quarter hour of the game's opening period.

It had been extremely tight up until Davis scored his first, with the best opportunity in the opening half hour falling to Bassett's Bailey Gallagher, who saw a shot just cleared off the line. But it was the visitors who wound up breaking the deadlock. Corsham's first goal came in somewhat fortunate circumstances as the visitors profited from a throw in decision that should have gone Bassett's way. The hosts still had the opportunity to successfully defend from it though. However, Davis scored with a low curling shot from the right edge of the box that found the corner of the net courtesy of a deflection.

That goal initiated a spell in which Corsham found themselves on top. And they were soon 2 -0 up after Chris Taylor conceded a penalty and Davis sent Eddie Cavanagh the wrong way from the spot. It was then almost three just before the interval, but Cavanagh did brilliantly to save Gary Higdon's header at point blank range.

Bassett were by no means defeated at the break, but with a two goal deficit they found themselves with plenty to do if they were to have any chance of getting something from the match. And the hosts fought well after the restart, being arguably the better side during the second half. On the hour mark, leading scorer John Mills hit a powerful shot from the edge of the box that 'keeper Rob Brown took well. Late on the forward had the ball in the back of the net direct from a corner, but that was disallowed for a foul on Brown. Shortly after, Chris Taylor's free kick from just outside the area deflected narrowly wide off the wall.

The visitors then had the final opportunity of the match when sub Baldwin Osayi Igbinobaro went on a surging run. However, Cavanagh was equal to his effort, the 'keeper saving with his feet.


The loss means Bassett were unable to finish the campaign with a winning record, their final totals for the season being 16 wins, 16 defeats and six draws from their 38 league fixtures – enough for 12th place. That points haul does mean the side finish with the highest total the club have recorded while in the Hellenic Premier Division. Combined with the record-setting run in this year's FA Vase, the campaign can, on balance, be counted as a success.

But the season also ends with the sense that Bassett could have perhaps achieved at least a bit more in what was a highly competitive division. Against the nine teams they finished alongside in the bottom half, Bassett picked up a hugely impressive 42 points. However, against those winding up in the top ten, twenty matches yielded a return of just twelve points – six of which came against Longlevens.

While suggesting Bassett were a fair distance in quality behind those teams, a closer inspection of the team's record suggests otherwise. Indeed, of their losses in the league, just five were suffered by greater than a two-goal margin, while Bassett claimed points off three of the teams finishing in the division's top four. Nevertheless, after 14 seasons (twelve of which have been completed) in the top tier of the Hellenic League, a top half finish remains elusive still.







MISBEHAVING FANS IN NON LEAGUE



LAST week, NLP editor Matt Badcock spoke in his column about the alarming trend of fan misbehaviour which is sadly creeping into our game.

Believe me, it's not something we take any enjoyment from, but it came to a head one Saturday night as we were preparing to put the paper to bed.

The original plan was to celebrate a National League record crowd at Notts County when a massive 16,511 supporters clicked through the turnstiles to see the Magpies take on Yeovil Town.

On the same day, there were over 10,000 watching Wrexham play Aldershot Town and another 7,000+ crowd at Chesterfield for the crunch clash with Solihull Moors. So, you can imagine our angst when instead of 16,511 fans making the front page headlines it the actions of just one idiot who stole the limelight.

About an hour before we went to press, a video was brought to our attention of a so-called Guiseley 'fan' jumping over the barrier of Warrington Town's Cantilever Park ground and switching the water bottle of Wire keeper Tony Thompson which was nestled into the net.

It then emerged that the bottle in question had apparently been contaminated with urine. Thompson drank it and then approached the alleged perpetrator, prompting him to be sent off. The front page headline 'Disgusting' said it all.

While, thankfully, this is a one-off incident it has once again raised concerns of bad fans' behaviour, which is dragging the pure reputation Non-League football through the mud.

With the Premier League and Championship on hold for the World Cup, Non-League clubs up and down the country have worked extremely hard putting on special deals, trying to pack their bars and clubhouses for people to watch the action in Qatar and to generally propel this level of the game into the wider spotlight. A

celebration of Non-League football if you like.

As Matt rightly pointed out, the frustration is these incidents don't appear to be isolated. On a number of occasions this season we've had to report unsavoury instances of poor behaviour inside football grounds.

