Today's Opponents

Iminster Town

Iminster Town Football Club, like most clubs, started life just as a men's side and it has been possible to find traces of a side playing in the late 1890's in the British Newspaper archive but the precise date of formation is not known. At sometime at the start of the 20th century they were known as Iminster United but changed their name to Iminster Town in 1920 whilst members of the Perry Street & District League. During the 1930's they won the Somerset Junior Cup on three occasions. Just after the Second World War Iminster commenced entering the FA Cup and did so throughout the 1950's with the best performance being making the Second Qualifying Rounds on a number of occasions.

The club joined the Western Football League in the newly reformed Division One for the 1976–77 season. The following season, Iminster were promoted to the Premier Division after finishing third. They lasted two seasons in the top flight of the Western League, during which time they reached the Third Round of the FA Vase, before being relegated back to Division One. Two seasons later, the club left the Western League altogether.

Iminster Town joined the Somerset Senior League Division One in 1985–86, but were relegated to Division Two in 1988. The next season the club were crowned champions and regained their Division One status. They remained in the league until being relegated in 1995. Again they bounced back the following season by winning Division Two. In 1999, the club was again relegated, and only returned to Division one after finishing runners-up in 2002–03. The following season, Iminster were crowned champions of Division One and reached the Premier Division for the first time. In 2008, the club was relegated back to Division One, but returned to the Premier Division in 2012 after again winning the league title. This time round they stayed in the Premier Division for three seasons but all three seasons saw them near the bottom and they were relegated to what had become a regionalised Division One, playing in the West Division.

They were back down for just two seasons, however, returning to the Premier Division after winning the 2016-17 Division One West title. They have held their own since returning to the Premiership generally finishing safely in mid table.

In terms of the Ladies team at the club, the earliest record we have been able to trace is membership of the Somerset County League Division One in Season 2013-14 which Iminster won to earn promotion to the South West Regional Women's League where they have remained ever since. After three seasons in Eastern Division One they earned promotion to the Premier Division after finishing in third place. Their first two seasons in the top flight of the league saw them finish in seventh and eighth place respectively.

The first Covid impacted season saw Iminster Town sat in 5th place in the table with just one defeat from eight fixtures and with games in hand at the time the season was brought to a premature end. They were very much looking like they were a major contender in the title race. They had also reached the semi-final of the Pat Sowden Cup in what was shaping up to be their most successful season ever. They opened their season with a 4-0 away win over AEK Boco in the FA Cup. But they finally exited the FA Cup at the hands of Portsmouth based side Moneyfields. Their one and only defeat in the league came away at Middlezoy where they lost 2-1. The following season Iminster played just two league games before Covid once again ended the season but both games were won. Both games were against Bassett.

They carried that form into Season 22-23 and in an excellent season for the club they finished second in the table with fourteen wins and just two defeats in their eighteen league fixtures and missed out on the league title to St Austell by a solitary point. Last season, however, was to prove a disappointment as they finished third from bottom and were relegated to the Western Division but are currently top of the table and looking like they will bounce straight back.

Boasting a lot of talent and potential, she claimed the number one jersey early in the 2021-22 season and never looked back, featuring sixteen times while earning both the Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year awards for her excellent performances. Powell went on to make another 22 appearances last season, starting all but three games. She has also actively contributed towards coaching some of the goalkeepers in the club's girls' teams, offering her expertise and guidance.</p>	
	<p>Davies is a promising young goalkeeper entering her second season with the club who will be providing competition for the number one jersey. The younger sister of forward Libby, Nia joined Bassett last season, making 16 appearances, including seven starts. Her debut - and first start - last season came in a 3-0 Wiltshire County Cup victory against Salisbury.</p>	
	<p>Fraser is a strong, technically gifted full back who joins Bassett this season from Swindon Town. Fraser featured for Swindon in each of the past three seasons. In the Covid-shortened 2020-21 campaign, she played six times for the Robins' Development team, scoring once. She then spent most of the 2021-22 season with Swindon's First Team, playing 14 times in the tier four FA Women's National League Division One South West before splitting time between the First and Development teams last year.</p>	
	<p>Cox is a young full back who joins this season from Swindon Town. A member of Swindon's 2021-22 Under 16 Wiltshire County Girls' League side, she progressed into senior women's football last season, appearing 18 times for Swindon's Development side</p>	<p>Mark Smedley</p>
	<p>A Bassett stalwart, Jefferies has been with the club for close to a decade and a half having initially started off playing in Bassett's Girls' section. Immensely loyal, she has featured for the Women's First Team in every season since reformed in 2009-10, helping Bassett climb up from Division Three of the Gloucestershire County Women's League. She is the club's all-time leading Women's appearance maker and holds the distinction of having appeared in every single Women's FA Cup game Bassett have played. Club captain, Jefferies leads by example from defence. While a solid centre back, she is more than willing to step out from defence and start attacks and is also a threat from set pieces. Ultra-reliable and more than happy to get stuck in with the ugly side of the game, Jefferies is another player who will serve as a role model for Bassett's younger players on and off the pitch. Jefferies is still a quality player too, winning her fifth Player of the Year trophy last season. In Bassett's 2018-19 double-winning campaign, her performances earned her both the Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year awards, while she picked up the Players' Player prize in 2013-14 and 2014-15.</p>	<p>PCM @STFCMD</p>

