## Welcome To Today's Game

I would like to welcome all that have travelled up from Dorset, the coaches, players and supporters, from Ridgeway women's team who are experiencing their first visit with us here at the Sustain Stadium. We visited Ridgeway back in September, and on the day we very clinical with the chances we created, and were very happy to win the game 7-0. It was our first visit to Ridgeway and would like to say that the after match hospitality at the Famous Old Spa was very good, and it was very pleasing that they had taken the time and effort to organise. **Gulliver strikes gold as Bassett coast in Dorset**

Royal Royal Wootton Bassett Town will be regular visitors to Dorset over the course of the 2023-24 season with four of their nine South West Regional Women's Football League Division One Eastern opponents based in the county. And Bassett will be hoping each subsequent trip will be as successful as their first following a comfortable 7-0 triumph away at Ridgeway.

Adam Wood's side were once again in dominant form as they made it four wins from four in all competitions to finish what has been a superb first month of the season top of the table.

Hannah Gulliver was the star of the show, netting an impressive hat trick to take her to six goals for the season already..

Gulliver grabbed the opener after just six minutes, slotting home after latching onto Erin Hemsley's through ball as the visitors made their early pressure count.

Amber Egerton soon made it 2-0, producing a delicate lob after a Gulliver corner was punched away only as far as the edge of the



box.

After scoring twice in the opening ten minutes, Bassett had to wait until the closing stages of the first half for their third. When it arrived, Gulliver produced a poacher's finish, tapping in after a Holly Baker cross was deflected into her path.

Youngster Caily Morse made it 4-0 early in the second half, coolly slotting in after a well worked move involving Laura Jefferies and Honor Fraser.

Holly Baker then got in on the act, scoring twice in quick succession around the hour mark.



Her first rounded off another good move that involved Nia Davies, Morse, Gulliver and Fraser. The latter pair played a near one-two with Gulliver crossing to the far post where Baker was on hand to keep her cool and beat the onrushing 'keeper'.

Briony Hurd then launched a quick counter after jumping on a stray pass. Her through ball found Baker who, after a give-and-go with Jasmine Kennedy, made no mistake.

Morse could have had her second of the match, but somehow couldn't convert following a triple chance.

While she failed to convert, Gulliver made certain of her hat trick with quarter of an hour remaining, producing a simple finish following another defence splitting pass.

	<p>Powell is a young goalkeeper entering her third season in senior football. She has great shotstopping ability and is also confident with the ball at her feet. Boasting a lot of talent and potential, she claimed the number one jersey early in the 2021-22 season and never looked back, featuring sixteen times while earning both the Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year awards for her excellent performances. Powell went on to make another 22 appearances last season, starting all but three games. She has also actively contributed towards coaching some of the goalkeepers in the club's girls' teams, offering her expertise and guidance.</p>	
	<p>Davies is a promising young goalkeeper entering her second season with the club who will be providing competition for the number one jersey. The younger sister of forward Libby, Nia joined Bassett last season, making 16 appearances, including seven starts. Her debut - and first start - last season came in a 3-0 Wiltshire County Cup victory against Salisbury.</p>	
	<p>Fraser is a strong, technically gifted full back who joins Bassett this season from Swindon Town. Fraser featured for Swindon in each of the past three seasons. In the Covid-shortened 2020-21 campaign, she played six times for the Robins' Development team, scoring once. She then spent most of the 2021-22 season with Swindon's First Team, playing 14 times in the tier four FA Women's National League Division One South West before splitting time between the First and Development teams last year.</p>	
	<p>Cox is a young full back who joins this season from Swindon Town. A member of Swindon's 2021-22 Under 16 Wiltshire County Girls' League side, she progressed into senior women's football last season, appearing 18 times for Swindon's Development side</p>	
	<p>A Bassett stalwart, Jefferies has been with the club for close to a decade and a half having initially started off playing in Bassett's Girls' section. Immensely loyal, she has featured for the Women's First Team in every season since reformed in 2009-10, helping Bassett climb up from Division Three of the Gloucestershire County Women's League. She is the club's all-time leading Women's appearance maker and holds the distinction of having appeared in every single Women's FA Cup game Bassett have played. Club captain, Jefferies leads by example from defence. While a solid centre back, she is more than willing to step out from defence and start attacks and is also a threat from set pieces. Ultra-reliable and more than happy to get stuck in with the ugly side of the game, Jefferies is another player who will serve as a role model for Bassett's younger players on and off the pitch. Jefferies is still a quality player too, winning her fifth Player of the Year trophy last season. In Bassett's 2018-19 double-winning campaign, her performances earned her both the Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year awards, while she picked up the Players' Player prize in 2013-14 and 2014-15.</p>

