# Men's First Team Bassett Bulletin Welcome To Today's Game

**GOOD AFTERNOON** and welcome to the Sustain Stadium here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Uhlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against Hereford Pegasus.

A warm welcome to all the players, management team, club officials and supporters from Hereford Pegasus who have made the journey from Hereford to be with us today. We hope you all enjoy your short stay with us this afternoon and we wish you a safe journey home.

Well since the last programme we have won one and lost one. The 4-1 win over Longlevens came in the league and means we are now unbeaten in six league games, five of which have been won, the only dropped points coming in the game away at league leaders Hartpury University. Whilst we sit tenth in the table we are just four points off the play-off places now.

The defeat came last week in the FA Vase against AFC Stoneham, the 3-0 defeat meaning our prize money from the Vase is just £250 which is the downside of getting byes from the two qualifying rounds. At least the early exit will mean that next season we will be back in the qualifying rounds.

This afternoon's visitors got off to a flying start this season, winning six and drawing one of their opening eight fixtures to sit top of the league. However, since beating Slimbridge 4-1 at the start of September Pegasus have gone seven league games without a win, picking up just two points from those seven games which has seen them slip down to 12th place in the table.

Our record against Pegasus Juniors in recent seasons is an excellent one. We have won all six of the last six meetings and are unbeaten in eight games against today's opponents, seven of which have been won. Overall we have won 13 to nine for Pegasus since the first meeting back in Season 1993-94, with six draws between the two sides (these stats have been corrected from last season's programme for this fixture after I gave Pegasus an additional win in error).

Hopefully this afternoon will see us maintain that recent excellent record against today's opponents. The player sponsorship for both the Men's and Women's teams has gone well this season but there are still a few available for both teams at £50 a player. With the list of players still available you can get to sponsor Brad Pitt for £100!

The Women's side's recent dip in form has now seen them go five games without a win. After exiting the FA Cup 3-1 away at Torquay United, last Sunday saw them entertain Cirencester Town here at the Sustain Stadium where they were held to a 2-2 draw that sees them sit fifth in the table. This Sunday they are away to Bath City which is then followed by a home game against league leaders Gloucester City. Both are tough games but if the women's side are to return to Step 5 of the Ladies Pyramid they probably need to win both games.

Another side that have struggled of late are the Development side who look to be in for a potential relegation battle in the Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League, with four sides likely to be relegated at the end of this season. Ahead of Wednesday night's encounter with Larkhall Athletic Development, another side who have struggled this season, Mark Simpkin's side had won just one of their previous five league games and lost two in a row. Thankfully that run was brought to an end with a 4-2 success that saw Bassett climb five places in the table and out of the relegation places.

You will have noticed that I have started including the Youth Section results and league tables in the programme. In compiling these it is somewhat depressing to see not a single side in the top division at any of the age groups. Thinking back to where we used to be one of the strongest clubs in youth football in the Swindon area, not sure what has caused this shift, but I feel this needs a review to see what can be done as it does not bode well for the future of the adult sides.

Enjoy the game and hopefully three more points to see us continue to climb the table.

In 1955 when Noel Watkin oversaw the Herefordshire County Boys. There was a great team bond, so when the County fixtures were through, the team asked if they could stay together and Pegasus Juniors came into being, taking the name from the famous amateur side of the era.

It was inevitable that players would move on to higher grades of football and many did that with distinction. Pegasus Juniors original members Jack Perks and Bob Pasley remained, they proudly gained membership into the Hellenic League in 1978 and established a club house in Hereford.

In 2005 Pegasus Juniors opened their new ground at Old School Lane with funding from The Football Foundation, Football Association local trusts and directors. The facilities have continually been improved since with grant funded work in 2013 replacing the perimeter fence, upgrading the car park and extending the clubhouse. 2019 saw our biggest project to date, with the installation of a state-of-the-art artificial turf pitch along with upgraded LED floodlights.

In 2010 the club decided to move its first team to the West Midland (Regional) League for season 2011/12 as the Hellenic League was, at the time veering, in an easterly direction. The highlight during our eight seasons in the West Midlands was undoubtedly finishing as runners up with 100 points in a high scoring season. More recently an exodus of senior players led to a very young team finding themselves at the wrong end of the table.

