Men's First Team Bassett Bulletin

Wolcomo to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Bank Holiday Monday Uhlsport Hellenic League home fixture against Corsham Town. A warm welcome to all our visitors this afternoon who have made the short journey from Corsham. We hope you all enjoy your brief stay with us this afternoon and wish you a safe journey home.

Due to the Bank Holiday weekend this programme is having to be produced ahead of the FA Vase game against Cinderford Town and before the three games that were set to take place in the Premier Division of the Uhlsport Hellenic League on Saturday. Statistics in the programme should all be back up to date ahead of next Saturday's FA Cup encounter with Torpoint Athletic.

Corsham Town have made a good start to the season and at the time of writing these notes sit second in the table. Like ourselves they have been given a lot of home games at the start of the season with five of their seven games played to date being at home and they were set to be at home again on Saturday to Kintbury Rangers in the FA Vase. They have won four and drawn one of their opening six league fixtures to occupy that second spot but made an early exit from this season's FA Cup, losing 1-0 at home to current Hellenic League Premier Division leaders Slimbridge. This season Corsham have allowed Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League side Park United to share their Secure Stadium. The early exit from the FA Cup meant that two of Park's league fixtures have been bounced by the Hellenic League already but as Fixture Secretary of the Wilts League I have appreciated the efforts that Corsham and Park have gone to try and still fulfil the Wilts League fixtures, even considering staging two games on the same day at the ground.

Whilst you will see in today's record that overall our record against Corsham is the better of the two teams, in recent times our record against Corsham has been a very poor one with no win in the last nine meetings between the two sides. With Corsham going so well they will start as clear favourites this afternoon but who knows we may just pull off a surprise result.

Whilst the result on Wednesday night against Fairford Town was not the one we wanted it is important that we don't dwell too much on the defeat and that first half in particular. It is important that we bounce back from that disappointment as quickly as possible and hopefully by the time you read these notes we are through to the next round of the Vase with a confidence boosting victory over Cinderford Town.

Whilst the Fairford result was a tough one to take, particularly given the connections to so many in the opposition dressing room, what was particularly pleasing was the crowd of 341. Our average league attendance from the three fixtures played already is now 232 with another large crowd anticipated here today with the visit of near neighbours Corsham Town.

Two more games to come here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground in the next nine days, starting with Saturday's FA Cup encounter with Torpoint Athletic from the Western League. Subject to not requiring a replay in that FA Cup fixture, we are then scheduled to be at home the following Wednesday for the rearranged league game against Mangotsfield United. This rescheduling has meant the Development Team's scheduled fixture against Letcombe has been pushed back a couple of weeks.

After that Mangotsfield fixture the first team, are currently scheduled to revert to Saturday fixtures for a while after a hectic start to the season, although I suspect news around the Floodlit Cup, the Marsh Challenge Cup and Wiltshire Premier Shield fixtures are not too far away.

Enjoy this afternoon's game and hopefully come five-o-clock we will be celebrating our first league win of the season.

Attendances so far this season have been fantastic and knowing the Corsham travelling support, I am sure today will be the same. Please get behind the boys again today, I know how much it means to them.

1878 The earliest record found of Corsham Football Club.

1893 Club becomes affiliated to the Football Association.

1894 The first Wiltshire County Football League was formed with the original member clubs being Bradford, Calne, Chippenham, Corsham, Southbroom (Devizes), Melksham, Trowbridge Town, and Warminster.

At the end of the **1894/95** season Corsham would be the inaugural champions, winning the league on goal average over Southbroom, helped by an emphatic 17 - 1 win over Calne in their final game.

Over the years, the team has often been referred to as the Quarrymen due to the high level of quarrying in and around Corsham.

1894 to **1997** Corsham Town play in the Wiltshire County League (Step 7).

1997/98 Promotion was achieved to the Western League Division 1 (Step 6) after winning the county league by goal difference from Devizes Town Reserves under manager Pete Tripp.

2001 Ground improvements continued under the chairmanship of Colin Hudd, floodlights were installed, a 112 spectator stand erected and hard standing laid around the pitch perimeter.

2004/05 Promotion was achieved to the Western League Premier Division (Step 5) under manager Colin (Nobby) Bush.

