Bassett Bulletin

GOOD AFTERNOON and welcome back to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this UHlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against Worcester Raiders. A warm welcome to all the players, management team, club officials and supporters from Worcester Raiders who have made the journey south for today's game. We hope you all enjoy your short stay with us this afternoon and we wish you a safe journey home.

After last week's narrow 1-0 defeat in the Wiltshire derby encounter with Corsham Town we are now on a run of three straight defeats, all away from home, which followed our run of four straight wins, all here at the GBSG. Hopefully our return to home turf will see us bring the losing run to an end here this afternoon. Since that last home game when we defeated Thornbury Town 3-1, we have lost 2-1 at Slimbridge to a late goal, pushed Cinderford all the way before eventually losing 2-0 and then taken Corsham Town all the way last Saturday but we were in the end unable to find a reply to the early Corsham Town goal. A match report on all four games is included in today's programme.

Today's encounter with Worcester Raiders will be the third meeting of the season between the two sides and Worcester Raiders won both the previous two meetings. We suffered a heavy 7-2 defeat in the reverse fixture back in October before losing 3-0 at home in a December Challenge Cup contest. Bassett will therefore be hoping for a positive outcome at the third time of asking against a Raiders side who - like their fellow contenders at the top - have suffered a brief wobble recently.

Our overall record against Worcester Raiders is also not a good one with just one win in the previous eight meetings between the sides, with two draws and five defeats for Bassett.

Worcester Raiders currently sit fourth in the table and are looking good for the play-offs so we know we will need to be at our best here this afternoon if we are to get anything out of today's game and start to improve that poor record against today's opponents.

The Development Team last Saturday fell to a second straight defeat when they lost 2-1 at home to Devizes Town Reserves, with Devizes scoring a very late winner to leave with all three points. This followed the 4-1 home defeat at the hands of promotion chasing Larkhall Athletic Development the previous week. Today sees Mark Simpkins side visit a much improved Trowbridge Town side for another tough looking fixture looking to end what is now a run of three games without a win.

There was much better news with regard to the women's side last weekend as they returned from league leaders Corsham Town with all three points following a 2-0 away win, avenging the 2-0 home defeat they suffered back in February. This was a vital win and puts the women's team's destiny in their own hands now. Win every game to the end of the season and they will be champions of the South West Regional League Division One North. In addition, they have a little matter of a Wiltshire FA County Cup final against Swindon Town at Melksham to come next week. Unfortunately, there will not be any more games in the League Cup as Bassett fell to a 2-0 defeat in their quarter final encounter with Bitton to exit the competition.

Elsewhere in the club, it is not long now until the highlight of the Youth Section's season, the annual tour to Holland. The tour party depart on Saturday 28th of March, returning on Tuesday 31st March and the three Bassett sides (U12 Blues, U13 Blues and U13 Girls) will play fixtures against SV Monster and FC 's-Gravzande as well as visit the Feyenoord and Sparta Rotterdam stadiums. The usual programme has been prepared for the tour and I must say it was a lot easier to pull together using the Xara Designer Pro software.

Enjoy the match here this afternoon and hopefully we can secure three more vital points to help secure our safety as quickly as possible.

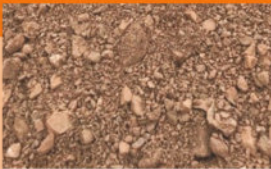

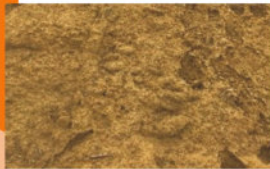

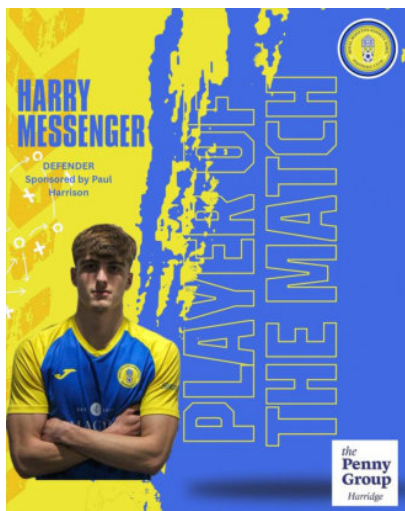

Today's Opponents

Worcester Raiders



Worcester Raiders were formed in 2001 as a youth club, joining the Worcester & District Football League in 2009 upon the formation of a senior side. In 2013, Worcester Raiders joined the West Midlands (Regional) League Division Two, gaining promotion in their first season in the National League System.

