Welcome To Today's Game

GOOD EVENING and welcome to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this UHlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against local rivals Fairford Town. A warm welcome to all our visitors who have made the short journey from Fairford, we hope you enjoy your brief stay with us this evening and wish you a safe journey home.

Tonight's game is vital for both sides in their push for the play-offs, with Fairford sat just one place and four points below us in the table. These local derbies are always close run contests, with plenty of passion shown, and this one tonight has added extra spice given what potentially hinges on the game. By switching the game to a Friday night hopefully we will be rewarded by a larger than normal crowd. We certainly had that last week with the bumper attendance of 256 for our fixture against Corsham Town. We were possibly helped by being just about the only game on in the local area and it was very much spot the other clubs in attendance with representatives from Highworth Town, and Devizes Town amongst the ones I noted, along with a sizeable contingent who had travelled from Corsham.

To lose to a late winner like we did last Saturday was very hard on Sam and the lads. I only caught the second half as I was covering the Dev Team game for the Wiltshire Senior League, but we definitely deserved something out of the game from what I saw. We could possibly have won it if Alfie had put that chance away five minutes from time. Nine times out of ten I think he would have scored with that chance, it was just a shame that this was that one occasion where he put it over the bar. You would have thought the Corsham players had won the FA Cup Final, the World Cup and the Champions League the way they celebrated at the end and the celebrations that went on in the dressing room were also over the top and a bit disrespectful in my opinion. Hopefully we will can the chance to avenge

that defeat in the play-offs. Firstly we need to book our place in those play-offs and three points this evening is essential really. Our recent record against Fairford is a good one with just one defeat in the last six meetings. Whilst Fairford have the better record with 12 wins to our 11, two wins and a draw in the last three games against them has brought us close to matching their record in the fixture and win tonight would restore parity.

The Development Team finally put an end to their miserable run of defeats last Saturday with a 2-0 win over Calne Town Reserves. In reality they could have won by a lot more and Calne didn't really create any clear cut chances in the full 90 minutes due to an excellent performance from the Bassett defensive line. Man of the match was Mani Mesas who got both goals. This weekend they are also playing this evening with a short trip down the road to Malmesbury Victoria Development, assuming the pitch has dried out following all the recent rain which has seen the Malmesbury pitch flooded on six occasions this season. If it is on tonight you can guarantee it will be heavy which might not suit a side like ourselves used to playing on 3G this season.

On Sunday the Women's side drew with Bath 1-1 for the second consecutive week at the Sustain Stadium. As this second game was a cup match penalties followed to decide matters and the good news is that we prevailed in the shoot out to progress to the next round where we will meet the winners of the tie between Stockwood Wanderers and Ilminster Town. On Sunday the Women's side are back in league action with a trip to the seaside to take on Weymouth looking to get three more points to finish as close as possible to champions Poole.

Enjoy the game and hopefully three points in our quest to make the end of season play-offs.

SOCCER SKILLS ACADEMY EASTER HOLIDAY CAMPS

The Soccer Skills Academy, operated by club partners Wiltshire Football Academy, will be holding two holiday camp at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground during the Easter school holidays.

The first camp will take place from Tuesday 2 to Friday 6 April.

The second camp will take place from Monday 8 to Friday 12 April.

Fairford Town



Whilst Fairford Town Football Club was formed in 1891 and for many years played in the Cirencester & District League against local teams with varying degrees of success.

After the second world war the club joined the Swindon & District League, winning the Premier Division in both 1964/65 and 1968/69, also winning the Advertiser Cup in the same years, and in 1962/63 won the Gloucestershire Junior Cup.

Success in the Swindon & District League was followed by election to the Hellenic League in 1970, only missing promotion from the first division on goal average at the first attempt, the club were also beaten finalists in that year's division one Challenge Cup.

The following year, 1971/72 saw Fairford win the Hellenic first division and division one Challenge Shield, whilst the reserve side won the Gloucestershire County Minor Cup, the Advertiser Cup and finished runners-up in the Swindon & District Division One.

The successful run continued and Town were the beaten finalists of 1972/73 in the Premier Division Cup, only to be relegated back to Division One in 1973/74.

Fairford Town were again promoted in 1975/76 and steady progress led to the

Premier Division Runners-up in 1978/79 and 1979/80, also winning the Premier Division Cup in 1978/79.

The Club were winners of the Gloucestershire Challenge Trophy in 1979/80 and 1998/99 and Runners-up in 1982/83 and 1994/95.

The most recent league success has been Premier Division Runners-up in season 1994/95 following a similar position in Season 1990/91. The Club has also achieved numerous wins in the Arthur Shipway Cup and Fairford Hospital Cup.

The 2016/17 season saw the club secure a return to the UHlsport Hellenic Premier Division after a five-year absence, winning the Division One West title with 75 points.

In recent years the club has grown on and off the pitch. The first team are now established and challenging in the UHlsport Hellenic Premier Division with a Reserves side also competing in Hellenic Division 2 South. 2020 also saw the creation of Fairford Town Academy with teams running from under 12s through to under 18s. We aim to place the football club within the heart of the local community and are keen to continue to grow and achieve our goal of promotion to the Southern Football League for the first time in the club's history.

