Welcome To Today's Game

GOOD EVENING and welcome back to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this second UHlsport Hellenic League home fixture of the 2025-26 Season with Hallen tonight's opponents. A warm welcome to all our visitors who have made the journey along the M4 from Bristol, we hope you enjoy your brief stay with us this evening and wish you a safe journey home.

Hallen are back in the UHlsport Hellenic League after a three season absence having transferred across to the Western League after finishing bottom of the Hellenic Premier Division at the end of the 2021-22 Season.

Hallen have moved between the Western and Hellenic Leagues a couple of times over the years, initially starting in the Hellenic in the early 1990s having won the Gloucestershire County League in 1992-93 before moving to the Western League at the start of the millenium. They would spend 21 seasons in the Western League before that one difficult season back in the Hellenic in 2020-21. After two mid-table finishes back in Western League Division ONE, last season saw them promoted back to Step 5 securing the league title in style, finishing some 13 points ahead of runners-up Calne Town. We have met Hallen on ten previous occasions in the Hellenic League but have just one win to our name in those ten games, three games have seen us defeated with the remaining six all finishing as draws. What odds on another draw this evening?

Saturday saw us pick up our first league point of the season following a 1-1 draw against Cirencester Town in front of yet another bumper crowd at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground. It is always frustrating when the opposition score late on to take points away from us but I understand we were under some sustained pressure in the second half. I expect Cirencester will be at the top end of the table come the season end and I am sure we will look back on this as a point gained rather than two lost.

Hopefully tonight will see us register that first league win of the season and see us climb a few places in the league table.

The Development side were also picking up a point on Saturday, drawing 1-1 with Faringdon Town who remain unbeaten after three league games. Last season Bassett had lost the corresponding fixture 3-1, so again we should look at this as a positive, if we can better last season's results in each game the Development team should not be involved in a relegation battle this season.

This coming Saturday we are home to Amersham Town in the Preliminary Round of the FA Cup, an opponent we have never played before. Amersham play in the Combined Counties Premier Division North division and have started their league campaign with a 1-1 draw against North Greenford United followed by a 3-0 home win over Wokingham Town on Saturday. In the Extra Preliminary Round of the FA Cup they defeated Cinderford Town from our division 1-0. It is a shame that Amersham do not have a midweek game this week else I could have done some scouting work for Jonny. After the FA Cup game on Saturday, assuming there is no need for a replay, next up will be the return of Sam Collier and his Fairford Town side the following Wednesday night. This game will see a few familiar faces back at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for the first time since their summer departure.

On a final note, one of our coaches and vets' player, Ben Gould, and his son Frankie, who plays in the Youth Section, were heroes on Sunday whilst on holiday in Bulgaria. Frankie was swimming in the pool and noticed a man at the bottom. He told Ben, who dived in and dragged the man out of the pool and started giving him CPR. There was a meeting the next day where Ben was told the guy had suffered a suspected stroke and was in a critical condition. Ben was later told the man had actually suffered an asthma attack, with the family extremely grateful to Ben and Frankie's for their prompt action that had saved the man's life.

Enjoy tonight's game against Hallen and with a bit of luck and hard endeavour we will be celebrating our first league win of the season.

We're also seeing real progress at the Development Team, where players are getting their first taste of men's football.

Having listened to the feedback from those within the club we are making the first team much more accessible to all of our youth teams. We will be inviting them to come along and watch home games and for the younger players we will use them as our matchday mascots.

There is real positivity and energy around the club following the changes from our supporters, players, matchday volunteers and staff and we want to harness this.

We are seeing an increase in our fan base and really want this to improve this further with the local community getting behind the team which is why we have changed our mid-week fixtures to a Wednesday night.

Will we win every game? No.

Will we be competitive in every game? Absolutely.

Will we continue to provide opportunities for young players to progress? Without a doubt.

The club was formed by members of a new community living at Lawrence Weston on the outskirts of Bristol, which had been developed shortly after World War Two. The club was named Lawrence Weston Athletic and played in the Bristol & District League, and it has moved forward steadily since moving to the village of Hallen in 1979, to conform with League Ground grading. Much of the credit for the progress of this club can be accredited to the late Frank Fairman and his family. His son Francis, and grandson Lee continue the link with the club. In fact Lee played a major part in our fight for survival during the summer of 2015, when the club was in danger of losing its home. So it was no surprise when long serving Chairman Barrie Phillips nominated Lee to take over the chair from himself, at the next AGM. The club became known as Lawrence Weston Hallen when it moved to Moorhouse Lane, joining the Gloucestershire County League in 1982, and under that title were runners up 1987-88, and Champions 1988-89, after which the club dropped Lawrence Weston from its title to become known as simply Hallen. The club completed the double in 1992-93, when winning the Gloucestershire Challenge Trophy and the League title. Promotion was achieved, joining the Hellenic League Division One, and after further improvements to the facilities (particularly the erection of floodlights and a 200-seater stand), a runner-up position in 1996-97 led to another step up, to the Hellenic League Premier Division. The club had always considered the Western League as its goal, as this League was more familiar with Bristolians than the Hellenic League. Their wish to transfer over was granted at the second time of asking but it was insisted that the club join the First Division for season 2000-01. The club finished fourth in its first season in the Western League and reached the last sixteen of the F.A. Vase losing to Brigg Town 6-5 in extra time. Further progress was made when new manager Gary Damone led the team to the Division One title in Season 2003-4, and fourth place in the Premier Division at the first attempt.