In 2019, Worcester Raiders won Division One, gaining promotion to the Premier Division. Worcester Raiders entered the FA Vase for the first time in 2020–21. At the end of the 2020–21 season the club were transferred to Division One of the Hellenic League as part of the FA's restructuring of the National League System.

In the 2021–22 season, Worcester Raiders finished second behind Studley F.C. in Division 1 of the uHlsport Hellenic League. Despite a 3-0 loss to Hereford Pegasus F.C. in the playoff final, Worcester Raiders were promoted to the Premier Division of the Hellenic League following the closure of Walton Casuals F.C. in the Southern League Premier South, leading to the reprieve for Merthyr Town and Cinderford Town A.F.C. The result was Worcester were promoted to the Hellenic Premier as runner-up in that play-off.

Worcester Raiders initially played at Claines Lane. On 29 July 2020, English Premiership rugby union club Worcester Warriors confirmed Worcester Raiders would move into Sixways Stadium, with Worcester Warriors' co-owners Colin Goldring and Jason Whittingham becoming joint majority owners of Worcester Raiders in the process.

In September 2022 the future of the club was left uncertain after the gates to their ground were locked, as a result of Worcester Warriors' financial problems. This effectively left Worcester Raiders homeless with nowhere to play their home matches. However, it was later confirmed that the Raiders had reached an agreement with the Warriors' administrators to remain at Sixways.

Worcester Raiders had a successful first season in the UHlsport Hellenic League Premier Division securing a fourth place finish sandwiched between two Wiltshire Clubs Corsham Town and Royal Wootton Bassett Town. This was the highest ever position in the Club's history. Season 2022-23 saw Raiders enter the FA Cup for the first time in the Club's history, winning the first two rounds against Daventry and Malvern before getting knocked out by Worksop.

Season 2023-24 was not quite as successful with Raiders slipping down to 10th place in the final table some 13 points adrift of the play-off places.

Last season Worcester Raiders just missed out on the end of season play-offs, finishing in sixth place, five points below Highworth Town who were the last team to qualify for the play-offs.

This season once again sees Worcester Raiders challenging for a place in those play-offs, currently sat in fifth place which would be enough to make it into the play-offs should they still be there or even higher come the end of the season.

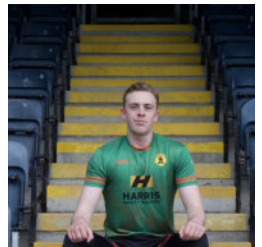

Resilient Bassett rattle Raiders late to claim point

Time and again this season, Royal Wootton Bassett Town's resilience has stood out as the team's defining characteristic. Unlike in previous years, so far this campaign there has never been a time when Sam Collier's side have been out of a game - even when they have fallen behind. And that strength was again on show in Bassett's first ever meeting with Worcester Raiders.

After last week's clash with Westfields, this was another tough engagement with the Raiders opening the afternoon in third. But Bassett - without centre halves Adam Corcoran and Dave Bampton through suspension as well as Matt Bennett, Scott Chilcott, Jack Hobson-McVeigh and Chris Taylor - dug deep, producing another solid display to earn a point.



They did so the hard way too, twice coming from behind in an entertaining 2-2 draw. Bassett should arguably have been ahead though as Gio Wrona managed to rattle the bar with the goal at his mercy early on after great interplay between Tommy Ouldrige and Matt Jones. Worcester soon capitalised on that miss, taking the lead through Jordan Murphy who slotted home from Jade Ferron's fizzing low cross.



While plugging away at the Worcester back line and dealing with what the dangerous Raiders threw at them, it took until midway through the second half for Bassett to draw level for the first time. After Ouldrige won a free kick inside the visitors' half, Jones teased in a delivery which Landon Golding, having lost his marker, met with a glancing header into the corner of the net.

Raiders then made it 2-1 as Joe Billingham was on hand to tap in after Matt Crowther could only parry from Murphy's shot on the turn.

That meant Bassett were again forced to dig deep. But, with time winding down, they snatched the equaliser and point they deserved in some style.

Veteran Alan Griffin drew a foul around 30 yards from goal, and Jones stepped over the ball. Catching Raiders 'keeper Ryan Young off guard, the left footer steered a delightful low curler around the wall and into the bottom left corner. It was a fine strike - and one that earned another important, valuable result against one of the division's fancied sides.