Bennett Brace Salvages Derby Draw

For Royal Wootton Bassett Town's habit of coming from behind to earn a result continued as, courtesy of a Matt Bennett brace, Sam Collier's side overcame a 2-0 half time deficit to claim a point in an entertaining Friday night derby at home against Fairford Town.

In four of their last five games - and in their three most recent Hellenic League Premier Division fixtures, Bassett have fallen behind before reeling off impressive comebacks that have allowed the side to maintain their positive run of form.

However, while Bassett found themselves facing single goal deficits against Westfields, Worcester Raiders and Wellington, the comeback pulled off against Fairford was arguably more impressive as Collier and his team found themselves two goals down and facing the prospect of a third straight home loss against the Reds. But a half time overhaul - which saw the Bassett boss gamble by brining on three substitutes, including Bennett - did the trick and ultimately earned a share of the spoils.

A draw was arguably a fair outcome - and reflective of the fact that this was the proverbial game of two halves. Having soaked up early Bassett pressure that failed to translate into any meaningful chances, Fairford took the lead when unmarked defender Robbie James was on hand to steer in after a dangerous Tom Chamberlain free kick delivery had been redirected back across the face of goal by Olly Whelan.

The visitors soon doubled their advantage as half time neared. Adam Corcoran was unable to head clear from 'keeper Joe Wright's long pass forward and Danny Gudger took full advantage, beating Matt Crowther to the loose ball before rounding the 'keeper and steering in from an angle.

That left Bassett with a huge amount to do to get themselves back into the game. And while Collier resorted to shuffling his pack, bringing on Bennett, Bailey Gallagher and Sam Packer, his side were lucky that they didn't face an even greater deficit when Fairford forward George Peare, with the goal at his mercy, struck wide of the mark with a first time effort from close range early in the second half.

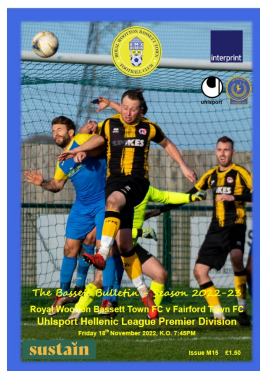


Having survived that scare, Bassett quickly got themselves back into the match. Moments later with the ball at the other end, Jack Hobson-McVeigh whipped in an inswinging corner, and Bennett, shaking off his marker, flicked in a header at the near post to make it 2-1.

It didn't take long for the scores to be levelled and for Bennett to grab his second. While under pressure from the forward, Fairford 'keeper Wright failed to hold on when coming out to catch a bouncing ball - and Bennett seized upon the error, slotting into the bottom corner from ten yards out. With the scores back level, that set up the game for an exciting finish. And both sides would have chances to snatch a winner late on. The error-prone Wright almost fumbled a Hobson-McVeigh corner into his own net but was saved by Whelan's goalline clearance.

For Fairford, Gudger came close as he saw a shot of his from the edge of the area catch a deflection and go narrowly over. Bassett then had arguably the best opportunity to claim the points when Alfie Presley got on the end of Bennett's fine low cross to steer towards goal but, fortunately for the visitors, his shot from eight yards out was straight at the 'keeper.

Bassett thus finish their run of four home league games unbeaten, with a win against Bradford Town and three consecutive draws. Those against Westfields and Worcester Raiders were certainly impressive, though Bassett would perhaps have wanted more from this fixture against Fairford.



Nevertheless, the team avoided defeat - and again showed their character to complete another comeback job.

Collier was absent from the dugout for the game but will have been grinning from ear to ear as goal updates flowed in during the opening half.

Bassett put Fairford to the sword as everything seemed to come together in a blistering 15 minutes of football.

The floodgates opened on the 20 minute mark. Bassett were awarded a penalty following a clumsy tackle from behind on Louis Spalding and Matt Jones rammed home to put the visitors ahead.

Bassett's lead was then soon doubled. Trying to play out from the back, Fairford sloppily gave the ball away. Connor Waldon charged down the left before the ball was worked across through Chris Taylor and Sam Packer to Brad Pagliaroli who deftly curled a beautiful first time effort into the top corner from the edge of the box.



Leading scorer Waldon was keen to get in on the act and duly did so after half an hour. A Fairford counter was broken up by Jowan Partridge who sent a ball over the top into the right corner for Jones, who steered in a towering cross that

Waldon guided in with a stooping back post header.

Sam Packer then grabbed his first of the campaign to make it 4-0 with ten minutes still left to play until the interval. More woeful defending was seized upon, this time by Pagliaroli, who - shortly after seizing possession - threaded a defence splitting through pass which Packer raced onto before coolly slotting beneath helpless home 'keeper Ben Mitchell.




Bassett had the ball in the net again before the interval but an offside flag denied Waldon a second headed effort from Jones' free kick.

By that point it was more or less game over. Jamal Lawrence pulled one back on the hour, slotting in after skilful play from Ben Lodge, while Joe Shutt added a second deep into injury time with an outstanding free kick. But Fairford were well beaten thanks to Bassett's first half onslaught.

