Mangotsfield United are one of the teams likely to feature once again at the top end of the table this season. Last season they made the end of season play-offs, losing to eventual play-off winners Sporting Inkberrow at the semi final stage. 47 Years & Counting



For those who don't know me I am a Yorkshireman born in Bradford in 1954. I moved to Royal Wootton Bassett in 1978 through work and joined the club as a player as soon as I got here. Royal Wootton Bassett Town is the only club I've played for here and was never a journey man, loyalty means a lot to me.

My playing background includes signed as an Associated School boy for Blackpool who were then in the old 2nd Division 1971. My time was cut short after breaking an ankle the week before my 18th birthday in local football and then Blackpool weren't interested. My father wouldn't agree to me becoming an apprentice, I had to get my exams done. Not that I did very well in them.

My senior football was played in the West Riding County Amateur league for Bradford Rovers sadly no longer in existence. No payments in those days and transport was by local buses. The days when tackles were tackles and you got up and got on with it.

I did play against some interesting characters during my school days, David Bairstow who went on to be England wicket keeper, dad of Jonny but sadly committed suicide, a big loss. He also played for Bradford City as an amateur when cricketers played two sports and Brendan O'Callahan who went on to play for Stoke City and capped six times for Eire.

One of my best friends at junior school was Peter Firth who went on to play opposite Richard Burton in the film Equus in 1977 and was lead in Spooks as Harry Pearce from 2002-2011.

I joined as I say Bassett in 1978 having moved here for work, and have been here ever since. In 1979 I met my wife and we married in 1982. Susan also doesn't originate from here but from Highworth where her mother moved from London. We married in 1982 and have two children.

Kara who many will know and Gary who captained the rugby club before playing National 3 rugby for Salisbury.

When Mick Woolford came as manager in 1988, I was his first captain and scored his first league goal against Amesbury Town at the old Rylands Way. He is in my opinion the best we have had. He still supports us to this day at every home game.

My playing days were over after a knee ligament strain in 1989 but I had already taken on the treasurers roll in 1982 which I continued till 2002. Rod Carter and I had already taken over the ground maintenance in the mid 90's and continued until we left in 2013. Probably the most enjoyable Saturday mornings we had; our friendship has carried on till this day. We also played a big part in the bingo that ran every Monday night and was the only real source of income for the club. Sadly that all came to a halt in 2005. We were both made life members in 2008 and it's a privilege to be part of this great club's history.

My daughter Kara then joined as the club Therapist having qualified from Plymouth University and an Honours degree from Hartpury. The league had made it a requirement in 2005-2006 season that clubs had to have a therapist. Now 20 years on she is still with us and runs her business here at the club.

My current roll with the club is Kitman now some 20 years and what follows is an insight to a week's work. Kit comes in all shapes and sizes and one size doesn't fit all. Unlike pro clubs where players are contracted, they can purchase the kit to fit individuals, at our level it's almost a guessing game. Socks are okay but some want cut offs and some want full socks so need some of each. Shorts medium and large but you need to know who's playing to get the correct kit laid out.

Similarly with players now having squad numbers I need to know who's playing at least a day before so that the kit is laid out correctly or packed correctly if we are away. The players are one of the most important parts of the club.

After each game both First and Dev kits have to be washed, three loads for each side. Warm up tops, shirts and then shorts and socks. Luckily, we have two machines so home games warm up tops are washed during the game. The shirts, shorts and socks are then in the wash but dependent on whether they need rinsing through before washing all takes time. I'm grateful to Bryan Wood for his assistance when I can't be available.

The side away from home, the kit will not be washed till the next morning so a trip back to wash is required. That's Saturday and Sunday covered.

If we have mid-week fixtures at home then kit has to be ready for Tuesday (Devs), Wednesday (1st's). If games are at home, then kit must be laid out and if away then packed away in the bags to be collected.

The whole process then starts again. Kit also has to be dried but not by tumble drier if we can avoid it.

I suppose over the course of a week I'm spending a good eight hours at the club washing and preparing kit when we have mid-week games as well. Doesn't go down well with the wife occasionally.

My pet hate is players who can't leave their kit the correct way round especially socks!

We constantly monitor the state of the kit so we know if we need to replace anything.

What I would like to say is that we have terrific people connected to this club who all do vast amounts of work unseen to not only spectators but players too. We do it because we love the club and aspire to be the best at everything we do. We are always looking for volunteers to join our happy band.