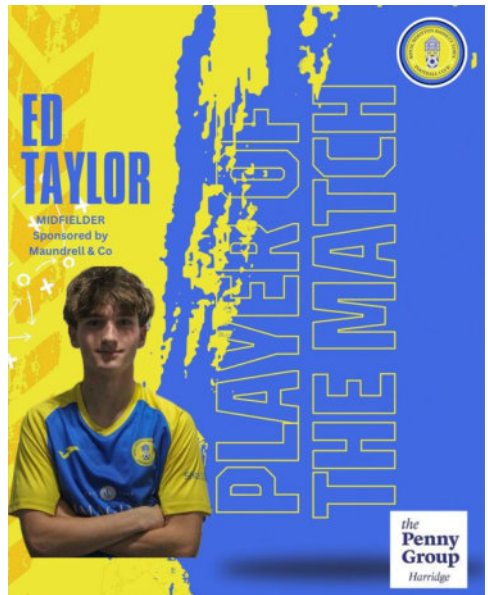

Stoppage time heartbreak as Swans snap winning streak

Royal Wootton Bassett Town conceded a pair of stoppage time goals as Jonny Aitkenhead's side suffered an agonising 2-1 defeat away against Slimbridge.

Bassett, who had led for the majority of the game courtesy of Ben Cleary's 20th minute goal, looked on course for a fifth consecutive win - and a significant coup against the promotion chasing Swans.

However, Jack W Smith salvaged an equaliser in the 92nd minute before an unfortunate Jack Coward own goal in the fifth minute of added time sealed an important, yet ultimately lucky three points for Slimbridge.

While devastated by the nature of their defeat, Bassett can take great credit from an otherwise excellent performance against their high-flying hosts that deserved some form of reward.

Indeed it was an evenly contested match with little between the teams.

Bassett had arguably the better of the early exchanges, and struck the woodwork twelve minutes in. Slimbridge 'keeper Steve Sarkodie flapped at a curling TJ Bohane effort, with the ball dropping for Harvey Fox who attempted to lift a deft lob into the net that clipped the crossbar.

The visitors were soon ahead though. Bohane flicked on a throw in on the edge of the area and the ball fell to Cleary who lashed in on the turn with a powerful 12 yard drive.

The Swans reacted to going behind though and twice came close before the interval as Smith struck off target after a corner fell to him and Ollie Barnes shot narrowly wide.

Clear opportunities were a less common occurrence for the majority of the second period as both defences snuffed out any danger.

But as the game entered the closing stages, Bassett had a pair of chances to double their lead, but couldn't find a way past Sarkodie to kill off the game. First the 'keeper raced off his line to parry away at the feet of Cleary when the forward had got in behind. Fox then shot wide from a tight angle after having got past the 'keeper.

Slimbridge were therefore still in the match - and Smith snapped up the opportunity to pull



his side level when another corner fell to him in the box and he fired low into right corner of the net.

That was harsh on Bassett. But what came next was even crueler. Smith helped on a ball lumped forward from deep which

seemed set to run out of play. But an outstretched Jacob Rodgers somehow managed to keep the ball in play and his cut back from the byline struck Coward on the chest and spun over the line.

After being moments away from a fifth consecutive win - and an upset over a Slimbridge side who are chasing the title, Bassett were beaten.

There's little time to dwell on defeat though, with Bassett having the opportunity to pick themselves up away at Cinderford Town on Saturday.

Hellenic Premier Division

Roundup - Sat March 14

A busy programme across the Hellenic Premier delivered goals, drama and some eye-catching scorelines as teams continued their push toward the business end of the 2025/26 season. **Cirencester Town** edged past **Longlevens AFC** in a tight contest, securing an important 2-1 home win thanks to goals from Leuan Bailey and Edward Scott, former Bassett striker Ben Lodge with the Longlevens reply. The win sees Cirencester just sat outside the play-off places.

Corsham Town continued their play-off push with a narrow 1-0 victory over **Royal Wootton Bassett Town** thanks to a disciplined defensive performance. The all-important goal was scored early on by Nick McCootie, the goal coming in the fourth minute of the game. A more detailed report on the game can be found elsewhere in today's programme.

A dominant display from relegation threatened **Cribbs** saw them put five past **Lydney Town** in one of the day's most emphatic results to also move off the bottom of the table, with their beaten opponents replacing them the foot of the table. The goals were shared around with Arron Sweete, Joel Smith, Trayvion Jackson, Keiran Clayton and Luco Ponsillo all finding the back of the net.

Fairford Town claimed all three points in a competitive encounter with **Hereford Pegasus** to maintain their outside chance of making the play-offs. Luke Hitchman gave them a 1-0 half time lead and former Bassett striker Dan Grieve doubled their lead ten minutes from time. Joe David then pulled one back for Pegasus a minute from time, but it was little more than a consolation goal as Fairford saw out the remaining time without conceding again to win 2-1.