Joint Managers Mick Panniers and Dave Cadwallader came together in the dugout to lead the team as we came back 'home' to the Hellenic League for 2019/20 in Division One West. Following two Covid curtailed seasons, Mick stepped away from management with a move 'upstairs' in a Director of Football role. 'Caddy' along with Mark Hibbard were then appointed as Joint Managers for the 2021/22

season.

Having finished 4th in Hellenic League Division 1 at the end of the 2021/22 season we took part in the first ever Play Offs at Step 6. In the semi-final we travelled to Clanfield. winning 4-0 and setting up a Play Off Final against Worcester Raiders at Sixways Stadium. Scoring within the first 20 seconds of the final set us on our way to a memorable night, going on to win the game 3-0. The final whistle signalled jubilant scenes throughout the team and travelling support. We had secured promotion back to Step 5 and a place in the Hellenic Premier Division for the 2022/23 season. In addition to the Promotion, it also meant a return to the F.A. Cup for the first time in seven years. Our first season back in the Premier Division was a creditable one achieving an 8th place finish.

The 2023/24 season saw us finish 9th, after a great start to the season a poor run over Christmas saw a play off challenge ended. Big news came off the pitch though with news of a new pitch side facility to be built. The new multi-purpose building will include a sponsor's suite, education room in addition to a snack bar and toilets. It will be our first pitch side facility since the opening of The KGD Stadium.

### Topping Tops off a Fine First Season

Wootton Bassett Town 2 Pegasus Juniors 1

Wootton Bassett Town finished their first season back in the Hellenic Premier Division how they started it with a hard fought victory against Pegasus Juniors. The league's basement side did not go down without a fight, succumbing 2-1 after Adam Topping's classy finish - his first career first team goal with seven minutes remaining decided the game's outcome.

The afternoon started brilliantly for the hosts when Tom Dingle emphatically fired in on the turn just two minutes in after Mark McMeeking recycled a half cleared Matt Bown corner.

But the visitors made Bassett sweat, defending astutely despite having to deal with plenty of pressure. Sam Collier did find the back of the net as well during the first period but saw his expert finish ruled out for offside, while Ethan Delaney twice missed from favourable positions before the break.

The final finish continued to elude Bassett in the second period, and nearly wound up preventing Dave Turner's side from rising two places to a solid 15th position in the table.

There were chances aplenty but the lead could just not be extended. Collier saw a firm effort tipped onto the post moments after the restart following great play from Dingle, who had successfully chased down a lost cause, and Delaney in the right corner.

Midfielders Sam Packer, James Turner and Bown then all saw well struck drives from just outside the area miss narrowly, the former having his effort blocked on the goalline.

Collier was next to come close, seeing two shots in quick succession blocked by in form 'keeper Nick Isles at point blank range following a neat flick from substitute Topping. The forward, just two shy of recording his 50th goal for the club, then beat Isles to a looping Bown cross but his header dropped agonisingly wide of the right hand post with just over ten minutes to play.

Taking advantage of their hosts' profligacy, the visitors thought they had snatched a share of the points when Mark Smith's backpost header was adjudged to have crossed the line after a testing Tom Boyle corner beat Stewart Thompson.

But moments later the decisive goal came. Delaney pitched a ball over the top of the defence from the left wing, and a sliced clearance set free Topping, who coolly lobbed Isles.

In injury time the 'keeper fabulously kept out another Turner thunderbolt, but that mattered little as his side failed to fathom any more openings at the other end.

It was by no means an outstanding Bassett performance, but it was enough to add further gloss to a fine first season back at step five. The three points lifted them into 15th above Bracknell Town and Oxford City Nomads, capping a year which saw the team match the club's record run in the FA Cup, progress in the FA Vase, beat local rivals Highworth Town and eventual champions Wantage Town and - most importantly of all - survive.

A job well done by all involved.





