# Women's Team Bassett Bulletin

## Welcome To Today's Game

**GOOD AFTERNOON** and welcome back to the Sustain Stadium for our third home league fixture of the season, we welcome our near neighbours Purton, who will have made the shortest of trips with only four miles separating the two grounds. This will be the first time we have hosted our near neighbours in a women's fixture, having only played them on two other occasions, this being Purton women's second season, having won the Wiltshire league at the first attempt, with us being the only team to defeat them drawing them in the Wiltshire cup. We have already played Purton away at the Red house in the opening fixture of this season, back in September in what was a tight game. We won the game that day with a first half goal from Libby Davies and did not seal the points until the last 15 minutes, when Emma Sykes popped up with two goals to give us 3-0 win. There is no getting away from the fact today's game is a local derby, not so much of blood and thunder, as the men's game, but pure bragging rights along with three points at stake.

In my last programme notes (Poole Town) I said how disappointing it was to go out of the FA cup at home to AFC Stoneham, and a chance missed to make history by going into the First Round Proper. Having now seen this squad of players, play back to back games against Poole Town and losing the home encounter 5-1 meant most neutrals would not have given us a chance in the away game. However, credit to Adam and the team for showing the character they needed to bounce back with a 2-1 victory. The performance

at Poole last week should now give us a platform to build on, for the rest of the season as we were more relaxed and composed while on the ball and worked relentlessly for each other all over the pitch.

The future aims for me as Head of Women's & Girls section is to help develop our girls teams from U8 up to U16s and to create a clear pathway into U18/Development football or even the first team. This is four to five years away and will be gradual progression but short term I would like to see the women's team regain promotion back up to the South West Premier Division. Although this will not be easy because only the top team of this division is guaranteed promotion. I also want for us to find a regular Tuesday night training slot in order to allow the ladies side to train consistently twice a week for the whole season.

I hope you enjoy the game this afternoon and hope that Adam and the team can produce another top performance to secure another three points.

# Last Meeting v Purton (A)

Royal Wootton Bassett Town opened up their South West Regional Women's Football League Division One Eastern campaign with what ultimately proved to be a convincing 3-0 derby victory away at Purton.

Two late goals from Emma Sykes made sure that Bassett had to wait just 90 minutes to record their first league win - a stark contrast to last season when Bassett were forced to endure an eight month stretch before registering three points for the first time.

Only the second ever meeting between the teams despite the very short distance that separates Bassett and Purton, their opening league encounter was very much reminiscent of last season's Wiltshire County Cup quarter final tie.

Bassett triumphed 3-1 on that occasion, but left it late to seal victory. While this time keeping a clean sheet, Adam Wood's side again were made to sweat before eventually pulling clear for a deserved victory.

The visitors led at the break courtesy of a Libby Davies on the half hour mark. Beating the offside trap to race onto a Kelly

Nightingale clearance, she coolly converted when through one-on-one.

Bassett were deserved leaders on the balance of play, but it wasn't an entirely comfortable lead as Clare Moreton saw a long range effort crash off the outside of the post after Davies had spurned two more excellent opportunities following defensive errors from the hosts.

It took time for the second to come. Maddy Elliott fired straight at the Purton 'keeper when well placed early in the second half before Moreton came close to catching Millie Powell off her line from distance.

Eventually thought Bassett's second arrived as time started to wind down. Laura Jefferies, who had seen a free kick from much closer range rattle the bar, sent in a towering delivery from deep, which - catching a bobble - forced the home 'keeper to tip onto the post. And Sykes was on hand to bundle home the rebound.

While a somewhat messy goal, Bassett's third was then well-worked. Natalie Goodright picked out Sykes, who fed Davies with a first time pass. Her cross then found Lucia Green at the far post and the young debutant selflessly cut the ball back for Sykes, who produced an assured finish into the bottom corner.

Having made a winning start in the league, Bassett will now aim to make progress in the Women's FA Cup in next week's tie against Longwell Green.

