### **Maddy on the Mark to Snatch Late Winner**

#### **Shaftesbury 1**

#### **Royal Wootton Bassett Town 2**

Maddy Elliott scored a dramatic late winner to deliver a 2-1 victory for Royal Wootton Bassett Town over a resilient Shaftesbury side - and keep her side's South West Regional Women's Football League Division One Eastern title hopes alive.

Bassett seemed on course for just a point against a Shaftesbury outfit who hassled their visitors all afternoon. And, with Poole Town beating Stockwood Wanderers in the first of their two meetings, such an outcome would have seen Adam Wood's side fall to eleven points back on their opponents - a deficit they wouldn't be able to overhaul with the three games in hand they possess.

But with five minutes remaining Elliott was on hand to sweep home a rebound after home 'keeper Emma Stranger could only parry Caily Morse's effort.

That therefore transformed what had been a previously frustrating 85 minutes into a happy 90 minutes for the visitors.

Last season's Dorset Women's League champions, Shaftesbury have found the going tough results-wise in their opening campaign at tier six. But they started the new year with a solid 0-0 draw at home against Bath City and continued their strong start to 2024 against Bassett.

And they led as early as the seventh minute, Chelsie Johnson driving through the Bassett defence before emphatically firing into the bottom corner of the net beyond a helpless Millie Powell.

Bassett quickly responded and came close to an equaliser after Honor Fraser's dangerous cross led to a spell of head-pong

in the box, with Natalie Goodright eventually striking the bar.

But on the quarter hour mark Bassett had their breakthrough. Build up play involving Lucy Goodright and Hannah Gulliver eventually saw the ball worked to Emma Sykes and she produced a fine strike from 25 yards out to get her side back on terms.

Bassett were out of sorts though, encountering strong resistance from Shaftesbury which led to some sloppiness at the other end with one misplaced pass almost gifting the hosts a second.

Eventually though Bassett were able to put Shaftesbury under some sustained pressure. But that failed to produce an equaliser.

Erin Hemsley and Elliott both failed to locate the target before Gulliver struck straight at Stranger.

A towering Laura Jefferies corner was seemingly pushed into her own net by Stranger but the ball was deemed not to have crossed the line.

Great play from Hemsley then failed to find its reward as she was denied by Stranger.

Bassett thus seemed on course for a draw. That was Jefferies played a one-two with Gulliver and delivered a superb cross to Morse. Morse's shot was rather tame but Stranger could only parry and Elliott was on hand to gladly stroke home.

There was to be one late scare when Poppy Failes found herself one-on-one with Powell but, superbly, the Bassett 'keeper foiled her.

That was the last chance of note and, despite not being near their best, Bassett had got the job done.

# Today's Opponents

## Shaftesbury FC History

Shaftesbury Football Club was established in 1888 and the clubs first success was winning the league cup in 1900 and then in 1905/06 along with the League Title.

In 1908/09 season, Shaftesbury formed a reserve side and also a mid-week league side known as Shaftesbury Wednesday. In the early 1920's the first youth team was formed, called Shaftes-bury Athletic.

Shaftesbury's next success was in 1932/33 season, winning the Dorset Senior League, the most successful period came in the 1940/50's when Shaftesbury won 12 cup competitions in a 10 year period.

Shaftesbury then moved the ground, known as Cockrams in 1974, even today still playing here, but in a slightly different location, due to the arrival of Tesco supermarket.

Many more titles were won over the years with winning the League Cup in 1976, League Champions & Combination Cup in 1988/89, Combination Cup winners in 1994/95, League Winners 1996/97.

In 2004/05 Shaftesbury entered the Wessex League and for the first time in 2005/06 entered the FA vase & in 2006/07 the FA

Cup.

In 2011/12 Shaftesbury re-joined the Dorset Premier League, many changes happened on and off the pitch and the regrowth of the team showed as they started to shine year on year in the is League.

