# Women's Team Bassett Bulletin

## Welcome To Today's Game

**GOOD AFTERNOON** everyone and welcome back to the Sustain Stadium for our first home fixture in the ladies calendar this season. Sadly we were relegated at the end of last season after finishing bottom on goal difference. The task was always going to be a pretty tough one and despite better performances in the latter stage of the season we were unable to haul ourselves off the bottom and now find ourselves plying our trade in Tier 6 of the women's football pyramid.

This preseason has already seen lots of change. Simon Harrison was originally set to continue as manager of the women's team but after he chose to step down, his assistant Adam agreed to take charge of the team for the forthcoming season with Sam Wood stepping up as assistant manager. Over the summer we also lost Martin Peters who stepped away from the goal keeping position so with a spot to fill this has now been filled by Rich Fawcett, which has been welcomed greatly by our two young keepers. A mixed bag of results for the ladies over preseason, however, I'm excited to see how they fare in this division as Adam has managed to secure some good new signings while also retaining some key players from last years squad.

This will be our second league game today after our first fixture was an away derby day opener to recently promoted Purton, who went the whole season unbeaten in the league, securing promotion to Tier 6 (their only loss came to us in the County Cup). Despite not attending the game I heard from fellow spectators that it was a good performance on a pitch that could have done with some TLC (I heard the grass was incredibly long). The weather on the day was extremely warm and it was lovely to hear that many spectators both young and old were out supporting the girls in their first league win of the season, and we are excited to welcome them back to the Sustain Stadium today.

Last week we travelled to Bristol to face a depleted Longwell Green in the Woman's FA Cup, a game that should we win was worth £1,800. A huge amount for the club! Adam took a strong side to Bristol on the day and managed to wrap the game up within the first 15 minutes of the match to a team who sadly lost players to injury throughout the game and with only the bare 11 the task was always going to be tough. We secured our place in the next round and await a trip to fellow league opponents Stockwood Wanderers on October 1st.

I would also like to thank Kingsley Letting Agency who have agreed to sponsor our new ladies match-day tracksuits this season. And I'm also very grateful to all those who have chosen to sponsor some of the players and management team for the upcoming season. With over 18 of the team sponsored already, we are still on the look out for a few more, who have yet to be sponsored. Not my first article with RWBTFC but my first as manager so let me start by hoping that everyone had a great close season and I am delighted to welcome you back to the Sustain Stadium.

Although I write this off the back of two fantastic victories, as it is the first home game of the season it would be suitable to talk preseason first.

There have been some managerial changes, I was honoured to be offered the role by Bryan when Simon had resigned but the hard work was already underway for the upcoming season. The squad have seen some small changes as expected but I am hoping that you will enjoy some quick, exciting, attacking football which I believe will not only help us get back into tier five but will help us develop our identity, something I feel strongly that teams of our stature require. The team have worked extremely hard, we have increased our sessions to twice a week and have already started work on how we want to play and the standards we want to be accountable for.

Last week, we travelled to Longwell Green in the FA Cup who unfortunately were only able to name 11 players in their squad on an extremely hot day. We were able to take a full compliment (18 players) and although we were only able to use three subs, I think we managed the game perfectly and always looked like the team that were not going to tire as we saw Longwell have to go down to ten and even nine at points. As I said to the ladies after the game, however, you can only play what is in front of you and the FA Cup is a money spinner so there was a lot on the line. Thank you to those who travelled to watch the game, if nothing else I hope you enjoyed the 14 goals we managed to net.

Onto today, Frome had a very respectable third place finish in this division last season so I am expecting a tough game but we have prepared for this like any other. I hope you all enjoy the game and look forward to hearing you all!

Powell is a young goalkeeper entering her third season in senior football. She has great shotstopping ability and is also confident with the ball at her feet. Boasting a lot of talent and potential, she claimed the number one jersey early in the 2021-22 season and never looked back, featuring sixteen times while earning both the Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year awards for her excellent performances. Powell went on to make another 22 appearances last season, starting all but three games. She has also actively contributed towards coaching some of the goalkeepers in the club's girls' teams, offering her expertise and guidance.



**Nia Davies**

Davies is a promising young goalkeeper entering her second season with the club who will be providing competition for the number one jersey. The younger sister of forward Libby, Nia joined Bassett last season, making 16 appearances, including seven starts. Her debut - and first start - last season came in a 3-0 Wiltshire County Cup victory against Salisbury.



