Men's First Team Bassett Bulletin

Welcome to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Uhlsport Hellenic League home fixture against Fairford Town. A warm welcome to all our visitors tonight from Fairford, including several who have served our own club extremely well over recent times. We hope you all enjoy your brief stay with us this evening and wish you a safe journey home.

This is our fifth home game in a row in the space of just two weeks thanks to FA Cup draws, all at the same time as my league duties at the Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League are at their peak. No sooner has one programme been sent to the printers, another needs to be started. Add into the mix that I then went down with Covid last week it will be nice when things return to normal and are a little less hectic. At the end of the day though, FA Cup home draws should be welcomed as they are always great occasions. programme has only been started after the normal midweek deadline for sending to the printers has past, but if you are reading this on Wednesday evening it has obviously been printed ok.

I had hoped to finally get to my first team game on Saturday but still testing positive for Covid on the morning of the game it was felt best for everyone that I stay away, even though there are no restrictions these days.

Saturday's win over Amersham Town was an excellent result and means we have already won more prize money in the FA Cup than we did last season and, with another home draw, have a chance of at least matching our best ever showing in this prestigious national competition. Our opponents in the next round are Torpoint Athletic who we have played once before in the FA Vase, goals from Jon Mills and Gio Wrona giving us a 2-0 home win in the Second Round of the Vase back in November 2021. The crowd that day was 293 with Torpoint brining a lot of fans from Cornwall for the game. Torpoint are currently unbeaten in their opening four games in the Jewson Western League Premier Division so will be tough opponents but probably won't be relishing that long journey from Cornwall in holiday season.

On the subject of crowds, it is pleasing to report the increase in crowds at the start of the season. Whilst we only track average league attendances on the page later in the programme, the two FA Cup games have seen crowds of 192 and 187, giving an overall average from the four games to date of 184, with the league average slightly lower at 178. With the traditional big attendance games still to come against Highworth Town, Corsham Town and starting tonight against Fairford Town, I am fully expecting the overall average season to continue the upward trend experienced in recent seasons.

Last Saturday saw the Dev Team continue their decent start to the current season with an impressive 4-1 away win at Down Ampney who are a good side, with our former player Charlie McCuish a strong presence up front for them. A match report from that game is in tonight's programme and subscribers to Your Sport Swindon can view the highlights from the game on their website. With just one defeat in their opening four games the Dev side under Mark Simpkins have got off to a much better start than last season in what is already shaping up to be a very competitive division. The start of the Vets' and Women's team seasons is now not too far away. It was interesting to see that Charlie Austin had signed for Purton Kingsdown Vets' but having now signed and played for Basingstoke Town he will now be ineligible, so will not be seen at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground on a Wednesday night, at least not this season. The Women's side will no doubt be keen to get their season up and running, with added enthusiasm after the success of the England team at the Euro's. The women's game at grass roots level still has some challenges though, as evidenced by the South Division of the South West Regional League being down to just six teams this season, half the number of our North division.

Enjoy tonight's game and hopefully come ten o'clock we will be celebrating our first league win of the season.

Today's Opponents Fairford Town



Fairford Town Football Club was formed in 1891 and for many years played in the Cirencester & District League against local teams with varying degrees of success.

After the second world war the club joined the Swindon & District League, winning the Premier Division in both 1964/65 and 1968/69, also winning the Advertiser Cup in the same years, and in 1962/63 won the Gloucestershire Junior Cup.

Success in the Swindon & District League was followed by election to the Hellenic League in 1970, only missing promotion from the first division on goal average at the first attempt, the club were also beaten finalists in that year's division one Challenge Cup.

The following year, 1971/72 saw Fairford win the Hellenic first division and division one Challenge Shield, whilst the reserve side won the Gloucestershire County Minor Cup, the Advertiser Cup and finished runners-up in the Swindon & District Division One.

The successful run continued and Town were the beaten finalists of 1972/73 in the Premier Division Cup, only to be relegated back to Division One in 1973/74.

Fairford Town were again promoted in 1975/76 and steady progress led to the Premier Division Runners-up in 1978/79 and 1979/80, also winning the Premier Division Cup in 1978/79.

The Club were winners of the Gloucestershire Challenge Trophy in 1979/80,1998/99 and 2024/25 and Runnersup in 1982/83 and 1994/95.

The most recent league success has been Premier Division Runners-up in season 1994/95 following a similar position in Season 1990/91. The Club has also achieved numerous wins in the Arthur Shipway Cup and Fairford Hospital Cup.

The 2016/17 season saw the club secure a return to the Uhlsport Hellenic Premier Division after a five-year absence, winning the Division One West title with 75 points.

In recent years the club has grown on and off the pitch. The first team are now established and challenging in the Uhlsport Hellenic Premier Division with a Reserves side also competing in Hellenic Division 2 South. 2020 also saw the creation of Fairford Town Academy with teams running from under 12s through to under 18s. We aim to place the football club within the heart of the local community and are keen to continue to grow and achieve our goal of promotion to the Southern Football League for the first time in the club's history.