	<p>Powell is a young goalkeeper entering her third season in senior football. She has great shotstopping ability and is also confident with the ball at her feet. Boasting a lot of talent and potential, she claimed the number one jersey early in the 2021-22 season and never looked back, featuring sixteen times while earning both the Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year awards for her excellent performances. Powell went on to make another 22 appearances last season, starting all but three games. She has also actively contributed towards coaching some of the goalkeepers in the club's girls' teams, offering her expertise and guidance.</p>	
	<p>Davies is a promising young goalkeeper entering her second season with the club who will be providing competition for the number one jersey. The younger sister of forward Libby, Nia joined Bassett last season, making 16 appearances, including seven starts. Her debut - and first start - last season came in a 3-0 Wiltshire County Cup victory against Salisbury.</p>	
	<p>Fraser is a strong, technically gifted full back who joins Bassett this season from Swindon Town. Fraser featured for Swindon in each of the past three seasons. In the Covid-shortened 2020-21 campaign, she played six times for the Robins' Development team, scoring once. She then spent most of the 2021-22 season with Swindon's First Team, playing 14 times in the tier four FA Women's National League Division One South West before splitting time between the First and Development teams last year.</p>	
	<p>Cox is a young full back who joins this season from Swindon Town. A member of Swindon's 2021-22 Under 16 Wiltshire County Girls' League side, she progressed into senior women's football last season, appearing 18 times for Swindon's Development side</p>	
	<p>A Bassett stalwart, Jefferies has been with the club for close to a decade and a half having initially started off playing in Bassett's Girls' section. Immensely loyal, she has featured for the Women's First Team in every season since reformed in 2009-10, helping Bassett climb up from Division Three of the Gloucestershire County Women's League. She is the club's all-time leading Women's appearance maker and holds the distinction of having appeared in every single Women's FA Cup game Bassett have played. Club captain, Jefferies leads by example from defence. While a solid centre back, she is more than willing to step out from defence and start attacks and is also a threat from set pieces. Ultra-reliable and more than happy to get stuck in with the ugly side of the game, Jefferies is another player who will serve as a role model for Bassett's younger players on and off the pitch. Jefferies is still a quality player too, winning her fifth Player of the Year trophy last season. In Bassett's 2018-19 double-winning campaign, her performances earned her both the Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year awards, while she picked up the Players' Player prize in 2013-14 and 2014-15.</p>

	<p>Johnson is a talented young defender who joined Bassett last season from Swindon Town. Johnson was part of Swindon's 2021-22 Under 16 Wiltshire County Women's and Girls' League double-winning side, earning Players' Player of the Year. She also played for Ashton Keynes' all-conquering Gloucester County Girls' League Under 16s side in 2021-22. Johnson then featured twice for Swindon's Development side last season before joining Bassett. Playing 15 times and starting all but one game, she formed a strong partnership in the heart of Bassett's defence with Laura Jefferies.</p>	
	<p>Kirk is a talented defender who is entering her fifth season with the club. A player who reads the game exceptionally well and possesses a calmness which is rare in a player so young, she performed impressively in twelve appearances in the 2019-20 campaign – her first in senior football. Two seasons ago she featured eleven times with ten starts before experiencing an injury-shortened campaign last year in which she played just three times. Now on the path to recovery, Kirk will be hoping to return to the strong form she showed before being sidelined.</p>	
	<p>A player who has come through Bassett's youth section, O'Nions is a hard-working left-sided player with plenty of potential. O'Nions made her first foray into senior women's football at the end of the 2020-21 campaign, gaining experience in a series of friendly fixtures. She gave a good account of herself in those matches, and she went on to feature 13 times in competitive action in 2021-22 before making 17 appearances last season, including 13 starts. A student of the game and a valuable contributor to the club, she has also served as a coach for Bassett's girls' teams as well as at the Saturday morning Wildcats' sessions. This season O'Nions will be looking to continue her development with Bassett as a player, while also studying at university.</p>	
	<p>Entering her sixth season with Bassett team, Smith is a highly talented central defender who has come through the club's youth section. She made her Women's First Team debut towards the end of the 2018-19 season after turning 16 and proved to be a vital player during Bassett's title run-in. Smith then appeared 13 times in 2019-20, 5 times in the curtailed 2020-21 campaign, 15 times in 2021-22 and in five games last season. An accomplished defender who combines the physical side of the game with an assured calmness in possession, she will be looking to further continue her development with Bassett while also studying at Loughborough University.</p>	<p>The Smiths</p>
	<p>Nightingale is a versatile player capable of playing in either defence or midfield who joins Bassett this season. She brings significant experience playing at a higher level too having spent most of the last decade with sides in the FA Women's National League. Nightingale has played a large part of her career with Swindon Town, enjoying spells with the Robins between 2014-15, 2017-19 and 2021-23. She has also featured for Forest Green Rovers (2015-16), Swindon Supermarine (2016-17) and Keynsham Town (2019-21).</p>

A player who knows how to find the back of the net, she joins from Ashton Keynes Youth, where she starred over the course of the past two seasons for their successful Under 16s side. In 2021-22 she scored ten times as her side finished runners-up in the Gloucester County Girls' League, before firing a hugely impressive 26 goals as her team went one better last season. Burridge has also represented Highworth Town Under 16s where she netted four times in six games last season.</p>	
 <p><b>Amber Egerton</b></p>	<p>Having joined in 2014-15, Egerton is one of Bassett's longest-serving players. She is a versatile player who will play anywhere she is asked and will always give 100 percent for her team. A dynamic, energetic midfielder, Egerton will also chip in with a few goals and assists. In 2019-20, she was a hugely impressive performer. An ever-present, she scored twice and was joint winner of the team's Players' Player of the Year award prize. She previously won that award in 2015-16 and 2016-17 and is a three-time winner of Bassett's Manager's Player of the Year prize (2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17). Injuries limited her appearances in 2021-22, but Egerton bounced back last year, playing 21 times and scoring twice. Overall, since Bassett entered the South West Regional Women's Football League in 2017-18, she has played 91 times, registering 12 goals.</p>	<p><b>Dennis Green</b></p>
 <p><b>Natalie Goodright</b></p>	<p>Goodright is a midfielder who joins Bassett this season from Swindon Town. She is a player who, despite still being young, possesses plenty of experience playing at a higher level. ### **Five star Dolphins blow early hole in promotion hopes**

After The South West Regional Women's Football League season might only be two months' old, but Poole Town struck a potentially decisive early blow in the battle for promotion from Division One Eastern as they triumphed 5-1 against Royal Wootton Bassett Town at the Sustain Stadium.