**Honor Fraser**

Fraser is a strong, technically gifted full back who joins Bassett this season from Swindon Town. Fraser featured for Swindon in each of the past three seasons. In the Covid-shortened 2020-21 campaign, she played six times for the Robins' Development team, scoring once. She then spent most of the 2021-22 season with Swindon's First Team, playing 14 times in the tier four FA Women's National League Division One South West before splitting time between the First and Development teams last year.

Cox is a young full back who joins this season from Swindon Town. A member of Swindon's 2021-22 Under 16 Wiltshire County Girls' League side, she progressed into senior women's football last season, appearing 18 times for Swindon's Development side.



**Laura Jefferies**

A Bassett stalwart, Jefferies has been with the club for close to a decade and a half having initially started off playing in Bassett's Girls' section. Immensely loyal, she has featured for the Women's First Team in every season since reformed in 2009-10, helping Bassett climb up from Division Three of the Gloucestershire County Women's League. She is the club's all-time leading Women's appearance maker and holds the distinction of having appeared in every single Women's FA Cup game Bassett have played. Club captain, Jefferies leads by example from defence. While a solid centre back, she is more than willing to step out from defence and start attacks and is also a threat from set pieces. Ultra-reliable and more than happy to get stuck in with the ugly side of the game, Jefferies is another player who will serve as a role model for Bassett's younger players on and off the pitch. Jefferies is still a quality player too, winning her fifth Player of the Year trophy last season. In Bassett's 2018-19 double-winning campaign, her performances earned her both the Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year awards, while she picked up the Players' Player prize in 2013-14 and 2014-15.

Johnson is a talented young defender who joined Bassett last season from Swindon Town. Johnson was part of Swindon's 2021-22 Under 16 Wiltshire County Women's and Girls' League double-winning side, earning Players' Player of the Year. She also played for Ashton Keynes' all-conquering Gloucester County Girls' League Under 16s side in 2021-22. Johnson then featured twice for Swindon's Development side last season before joining Bassett. Playing 15 times and starting all but one game, she formed a strong partnership in the heart of Bassett's defence with Laura Jefferies.



**Rosie Kirk**

Kirk is a talented defender who is entering her fifth season with the club. A player who reads the game exceptionally well and possesses a calmness which is rare in a player so young, she performed impressively in twelve appearances in the 2019-20 campaign – her first in senior football. Two seasons ago she featured eleven times with ten starts before experiencing an injury-shortened campaign last year in which she played just three times. Now on the path to recovery, Kirk will be hoping to return to the strong form she showed before being sidelined.



**Ellie O'Nions**

A player who has come through Bassett's youth section, O'Nions is a hard-working left-sided player with plenty of potential. O'Nions made her first foray into senior women's football at the end of the 2020-21 campaign, gaining experience in a series of friendly fixtures. She gave a good account of herself in those matches, and she went on to feature 13 times in competitive action in 2021-22 before making 17 appearances last season, including 13 starts. A student of the game and a valuable contributor to the club, she has also served as a coach for Bassett's girls' teams as well as at the Saturday morning Wildcats' sessions. This season O'Nions will be looking to continue her development with Bassett as a player, while also studying at university.



**Mollie Smith**

Entering her sixth season with Bassett team, Smith is a highly talented central defender who has come through the club's youth section. She made her Women's First Team debut towards the end of the 2018-19 season after turning 16 and proved to be a vital player during Bassett's title run-in. Smith then appeared 13 times in 2019-20, 5 times in the curtailed 2020-21 campaign, 15 times in 2021-22 and in five games last season. An accomplished defender who combines the physical side of the game with an assured calmness in possession, she will be looking to further continue her development with Bassett while also studying at Loughborough University.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town opened up their South West Regional Women's Football League Division One Eastern campaign with what ultimately proved to be a convincing 3-0 derby victory away at Purton.

Two late goals from Emma Sykes made sure that Bassett had to wait just 90 minutes to record their first league win - a stark contrast to last season when Bassett were forced to endure an eight month stretch before registering three points for the first time.

Only the second ever meeting between the teams despite the very short distance that separates Bassett and Purton, their opening league encounter was very much reminiscent of last season's Wiltshire County Cup quarter final tie.

Bassett triumphed 3-1 on that occasion, but left it late to seal victory. While this time keeping a clean sheet, Adam Wood's side again were made to sweat before eventually pulling clear for a deserved victory.

