Men's First Team Bassett Bulletin Welcome To Tonight's Game

GOOD EVENING and welcome to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this opening Uhlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture of the 2024-25 Season against near neighbours Fairford Town. A warm welcome to all our visitors who have made the short journey from across the border, we hope you enjoy your brief stay with us this evening and we wish you a safe journey home.

It hardly seems like any time has passed since we were staging the play-off game against Cinderford Town here at the Sustain Stadium in front of a crowd just short of 1,000. Whilst the result did not go our way that night it was a tremendous achievement from Sam and his side to get to the play-off final, securing our highest ever finish in non-league football along the way. Having tasted the experience of challenging for honours and that play-off final last time round we will be keen to go one better this coming season and achieve promotion to the Southern League and perhaps win a cup along the way.

Sam has certainly been busy in the summer assembling what looks to be a strong squad ahead of the new campaign. It will be important to get off to a good start but Fairford will definitely be one of the sides expected to be up there challenging for honours and tonight represents a good test of the type of season we might have. Get a good result tonight and it will bode well for the season ahead.

Our record against Fairford did not used to be a good one, but Sam's tenure in the hot seat has seen a dramatic turn around in our overall results. There has been just one defeat in the last seven meetings, with Bassett coming out on top in four of those matches with two drawn games. The sides have met on 32 occasions and it is now 12 wins apiece with 8 games drawn. We have also won all of the last three meetings between the sides and hopefully that run of results will continue here tonight.

It is interesting to observe what has gone on at Corsham in recent weeks and I somehow feel that they will not be as strong as last season. In terms of the teams I fancy to have a good season, in addition to the two sides here this evening, I would expect Slimbridge, Highworth Town and Hartpury University to be up there challenging for honours, alongside Westfields and Worcester Raiders who had a disappointing season by their own normal standards last season and I expect both will come back stronger this campaign.

The games will certainly come thick and fast this season with the last league game currently scheduled for as early as March 1st, although the great British weather will extend that date well into April. I suspect the Hellenic League want to avoid a repeat of last season where they took a bit of flack for the scheduling of the play-offs when one of the teams involved (the ultimate winners) had not completed their league fixtures before the play-offs started.

The first team are back in action again here on Friday night when we entertain Mangotsfield United in the FA Cup.

The Development Team get their season under way this coming Saturday when they travel to Pewsey Vale, another tough start to the season as Pewsey have finished in the top three in each of the last four seasons.

I note that there is no Under 18 Floodlit team this season which, whilst I understand the logic, I personally do not agree with, as it was always a way of bringing players into the club to augment what was coming through our own Youth Section. With not a single team in any age group in the top division of the North Wilts Youth League this coming season, I would have thought there is an even greater need to have something to help attract players in.

Enjoy the game and hopefully three points to start of the season ahead of that Friday night FA Cup encounter with Mangotsfield.

Opponents History Fairford Town



Whilst Fairford Town Football Club was formed in 1891 and for many years played in the Cirencester & District League against local teams with varying degrees of success.

After the second world war the club joined the Swindon & District League, winning the Premier Division in both 1964/65 and 1968/69, also winning the Advertiser Cup in the same years, and in 1962/63 won the Gloucestershire Junior Cup.

Success in the Swindon & District League was followed by election to the Hellenic League in 1970, only missing promotion from the first division on goal average at the first attempt, the club were also beaten finalists in that year's division one Challenge Cup.

The following year, 1971/72 saw Fairford win the Hellenic first division and division one Challenge Shield, whilst the reserve side won the Gloucestershire County Minor Cup, the Advertiser Cup and finished runners-up in the Swindon & District Division One.

The successful run continued and Town were the beaten finalists of 1972/73 in the Premier Division Cup, only to be relegated back to Division One in 1973/74.

Fairford Town were again promoted in 1975/76 and steady progress led to the

Premier Division Runners-up in 1978/79 and 1979/80, also winning the Premier Division Cup in 1978/79.

The Club were winners of the Gloucestershire Challenge Trophy in 1979/80 and 1998/99 and Runners-up in 1982/83 and 1994/95.

