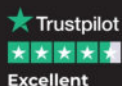

GOOD EVENING and welcome back to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this UHlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against current league leaders Roman Glass St George, the oldest club in Bristol.

A warm welcome to all our visitors who have made the journey along the M4, we hope you enjoy your brief stay with us this evening and wish you a safe journey home.

Whilst playing the league leaders is always a difficult game, our record against tonight's visitors is also very poor, with just three wins in ten meetings between the two sides, with seven defeats including three cup games. In a way this is something of a free hit tonight as very few will be expecting us to take anything out of this game against a side who look set for a place in the promotion place offs as they move into the second half of the season eleven points clear of the sides outside the promotion play-off spots. As I said our overall record against Roman Glass is not good, but our recent record is even worse with five defeats in our last five meetings.

I understand we were a much more compact and more difficult side to breakdown on Saturday and consequently much less susceptible to the quick break as we had been at Hallen the previous week. Concentrate on keeping the goals out and I am sure the results will come. Hopefully, Jonny will have everyone else available this evening.

The fact that we have used 44 players already this season is not a good sign, the season's we have done well have tended to be when we have been able to field a regular lineup, but hopefully we will be able to start fielding a consistent lineup now for the rest of the season.

It was a good weekend for the club all-round with the Development side picking up their tenth win of the campaign on Saturday and they have already amassed more points than they did the whole of last season, and they are only just over the halfway stage. Early December sees the big Wiltshire Senior Cup game against Warminster Town but before that Mark Simpkins side have a big game against league leaders Shrewton United this coming Saturday at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground as they look to maintain their unbeaten run against the league leaders.

On Sunday the Women's team maintained their unbeaten start to the league campaign with a hard fought 2-0 win over Paulton Rovers thanks to two second half goals from Lauren Bulley to move fourth in the table with games in hand over most of the sides above us in the table. This coming Sunday sees Bassett set to meet the league leaders Whitchurch at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground in what will be a vital game in our quest to get promotion back to Tier 5.

Back to this evening's tough game. We know we will need to be at our very best to get something out of tonight's game but, as we showed against Corsham Town earlier in the season, we are capable of beating the top sides if we are on our game. Could tonight be another one of those nights? Enjoy the match and hopefully the club will be celebrating another much needed confidence boosting win in the bar after the game.

Tonight's Opponents

Roman Glass St George



The club Roman Glass St George is the result of an amalgamation between Bristol St George and Roman Glass. Bristol St George was formed in 1882 and is the oldest club in Bristol. They were founder members of the GFA in 1886 and won the GFA Senior Challenge Cup on two occasions 1894 and 1895 beating Eastville Rovers 3-1 on the first occasion.

The club also entered the FA Cup in 1891 and the inaugural FA Amateur Cup in 1894. The current ground at Bell Hill was opened with a match between a Bristol & District XI and the English champions Aston Villa in 1894. In 1897 the club turned professional and spent two seasons in the Birmingham & District League. The club reverted to amateur status in 1901 and continued that way until joining the Western League in 1928. In 1935 after struggling financially they dropped out and joined the Bristol & District League once again. They won the first division only once in 1949/50 but were always a leading team until they became founder members of the Bristol Premier Combination in 1957. St George played in this league winning it five seasons in succession from 1963/64 season to 1967/68 until they joined the Gloucestershire County League on its formation in 1968.

The Sixties was the Golden era for the club as in addition to winning these league titles they also managed to win the Gloucestershire Senior Amateur Cup, five times which included four successive seasons. Success was also found in the FA Amateur Cup when they regularly took on the top amateur clubs in the Country such as Hendon, Dagenham, Hayes and Leytonstone in front of crowds numbering thousands.

St George won the County league in 1969/70 and was runners-up twice before a gradual decline in fortunes until in 1987 the club were expelled from the league due to sub standard facilities. A return to the Premier Combination saw a brief improvement resulting in winning the Premier Division in 1992/93. With no promotion gained the club nosedived and were in danger of folding when Roman Glass stepped in.

Roman Glass originated as a street team called Wyndham Wanderers in 1960 and played in the Bristol Church of England League and then joined the Bristol & District League in 1974. The club enjoyed moderate success gradually climbing the leagues and in 1980 changed its name to Roman Glass. The club began to decline until in 1990 Roger Hudd took over as manager and steered them to win the Division 4 title the club continued to improve gaining successive promotions until the amalgamation in 1995.