In recent years the club has grown on and off the pitch. The first team are now established and challenging in the Uhlsport Hellenic Premier Division with a Reserves side also competing in Hellenic Division 2 South. 2020 also saw the creation of Fairford Town Academy with teams running from under 14s through to under 16s. We aim to place the football club within the heart of the local community and are keen to continue to grow and achieve our goal of promotion to the Southern Football League for the first time in the club's history.

The 2024/25 season saw the club win the Gloucestershire FA Senior Amateur Cup and also saw the Under 18s win the prestigious Southwest Counties Youth League.

Vital Point Gained Over Rivals Fairford

Another goal direct from a corner, this time by Tony Macek wasn't enough to separate Bassett and Fairford as both teams shared the points in an aggressive derby game; Simon Gregory on target for the visitors.

Bassett were much the better team in the first half with many chances going begging, most falling to Geoff Swatton who the Fairford defence struggled to handle. On eleven minutes Swatton shot at goal from the edge of the area but James Price collected the ball easily. Four minutes later Swatton had a go from thirty yards, Price making another save.

Bassett took the lead in the 21st minute when, for the second week running, they scored direct from a corner – this time Tony Macek with the goal. His corner from the left produced an absolute howler from Price who fumbled the ball into his own net.

Swatton found himself booked two minutes on when he and Russell Jones had a tussle in which Jones allegedly spat at the Bassett forward also gaining himself a yellow card.

On the half hour mark, Neil Matthews found himself in the book for an elbow on Steve Yeardley, a challenge that should have seen the Fairford player walk. Two minutes later Courtney Chessell was booked for dissent after kicking the ball away after referee Terry Cleasby gave Bassett a dubious free kick.

Bassett continued to be unlucky in front of goal and seven minutes from the break Geoff Swatton could have doubled the lead but didn't take advantage of poor defending from a Macek corner, hitting wide from six yards out.

Macek came close again in the 41st minute having his shot tipped wide from a John Magani ball. From the Macek corner Magani could have scored, getting a toe on the ball in a goalmouth scramble but Price somehow managed to get the ball away, making a point blank save.

In the second half, Fairford managed to grab a goal early on when ex-Bassett defender Luke Sharps put in a free kick to the far post, Simon Gregory was there to meet it, slotting in from eight yards out.

Rich Stevens was forced into action five minutes after the goal when a Fairford counter attack ended up with a Chris Knowles shot being palmed wide by the Bassett 'keeper.

In the 65th minute Sharps found himself in the book after a stupid lunge at John Magani.

The game continued to be a tight, aggressive affair with both teams creating chances but not finishing them. In the 76th minute Ben Gascoyne replaced Nathan Hall.

Next player to get booked was Tony Macek for another rash challenge. However, Macek's challenge was not bad as Simon Gregory's five minutes from time; Gregory took out Swatton thus gaining himself a booking. Bassett then made a substitution as Neil Bridges came on for Swatton.

Bridges was nearly Bassett's hero as two minutes after his introduction he and Magani could have sealed the win for Bassett. Bridges shot from the edge of the area was fisted away, on the rebound Magani took the ball round the stranded Price but his shot was cleared off the line.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town advanced to the Emirates FA Cup first qualifying round with an impressive 3-1 victory at home against Amersham Town.

Jonny Aitkenhead's young side are now just a win away from matching the club's record run in the competition - and they more than deserved their preliminary round victory.

As was the case in their pair of extra preliminary round fixtures against Lydney Town, Bassett took the lead early on.

With just seven minutes on the clock, Ben Cleary nipped in between the last man and goalkeeper Matt Messer, drawing a foul in the process. Cleary then dusted himself down and confidently struck the resulting penalty into the bottom right corner, beyond the reach of Messer who guessed correctly.

That goal would be crucial in an otherwise evenly matched first half as Bassett went into the interval in front.

Amersham, powered by the goals of Swindon Town's summer signing Jake Tabor, had reached the third qualifying round last season and were hoping to advance another step towards matching that run.

And they were certainly up for the battle, pulling level early in the second half through Razvan Roman.

But parity did not last long.

Ed Taylor played in a low corner from the right side into the path of Jono Peachey-Score. The striker pulled off a dummy, allowing the ball to run to player of the match Adam Voller on the edge of the box - and he swept a delightful low, whipped finish into the left corner of the net.



The game still hung in the balance - until eleven minutes from time when Marcel Lewis put the game to bed.

Amersham were unable to clear from another corner, allowing Bassett to recycle the ball. Substitute Kassa Anderson gained possession in the right corner. At the byline and under pressure from a defender, Anderson had a lot of work to. But some silky footwork opened up space for him to the pull the ball back to Lewis, who cut inside his man and saw a deflected effort find the net.

That was game, set and match. All eyes now turn to Monday's draw.