The most recent league success has been Premier Division Runners-up in season 1994/95 following a similar position in Season 1990/91. The Club has also achieved numerous wins in the Arthur Shipway Cup and Fairford Hospital Cup.

The 2016/17 season saw the club secure a return to the Uhlsport Hellenic Premier Division after a five-year absence, winning the Division One West title with 75 points.

In recent years the club has grown on and off the pitch. The first team are now established and challenging in the Uhlsport Hellenic Premier Division with a Reserves side also competing in Hellenic Division 2 South. 2020 also saw the creation of Fairford Town Academy with teams running from under 12s through to under 18s. We aim to place the football club within the heart of the local community and are keen to continue to grow and achieve our goal of promotion to the Southern Football League for the first time in the club's history.

The belief's back at Bassett

Revitalised Wootton Bassett were victorious for the second weekend in succession - enjoying a derby victory and booking their place in round two of the Supplementary Cup in the process. On the back of their first league success since September last weekend. Bassett were good value for a 2-1 triumph at Fairford on Saturday. Caretaker boss Chris Jones isn't taking credit for any tactical masterstrokes, insisting the reason for the reversal of fortune was a simple one.

"We've tweaked a few things but the main thing we've done is try to give the lads some self-belief, belief in their own ability, which gets knocked after a losing streak.

"They're starting to get that back."

Dave Tyler galloped through the middle to fire Bassett into an early lead. Chris Mills' deflected effort doubled the advantage a minute before half-time. Fairford pressed hard in the second period, but Lee Clark's late consolation goal was their only reward

"I was very pleased. We've could have scored a couple more to be honest," added Jones.

"The guys have all worked really hard.

"I'd rather have taken three points in the league, but the cup is a nice distraction and a good chance to build some confidence."

<u>Jamie Reid</u> – 35 years old. Became manager of Fairford in May 2022 following 4 years as assistant to Jody Bevan. As a player Jamie was a no-nonsense midfielder where he was a regular for many years at Gloucester City, Cirencester Town and Mangotsfield Utd. A succession of knee injuries forced a premature end to his playing days.

<u>Sam Farr</u> – Assistant Manager. Possibly the nicest man in football. Sam made his name as a player primarily with the Cirencester Town Development before moving to Fairford in 2019 initially as a player and then as manager of the reserve team. Promoted to assistant manager following Jamie Reid's appointment in 2022.



After starring for Corsham Town as they finished fifth in the Hellenic League Premier Division and reached the Wiltshire Premier Shield final in 2021-22 Brown moved to Cribbs early on in the following season and played a key role as they finished as champions while conceding just 15 times all season. An intelligent, composed player who is strong in the air, Case is an extremely impressive young centre half. After starting out his youth career with Bassett, Case joined Swindon Town's Academy. Following his release, he joined Highworth in 2021-22 and, across two seasons, featured 62 times for the Worthians, scoring three goals. In his first season with Bassett, Hobson-McVeigh scored five times in 36 games before adding seven goals in 37 appearances last season.

Chris Taylor A vastly experienced central midfielder who is entering his fifth season with Bassett. A classy operator, who is supremely confident on the ball and possesses excellent distribution and superb fitness, Taylor has been a standout player during his time in blue and yellow - and last season earned a Manager's and Players' Player of the Year double. Overall, he has featured 115 times while scoring twice since making his Bassett debut in 2020-21. Taylor joined Bassett after four years at Highworth Town, during which he helped the Worthians achieve promotion to the Southern League. However, it is with Swindon Supermarine that Taylor has spent most of his career. An England Under 15 international in his youth, he featured four times for Swindon Town in 2002-03 before being released by the Reds in 2006. Taylor then joined Supermarine and made 355 appearances over the course of nine seasons. In that time he achieved promotion to the Southern League Premier Division in 2006-07 and was part of the Supermarine side that reached the FA Cup second round in 2010-11. Taylor has also played for Newport County, Maidenhead United, Cirencester Town, Hungeford Town and Australian side Dandenona Thunder.