Cinderford Town are another side with a slim chance of making the place offs and they returned from **Highworth Town** with all three points following a 2-0 away win, Harry Leeson scoring in the first half and Jack Watts making sure of the points with a second 16 minutes from time.

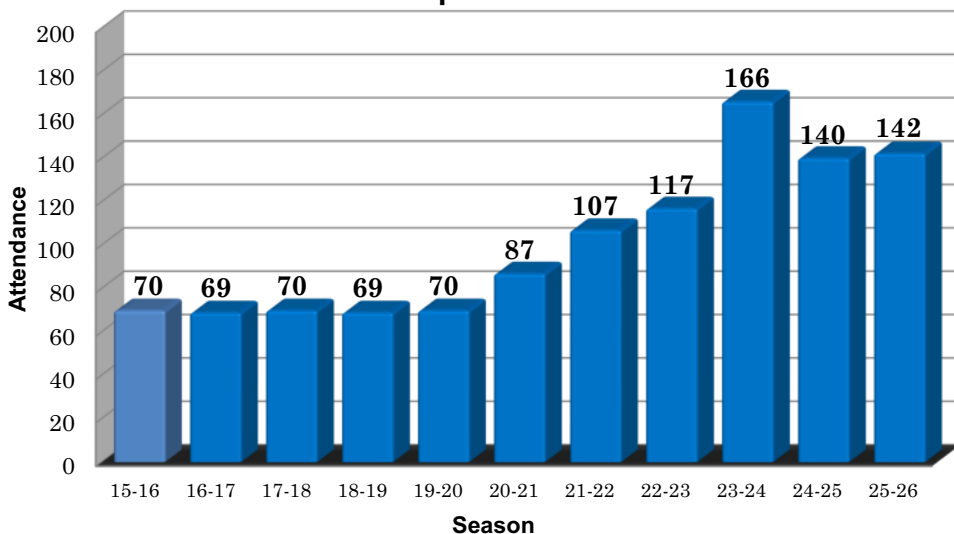

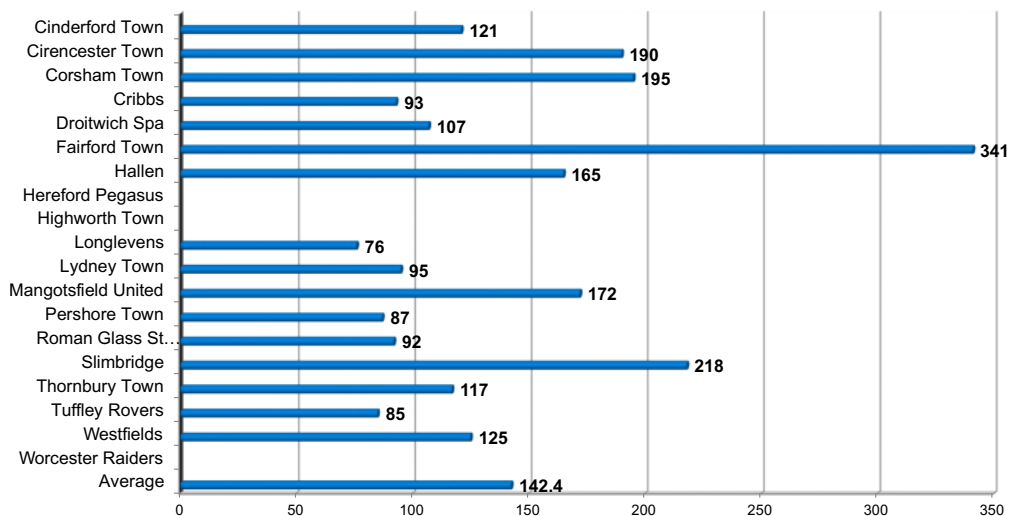

Playing some flowing football (in contrast to their hosts), Bassett certainly matched Corsham, with the teams trading chances after the hosts went ahead.

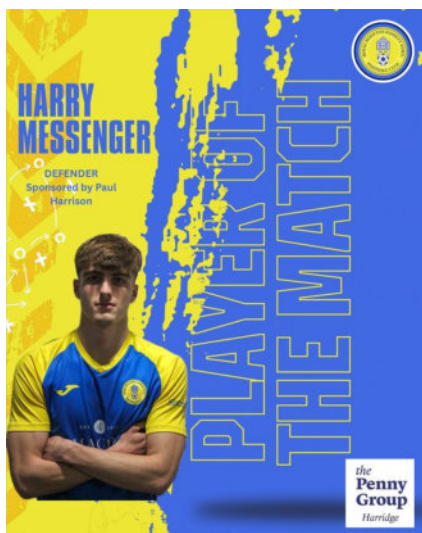

Chances were at a premium after the restart. However, the best opportunity of the half fell Bassett's way. Ollie Smith volleyed just wide of the left post after he ghosted into the box to connect with a Ben Cleary's low ball into the area. It was a case of so near yet so far for Bassett come full time.