Roman Glass St George in the Premier Combination immediately gained success, winning promotion to the Premier Division that season and then winning that league in 1998/99 season to earn promotion to the County League. The club won the County league in 2001/02 and then season 2006/07 which resulted in promotion to the Toolstation (Western) League, a league the club last played in, in 1935.

Following Promotion to step 5 of the pyramid Roman glass st George FC had 2 Seasons in the Toolstation Western league Premier division and now due to the restructure, compete in the Hellenic Premier division.

Character is going to be key if Royal Wootton Bassett Town are going to haul themselves out of danger in the Hellenic League Premier Division - and players with the stomach for the fight.

The thirteen players who put in a shift across a tense ninety minutes away at Cribbs certainly demonstrated the qualities that are needed.

And their dogged, determined display earned a vital 2-1 victory for Jonny Aitkenhead's side against opponents who also find themselves fighting at the wrong end of the table.

At times it wasn't pretty - particularly towards the end when Cribbs applied intense pressure. And Bassett (finally) had some good fortune with the hosts missing a second half penalty.

But Bassett also demonstrated their quality with the ball - and that was key to what proved to be the winning goal, scored by Dylan Griffin in the game's 27th minute.

The first chance of the match fell to Cribbs right back Corey Stock whose powerful 20 yard drive stung the palms of Lewis Clark with an offside flag helpfully denying Kosuke Ono the opportunity to follow up with the rebound.

Bassett should then have led on 14 minutes when a slip from captain Oscar Sullivan set Ben Cleary through on goal. The striker did almost everything right, slowing things down as he bore down on goal. However when it came to the shot he somehow skewed wide.

At that point the Bassett faithful may have been thinking it was going to be one of those days.

And that feeling would have strengthened four minutes later when Cribbs took the lead. Beating Clark to the loose ball after the Bassett' keeper spilled Arran Sweete's free kick, Sullivan earned his team a penalty. And Sweete stepped forward, coolly sending Clark the wrong way.

Bassett quickly got back on terms though. Ollie Smith whipped in a fine cross that Hugo Kemmery spilled at the left post. George Cook then kept things a life, teasing a ball back in that Cleary, with his back to goal, hooked in with an impressive close range acrobatic effort.

That was redemption for Cleary - and for Bassett. And the visitors were soon ahead.

Their second goal was a beautiful team effort. Intricate play involving Griffin, Gabe Reivers, Ed Taylor and Cleary saw Bassett weave a way through congested space in the heart of the pitch. That set free Griffin, whose quick feet opened up room to poke an effort that nestled in the bottom corner via a deflection.

Bassett now held the upper hand though Cribbs avoided falling further behind. They came close on the stroke of half time too when Louie Farrow's back post headed was palmed away by Clark.

The second half saw Bassett start well enough. Cribbs were held at bay while Cleary forced Kemmery to parry with a flicked near post header from a Smith cross.

But as the half went on, Cribbs asserted greater control and Bassett started to open up.

Both Sweete and Anthony Essono could only snatch at chances when Bassett failed to deal with balls into the box.

But while they bent, Bassett did not break, with the closest Cribbs came to snatching an equaliser coming in injury time when Clark fisted a low Sweete drive away after Max Kendle's long throw fell for him on the edge of the area.

The full time whistle soon arrived and Bassett could finally breathe. Finally they were winners in the league again, their victory coming courtesy of a gutsy team effort