#### **Purple Pain**

#### Saturday 19th October 2024

After record-making runs to the third round in each of the past three seasons, Royal Wootton Bassett Town's participation in this year's Isuzu FA Vase was brought to an end at the first hurdle as Sam Collier's side were well beaten 3-0 in their first round tie away at Wessex League Premier Division AFC Stoneham.

Bassett were a clear second best as Stoneham - neat and tidy in possession while making use of clever moment off the ball - jumped into a 2-0 half time lead before putting the game well and truly to bed midway through the second period.

Only in the final quarter of the match - with the game beyond them - did Bassett finally spark into life. But not even a consolation was forthcoming as they immediately exited with little more than a whimper a competition that for the past three years has brought much success to the club.

Bassett fell behind as early as the ninth minute. A long ball over the top from centre half Jake Thompson did for them, with Tyrrell Sampson racing onto it before curling a fine effort from the left edge of the area into the back of the net with the aid of the right post.

There was to be no real reaction to going behind early from Bassett, who should have come into the game full of confidence going forward after netting 17 goals in their last four games.

Admittedly it didn't help their cause that target man Chris Zebroski pulled up in the warm up.

But the best they could muster were half chances, with Bailey Gallagher failing to connect with a clean header when well placed following a Noah Coates cross and Alfie Presley snatching at a close range effort that Callum Lee tipped around the near post.

And with three minutes to go until the interval they found themselves in a deep 2-0 hole.

Stoneham were able to advance forward with ease, and Jamie Johnston danced through to break the midfield line before feeding Mat Bainbridge, who brushed off the attentions of Adam Corcoran before finishing with aplomb into the bottom corner.

The hosts almost had a third in stoppage time too when Alex Welch teed up an unmarked Jim Orvis but he skewed a shot straight at James Foster.

Despite facing a 2-0 deficit, it was a case of as things were for Bassett when play resumed. An early substitute did soon arrive with George Peare replacing Adam Corcoran - though this was a like-for-like change with Peare - a player capable of playing at either end of the pitch - slotting into the heart of defence.

Bassett then had a huge let off when Johnston, with a free run at goal after Owen Fee's clever overhead kick on the halfway line split the visiting defence, somehow placed wide of the left post when it seemed easier to score.

But Stoneham's third soon arrived. The hosts broke with conviction after a Bassett corner came to nothing. Fee fed Sampson in the left channel and he drove towards goal before cutting inside Ollie Case and coolly slotting into the bottom corner for his second.

That was game, set and match with just under half an hour still to play.

Stoneham knew that, barring a miraculous comeback, they had their name in the hat for Monday's second round draw. And they did take their foot off the gas a little, while Bassett finally sought to throw some caution to the wind.

There was to be a brief flurry of chances for Bassett too. Noah Coates forced Lee to tip behind for a corner with a tight-angled shot, with Case heading wide at the back post from the resulting corner.

Then, after Alfie Presley had shot straight at Lee, the home 'keeper presented Brad Pagliaroli with what should have been a present as he passed straight to the Bassett winger. However Pagliaroli's attempted chip sailed over.

It was clear that it wasn't to be Bassett's day when a triple effort soon came to nothing. Lee injured himself in the process of making a point-blank save to deny Pagliaroli before Lewis Nagle threw his body in the way to block Tom Moore's close range follow up. The ball then broke for Presley who sliced over from a matter of yards out at the left post.

Lee was unable to continue after the knock he sustained with substitute Tom Annetts an outfield player - receiving the call to take over between the sticks.

Bassett were unable to find a way past Stoneham's auxiliary 'keeper though. Seemingly wrong-footed, Annetts did brilliantly to change direction and parry a deflected Pagliaroli free kick the wrong side of the post. He then made further, more routine saves to keep out Ollie Pitt and Pagliaroli.

With Bassett finally pressing, Stoneham had opportunities to further extend their winning margin too.

A counter-attack that Nagle initiated ended with Alex Welch drilling just wide of the left

post while an unmarked Orvis shot straight at Foster after being teed up by Duarte Martins shortly before the final whistle.

Bassett's participation in this year's Vase therefore ended with little to show for it. Their six game unbeaten streak also is no more.