The win gives Poole, who have played two games more, a nine point lead over Bassett. And the result means that Adam Wood and his side can ill afford to lose the return fixture which takes place as soon as next Sunday.

On sixteen minutes Summer Williams seized on a poor clearance before picking out Emma King who made no mistake.

Another defensive error then set up Chloe McCombie, who intercepted Darcy Cox's attempted clearance before slotting past on an onrushing Millie Powell.

Ten minutes before the break Bassett were able to halve their deficit. Great pressing from Caily Morse forced Poole to turnover possession deep inside the visitors' territory and her finish proved too much for Bebe Smith.

That goal unnerved Poole briefly and two chances in quick succession fell to Maddy Elliott, however on both occasions she was unable to find the target.

Poole capitalised on those let offs, grabbing a third before the break. Briony Hurd's headed clearance fell into the path of the visitors' Lauren Kelly and she burst past Cox

before conjuring a shot that proved just too powerful for Powell who was unable to keep the ball out, despite getting a hand to it.

A King penalty following a Kelly Nightingale foul put the outcome beyond doubt midway through the second period.

Katie Marshallsay then completed the scoring with quarter of an hour to go as Poole sealed an emphatic win.

In such a small division - whose size was reduced further after Pen Mill's withdrawal - with just one guaranteed promotion place, the margin for error was always going to be small for those sides aiming to reach the Premier Division.

Even though they are just five games in, Bassett's promotion hopes now rely heavily on a win next week and Poole dropping points elsewhere.

There is still plenty to play for though both in the league and County Cup. And Bassett's start to the season, in particular the Women's FA Cup run, has been a strong one. Bassett now will seek to bounce back at the earliest opportunity - and quickly avenge this heavy defeat..

### **Captain fantastic helps get Bassett back in business**

Royal Wootton Bassett Town came from behind to secure a vitally important 2-1 victory away at Poole Town as Adam Wood and his side bounced back from last week's heavy defeat against the Dolphins. And captain Laura Jefferies was instrumental in her team's win, equalising before teeing up Natalie Goodright for the go ahead goal as Bassett impressively ground out a much needed result.

With only one team guaranteed to go up, last week's chastening 5-1 home loss against Poole left Bassett's South West Regional Women's Football League Division One Eastern promotion hopes hanging in the balance. And with back to back fixtures against the Dolphins, a second defeat would likely have proved terminal for those chances.

The pressure was therefore on as Bassett made the journey to Dorset. But in testing circumstances the team delivered, grinding out three important points.

While Jefferies is the one making the headlines courtesy of her involvement in both Bassett goals, victory was earned thanks to vital performances across the pitch.

'Keeper Millie Powell was one of them as she made three crucial saves in the opening exchanges. Lauren Kelly was first to be denied before a Powell fingertip helped guide an Emma King effort on to the post. Powell then stood firm to deny King again after she had beat the offside trap.

For the remainder of the opening half Bassett had the better of the chances.

Seizing on a defensive slip, Holly Baker ran at goal before seeing her shot scooped up by Bebe Smith.

Hannah Gulliver twice came close, sending a free kick in a good position wide before

narrowly shooting over.

After a Maddy Elliott strike was blocked, King scuffed wide at the other end.

Two Emma Sykes passes then almost teed Bassett up for the opening goal. Her first was intercepted by Smith just ahead of Gulliver before her second picked out Elliott who could only fire straight at the 'keeper.

The first half therefore ended goalless. However it didn't take long after the restart for the deadlock to be broken.

Bassett had already survived a scare when Darcy Cox recovered well to deny Kate Marshallsay a sight on goal after she had intercepted a Kelly Nightingale pass.

But Poole eventually went ahead. Beth Anderson opened up the Bassett defence before the ball was worked to King whose cross picked out an unmarked Marshallsay to tap in.

Bassett responded well though as Jefferies soon equalised. Powell did well to punch away a corner and from the resulting phase of play, Bassett broke forward with Sykes finding Jefferies who produced a perfectly weighted lob to beat Smith from twenty yards out.

That set up a tense final quarter of the match.

For Poole Marshallsay was denied by Powell while Kelly shot wide. At the other end Jefferies saw an effort bounce off the bar.

Then as time wound down came the decisive moment as Jefferies delivered an inch perfect set piece which Goodright headed home from a matter of yards.

It wasn't the most beautiful of goals but it certainly was an important one, with Bassett seeing out the remaining time to preserve a massive win.

There is still plenty of work to do if Bassett are to vie for promotion. But winning the two games in hand they hold over Poole will now see the teams draw level on points. And it's now a wide open race too with Stockwood Wanderers - three points ahead of Bassett having played a game more - and Bath City - level with Wood's side - also in the mix.