People say I'm grumpy but perhaps that's the Yorkshireman in me but I only want the best for Royal Wootton Bassett Town Football Club.

MANGOTSFIELD UTD

A BRIEF HISTORY



The 2025/26 season will mark Mangotsfield's fourth year competing at step 5, following a total of 22 seasons as a Southern League club, which includes the annulled 2019/20 and 20/21 seasons. After spending thirteen seasons in the "Pitchin In" Southern Football League Division One South, the club previously achieved a 9th place finish in 2009/10, 3rd in 2010/11 (though they lost the play-off semi-final 1-3 to Frome Town), 14th in 2011/12, 13th in 2012/13, 11th in 2013/14, 10th in 2014/15, 14th in 2015/16, 8th in 2016/17, and 16th in both 2017/18 and 2018/19. After the two-year "Covid gap", Mangotsfield ended the 2021/22 season in 18th place (out of 19 teams) and were automatically relegated to the Hellenic League Premier Division.

Football has been played in the village since 1888, and four years later, Mangotsfield FC became a founding member of the Bristol & District League (which later evolved into the Western Football League in 1895), but the club ceased operations after a decade. From 1898 until the 1950s, Mangotsfield FC was disbanded and reformed multiple times. In January 1951, the parent club eliminated the Reserve XI for financial reasons, leaving many local players without a team. These players chose to establish a new club in the village, and at the beginning of the 1951-52 season, the newly formed Mangotsfield United FC was entered into the Bristol & District League, Division VII. They achieved five consecutive promotions and gained entry to the Bristol & District Premier Combination in 1957.

The club remained in that league until the 1972-73 season when it was accepted into the Western League. During the 1970s, the club became established in the Western League, and despite being relegated to the first division in 1981-82, "The Field," as they were affectionately known, quickly bounced back the following season. Under the leadership of the charismatic Ralph Miller, who served as Chairman and took on the responsibility of enhancing the ground and its facilities, the club became a formidable presence in the Premier, frequently competing for top positions.

In 1991, the club, under the management of Harold Jarman and with the assistance of Terry Rowles, celebrated regional success by winning the (then) Great Mills League Premier Division title, finishing ahead of the runner-up, Torrington. Unfortunately, they were unable to gain promotion to the Southern League due to their ground not meeting the necessary grading standards, leading to several challenging seasons that resulted in the disbandment of the team.

However, with the election of Richard Davis as Chairman, improvements began to take shape off the pitch. In 1995, Terry Rowles returned to take over the management of the club and kept them in the public eye by consistently achieving top three or four finishes in the Great Mills/Screwfix League, along with a notable appearance in the FA Vase semi-final, where they were defeated by Clitheroe. Nevertheless, their aspirations for promotion and participation in Southern League football were persistently hindered by the ongoing successes of Taunton and Tiverton Town. It was deemed crucial to establish a solid operational foundation, enhance ground facilities, and secure a long-term lease on their Cossham Street ground.

A BRIEF HISTORY CONTINUED

In earlier years, the partnership between Roger Pullin and Richard Davis witnessed numerous enhancements, including the installation of Conference-style floodlights. By the conclusion of the 2003/04 season, the Cossham Street end of the ground was covered, alongside the addition of new toilet facilities and improvements to the social club. Former player Andy Black returned to the club as Manager in 1999, leading the team to promotion to the Dr. Martens Southern League and achieving three successful campaigns. However, the 2003/04 season did not unfold favorably, and just prior to Christmas, Black was succeeded by Martyn Grimshaw. Towards the end of the season, Nigel Webb joined as his Assistant, but the club could only secure a 13th place finish, which fell short of the expectations for the planned restructuring of the Pyramid.

The management duo prioritized promotion in the 2004/05 season, and the club led the table for the majority of the campaign, ultimately claiming the Division One West title with an impressive 21-match unbeaten streak. After 28 seasons at the Western League level, the club had only spent five seasons at the Southern League level before advancing to the Premier Division. In April/May 2005, Roger Pullin departed from the club, and Mike Richardson assumed the role of Chairman with a new Board.