Focus will now return to the league where the aim will be to bounce back from this cup reverse and continue to make up ground in the hunt for another Hellenic League Premier Division playoff finish.

Player of the match: Noah Coates - linked up well with Brad Pagliaroli on the right side and demonstrated the will to get forward and run at the Stoneham defence that was missing in other areas of the pitch.



# Wiltshire Senior League Premier Division Roundup 19 Oct

Due to cup games and postponements, there were just six games played this weekend in the Premier Division of the Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League with the big game of the day being at Pewsey Recreation Ground where third in the table Pewsey Vale entertained the league leaders Kintbury Rangers. A solitary strike from Kintbury's Kye Williams was all that separated the two sides at the break but second half goals from Jesse Bowers and a first for Danny Hale since his transfer from Blunsdon ensured Kintbury went home with all three points following a 3-0 win. With second place Wroughton in County Cup action the win for Kintbury saw them extend their unbeaten start in the league and open up a six-point lead over Wroughton, with both having played 13 games.

Melksham Town Reserves moved up to third spot in the table with a hard fought 3-2 win away against Salisbury Development on the 3G at Sarum. They started well getting an early lead on eight minutes, but Salisbury were back on level terms ten minutes later through Henry Anoma and it remained 1-1 at the break. Having scored early in the first half. Melksham repeated the trick in the second half, going to 2-1 up within a minute of the restart. For the second time in the game Salisbury levelled matters up, Dan Bazen firing in midway through the second half. There was to be late drama though, Melksham snatching a winner three minutes from time to break Salisbury hearts. There were two more goals for Kegan Smart for Melksham as he took his tally to 14 for the season. Aron Byfield with the other Melksham goal which saw Melksham move above Pewsey Vale and to within two points of second place Wroughton having plaved one game more.

Letcombe could well turn out to be Kintbury Rangers main challengers for the title, with games in hand over all the teams above them in the table they could move to within four points of the leaders if they won both of their games in hand. They picked up their eighth league win of the season on Saturday thanks to a storming first half performance that saw them lead 3-0 against Royal Wootton Bassett Town Development, James Webster getting the opener before two goals from Kieron Kirby put them in a commanding position. Flynn Walters pulled one back for the home side but a fourth for Kintbury scored by Dan Timbrell made sure of the points, a second for Flynn for the home side proving to be nothing more than a consolation goal as it finished 4-2 to the visitors.

Bemerton Heath Harlequins Reserves have been consistently inconsistent this season but are currently having one of their better runs. Having won 2-1 at home against Shrewton United last week they made it two wins in a row with a 3-0 away success on their first ever visit to **Faringdon Town**. Goals from Dean Reynolds, Jack Stevens and a third of the season from Josh Hoey secured the points for the Salisbury based side who moved level on points with both Calne Town and eighth placed Kingsdown as a result of the win.

Shrewton United bounced back from that defeat at the hands of Bemerton last week with a 4-1 victory over Calne Town Reserves, who lost and conceded four goals in the process for the second week running. Two quick fire goals early in the first half set them on their way. The first on 15 minutes saw a Calne defender turn a Lewis Cross shot across goal into his own net. A minute later Shrewton doubled their lead, Charlie Jackson scoring his eighth of the season. Calne managed to avoid conceding again before the break but found themselves 3-0 down six minutes into the second half, James Collins scoring with an audacious back heel after good work from Aiden Compton had set him up. Čalne pulled one back 12 minutes from time but any thoughts of a comeback were ended when Lewis Cross added a fourth nine minutes from time after an assist from Ben Jenks as it finished 4-1 to Shrewton

Larkhall Athletic Development have not had a particularly good start to the season and currently sit second from bottom in the table with just three points. The Bath based side were up against the team who started the day just above them in the table, Shrivenham and it was to be another day where things did not go the way of the Bath based side, although it had started brightly with them going 1-0 up. However, James Hirst got Shrivenham back on level terms with his fourth goal of the season as the teams turned round at the break all square. Hirst then netted a second and his fifth of the season to put Shrivenham 2-1 up before Alex Harrison made sure of the points with a third for Shrivenham. A series of injuries saw Larkhall reduced to nine men at the end of the game, with manager James Riccio having to take over in goal as Shrivenham secured their third win of the season and their second victory of the week. Larkhall will look to turn around their fortunes in midweek when they play host to another struggling side, Royal Wootton Bassett Town Development.