Tommy Ouldridge A mercurial midfielder who is entering his fourth full season with Bassett. While capable of playing in an advanced role both through the middle and out wide, Ouldridge settled into a deeperhying position last season and continued to excel. He is an extremely talented player who possesses great skill, the ability to pick out any pass, an excellent delivery and an eye for goal. Ouldridge came through Swindon Town's youth system and was in and around the Robins' first team, though never made an appearance. He was released by Swindon after loan spells at Chippenham Town and Cirencester Town during the 2017-18 season. He started the 2018-19 campaign with Hungerford Town before moving back to the Centurions where he spent the majority of the next two seasons. After also briefly featuring for Shrivenham in 2019-20, Ouldridge played six times for Bassett in 2020-21, scoring three goals. A season later, he featured 41 times, scoring seven goals. Sam Collier (Manager) Collier has served as Bassett manager since taking the role, initially on an interim basis while still also a player, in January 2018 in 2018-19, this first full season in charge, Collier guided the team to 10th in the Hellenic League Premier Division - at that point, the club's highest ever finish. Bassett then exceeded that record with a 5th place finish in 2022-23. Last season Bassett went one better, finishing 4th while also reaching the Hellenic League Premier Division promotion playoff final. Bassett have also set records in national cup competitions under Collier's setwardship, with this sides equalling the club's best FA Cup run in 2020-21 and going further than ever before in the FA Vase, reaching the third round in 2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24. This collier's second job in management after he served as Shrivenham player-manager from February 2014 to 2015. As a player, Collier has made 160 appearances for Bassett Mainly featuring as a striker, he has scored 17 goals, finishing as top scorer in 2009-10, when Bassett earned promotion from Hellenic League Division One West, and 2010-11. Collier has played in almost every other position for Bassett too though - including as goalkeeper, making a last minute penalty save in 2022-23 to preserve a point against eventual champions Cribbs. Next Up at the Sustain Stadium FA Cup Action Under the Lights

Next up here at the Sustain Stadium at the GBSG is FA Cup action on Friday night under the lights as Bassett seek a return to success in the biggest of all national cup competitions.

Bassett exited the 2023-24 Emirates FA Cup at the extra preliminary round stage - the first time in four years they had fallen at the first hurdle.

This season Bassett will therefore be looking to quickly banish memories of that loss and recapture the form that saw them venture to the second qualifying round in 2020-21 and the first qualifying round in 2022-23.

First though Bassett will have to overcome fellow Hellenic League Premier Division rivals **Mangotsfield United** - the side who knocked Sam Collier's out last season - in the extra preliminary round.

Mangotsfield triumphed 2-0 when the teams met in the FA Cup last season. However, this time Bassett have home advantage, with the tie due to take place at the Sustain Stadium this coming Friday 2 August (7.45pm kick off). Admission will be £8 for adults and £5

for concessions - including RWBTFC youth members.

That result does still represent the Mangos' only ever victory against Bassett in normal time. The four league fixtures between the teams have seen Bassett triumph three times, with the other ending in a goalless draw, while Mangotsfield prevailed on penalties after a 0-0 draw in the Hellenic League Floodlit Cup in 2022-23.

Although losing 5-1 to Ascot United the round after beating Bassett in the FA Cup last season, Mangotsfield do have a strong history in competition, having reached the fourth (and final) qualifying round on four occasions, most recently in 2009-10. They have not got beyond the first qualifying round since 2010-11 though.

The winners of the tie will then welcome Southern League Division One South side Didcot Town in the preliminary round on Saturday 17 August - a plum fixture that offers the chance of upsetting step four opponents.

Hellenic Premier Division Season Preview Operation Win Something

Over the last two seasons Royal Wootton Bassett Town have enjoyed a level of success that is unprecedented in the 17 years that the club's Men's First Team have now spent in the Hellenic League Premier Division.

In 2022-23, Bassett achieved a first ever top half finish as they wound up an impressive 5th place.

Then last season, Sam Collier's side went one better, finishing fourth. That was enough to qualify for the newly introduced promotion playoffs, and - after defeating local rivals Highworth Town in the semi finals - Bassett wound up 90 minutes away from a first ever taste of Southern League football.