The visitors led at the break courtesy of a Libby Davies on the half hour mark. Beating the offside trap to race onto a Kelly

Nightingale clearance, she coolly converted when through one-on-one.

Bassett were deserved leaders on the balance of play, but it wasn't an entirely comfortable lead as Clare Moreton saw a long range effort crash off the outside of the post after Davies had spurned two more excellent opportunities following defensive errors from the hosts.

It took time for the second to come. Maddy Elliott fired straight at the Purton 'keeper when well placed early in the second half before Moreton came close to catching Millie Powell off her line from distance.

Eventually thought Bassett's second arrived as time started to wind down. Laura Jefferies, who had seen a free kick from much closer range rattle the bar, sent in a towering delivery from deep, which - catching a bobble - forced the home 'keeper to tip onto the post. And Sykes was on hand to bundle home the rebound.

While a somewhat messy goal, Bassett's third was then well-worked. Natalie Goodright picked out Sykes, who fed Davies with a first time pass. Her cross then found Lucia Green at the far post and the young debutant selflessly cut the ball back for Sykes, who produced an assured finish into the bottom corner.

Having made a winning start in the league, Bassett will now aim to make progress in the Women's FA Cup in next week's tie against Longwell Green.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town were in dominant form as they thrashed Longwell Green 14-0 in the Women's FA Cup first qualifying round. Adam Wood's side registered eight goals in the first half before adding six after half time as they were relentless from the first minute to the last.

Facing lower level opponents from the Gloucestershire County League Division One, the gulf in class between the teams was clearly evident, with the game being more of a mismatch than a proper contest. Nevertheless, Bassett got the job done, playing some stylish football along the way, as they comfortably booked a second qualifying round date away at league rivals Stockwood Wanderers.

It didn't take long for the scoring to open, with the honours falling to Hannah Gulliver in just the fourth minute.

Libby Davies quickly made it 2-0 before Maddy Elliott got in on the act. Davies and Elliott then took it in turns to take Bassett up to 5-0, at which point Davies was withdrawn to save her legs for more tougher challenges to come.

Even with Bassett's biggest threat removed from the action, there were still three further goals to come before half time.

Emma Sykes - who netted a brace in the league opener against Purton - found the net again with an outstanding strike. What Sykes could produce, captain Laura Jefferies matched as she scored a screamer. Gulliver, adding her second, completed the scoring for the half.

Bassett could have afforded to take their foot off the gas for the second half. But that didn't happen as they continued to scorch the Longwell Green defence.

Natalie Goodright added number nine before Caily Morse quickly made it ten.

There was then a brief lull, with Bassett having to wait for number eleven. When it did arrive, Elliott completed her hat trick.

Substitute Aly Topping was on hand to make it a dozen from the penalty spot, with Jefferies adding Bassett's lucky thirteenth.

Youngster Morse - who also missed from a penalty - then finally rounded off the scoring as Bassett exceeded their previous record win in the competition by a remarkable six goals.

Tougher tests will certainly come. But - demonstrating the firepower at their disposal - Bassett made a clear show of attacking intent as they took the opening round of the Women's FA Cup by storm.

Bassett then almost had a second when Jude Stokes headed against the bar from a corner, before Beau Hicks' deft flick was kept out by an outstretched Joe Devlin and another long range Beavis shot was batted away. However Rovers equalised through Ethan Walters as half time neared. Racing onto a ball over the top, he produced a neat finish into the bottom corner from the edge of the area.

In a wide open contest, it was now Bassett 'keeper Tom Davis' turn for some heroics as he produced two assured saves from one-on-one opportunities. He was beaten again before the break but the woodwork came to his rescue, with the follow up being blazed over.

Play continued to be end to end following the restart but shots on target were at a premium.

The decisive moment eventually arrived though. A long ball out from the back and flick on caught the Bassett defence out and clever work from James Reynolds with the hosts stretched culminated in an unfortunate Leo Bagley turning a low cross into the box into his own net. That set up a frantic, dramatic finish which saw a Bagley cross-cum-shot from the right wing rattle the top of the bar and Reynolds send a shot inches wide when through on goal.

The biggest drama of all was to come when visiting 'keeper Devlin then made an outstanding acrobatic save from a fierce Matt Capel drive to ensure Tuffley stayed ahead as Bassett were unable to restore parity. Tuffley thus advance to host Street in the first qualifying round with Bassett now set to focus solely on their Wiltshire League Floodlit Division campaign which begins on Monday away at Bristol Manor Farm.