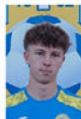
Dylan Griffin - Forward

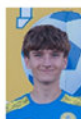
Otis Lewis - Midfield

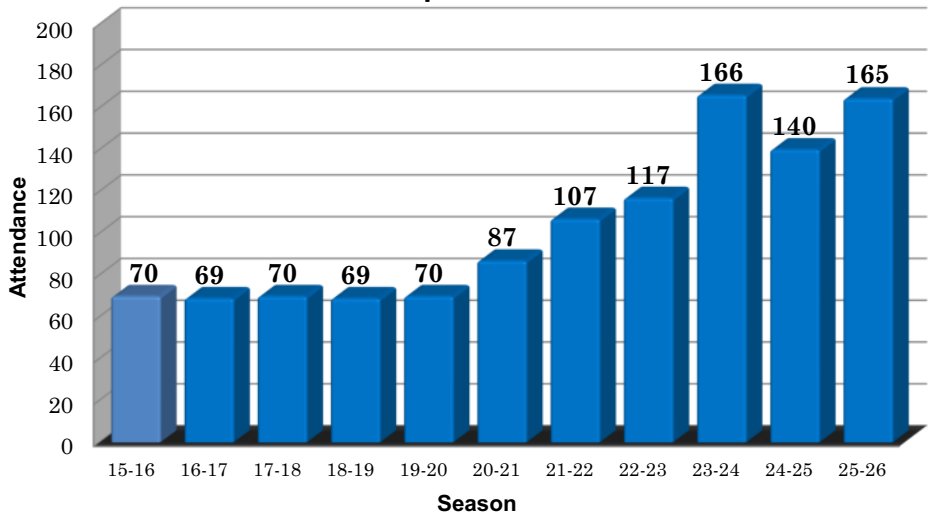

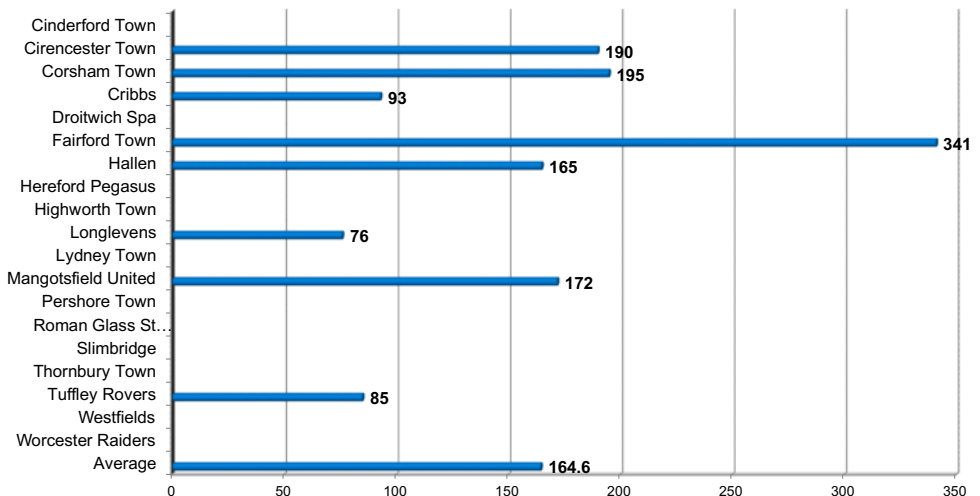

RADCLIFFE joint-boss Anthony Johnson's recent social media post caught the eye.

Highlighting their three goalscorers, Jordan Hulme, Rio Clegg and Mikey Afuye Johnson pointed out their upbringing through local amateur football to the positions where they were used to putting up the nets and paying subs.

His message to youngsters is to not turn noses up at lower levels, but get out and play competitive men's football.

Those three are now spearheading Radcliffe's National League North campaign that has got off to a flyer.

It's interesting as a reminder to young aspiring footballers there are many ways to make a career in football. Playing – and being paid – to play part-time at such a good level doesn't happen by accident. It takes hard work and dedication to achieve.

It's true there are some youngsters who may sneer at Non-League. Stories of some turning down the chance to go on loan to help with their development do float around.

Perhaps it's the social media culture where it's easier to have 'professional footballer' written in the X or Instagram bio.

But for those who do play, there are more opportunities than ever to make an impact and get spotted.

In recent seasons we've written about so many stories of players getting their chance in the Football League who are not drawn just from the top of Non-League, but right the way through all Steps.

"Let's use those (Hulme, Clegg and Afuye) as an example," Johnsons told us. "Rio Clegg has never been hurt by the system. Because he's never come through an academy, he's never been released by a Liverpool, United, Blackburn and landed at, say, an Oldham and had to start again.

"That leaves a lot of scar tissue, it does. I see it with young players we coach now – eight, nine, ten year olds who have been told they're not good enough – and people wonder why there's a pandemic of young lads with mental health!