The league fixture between **Blunsdon** and **Trowbridge Town** and the Fountain Trophies Senior Cup tie between **Kingsdown** and Division One side Down Ampney were both postponed due to waterlogged pitches.

FA CUP first round draw day is always one of the most eagerly-awaited of the Non-League calendar. It's the day when all those dreams and aspirations of drawing a big club are realised, when cup fever really kicks in.

Every year it throws up a tie or two to whet the appetites of the minnows, but this year's helping was unlike any other. in fact, I can honestly say that the roll of the balls - served up by Bradford City legend Stuart McCall and former Manchester United and Salford City winger Danny Webber on Monday night - were about as kind to Non-League clubs as I've ever known it to be.

Not just the odd tasty match-up to help fill a few column inches in The NLP on a Sunday, but a whole host of absolute belters to ensure we are bursting with preview ideas in the build-up to the weekend of November 2.

Of the 40 ties pulled out of the hat, 23 see a Non-League club pit their wits against their counterparts from Leagues One or Two. Eleven of those ties are at home, 12 away.

A further four are all-Non-League affairs, ensuring there'll be plenty of interest in the second round too come November 30.

While the grudge match between MK Dons and AFC Wimbledon will naturally be seen as the pick of the bunch by many, there are a number of mouth -watering ties with a strong derby feel.

Take Kettering Town, for example. The Poppies are already FA Cup folk heroes as the country's highest FA Cup goalscorers. Their 2-1 win at Farsley Celtic on Saturday extended their record to 920 – seven more than Tottenham Hotspur.

A healthy crowd gathered at the Latimer Park clubhouse on Monday night to witness their fate and they were toasting long into the night as they were handed an away tie to near neighbours Northampton Town.

Also celebrating a derby to savour were Weston-Super-Mare, who were handed an away tie at Bristol Rovers, and Alfreton Town, who will relish their short trip to face Notts County.

Elsewhere, Oldham Athletic boss Micky Mellon and striker James Norwood return to former club Tranmere Rovers, while Aldershot Town will be looking to repeat their heroics of last season when they make the trip to Bradford City's Valley Parade.

Of the Non-League home ties drumming up interest, Tamworth are getting ready for a monster clash when Huddersfield Town, winners in 1921-22, visit The Lamb, while all eyes will also be on National League North high-flyers Curzon Ashton when they host Mansfield Town.

Southend United were rewarded for their last-gasp victory over Eastleigh in the last round with a home tie against Charlton Athletic, while Boreham Wood have pulled it out of the hat once again, this time landing a crunch home clash with League One Leyton Orient.

Wood's National League South rivals Chesham United were paired with League One Lincoln City, Woking pulled out struggling Cambridge United and Worthing will fancy their chances of an upset at home to Morecambe.

But the top pick must surely be Sutton United, who undoubtedly pulled out the plum draw – a home tie against big-spending League One title chasers Birmingham City at Gander Green Lane.

The U's are no strangers to welcoming high-profile opponents, of course, after famously pulling out Arsene Wenger's Arsenal in the fifth round back in 2016-17.

At the time of writing, before Tuesday night's replays, Step 3 Harborough Town were the lowest ranked club left in the competition having ended Bury's cup dream in the last round.

And the Bees will relish a trip to Tonbridge Angels, of National League South, in what manager Mitch Austin describes as a "winnable tie".

Whatever happens come November 2, the eyes of the nation will be on the Non-League clubs once again with the 'three-up' brigade ready with their stats books to prove that the gap between the fourth and fifth tiers is narrower than ever.

Replays, of course, are no more hereon in, so it's a straight 90-minute shoot-out, decided by extra-time and then penalties if necessary.

Either way, the cup gods have shone on us and the stage is set for our Non-League clubs to earn a place in history. It promises to be a weekend to remember.