Now sometimes referred to as 'The Mangos', the 2020/21 season commenced with Glyn Ashton at the helm. He had previously managed the U18s Floodlit Youth team but took on the role of temporary Manager in 2019/20 following the unexpected exit of Manager Ollie Price, bringing in nearly his entire U18s squad. Glyn resumed his position managing the U18/Reserves team at the start of the 2021/22 season, while Ray Johnston, along with assistant Terry Moore, took over the first team management responsibilities. However, Glyn returned to the managerial position after the departure of Ray and Terry due to some disappointing performances and results. The club regrettably could not "avoid the drop," concluding the season in 18th position out of 19 teams.

During the summer of 2022, Chairman Mike Richardson was succeeded by Steve Brown, a new committee was established, and with a fresh commercial team in place, the club embarked on an exhilarating new chapter in its history.

In the 2022/23 season, Glyn Ashton resumed his managerial role after a brief tenure by John Allen and Josh Bruton. "The Field" ultimately secured an 11th place finish in the Hellenic Premier Division during their inaugural season at that level, triumphing in the Hellenic League Floodlit Cup on their first attempt. In the 2023/24 season, the anticipated improvement in league standing was not realized as the team finished in 13th place; however, they achieved further cup success by winning the Gloucester Challenge Trophy.

After several years of diligent efforts behind the scenes, planning permission for a 3G pitch at Cossham Street was finally approved. With deep appreciation to the Hellenic League, last season, "The Field" played all of their away matches (with the exception of one) during the first half of the season while construction was underway, and all their home games on the new 3G pitch at Cossham Street in the latter half of the season. The team finished the league in fourth place but fell short of promotion, losing to Sporting Inkberrow in the playoff semi-finals.

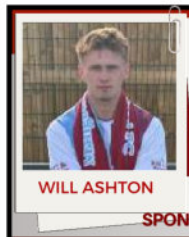

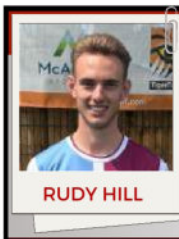

Fruitful start as Bassett squeeze past Mangos

Opening day success has been rare for Royal Wootton Bassett Town in recent seasons. But Sam Collier's side made sure they were quick off the mark to start the 2022-23 Hellenic League Premier Division campaign as an impressive performance helped Bassett to a narrow 1-0 victory against Mangotsfield United.

The visiting Mangos, newly relegated to the Hellenic League after more than two decades at Southern League level, were an unknown quantity for Bassett going into the match. But given the club's pedigree, there was a solid expectation that they would be a strong, competitive side.

That proved to be the case - particularly in the latter stages of the opening half when Mangotsfield really came to the fore. But Bassett stood firm against their visitors. And Alfie Presley's composed finish ten minutes into the second half ultimately proved enough to ensure that the hosts took all three points from an intriguing contest.

Bassett started the match with intent but, aside from a penalty appeal that was turned down, failed to really test Ashley Clarke in the Mangotsfield goal. The home side's best chance of the half then came around the half hour mark when Presley skewed wide as Bassett countered following a defensive lapse. By this point though it was Mangotsfield who were in the ascendancy, with the visitors having already seen a deflected effort graze the woodwork. Moments after Presley's miss, they were almost ahead too as a stunning volleyed effort seemed as though it was destined to open the scoring, but Bassett 'keeper Matt Crowther pulled off an outstanding acrobatic save to tip the ball around the post.



Going into half time goalless with both teams having enjoyed spells of pressure, the game was finely poised.

And it's outcome would soon be decided.

Ten minutes after the restart, an incisive Bassett break had the Mangotsfield backline on their heels. It did initially appear as though the attack would be snuffed out as imposing centre half Michael Grist went to ground to challenge Bailey Gallagher inside the visitors' penalty area following Tommy Ouldrige's dangerous diagonal pass. However, fortunately for Bassett, the ball fell into Gallagher's feet and, with Clarke drawn from his line, he squared for Presley to slot home.

Bassett now had the wind in their sails, but a second goal was not forthcoming. That made for a somewhat nervy finish to the match. However, with Collier's side defensively sound, Mangotsfield were unable to fashion anything of note despite the extra men they were throwing forward.

Torpoint turnaround dashes Cup hopes

Royal Wootton Bassett Town's hopes of equalling the club's record run in the FA Cup were dashed as Torpoint Athletic came from behind to win 3-1 in a first qualifying round encounter that was the proverbial game of two halves.