"We've got Rio Clegg, Mikey Afuye and a whole group of that age around the club where we can go: They're starving hungry.

"Then when you've got a Jordan Hulme, who has come from the exact same playground as them, put nets up and, it sounds awful, cleared dog s**t off the local park pitch, paid subs to then getting to paid to play semi-professional football, shows how far they've come.

"Yes, you've got young hungry lads coming through but you've also got lads at the top end who have been there and done it themselves. That helps keep their feet on the ground.

"We've got a group here – Matt Sargent, Danny Greenfield, Michael Afuye and Rio Clegg – who are all 23, 24, being watched by EFL clubs and they're an incredibly talented bunch.

"Then we've got the group above them who are coming into their prime. Then we've got our experienced group. It's almost three categories so we've got a really good blend."

EFL – and even Premier League – teamsheets this weekend will show there are plenty of routes to the same destination.

From Editor's Football Collection

1974 - Football In the Seventies

A recent addition to the Smedley Football Book Collection is the excellent book by Marvin Close covering the year 1974 entitled "1974 – football in the Seventies". For those old enough to remember the year of 1974, Britain in 1974 was a land of strikes, electricity cuts, a three-day working week that also saw the country's first official recession for 50 years. The country was in a mess with a Labour Government coming into power, a bit like today, initially with a minority government after the election of February 1974 produced a hung parliament, they then secured a much larger majority in October 1974.

The year started with Slade still at number one in the charts with "Merry Christmas Everybody" in which they sang "everybody's having fun" but, again a bit like today, people were not really having much fun at all as the country fell on such hard times. Not only were their strikes and the recession, which had seen off the previous Conservative government, there were fuel shortages driven by the oil crisis in the Middle East, power cuts and a state of emergency in Northern Ireland, with the IRA also carry out bombings on the UK mainland. This made London a dangerous place to visit, and even the pubs in the beautiful city of Guilford were attacked. All of this backdrop is covered in the early chapters of this excellent book. In addition, an early chapter notes the big problem afflicting the world of football at the time, football hooliganism, with Manchester United in particular straddled with a notorious hooligan element. The year would see the first murder on the terraces, the victim was 17-year-old Blackpool fan Kevin Olsson, who was stabbed to death at the back of the Spion Kop stand during a match between Blackpool and Bolton Wanderers.

There were other problems in the world of football, due to the power restrictions, floodlit football matches were banned, with midweek games sometime staking place during the afternoons. The issues caused by power shortages also saw games played on a Sunday in the Football League for the first time. Youngsters today, with Sky's Super Sunday, will not appreciate that prior to 1974 Sunday football in the professional game was non-existent.

With the hooligan problem the power issues and high unemployment, attendances plummeted as cash-strapped fans just couldn't afford to watch live games. Again, all of this is well covered in this readable compelling book.

The book also covers the departure of Don Revie from Leeds United to take over the England managers job to be replaced at Leeds United by Brian Clough, who lasted all of 44 days after a toxic fall-out with the players that Revie had left behind at Leeds.

The year of 1974 also saw the sad tale of the great Bill Shankly's retirement as Liverpool manager and the book covers how it all ended in tears and recrimination.

It wasn't all depressing though in the world of football. The year would see one of my all-time favourite football World Cup's, the 1974 World Cup in Germany, made all of the more enjoyable as England had not qualified and we could just watch and enjoy the football, without all the angst and depression that England put you through every time they qualify for the competition.

Another highlight of 1974 was seeing Manchester United having a nightmare season which would culminate in their first relegation from the topflight of English football for more than 30 years. And even better it was a goal from their former legend Dennis Law that confirmed their relegation. Chelsea were also at the bottom end of the table, setting them up for relegation the following season, subsequently sacking manager Dave Sexton which then led to the greatest ever season in football for my own little club whilst Chelsea battled it out in what is now the Championship in today's money.

Other good news was that the FA finally ended the shameful 50-year 'ban' on women's football, although my Auntie Wendy had probably missed out on her big chance by now. 1974 also saw major changes in revolution in amateur non-league football as paid players were allowed in the non-league game, which led to the reorganisation of the league pyramid as we know it today, with the England amateur team disbanded. In summary a book I thoroughly enjoyed and which brought back a lot of memories. As ever its highly recommended by the Editor.