 <p>Neve Johnson</p>	<p>Johnson is a talented young defender who joined Bassett last season from Swindon Town. Johnson was part of Swindon's 2021-22 Under 16 Wiltshire County Women's and Girls' League double-winning side, earning Players' Player of the Year. She also played for Ashton Keynes' all-conquering Gloucester County Girls' League Under 16s side in 2021-22. Johnson then featured twice for Swindon's Development side last season before joining Bassett. Playing 15 times and starting all but one game, she formed a strong partnership in the heart of Bassett's defence with Laura Jefferies.</p>	
 <p>Rosie Kirk</p>	<p>Kirk is a talented defender who is entering her fifth season with the club. A player who reads the game exceptionally well and possesses a calmness which is rare in a player so young, she performed impressively in twelve appearances in the 2019-20 campaign – her first in senior football. Two seasons ago she featured eleven times with ten starts before experiencing an injury-shortened campaign last year in which she played just three times. Now on the path to recovery, Kirk will be hoping to return to the strong form she showed before being sidelined.</p>	
 <p>Ellie O'Nions</p>	<p>A player who has come through Bassett's youth section, O'Nions is a hard-working left-sided player with plenty of potential. O'Nions made her first foray into senior women's football at the end of the 2020-21 campaign, gaining experience in a series of friendly fixtures. She gave a good account of herself in those matches, and she went on to feature 13 times in competitive action in 2021-22 before making 17 appearances last season, including 13 starts. A student of the game and a valuable contributor to the club, she has also served as a coach for Bassett's girls' teams as well as at the Saturday morning Wildcats' sessions. This season O'Nions will be looking to continue her development with Bassett as a player, while also studying at university.</p>	
 <p>Mollie Smith</p>	<p>Entering her sixth season with Bassett team, Smith is a highly talented central defender who has come through the club's youth section. She made her Women's First Team debut towards the end of the 2018-19 season after turning 16 and proved to be a vital player during Bassett's title run-in. Smith then appeared 13 times in 2019-20, 5 times in the curtailed 2020-21 campaign, 15 times in 2021-22 and in five games last season. Morse has the code to topple Terras

Weymouth 0 Royal Wootton Bassett Town 1

Caily Morse's early goal and a strong defensive effort guided Royal Wootton Bassett Town to victory away at Weymouth in the team's penultimate game of their South West Regional Women's Football League Division One Eastern campaign.

With runners-up spot already secured, on paper Bassett had little to play for as they made the long trip down to the Dorset coast. Despite that though, Adam Wood's side put in a strong performance that ultimately delivered victory - with the result meaning that Bassett will finish the season having beaten all but one of their league opponents. The lone side Bassett were unable to crack was Bath City - though Bassett can take solace from the fact they got the better of the Romans in their recent League Cup second round meeting.

The only goal of the game arrived after just three minutes. Libby Davies' through ball split open the Weymouth defence, with Maddy Elliott latching onto her past. Elliott's firm shot was parried by home 'keeper Issy Heybourne, but the rebound fell to Morse who pounced on the loose ball and coolly slotted home.

While there was to be no further scoring, the remaining 87 minutes were full of chances and intrigue with Bassett withstanding significant pressure - especially in the second half - as Weymouth were unable to get back on terms.

Bassett enjoyed a fast start and twice came close to extending their lead in the game's early stages. First, after getting in behind the Weymouth defence, Hannah Gulliver delivered a dangerous cross that Heybourne had to be alert to save. The Weymouth 'keeper then saved low from a left-footed Davies effort. Bassett knew from their home encounter with Weymouth in February that the Terras would represent a big challenge though. And it wasn't long before the hosts were threatening. Lucy Roberts fired narrowly over from a free kick on the edge of the box after Lilia Slattery was forced into conceding a foul.

Millie Powell then had to save with her feet to deny Emily Screen, with the rebound just evading home

captain Charlotte Wilson. Screen soon had a double opportunity, with Powell dealing with the first before Darcy Cox got her body in the way to block the second. Later in the half Screen found space to shoot but once again was denied by Powell. Powell continued to be in inspired form as, three minutes before the interval, she was able to keep out another Roberts free kick that seemed destined for the top corner.

A slice of luck almost saw Weymouth equalise early in the second period when Bianca Osborne's flick on somehow evaded Briony Hurd and landed in the path of Kaydee Thornicroft but the Weymouth substitute could only drag wide. There was some respite for the Bassett defence as play returned to the other end. 'Keeper Heybourne was bravely off her line to save at the feet of Elliott as the Bassett forward sought to latch onto Davies' pass. After seeing her ball in cleared only as far as her, Davies then scuffed wide after Weymouth failed to clear.

For the remainder of the game though the Bassett defence came under significant pressure. Bassett did ride their luck midway through the half as Thornicroft passed up a golden opportunity after being played in by Wilson's quick free kick. Ten minutes later Roberts was just off target with another free kick before strong defending from Cox allowed her to muscle Thornicroft off the ball as the Weymouth forward broke into the box.

The hosts final chance then fell to Ellia Webb who, after Bassett appeals for a handball went unanswered, could only shoot wide when under pressure from Jasmine Kennedy, who had made a good recovery run to be in position to hassle her opponent. Bassett thus were able to hold on for a victory that sees them pull within five points of champions Poole Town. Wood and his team will be hoping to narrow the Dolphins' margin of victory to just two points when they host Shaftesbury in their final league fixture.