2006/07 Saw Corsham Town winning the Western League Premier Division, which was hotly contested by many teams, including Bridgwater Town and Frome Town. The club also added a third successive Wiltshire Senior Cup victory.

2020/21 Keiran Baggs becomes manager with Gary Higdon as his assistant. Unfortunately, after 10 unbeaten league games the 2020/21 was curtailed by the FA due to the Covid pandemic.

The FA went ahead with planned restructuring of the Non-League Pyramid. The results from 2019/20 & 2020/21 were combined and this meant that Corsham Town were promoted for the 2021/22 season to the Hellenic League Premier Division (Step 5).

2021/22 The club finish in a very creditable 5th position n the Hellenic League Premier Division and reach the final of the Wiltshire Premier Shield Cup played at the County Ground against Swindon Supermarine.

In the 70th minute York went on a mazy run which saw him beat 3 players before firing confidently past the keeper.

Ten minutes later a lovely ball from McKay released York down the left. His cross just cluded Karn, making his debut, and was headed out by a Costaham defender to a gleeful Harrison, who hit it on the volley and smashed it past the keeper from just inside the box.

A fine end then to '87 for Bassett, which sees them riding high at the top of the league, and at the quarter final stages of both cups. Indeed their next game is on January 2nd when they entertain Supermarine in the Wilts Senior Cup, 2.00 p.m. kick off.

FA Cup First Qualifying Round

Bassett to host Torpoint in Emirates FA Cup first qualifying round

Royal Wootton Bassett Town have been handed a home tie against Western League Premier Division side Torpoint Athletic in the Emirates FA Cup first qualiyfing round. The Cornish side are set to visit the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground on Saturday 30 August.

From Editor's Football Collection

Football League Reviews

Introduced at the start of the 1965-66 football season a new magazine called the Soccer Review took its' bow. Within a season it was to be renamed the Football League Review ("FLR"). Initially published by a company called Sport and Screen, the magazine proclaimed its 'commitment 'To inform and entertain the people who support football'.

Published in black and white with some colour trim, it was usually stapled into its' host club programme, 16 pages in length and full of articles supplemented by a few photographs. The Review was 5 pence "when bought separately", which was basically never. It was full of behind the scene looks at the day to day running of football league clubs. From the start some of the larger league clubs refused to include the FLR fearing interference from League Secretary Alan Hardaker. Indeed, at the beginning, it was very much a mouthpiece Football League. The league secretary Alan Hardaker ran the league from "offices" (his house) up in St Anne's, Lancashire close to Blackpool and its' bright lights (bit like Brian King and the Hellenic League).

The first issue claimed that 150,000 were available at grounds across the country and specifically thanked Leeds United and Birmingham City for their support. Presumably they were amongst the first clubs to agree to include the FLR within their programmes. Perhaps then, it is no surprise that we see an article and team photograph of Birmingham City and also, not surprisingly, the first Club Call feature, which lasted many seasons in the magazine, was devoted to Don Revie's dirty Leeds United, as non-Leeds fans of my era knew them as.

The articles covered many aspects of the game and the people involved in it as opposed to providing details of matches and league tables. Interestingly for the times, as well as a Referees section, a Press cuttings feature and opinion from editor Harry Brown, these first few issues concentrated on women supporters.

That first season saw 34 issues published. This increased to 38 issues when the Football League took over for the second season. Whilst the League had taken over the publication, in that first season of their editorship they maintained it was not the "official view of the league". Come 1967-68 the editorial was now being called "League View" as they came more comfortable with the concept of a League magazine.

In total the FLR ran from August 1965 to the last issue in Christmas 1974. In total 366 issues were published. One of the big developments was the use of colour team photos (first one was Manchester United) and it was the introduction of these photos which have made the FLR's such collectable items amongst the football memorabilia community.

For economic reasons the Football League decided to support the magazine less financially and as clubs developed their own programmes less clubs felt the need to include the magazine, the end was near. The magazine ended in 1974 but looking back, it represents a great snapshot of the time, especially as it covers many topics slightly off the mainstream of mere matches, scores and scorers. It also heavily promoted the League Cup and if you recall in those early years it would have been the era when the mighty QPR and Swindon Town lifted the trophy. In one 1969 issue, there is a centre page photograph acknowledging the behindthe-scenes efforts at Swindon Town and the support given to the Arsenal players by their wives and girlfriends (WAGS late 1960's style).