The club also reached the final of the GFA Trophy and were denied a place in the first round of the F.A. Cup when losing to Nationwide Conference side Canvey Island in the fourth and final qualifying round.

This success saw Southern League side Taunton Town tempt Gary Damone to try his hand at a higher level, which in turn saw Hallen have a dip in form, as players were also tempted away.

It is however well known that a high percentage of players are happy to return to Hallen, and for season 2009-10 the club welcomed back Gary Damone as manager and many former players too. The club finished in a disappointing twelfth position in 2009-10, but a crop of long term injuries did not help. The club however were to lift the Western League (Les Phillips) Cup for the first time. The club had experienced a bad start to the 2010-11 season, which saw the departure of manager Gary Damone who chose to take charge of his own town club Wellington. Club stalwart Paul Owen was given the task of steering the team to safety. With just one win prior to taking over in November, he and his assistant John Tierney changed fortunes around and we were safe from relegation with six games left. Paul Owen's first full season as manager saw the club challenging for the title, but a dip in form saw the club slip to fourth. Off the field, the club had ensured promotion would not be denied, had the club won the title by obtaining the ground grading for Southern League football.

Season 2012-13 saw no repeat of a challenge for promotion, but the season was kept alive by reaching the final of the Les Phillips League Cup for a second time. In the final Willand Rovers won 1-0 before a crowd of 400 at Cribbs Friends Life FC. As Paul Owen had already decided to step down at the end of the campaign, it was unfortunate that he could not see his side lift the cup. By mid May the club announced that Hengrove Athletic manager Jamie Hillman was to take over as manager. He had been at the helm for eight years at Hengrove, and had just guided them to the Premier Division as runners up in April. The 2013-14 season under Jamie and his assistant Grantley Dicks, was a mixture of highs and lows.

The highs being success in lifting the GFA Trophy for a third time and reaching the fifth round of the FA Vase losing away to West Auckland Town. In contrast we finished the League campaign without a win in fifteen games.

Manager Jamie Hillman announced that he would be leaving, and previous manager Paul Owen agreed to return for the 2014-15 season. By November the League form was yet again cause for concern and Paul decided it would be best to bring in a new face, rather than wait to the end of the season. Steve Winter a former Walsall and Torquay player was appointed with a view, of him settling in, prior to the coming season.

He was to resign in December 2015, and long serving player Tom Collett took on the role as player manager assisted by Rayan Wilson for the 2016-17 season. Following another poor run of results, Tom Collett made way for former player Ben Willshire to return as the new manager. Ben guided the club away from relegation, but when fortunes did not change in the next campaign, it was decided his assistant Rob Sage should take over the helm prior to Christmas 2017, with Ben remaining as a player. The resignation of Rob Sage forced the club to seek another manager in February.

Former manager Gary Damone returned as interim manager, whilst the club decided on a replacement from a record number of applicants. The successful candidate being former player Ray Johnstone, who had guided Odd Down to the title in 2016. Ray recruited another former Hallen player Tony Davis as his assistant for the 2018-19 season, unfortunately Tony had to step down during the course of the season. It was a season which saw a more settled side, finishing in twelfth place the best for several years. Further progress was made during the 2019-20 season, with Ray being assisted by Dean Horseman, before it was brought to an abrupt end due to the coronavirus pandemic. Ray's departure early in the season 2020-21, saw Dean takeover as Manager in what turned out to be another pandemic disrupted season. A poor run of results at the start of 2021-22 resulted in Dean and his new Assistant Tony Beecham departing the club.

Stuart Jones and his trusty Director of Football Andy Hawkins took over, but unfortunately they could not magic a way out of the situation the team had been left in and we were relegated to step 6, which saw us back in The Western League, due to The FA's lateral movement.

Early on in season 2023-24 we saw Stuart step down from the managerial role, and replaced by Karl Baggaley, who added some new faces to the squad and ended the season just outside the play off positions. In his first full season (2024/25) Karl built a team to win the Division One title by a 13 point margin to get Hallen back to Step 5 football.