At the start of the season, the Football Association and leagues issued a document to clubs in an attempt to help eradicate some of the issues. The problem is, what can clubs do to prevent it? Guiseley handled this particular incident expertly well. They immediately banned the young man involved and vowed to clamp down on any accomplices. They deserve credit for their own swift action on what would have been a difficult weekend for them.

Unfortunately, preventative methods are having consequences on the terraces – and it's a real sad state of affairs. Clubs such as Walsall Wood and Prescot Cables are refusing entry for under 16s without a supervised adult and at Coalville Town the ground staff are even wearing body cams in a bid to identify persistent offenders.

As necessary as measures like that are, they represents everything that Non-League football shouldn't. We should be encouraging the support of the younger generation and we certainly shouldn't have to follow them round the ground on camera. Sadly, it's needs must.


It seems that the pure nature of a Non-League ground makes it an easy target. While elite stadiums are regimented so fans are confined to one seat and one entry/exit gate, a Non-League ground gives fans the freedom to wonder around and sit or stand where they want. That is being taken advantage of.

Don't get me wrong, 99 per cent of football fans, and Non-League fans in general, are decent folk. They just there to watch a game, support the club and enjoy the day. It's vital we don't tar everyone with the same brush.

Record numbers are turning to Non-League football for its integrity and its purity. Let's not let the proud reputation of our game be ruined by the few.

Royal W. Bassett Town 4 AFC Aldermaston 2

Just one game survived the wet weather in the Under 18 Floodlight Division this week, that game being the match at the Sustain Stadium between second in the table Royal Wootton Bassett Town and bottom side Aldermaston who had won just one of their opening seven games, losing the other six. The form book would have suggested a comfortable night for the home side, but it was anything but for Nick Warren's side in an entertaining game. Right from the start AFC Aldermaston matched the home side stride for stride and were much the better side in the opening half. They went 1-0 up just after the half hour mark when Freddie Stewart pounced on an error in the six-yard box by Royal Wootton Bassett Town's Charlie Stammers, Stammers failing to clear the ball enabling Stewart to fire Aldermaston in front. They went close to extending their lead a minute before half-time, Oscar Kirby firing in a powerful shot which was well saved with his feet by Jack Rae in the Royal Wootton Bassett Town goal and it remained just the one goal at the break.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town upped their game in the second half and went close to getting back on level terms ten minutes into the second half when Flynn Walters saw his shot deflected onto the post and out for a corner. They eventually did get themselves back in the game on the hour mark, a misplaced shot from Rhys Westlake fell to Euan Spackman who put it away for 1-1. The home side then went in front for the first time ten minutes later, a dangerous cross from the right by Charlie Stammers to the

far post saw Flynn Walters stretch to get on the end of it, which he succeeded in doing, keeping the ball in play putting it into the six-yard box, where Jacob Rendell-Haines had a simple tap in for 2-1.

They did not hold the lead for long though. Aldermaston were awarded a free kick 25-yards out in a central position and Oscar Kirby smashed the free kick into the top corner of the net to make it 2-2 with 15 minutes to go. Royal Wootton Bassett Town knew they could not really afford to drop many more points in their quest for the title and immediately sought to respond, Euan Spackman firing a shot just over the bar within a minute of Aldermaston's goal. As the game went into its final ten minutes it looked like the sides would have to settle for a point apiece, but Royal Wootton Bassett Town's Rhys Westlake had other ideas. With seven minutes to go the ball was fed into his feet on the edge of the Aldermaston box and he turned defender and slotted the ball past Aldermaston's keeper into the far bottom corner of the net for 3-2. Aldermaston once again sought to get back on level terms but in pushing caught plavers forward were on counterattack just two minutes after falling behind. A ball out of defence saw Flynn Walters pick the ball up on the halfway line and run past a couple of defenders with Westlake joining him to make it two-against one as the Aldermaston keeper came out, Walters unselfishly slid the ball across to Westlake who had an open goal in front of him and put it away for 4-2 and secure all three points for the home side. Royal Wootton Bassett certainly knew they had been involved in a tough game and if Aldermaston continue to play like they did that second win of the season cannot be too far away.