FA Cup First Qualifying Round

Bassett to host Torpoint in Emirates FA Cup first qualifying round

Royal Wootton Bassett Town have been handed a home tie against Western League Premier Division side Torpoint Athletic in the Emirates FA Cup first qualiyfing round. The Cornish side are set to visit the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground on Saturday 30 August.

Bassett's reward for Saturday's impressive 3-1 victory against Amersham Town is another home date against step five opposition, with Jonny Aitkenhead's side having avoided being paired with the step three teams coming into the competition and those who have made it through from step four.

From Editor's Football Collection Soccer Programmes in Jeopardy (1974)

In amongst a recent purchase of QPR away programmes from the early 1970s was one for the Leicester City v QPR game played on Saturday 15th December 1973 which included an article under the headline "Soccer Programmes in Jeopardy!". It was an interesting read regarding the challenges of a professional club producing a programme at that time, with some unique challenges caused by the miners strike and the resulting energy crisis. I found the article an interesting historical read and, although it was a completely different era, some of the underlying challenges faced by football clubs regarding programmes and fund raising are still quite similar to those faced in the non-league game today, although the numbers involved are a lot smaller, and the fund-raising activities used at the time seem somewhat quaint. Here is the article in full:

"From behind those mighty marble pillars Arsenal last week issued the cold statement that in view of the Government's emergency regulations forcing them to bring forward their kick-off time, they would be producing a fourpage programme. The gate on that day at the Highbury Stadium was over 14,000.

I can assure Fox fans that this sort of action will not be necessary at Leicester City this season. Already on two occasions in the Texaco Cup when our gates were below 10,000 - we produced a sixteen page programme. We did. of course, make a loss on these two editions. This, however, was counteracted by the fact that at the beginning of the 1973-74 season a larger percentage of advertising was accepted into our programme. At the time this measure came under some considerable amount of criticism. However, this foresight enables us to make the following statement: For the rest of the season our programme, in spite of the world paper shortage, and ever increasing costs, will continue to have a minimum of sixteen pages and on some occasions, when we have an attractive fixture (for example the forthcoming Derby match) the programme will be twenty four pages.

I would like to express my sincere thanks to our Advertising and Marketing Manager, Frank Milford, whose devotion to his job of selling the Club to the City of Leicester has made it easy for us to give the supporters value for money. It is interesting to note that if we disregard the advertising revenue the net retail profit on a twenty-four page programme is less than ten per cent – not taking into consideration unsold programmes.

From time to time, we do get letters from supporters criticising our programme. We respect these views and note them with interest. However, it is not altogether fair, in our opinion, to compare our programme with say Leeds and Everton. The average Leeds gate is nearly twice that of the Foxes, therefore – with such a large print order – they can obviously turn out a more competitive programme.

In the case of Everton they have something like 25,000 seats in their stadium and the price of a seat includes the cost of a programme. So, they have an automatic sale of 25,000 programmes before the match starts. This scheme could perhaps be introduced at Leicester City. Your views on this would be welcome!

The obvious problem with this method is that if a family of four came along and occupied four seats they would have to buy four programmes. However, if a season ticket holder paid for his programme in advance — guaranteeing a programme purchase at every match — the problem would be solved. Under this system the overall price could be reduce by say twenty per cent, and thus the majority of supporters would benefit, good news for our supporters!

For our next home game, against Wolverhampton, we shall give our programme a facelift. The Cross the Ball competition will no longer occupy the centre spread. It will be discontinued and replaced by the Football League's £25,000 Spot Ball competition. We shall be printing in the programme a 5p voucher for all supporters wishing to enter this competition – giving them the opportunity of winning the first prize of £20,000. We shall also be introducing a free Guess the Gate competition with a first prize of £25 to the supporter nearest to the actual gate.



As many supporters will be aware there is a £500 bonus prize for the agent selling the winning £20,000 Spot Ball coupon. Should this be won by one pf our programme coupons, the Commercial Department will be the recipient of the £500 and we would pass it on to you the supporters by giving – for that particular week – five bonus prizes of £100 to the Guess the Gate contestants nearest to the official attendance figure. Our centre page spread, at your request, will now be taken up with action pictures.

Today's distribution problems are very much eased as our board of directors had the foresight, early during the fuel crisis, to negotiate the hire of a generator. This prompt action will be welcomed by thousands of fans and in particular by the 7,000 who missed the start of our last League fixture against Spurs.

I take this opportunity of wishing all our supporters, Patrons and Sponsors a very merry Christmas and sign off with the news that on Boxing Day, when we entertain Wolverhampton at home, we shall be producing a bumper twenty page programme packed with pictures of the City stars.

For those interested, Leicester City beat QPR 2-0 and then on Boxing Day drew 2-2 with Wolves

Going forward, will new Commercial Manager Mike Price pick up on the Guess the Crowd idea? Should we introduce a Spot the Ball competition in the programme using some of Steve's excellent photos, as it should be easy to hide the ball using Photoshop. I know Woody likes competitions in the progarmmes, although he is also probably more interested in Torrmolinos for just £29!
