We also welcomed back Lani Dickinson who has been plying her trade for her university this season but now has time to fit Bassett into her busy schedule so I am sure once she is back in the fold you will all join me in being pleased to see her back in the blue and yellow.

Last time out saw us draw 1-1 with Weymouth, a rather large obstacle on our road to the league title. The result means we are relying on Purton to repeat their early season antics by beating Poole today whilst we will then need to ensure maximum points from our remaining four league games. Goal difference would be the separator if a draw is to happen between Purton and Poole but I think we can only really focus on us winning games at this moment in time. I stated to the players after the game that last week's draw against Weymouth may have summarised our season a bit whereby certain games have presented opportunities and we have not taken them. Millie Powell

Powell is a young goalkeeper entering her third season in senior football. She has great shotstopping ability and is also confident with the ball at her feet. Boasting a lot of talent and potential, she claimed the number one jersey early in the 2021-22 season and never looked back, featuring sixteen times while earning both the Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year awards for her excellent performances. Powell went on to make another 22 appearances last season, starting all but three games. She has also actively contributed towards coaching some of the goalkeepers in the club's girls' teams, offering her expertise and guidance.



Nia Davies

Davies is a promising young goalkeeper entering her second season with the club who will be providing competition for the number one jersey. The younger sister of forward Libby, Nia joined Bassett last season, making 16 appearances, including seven starts. Her debut - and first start - last season came in a 3-0 Wiltshire County Cup victory against Salisbury.



Honor Fraser

Fraser is a strong, technically gifted full back who joins Bassett this season from Swindon Town. Fraser featured for Swindon in each of the past three seasons. In the Covid-shortened 2020-21 campaign, she played six times for the Robins' Development team, scoring once. She then spent most of the 2021-22 season with Swindon's First Team, playing 14 times in the tier four FA Women's National League Division One South West before splitting time between the First and Development teams last year.



Darcy Cox

Cox is a young full back who joins this season from Swindon Town. A member of Swindon's 2021-22 Under 16 Wiltshire County Girls' League side, she progressed into senior women's football last season, appearing 18 times for Swindon's Development side.

A Bassett stalwart, Jefferies has been with the club for close to a decade and a half having initially started off playing in Bassett's Girls' section. Immensely loyal, she has featured for the Women's First Team in every season since reformed in 2009-10, helping Bassett climb up from Division Three of the Gloucestershire County Women's League. She is the club's all-time leading Women's appearance maker and holds the distinction of having appeared in every single Women's FA Cup game Bassett have played. Club captain, Jefferies leads by example from defence. While a solid centre back, she is more than willing to step out from defence and start attacks and is also a threat from set pieces. Ultra-reliable and more than happy to get stuck in with the ugly side of the game, Jefferies is another player who will serve as a role model for Bassett's younger players on and off the pitch. Jefferies is still a quality player too, winning her fifth Player of the Year trophy last season. In Bassett's 2018-19 double-winning campaign, her performances earned her both the Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year awards, while she picked up the Players' Player prize in 2013-14 and 2014-15.