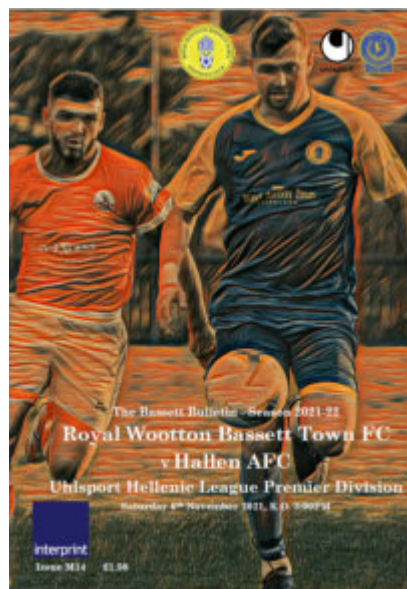

Report take from programme for subsequent game against Highworth Town.

Last Tuesday saw Bassett entertain one of the new sides in the league, Hallen FC, formally of the Gloucestershire League, were our visitors. Reputation suggested Bassett would have a difficult time. We continued where we left off against Carterton, taking the lead after 15 minutes, with a penalty by Lawrence Smith following a defensive handball.

Shortly after the re-start Kenny Regan added a second with a header from a free kick. Hallen then replied with a well taken goal before being reduced to ten men some ten minutes from time. Five minutes later Hallen equalised at the second attempt after a fine save from Mark Robinson. Another good team performance, but unfortunately it was a case of two points lost rather than one gained.

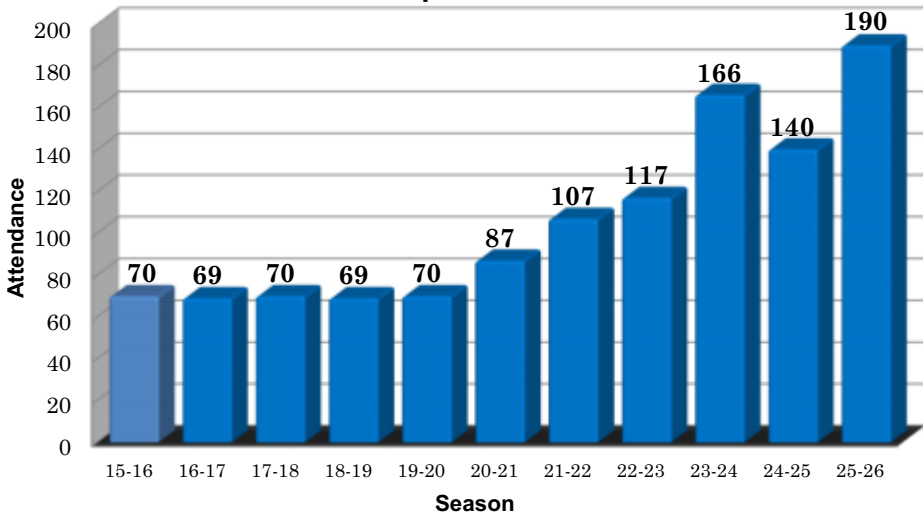

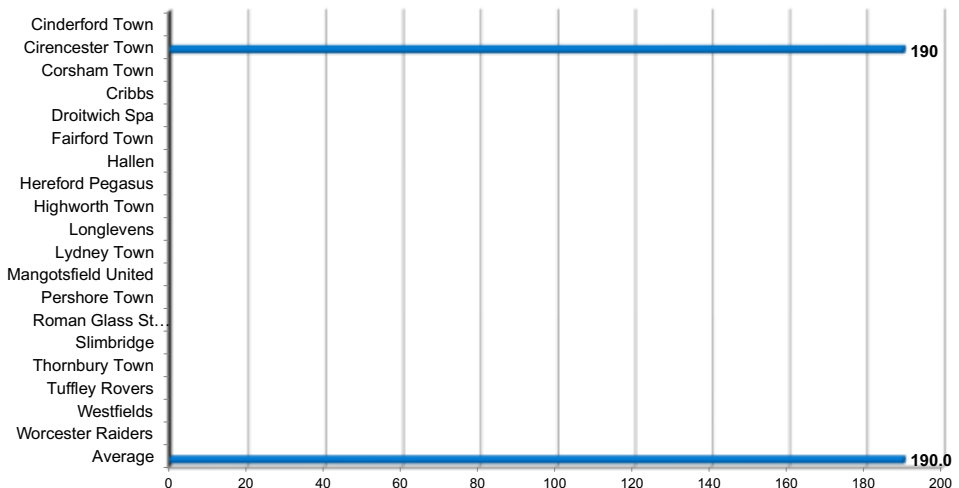

Adobe Women's FA Cup

Draws for the 2025-26 Adobe Women's FA Cup preliminary and first qualifying rounds have now been released. And Royal Wootton Bassett Town will start their journey in this year's competition with an away trip to brand new opponents.