Johnson was part of Swindon's 2021-22 Under 16 Wiltshire County Women's and Girls' League double-winning side, earning Players' Player of the Year. She also played for Ashton Keynes' all-conquering Gloucester County Girls' League Under 16s side in 2021-22. Johnson then featured twice for Swindon's Development side last season before joining Bassett. Playing 15 times and starting all but one game, she formed a strong partnership in the heart of Bassett's defence with Laura Jefferies.</p>	
	<p>Kirk is a talented defender who is entering her fifth season with the club. A player who reads the game exceptionally well and possesses a calmness which is rare in a player so young, she performed impressively in twelve appearances in the 2019-20 campaign – her first in senior football. Two seasons ago she featured eleven times with ten starts before experiencing an injury-shortened campaign last year in which she played just three times. Now on the path to recovery, Kirk will be hoping to return to the strong form she showed before being sidelined.</p>	
	<p>A player who has come through Bassett's youth section, O'Nions is a hard-working left-sided player with plenty of potential. O'Nions made her first foray into senior women's football at the end of the 2020-21 campaign, gaining experience in a series of friendly fixtures. She gave a good account of herself in those matches, and she went on to feature 13 times in competitive action in 2021-22 before making 17 appearances last season, including 13 starts. A student of the game and a valuable contributor to the club, she has also served as a coach for Bassett's girls' teams as well as at the Saturday morning Wildcats' sessions. This season O'Nions will be looking to continue her development with Bassett as a player, while also studying at university.</p>	
	<p>Entering her sixth season with Bassett team, Smith is a highly talented central defender who has come through the club's youth section. She made her Women's First Team debut towards the end of the 2018-19 season after turning 16 and proved to be a vital player during Bassett's title run-in. Smith then appeared 13 times in 2019-20, 5 times in the curtailed 2020-21 campaign, 15 times in 2021-22 and in five games last season. An accomplished defender who combines the physical side of the game with an assured calmness in possession, she will be looking to further continue her development with Bassett while also studying at Loughborough University.</p>	<p>The Smiths</p>
	<p>Nightingale is a versatile player capable of playing in either defence or midfield who joins Bassett this season. She brings significant experience playing at a higher level too having spent most of the last decade with sides in the FA Women's National League. Nightingale has played a large part of her career with Swindon Town, enjoying spells with the Robins between 2014-15, 2017-19 and 2021-23. She has also featured for Forest Green Rovers (2015-16), Swindon Supermarine (2016-17) and Keynsham Town (2019-21).</p>

### **Burrige brace delivers derby delight**

#### **Royal Wootton Bassett Town 3 Purton 1**

Royal Rosie Burrige marked her competitive debut with a match winning brace as Royal Wootton Bassett Town secured a season double over local rivals Purton with a come from behind 3-1 derby victory.

Adam Wood's side were once again pushed hard by their near neighbours but ended the afternoon deserved winners to move level on points with second place Stockwood Wanderers in Division One Eastern of the South West Regional Women's Football League.

Bassett had trailed with less than quarter of an hour on the clock when home ballwatching in defence of a corner allowed an unmarked Jasmine Payne to get on the end of a corner and head into the back of the net.

A lively second half then saw youngster Burrige determine the outcome of the game.

She put Bassett ahead shortly before the hour mark. After riding a challenge, Emma Sykes played a neat through ball forward, and Burrige nipped in just ahead of Sigthorsdottir, beating the 'keeper to the pass before coolly slotting between a pair of Purton defenders and into the net.

After Hannah Gulliver saw an effort blocked by Sigthorsdottir and Burrige found another Sykes pass just out of reach when well positioned, Bassett were almost caught out at the other end when Hayley Huckin found herself through on goal. However, the former Bassett forward was thwarted by a fantastic save from Millie Powell, who stood brave, taking a blow to the head in the process.

That proved a critical moment as shortly after Bassett had their third. Honor Fraser won possession, with the ball worked up to Gulliver who teed up Burrige for a neat finish.

Huckin had another chance for Purton to pull one back, but scuffed her shot when through on goal. That was to be the best Purton could muster for the remainder of the game.

Instead, Burrige had three further opportunities to add further gloss to a fantastic debut by completing her hat trick. However, Sigthorsdottir denied her when played through in behind the Purton defence, before Burrige sent two weighted efforts narrowly over the bar.

She had done enough damage though, providing a vital pair of goals that help keep Bassett's promotion tilt on the right track.