A performance worthy of at least a point yielded only a narrow defeat. Two more tests against promotion candidates are up next with Worcester Raiders visiting the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground next week before a visit to Roman Glass St George. Produce a similar display to this one and Bassett should hopefully have something to show from a tough March run.

Crunch clash sees Bassett clinch crucial Corsham victory

Goals from Lauren Bulley and Laura Jefferies earned Royal Wootton Bassett Town a vital 2-0 derby victory away against Wiltshire rivals in the latest dramatic twist in the race for the South West Regional Women's Football League Division One North title.

Corsham had claimed a 2-0 victory against Bassett last month to break James Lally's side's unbeaten league record. And the Reds had then moved six points ahead of Bassett after winning last weekend when Lally and his team were on cup duty.

Although not do or die for Bassett, the return fixture was a game they could ill afford to lose. But with the pressure on - and fighting against atrocious conditions on a horrendously cut up pitch - Bassett delivered the goods.

What could have been a nine point deficit to leaders Corsham had they lost is now just a three point gap with two games in hand for Bassett to play.

There's still plenty of distance left to travel as the season enters its closing stages, with none of the five teams duking it out at the top yet to create any form of breathing room over their rivals.

But this result proved Bassett could get the job done in a high stakes setting.

They had led early on when Briony Hurd launched a long throw into the box and Bulley punished some slack defending from Alice Blackman, stealing possession from the Corsham centre half in the hosts' penalty area before crashing an emphatic drive into the back of the net via the underside of the crossbar.



Bulley almost grabbed a second midway through the half when seizing on an underhit back pass before dragging wide.

Sloppy defending at the other end then afforded the hosts a golden opportunity to equalise as Darcy Cox put too much on a pass back to Millie Powell, whose heavy touch fell to Ruby Hopkins but she steered over from the edge of the box.

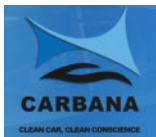
The difficult conditions only got worse in the second half as the driving rain got harder. But neither defensive flinched as they battled on, with no real clear cut chances

Eventually the outcome was settled late on - and captain Jefferies delivered the decisive blow. Stepping up to take a free kick on the right touchline a good forty yards from goal, she sent in a trademark towering delivery that flew into the net over the head of despairing Corsham 'keeper Lily Lewis.

Corsham sought desperately to use what time remained to get back into the game. And they almost did as Anna Lyons guided a Charlie Cowper free kick onto the bar. The ball then bounced back off Jefferies, with Powell springing acrobatically to her right to claw away what appeared a certain goal with an outstanding one-handed save. The danger wasn't clear though and the ball ricocheted back off Hurd before Powell, reacting quickly again, parried and smothered.

That secured a twelfth clean sheet of the season for Bassett - providing the cherry on the top of a crucial victory.

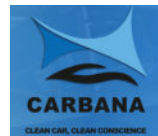

THE Class of 92 at Salford City, Ryan Reynolds and Rob McElhenney turbo-charging Wrexham and even Boyzone rocking up at Chorley, the Non-League game has long been appealing to celebrity investors.

As it would happen, Dagggers won their first game under KSI’s watchful gaze when they beat league leaders Dorking Wanderers 1-0.

Of course, opinions will vary on any celebrity involvement – as it did at Salford and Wrexham – but it’s fair to say the digital eyes of the world are on Non-League like never before. Technology has made the world a much smaller place and the game’s reach is greater than ever. Digital content is a huge factor in raising that awareness.

Last weekend, Witham Town enjoyed their biggest attendance in history – 1,205 – after YouTuber Ellis Platten encouraged his army of followers from his popular Away Days channel down to watch Town’s game against Gorleston in the Isthmian North.

“I think the English pyramid is the best in the world for many reasons,” Platten, who boasts 587,00 subscribers, said. “But one of the reasons is you can go anywhere in the country and within five minutes there will be a team which has a community to it. I don’t think there is anywhere else in the world that can rival that.”

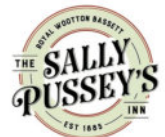

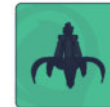