In each of the last three seasons, Bassett have suffered agonising exits at the third - and final - qualifying round stage with a pair of defeats away against Torquay United and a narrow home loss against AFC Stoneham sandwiched in between.

New manager James Lally will now be looking to take his side a step further and write club history by reaching the first round proper.

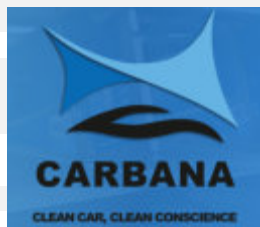

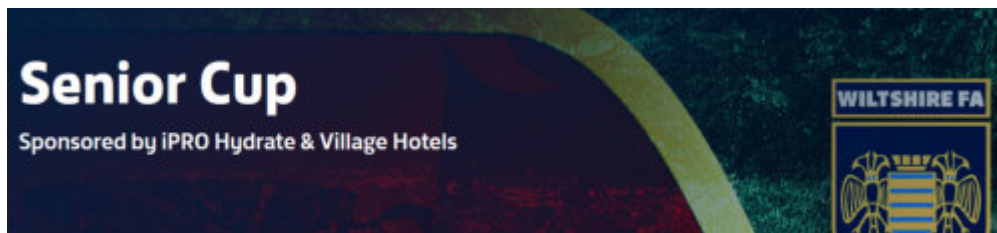

From Editor's Football Collection

Goal Magazines



When I was a young lad the football magazines of my generation were Shoot and GOAL. GOAL was the more serious of the two and a much better read aimed at the more mature football fan. It was launched in August 1968 with a swish

function at the Savoy Hotel in London, featuring GOAL Girls (indicative of the time and wouldn't happen today) and the assembled media, with Manchester United's Bobby Charlton signed up to do a weekly diary. Two months earlier Manchester United had won the European Cup and had finished second to Manchester City in the old First Division (to any youngsters reading this that was the top division, now known as the Premier League) and, with England the current World Cup holders, Bobby was a big signing for the new magazine. GOAL's tagline was that it was "The World's Greatest Soccer Weekly" and it did not cover just the First Division but went down the whole Football League, including plenty of full colour pictures/posters each and every week. Given the period and Swindon Town's win in the League Cup, Swindon and Don Rogers in particular feature quite a bit, which carried on when Don joined Crystal Palace. The magazine included a regular page called "Meet the girl behind the man" and Don and wife Jane featured in one edition, pictured in the sports shop they still run to this day.

By 1971 GOAL had achieved weekly sales of over 220,000, but unfortunately gradually declined from that high point before having to merge into Shoot in 1974, which in reality was akin to a corporate takeover with Shoot carrying on having taken out its main rival. The 1 June 1974 contained the following message in the Editorial column,

"It is with great regret that we have to announce that this is the last issue of GOAL. There are many factors which have forced this unhappy decision upon us, not least of which has been the tremendous increase in the last few months of paper, printing and distribution costs.

They leapt to such a degree that it is now impossible to continue increasing the price substantially. This we feel, we cannot do. We thank all our readers and our advertisers for the loyalty they have shown us during the past years, and hope that they will miss us just as much as we will miss them."

That final edition included a guide to the 1974 World Cup finals where pundit Leslie Vernon forecast that the top four would be 1 West Germany, 2 Italy, 3 Holland and 4 Brazil. He got the winners right and Holland made the final with Brazil in the play-off for third place, but Poland did for Italy, as they had done for England, in the initial group stage.

So, after 296 weekly issues GOAL magazine was no more. Thanks mainly to Ebay I have been able to collect a copy of each and every one of them. They are a fantastic historical record of football in this country in the late 1960s and early 1970s. The team and player pictures they contain are excellent as well as the interesting articles. Looking at the various adverts at the time you realise how inflation has changed the price of everything, as back then you could buy a pair of Dennis Law boots for £2.20 (I expect Pete might still own a pair). There were also some very strange adverts most weeks for people who want to grow taller! A sample of adverts from the time appear on the next page to give you an idea of the types of adverts that appeared and the price of everything.

The Goal brand was to reappear many years later as Goal Monthly in 1995, its strap line was "From the Makers of 90 Minutes" which was an independent that had been taken over by publisher IPC in the mid-90s. Goal Monthly went the same way as the original GOAL magazine and was 'incorporated' into Four Four Two magazine in July 1998 before finally reappearing in December 2017 but it was just not the same as that original. For anyone who is interested old copies of the original magazine are readily available on Ebay or from specialist dealers, such as Lee Hermitage of North Middlesex Football Programmes and Memorabilia, who have a plentiful supply of the magazines at very reasonable prices.