2015/16 season saw Shaftesbury Football Club have a successful year for some time, under new management. The first team won the Dor-set Premier League meaning promotion into the Wessex League (Div1).

2016/17 season was the first return to the Wessex League since 2004 and with a more than expected performance 'throughout' the sea-son, a top three finish saw promotion to the Wessex Premier & Shaftesbury's highest level of Football to come in 2017/18.

2017/18 was a successful year for the club with retaining a position in the Wessex Premier League and also reaching the Dorset Senior Final, unfortunately with a loss to Wimborne Town.

The final success of the year was to win the Salisbury Hospital Cup.

Boasting a lot of talent and potential, she claimed the number one jersey early in the 2021-22 season and never looked back, featuring sixteen times while earning both the Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year awards for her excellent performances. Powell went on to make another 22 appearances last season, starting all but three games. She has also actively contributed towards coaching some of the goalkeepers in the club's girls' teams, offering her expertise and guidance.</p>	
	<p>Davies is a promising young goalkeeper entering her second season with the club who will be providing competition for the number one jersey. The younger sister of forward Libby, Nia joined Bassett last season, making 16 appearances, including seven starts. Her debut - and first start - last season came in a 3-0 Wiltshire County Cup victory against Salisbury.</p>	
	<p>Fraser is a strong, technically gifted full back who joins Bassett this season from Swindon Town. Fraser featured for Swindon in each of the past three seasons. In the Covid-shortened 2020-21 campaign, she played six times for the Robins' Development team, scoring once. She then spent most of the 2021-22 season with Swindon's First Team, playing 14 times in the tier four FA Women's National League Division One South West before splitting time between the First and Development teams last year.</p>	
	<p>Cox is a young full back who joins this season from Swindon Town. A member of Swindon's 2021-22 Under 16 Wiltshire County Girls' League side, she progressed into senior women's football last season, appearing 18 times for Swindon's Development side</p>	<p>Mark Smedley</p>
	<p>A Bassett stalwart, Jefferies has been with the club for close to a decade and a half having initially started off playing in Bassett's Girls' section. Immensely loyal, she has featured for the Women's First Team in every season since reformed in 2009-10, helping Bassett climb up from Division Three of the Gloucestershire County Women's League. She is the club's all-time leading Women's appearance maker and holds the distinction of having appeared in every single Women's FA Cup game Bassett have played. Club captain, Jefferies leads by example from defence. While a solid centre back, she is more than willing to step out from defence and start attacks and is also a threat from set pieces. Ultra-reliable and more than happy to get stuck in with the ugly side of the game, Jefferies is another player who will serve as a role model for Bassett's younger players on and off the pitch. Jefferies is still a quality player too, winning her fifth Player of the Year trophy last season. In Bassett's 2018-19 double-winning campaign, her performances earned her both the Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year awards, while she picked up the Players' Player prize in 2013-14 and 2014-15.</p>	<p>PCM @STFCMD</p>