In a game whose kick off was delayed by an hour and ten minutes due to the visitors being caught in traffic on the M5, Jonny Aitkenhead's side were left to rue only being able to score the one goal in a first half that they dominated.

The visitors were understandably unsettled by their nightmare journey from Cornwall to Wiltshire - and also had to contend with playing against a strong wind in the first half when the contest eventually got under way in driving rain.

And Bassett sought to press home those advantages, making a lively start to the match which saw them take the lead within the opening quarter of an hour.

Ollie Smith fed a pass to Marcel Lewis on the right wing, who cut inside before producing a firm left footed drive from the edge of the box that flew past James Morley in the Torpoint goal.

Bassett were then on top for the remainder of the half but couldn't find a second.

Lewis came close on the half hour when a fizzing half volley from 20 yards out flew narrowly over after a looping Smith cross was only half cleared.



The effervescent Lewis then almost turned provider as he teased in a cross for an unmarked Ben Cleary whose close range glancing header went across the face of goal.

Those were just two of the opportunities Bassett had - and the hosts would be left to regret not having made more of them as Torpoint turned the tie around.

The Cornish side got back on terms within six minutes of the restart when Sam Pearson produced a cool finish to cap off a flowing move.

They then quickly found themselves ahead - doing so in some style as Tom Payne caught Adam House off his line and beat the Bassett 'keeper from a good fifty yards out.

Despite playing into the wind, Bassett were still able to create chances. And a low Smith ball into the box again went uncleared, falling to Lewis whose low drive was batted away by Morley.

While House had to be alert to keep out a tight angled effort from Joe Rapson, Bassett were the team on top as the game entered its final stages.

But Torpoint would deliver a suckerpunch late on. A quick ball out from Morley had Bassett on their heels and Pearson teed up substitute Ryan Richards for a simple finish that secured victory and a first ever second qualifying round appearance for Torpoint.