 <p>Neve Johnson</p>	<p>Johnson is a talented young defender who joined Bassett last season from Swindon Town. Johnson was part of Swindon's 2021-22 Under 16 Wiltshire County Women's and Girls' League double-winning side, earning Players' Player of the Year. She also played for Ashton Keynes' all-conquering Gloucester County Girls' League Under 16s side in 2021-22. Johnson then featured twice for Swindon's Development side last season before joining Bassett. Playing 15 times and starting all but one game, she formed a strong partnership in the heart of Bassett's defence with Laura Jefferies.</p>	
 <p>Rosie Kirk</p>	<p>Kirk is a talented defender who is entering her fifth season with the club. A player who reads the game exceptionally well and possesses a calmness which is rare in a player so young, she performed impressively in twelve appearances in the 2019-20 campaign – her first in senior football. Two seasons ago she featured eleven times with ten starts before experiencing an injury-shortened campaign last year in which she played just three times. Now on the path to recovery, Kirk will be hoping to return to the strong form she showed before being sidelined.</p>	
 <p>Ellie O'Nions</p>	<p>A player who has come through Bassett's youth section, O'Nions is a hard-working left-sided player with plenty of potential. O'Nions made her first foray into senior women's football at the end of the 2020-21 campaign, gaining experience in a series of friendly fixtures. She gave a good account of herself in those matches, and she went on to feature 13 times in competitive action in 2021-22 before making 17 appearances last season, including 13 starts. A student of the game and a valuable contributor to the club, she has also served as a coach for Bassett's girls' teams as well as at the Saturday morning Wildcats' sessions. This season O'Nions will be looking to continue her development with Bassett as a player, while also studying at university.</p>	
 <p>Mollie Smith</p>	<p>Entering her sixth season with Bassett team, Smith is a highly talented central defender who has come through the club's youth section. She made her Women's First Team debut towards the end of the 2018-19 season after turning 16 and proved to be a vital player during Bassett's title run-in. Smith then appeared 13 times in 2019-20, 5 times in the curtailed 2020-21 campaign, 15 times in 2021-22 and in five games last season. An accomplished defender who combines the physical side of the game with an assured calmness in possession, she will be looking to further continue her development with Bassett while also studying at Loughborough University.</p>	<p>The Smiths</p>
 <p>Kelly Nightingale</p>	<p>Nightingale is a versatile player capable of playing in either defence or midfield who joins Bassett this season. She brings significant experience playing at a higher level too having spent most of the last decade with sides in the FA Women's National League. Nightingale has played a large part of her career with Swindon Town, enjoying spells with the Robins between 2014-15, 2017-19 and 2021-23. She has also featured for Forest Green Rovers (2015-16), Swindon Supermarine (2016-17) and Keynsham Town (2019-21).</p>

A player who knows how to find the back of the net, she joins from Ashton Keynes Youth, where she starred over the course of the past two seasons for their successful Under 16s side. Terras draw all but ends title hopes

Royal Wootton Bassett Town 1 Weymouth 1

A potentially decisive afternoon in the race for the South West Regional Women's Football League Division One Eastern didn't go the way Royal Wootton Bassett Town wanted.

Adam Wood's side were held to a 1-1 draw at home against Weymouth. And with Poole Town winning 3-0 at home against Stockwood Wanderers in their penultimate match, that means that the Dolphins will be confirmed as champions if they triumph when they face Purton next week. Given their massive advantage on goal difference, a draw should probably suffice for the Dolphins too.

Knowing they had to win, Bassett started the game with intent but, despite knocking on the door, were unable to fashion any early clear cut chances.

A dangerous Emma Sykes delivery did force visiting 'keeper Issy Heybourne to make an alert save. But it was the visitors who had the first shot on goal as Millie Powell denied Bianca Osborne.

Osborne and teammate Bianca Redding shot straight at Powell again as the visitors posed a threat. But the better chances were falling Bassett's way as Hannah Gulliver turned her marker, firing just wide from the edge of the area. Eventually Bassett got their noses in front ten minutes before the interval as a fine turn from Libby Davies opened up space for her to produce an exquisite shot into the top corner.

It was a lead Basset took into the break - and both sides came out after half time with the aim to grab the all-important second goal.

A lively opening ten minutes saw Annie Redding stride into the Bassett box but she could only shoot into Powell's arms. At the other end, a last ditch tackle denied Davies when seemingly through on goal before Powell did brilliantly to parry from Kaydee Thornicroft, whose rebound effort was placed wide.

The game eventually settled down though and Bassett were the team again looking most dangerous. Holly Baker twice came close from a pair of Laura Jefferies deliveries. Davies then narrowly struck over. The failure to convert those chances then proved costly as Weymouth equalised with twenty minutes to go. Unable to clear a corner at the first attempt, the ball dropped for Emily Screen who swivelled and arrowed a low drive into the corner of the net.

Bassett responded to the equaliser and piled on the pressure in the closing stages. Alas, the hosts ran out of time. Caily Morse's dangerous ball into the box flashed across the face of goal when all it seemingly needed was a touch. Davies steered wide from a Jefferies free kick. Then in the dying moments a corner caused chaos in the Weymouth box but somehow the visitors were able to survive.

For Bassett it's a case of what if following only the third league game all season in which they have dropped points. With just nine teams in the division and one side guaranteed promotion, fine margins were always going to prove vital though - and so they have proven, potentially to Bassett's detriment as they sought to bounce back to tier five at the earliest opportunity.

That may create some sense of disappointment. But Bassett are still favourites to finish runners-up - an achievement in itself, while there's also the opportunity to push for a run in the League Divisional Cup when that kicks off in March.

The title may most likely be out of reach, but there's still plenty to play for.