The FLR can be found on Ebay either on its own or still within 1960's and 1970's clu programmes. Searching for all 366 of them. That's one big challenge. In fact, it is made harder by some editions having different adverts on the back page. I have at least one copy of each of the 366 editions. However, even though I am something of a completist I never felt the need to try and get a copy of each of the different adverts on the back page.

PRECISELY 104 days after Aldershot Town and Whitstable Town lifted the Isuzu FA Trophy and FA Vase respectively at a sundrenched Wembley Stadium, Non-League's two premier cup competitions are back for another eagerly-awaited campaign.

This afternoon, the 2025-26 FA Trophy kicks off with 32 clubs from Step 4 contesting 16 preliminary round ties.

A record 336 entrants begin the 12-round Road to Wembley and perhaps slightly unfortunate to be made to qualify is Grays Athletic, who have a proud FA Trophy history having won the second of two consecutive finals 20 years ago with victory over Woking, a year after beating Hucknall Town on penalties.

They make the trip this afternoon to Eastern Counties League Premier champions Brantham Athletic, one of four clubs making their FA Trophy debuts.

Rugby Borough, Hassocks FC and last season's FA Vase runners-up, AFC Whyteleafe, are the others with their sights set on a potentially lucrative run into the latter stages and the visit of a National League big gun.

In this week's NLP, our friends at @Non-League Factfile were back with all the facts and figures ahead of this afternoon's ties – and once again there was plenty to mull over.

Four clubs are looking to equal their best FA Trophy run with victory in this preliminary round, namely Garforth Town, Wellingborough Town, Gorleston FC and Westbury United, while ten ties involve clubs that will meet each other in league games this season.

And there's plenty of scores to settle on the field too with three of the 16 ties involving clubs that have met in the FA Trophy before.

Three years ago, Hanworth Villa beat Northwood 3-0 and Bashley defeated Frome Town 4-1, both in the first qualifying round. Margate knocked out Egham Town in the second qualifying round eight years ago.

The Isuzu FA Vase is equally as fascinating with no fewer than 623 having entered – the highest tally for six years.

This weekend, 202 first qualifying round ties take place up and down the country, involving 404 clubs from Steps 5 and 6.

Seven former FA Vase winners are in action: Whitley Bay (four times, 2001-02, 2008-09, 2009-10, 2010-11), Brigg Town (1995-96, 2002-03), Romford FC (2023-24), Thatcham Town (2018), Diss Town (1994), Stansted FC (1984) and Hoddesdon Town, the first club to lift the Vase at Wembley Stadium in 1974-75.

In contrast, 26 clubs are participating in the FA Vase for the first time with four more entering in the next round, on September 6.

The tie between Grangetown Boys Club and Leeds Ultra Football Academy guarantees there will be at least five debut clubs in the next round.

Step 6 clubs have enjoyed solid Vase campaigns in recent years and this first qualifying round draw ensured that 61 tenth-tier clubs will progress to the next round (plus Boldon Community Association who have a walkover).

At least 44 Step 5 clubs will exit in this round with a possibility of an upset in 97 ties.

Thirteen clubs will be looking to make history by tasting Vase victory for the first time, while Newcastle Blue Star, Shirehampton FC and Horbury Town are all looking for a first win at their third attempt.

The tie between Club Thorne Colliery and Horbury Town is the only tie to guarantee a club making second qualifying round tie for the first time, while three other ties will see the winners at least equal their best Vase run – Retford FC versus Appleby Frodingham, AFC Aldermaston v Bristol Telephones and St Day v Stoke Gabriel and Torbay Police.

Twenty-three ties involve clubs that have met in FA Vase before, but Stafford Town v Tividale FC is the only one to have occurred more than once before. They have one win apiece in their past Vase meetings.

And talking of grudge matches, Southern Combination side Pagham FC have had to wait 49 years for the opportunity to avenge a 7-0 defeat by Newport (IOW) – the longest of any side in the competition.

So, the first of ten rounds on the Road to Wembley starts here with the four Finals Day contenders contesting Non-League's most prestigious prizes under the arch on Sunday May 17, 2026.

It's an occasion to savour and a fitting finale to two much-loved competitions which grow in stature year on year.

Start your engines, it promises to be a bumpy ride.