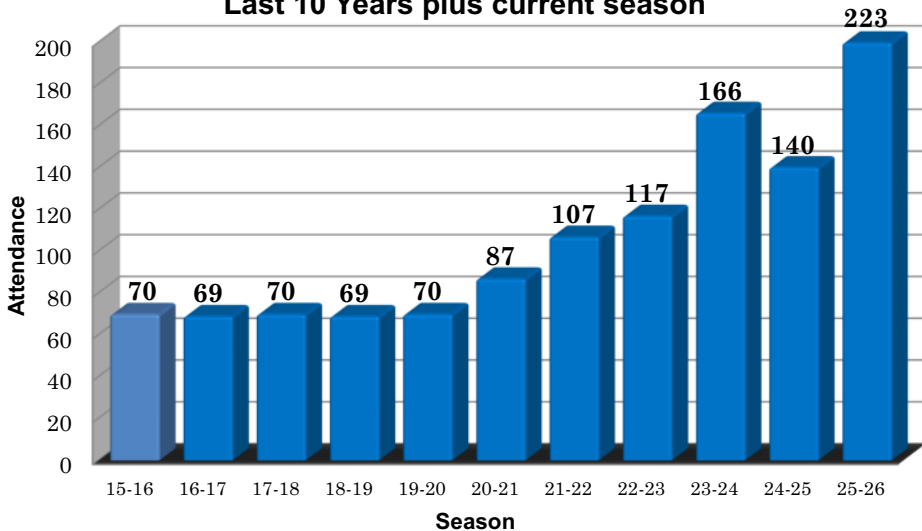

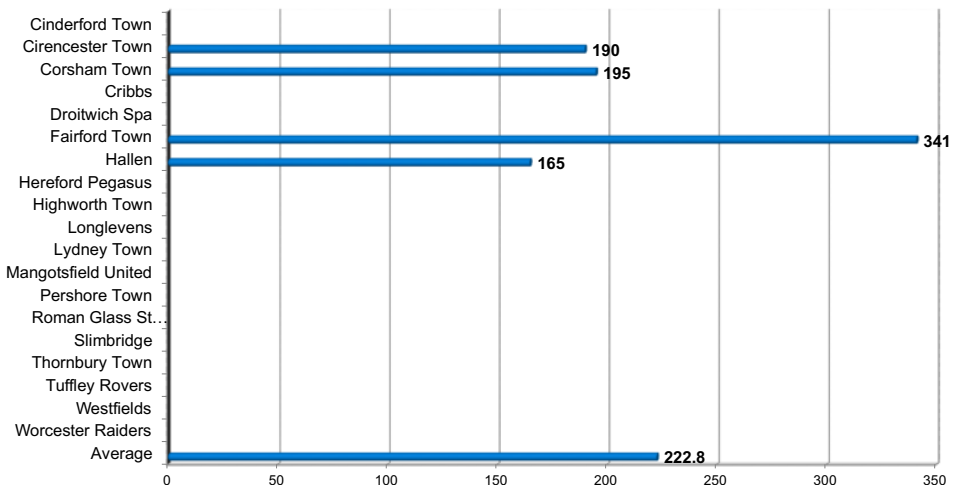

From Editor's Football Collection

My Old Bassett Youth Team Programmes

Before coming the Programme Editor for Royal Wootton Bassett Town I had plenty of practice preparing programmes over the years. I started producing programmes when I was manager/club secretary at Wootton Bassett Sports in Division 3 of the Wiltshire Senior League. I then carried them on when I moved to Minety, also in the Wiltshire Senior League. At the same time I was running Minety I was also manager of the then Under 9s for Wootton Bassett Town, which I carried on until the side were Under 18s, although I made the smart move to bring in Andy Stevens to help out with the Under 18s when work took me to live in Surrey, where I continue to live to this day. Programmes were produced for the youth team from U9 through to U12.

The hoarder and collector that I am means most of these programmes have been retained, residing in my dry shed in folders. I shared the contents of some of these programmes that I produced for Bassett Sports and Minety at one point on the Wiltshire Nostalgia Facebook site, although I doubt you would be able to find them very easily now, such is the way the social media platforms algorithms work. Anything posted on social media is really like flushing something down the toilet hence why a Website is the best for creating historical records. I never shared any of the Youth Section programmes that I produced for Wootton Bassett Town, but I still have them, starting with the Under 9s through to about the U12s. Some of the match reports that were in the programmes are on the club's website under the History Section. A certain Jonny Aitkenhead joined the team when we were Under 11s and within a season was installed as captain of the side given his strong leadership skills. Jonny will be pleased to hear that one of the programmes I have retained from his first season at the club is the one that features his player profile. This was included in the programme for the game against Ramsbury U11 played on Sunday 7th January 2001. For those who care about these things, Wootton Bassett Town U11s won 3-0 that day with a certain J. Aitkenhead scoring two of the Bassett goals, Mike Ford with the other. Jonny was also voted man of the match by his teammates that day and would go on to make 24 appearances that season, scoring 19 goals for the side. In total he would go on to make over 200 appearances during his time in the club's youth section.

At the time of the game against Ramsbury Jonny was also leading the players-player of the season voting and I believe went on to lift the players-player award at the end of the season, although that information is missing from my records. Wootton Bassett U11s would go on to finish runners-up in their division that season to Stratton Youth, managed by George Peare's dad Bruce, with Gordon Varley their club secretary.

The player profiles had first appeared in the Under 10 programmes and Jonny is probably grateful that by the time the Under 11 version of the player profile saw the light of day the in depth questions about what was his favourite pop group and who was his favourite teacher had been dropped, meaning we will never know whether he was a Steps or S Club 7 man (these had been the most popular answers amongst the team the previous season!).

Interestingly the teams listed on the back page of the programme (see next page) include two people with strong connections to Swindon Town FC. Included in the Wootton Bassett side that day was Matt Povey who is now the groundsman at Swindon Town. Meanwhile our Under 11 opponents Ramsbury were managed by Andrew Fitton who, in 2008, bought 75% of Swindon Town with a consortium of others for an undisclosed fee. He would go on to chair the club appointing managers Maurice Malpas, Danny Wilson and Paul Hart, eventually resigning as chairman in 2011 following Swindon Town's relegation. After his efforts with Ramsbury U11s he wisely did not appoint himself as manager as they only won three games all season at U11 and we beat them three times, twice in the league and once in the cup.

Given the fact that you can no longer show players names on FA Full-Time and the FA safeguarding police in their infinite wisdom have even wiped all the historic youth statistics from the early days for the North Wilts Youth & Minors League, even though the players concerned are all now in their mid-30s, my programmes are one of the few statistical records that still survive for this era. Not sure what Jonny's generation will do in terms of the equivalent Wiltshire Football Nostalgia site when they reach old age and want to look back on their early football days.

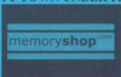