Corsham curse continues in derby bookended by drama

Royal Wootton Bassett Town 1 Corsham Town 2

A last minute goal saw Royal Wootton Bassett Town fall to a 2-1 defeat in an enthralling Hellenic League Premier Division derby against Corsham Town.

The top of the table clash pitting second against third more than lived up to its billing as both teams gave their all in a nail-biting, frantic contest. But Sam Collier and his side were left empty-handed and having to face up to a seventh loss in all competitions against Corsham across the past three seasons.

The game - watched by a bumper crowd boosted by the fact that most other games in the division and local area had fallen foul of the weather - was bookended by drama.

Corsham grabbed the lead as early as the third minute as James Rusby rifled a free kick into the top corner beyond Rob Brown.

But Bassett were instantly back on level terms as Kyle Tooze seized on a rebound after a Louis Spalding shot wrong-footed visiting 'keeper Alfie Kelsey and came back out off the post.

The game's third and decisive goal then came in the final minute of the allotted 90. Corsham captain Mark Cooper bundled the ball in. That was a suckerpunch for Bassett who rose to the occasion and performed excellently all afternoon.

A draw would certainly have been a fairer outcome, while Bassett will have felt they could have won the game too.

Between the early and late drama, the game was evenly and hotly contested. Chances were rather limited but they were there for both teams.

Corsham felt aggrieved on the quarter hour mark that they didn't have a goal awarded as Bassett cleared off the line.

Later as time wound down Alfie Presley volleyed narrowly over while substitute George Box brought a save out of Brown at the other end.

A winner seemed as though it would elude both sides - but then Cooper delivered a dagger to Bassett hearts. Once again, Corsham proved to be Bassett's nemesis.

For Bassett there's the small consolation that - unlike earlier in the season when thumped 7-1 away from home - they pushed Corsham all the way. But, with just one point from their last three games, Bassett's grasp of a playoff place is now starting to appear slightly more tenuous.

The good news is that Bassett are in a position where they already have points on the board with others playing catch up, while there are still plenty of games remaining that the chasing pack have to play against each other.

But Collier and his team still need to boost their points total to be certain they will make it to the playoffs.

And with their final three fixtures pitting them against likely champions Worcester City before tricky trips to Slimbridge and Cinderford Town, Bassett's next two home fixtures against Fairford Town and Brimscombe and Thrupp now arguably take on the status of must-win games.

The pressure is on. But this team have the ability to deliver. Match the performance against Corsham (even if it may have ended in defeat), and Bassett should pull through.

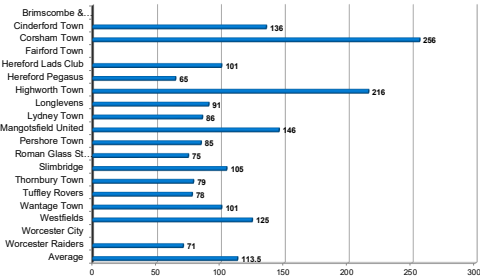

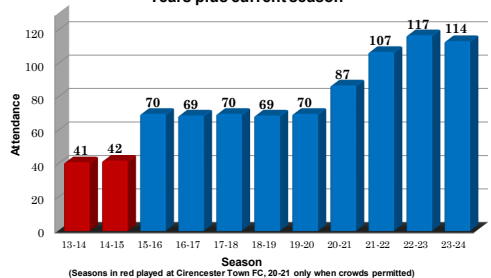

It doesn't take long to learn the tweet 'Game definitely on' doesn't always mean the game is definitely on.

And even when the match kicks off, it doesn't necessarily mean it will definitely finish.

During the final meeting at the hotel before jumping on the bus, it started raining. Driving towards the stadium, the rain continued. And got heavier. And heavier. The puddles got larger. The streets started to become streams.

The first sign of concern was seeing the stadium's adjacent 3G pitch - trained on just hours earlier - with large puddles.

Inside the stadium, the running track began to look more like a moat. Word came up from the dressing rooms that they too were slowly filling with water, the cables for the TV stations like electric eels swimming around.

By now the game had been called off. Brian Lee, the late former Football Conference chairman, wondered if anyone could find a sports hall to at least get some sort of action!

The car park was now a lake and it was time to man the lifeboats as players, still in full kit, waded to the coach – interrupted by a SUV driving up to the main door and sending a tidal wave of water back into foyer.

All that way for a game that never was. Some of the squad missed out in the future because of their age, never to be capped. If we hadn't travelled so far it would have been comical.

Funnily enough, England's senior game in Poland later that night was also rained off after the stadium roof wasn't closed in time. England 0-2 Weather.

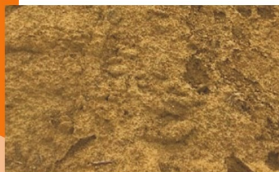

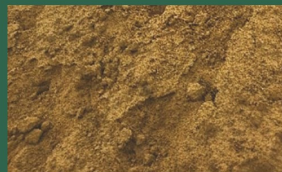