The 4-0 playoff final defeat to Cinderford Town in front of a mammoth home Sustain Stadium crowd was a chastening experience. But it has not dimmed Bassett's thirst for success.

If anything, it has served to make Collier and his team even more hungry for glory as the 2024-25 campaign awaits.

Since taking the managerial reins in January 2018, the Bassett boss has achieved a great deal. Bassett's impressive league finishes in each of the past two seasons built on the record-setting FA Vase runs that the club have enjoyed in the past three years, as well as the record-equalling journey in the FA Cup in 2020-21. Last season also saw Bassett reach the semi final of the Wiltshire Premier Shield - their third visit to the last four of a cup competition during Collier's spell in charge.

But what has proven elusive for Bassett and Collier is silverware. This season Bassett will seek to change that and, after frequently being the bridesmaids in recent years, finally get to be the bride.

Whether the league, the playoffs or a cup, Bassett's sights must be set on winning something in 2024-25.

It's certainly a lofty ambition, and one that won't come easy. Nevertheless it's

something that the highly talented squad Collier has built - and added to this summer - deserve to achieve.

Bassett will enter the new Hellenic Premier Division campaign as one of many teams who will fancy their chances.

With Worcester City - one of the most dominant sides to have featured in the division for a long time - now gone and with question marks over the status of last year's runners-up Corsham Town following their recent change in manager, there's a sense that the division could be a wide open, unpredictable affair this season.

Near neighbours Highworth will no doubt be vying to be in the mix as will the likes of Slimbridge, Fairford Town and Roman Glass St George, who all narrowly missed out on the playoffs in 2023-24. Pershore Town enjoyed a strong start to life at step five last season before fading away; they'll be hoping for consistent strong displays the entire way this time. The likes of Westfields, Worcester Raiders and Mangotsfield United will also be aiming to fight towards the top after underachieving somewhat last Meanwhile, although coming from opposite directions, newcomers Cirencester Town and Hartpury University will surely have their eyes on challenging towards the top end of the table.

Although not mentioned in the preceding paragraph, the division's remaining sides will all be looking to make their mark as well. After all, the Hellenic Premier has been highly competitive each of the past couple of years. And, while finishing towards the top the past two year, Bassett have rarely faced an easy game.

That's likely to be the case again, though Bassett will be hoping that with the firepower added to the squad, any league success will be built on firmer foundations than last season when 14 of their 23 league wins came just by a single goal.

Prolific goalscorer Ollie Pitt and target man George Peare (both pictured below) have been added as they both join from Brimscombe and Thrupp. Pacey winger Tyrone Tucker-Dixon and young star Finn Hopkins (signed from Shrivenham) have also been recruited to add pace and youth at the sharp end of the pitch.

Bassett's back line - a big strength last season - has been bolstered as well. There is competition for the goalkeeper position with, Rob Brown, James Foster and Sam Jepson all signed. Full back Dan Hill and the experienced Jonny Aitkenhead recruited. And they'll be tasked with helping fill the gaps created by the departure of Dave Bampton and the reduced availability of Jowan Partridge who begins his university studies.

Young midfielders Finlay Skittrall and Mickey Wilkes will get their opportunities to impress too.

Overall though, the squad remains much the same as last year. And that's no bad thing given the quality that remains in all areas of the pitch.

Preseason has been a generally positive one too. Bassett began with a notable 2-1 win away against Southern League North Leigh thanks to goals from Bailey Gallagher and Alfie Presley. Louis Spalding scored the only goal of the game as Bassett edged out Wantage Town 1-0 at home. There then followed a 1-0 victory against Reading City courtesy of Tyrone Tucker-Dixon'a second half strike. Bassett recorded a convincing 3-1 triumph away at Kintbury Rangers in their penultimate friendly as Presley (2) and Finn Hopkins netted.

Bassett did finally fall to defeat in their final friendly - but they battled impressively in a 2-0 loss against National League Forest Green Rovers in front of a bumper Sustain Stadium crowd.

Although results and performances have been encouraging, those games mean little in the grand scheme of things though.

Now the real action starts - and for Bassett that means the start of a season in which they will be aiming even higher than last time around.