 <p><b>Neve Johnson</b></p>	<p>Johnson is a talented young defender who joined Bassett last season from Swindon Town. Johnson was part of Swindon's 2021-22 Under 16 Wiltshire County Women's and Girls' League double-winning side, earning Players' Player of the Year. She also played for Ashton Keynes' all-conquering Gloucester County Girls' League Under 16s side in 2021-22. Johnson then featured twice for Swindon's Development side last season before joining Bassett. Playing 15 times and starting all but one game, she formed a strong partnership in the heart of Bassett's defence with Laura Jefferies.</p>	
 <p><b>Rosie Kirk</b></p>	<p>Kirk is a talented defender who is entering her fifth season with the club. A player who reads the game exceptionally well and possesses a calmness which is rare in a player so young, she performed impressively in twelve appearances in the 2019-20 campaign – her first in senior football. Two seasons ago she featured eleven times with ten starts before experiencing an injury-shortened campaign last year in which she played just three times. Now on the path to recovery, Kirk will be hoping to return to the strong form she showed before being sidelined.</p>	
 <p><b>Ellie O'Nions</b></p>	<p>A player who has come through Bassett's youth section, O'Nions is a hard-working left-sided player with plenty of potential. O'Nions made her first foray into senior women's football at the end of the 2020-21 campaign, gaining experience in a series of friendly fixtures. She gave a good account of herself in those matches, and she went on to feature 13 times in competitive action in 2021-22 before making 17 appearances last season, including 13 starts. A student of the game and a valuable contributor to the club, she has also served as a coach for Bassett's girls' teams as well as at the Saturday morning Wildcats' sessions. This season O'Nions will be looking to continue her development with Bassett as a player, while also studying at university.</p>	
 <p><b>Mollie Smith</b></p>	<p>Entering her sixth season with Bassett team, Smith is a highly talented central defender who has come through the club's youth section. She made her Women's First Team debut towards the end of the 2018-19 season after turning 16 and proved to be a vital player during Bassett's title run-in. Smith then appeared 13 times in 2019-20, 5 times in the curtailed 2020-21 campaign, 15 times in 2021-22 and in five games last season. An accomplished defender who combines the physical side of the game with an assured calmness in possession, she will be looking to further continue her development with Bassett while also studying at Loughborough University.</p>	<p><b>The Smiths</b></p>
 <p><b>Kelly Nightingale</b></p>	<p>Nightingale is a versatile player capable of playing in either defence or midfield who joins Bassett this season. ### **Bassett exit cup in seven goal thriller**

Royal Wootton Bassett Town's hopes of ending their season with cup success were dashed as Adam Wood's side exited the South West Regional Women's Football League Divisional Cup following a 4-3 defeat in a quarter final thriller against Ilminster Town.

With runners-up in the Eastern Division already secured, Bassett were aiming for a deep run in the League Cup. However they were left to rue the fact they squandered a two goal lead against Western Division high-flyers Ilminster, who - after falling behind - scored four times before Libby Davies made the final stages interesting.

It was certainly an entertaining match for the neutral - though very frustrating in the end for the hosts.

Bassett drew first blood when Davies found Hannah Gulliver who beat defender Matilda Wallbridge before slotting past Ilminster 'keeper Charlotte Johnson.

Fine goalkeeping and the woodwork then ensured it remained just the one goal as Johnson tipped away a Gulliver effort that appeared headed for the top corner before, at the other end, the dangerous Jodi Cornwall struck the bar and then saw a free kick tipped around the post by Millie Powell.

Eventually though Bassett doubled their advantage. And Gulliver returned the favour to Davies. Her through ball fed Davies, who outmuscled Georgia Mann before firing into the net.

That goal put Bassett in a commanding position. However, two goals in quick

succession got Ilminster back on terms.

A soft foul led to the first as Cornwall steered the resulting free kick beyond Powell.

Moments later Ilminster were level. A lapse in concentration saw Bassett concede possession before the visitors earned a corner. The resulting set piece was then played short and Steph Beck found the net from the edge of the box.

Bassett did have chances either side of the interval to restore their lead, but Natalie Goodright could only find the side netting from a tight angle while Emma Sykes struck just wide following build up play involving Davies and Briony Hurd.

But it was Ilminster who were to go ahead for the first time on the afternoon when Ellie Orritt was quickest to react to a Cornwall effort that came back out off the bar.

Bassett were living dangerously as Cornwall again came close before Powell saved well from Abi Meyer.

Having survived those scares, the hosts then thought they had equalised when Gulliver played in Davies but the forward's shot rattled the post.

That moment would prove decisive as Bassett failed to clear from a throw and Harrie Kelly pounced to extend Ilminster's advantage.

Davies would reduce arrears, producing a fine solo goal as she beat two defenders before getting the better of Johnson.

But an equaliser was not forthcoming, with the closest Bassett came to getting a fourth being a Davies free kick that sailed over.

Bassett were this unable to extend their season further - and they now know that their 2023-24 campaign will end at the end of April when they finish their league season at home against Shaftesbury.
