Men's First Team

Bassett Bulletin

GOOD AFTERNOON and welcome back to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this UHlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against Cinderford Town. A warm welcome to all the players, management team, club officials and supporters from Cinderford who have made the journey from Gloucestershire. We hope you all enjoy your short stay with us this afternoon and we wish you a safe journey home.

Last week we extended our unbeaten run to four games with an excellent 3-0 win over Westfields, making it back-to-back 3-0 wins here at the GBSG after defeating Lydney Town in our previous home game. What are the chances of another 3-0 win here this afternoon? Whilst we are on a good run at the moment so too are today's opponents whose 3-1 home win over Corsham Town last week made it six games unbeaten in the league for Cinderford. From looking like they may get dragged into the relegation battle they have shot up the table and now sit in ninth spot in and with games in hand over a lot of the sides above them in the table and may yet finish in the play-offs. Having been relegated from the Southern League at the end of last season they could immediately bounce back after just one season at Step 5 and we know we will have to be at our best here this afternoon if we are to secure a result.

The two sides have only met five times previously, the most remembered fixture being the play-off final two seasons ago that we lost 4-0 here at the GBSG to miss out on the chance of promotion to the Southern League. Despite that defeat we have won as many as we have lost against Cinderford, with two wins, two defeats and one draw in those five games, with both teams having a penalty shoot out win in their two victories. The penalty shoot out win for Cinderford Town came in the game earlier this season in the FA Vase which finished 3-3 at the end of 90 minutes. A match report on that game is included in today's programme. We will be looking to avenge that cup defeat here this afternoon.

The Development Team were without a game last week and return to action this afternoon when they make the short trip down the road to play Purton Kingsdown at the Red House. When the two sides met at the GBSG at the end of November two goals from Flynn Walters and one from Ben Spackman secured a 3-0 win for Bassett so this afternoon Mark Simpkin's side will be looking to complete a league double over Purton Kingsdown to consolidate their current fifth place position in the league table.

The women's side suffered a setback in their quest for promotion last Sunday when they fell to their first defeat in the league this season, going down to two late goals against one of the sides they are vying for the title with, Corsham Town. It was a case of not taking our chances and then falling to a sucker punch at the end of the game. This week the women are again home when they take on Appledore from Division One South in the League Cup and manager James Lally will be keen that his side quickly return to winning ways. Whilst Bassett play in a Tier 6 division of 12 teams, Appledore's division at the same level has just five teams in it following several withdrawals before the season started and one after the season had commenced. A division of just five teams is way too small and is caused by the long travel distances that are expected of sides at the level. It is just one of a number of issues the FA have with the women's game where, in my view, they have sought to replicate the men's pyramid structure before the women's game is sufficiently developed in terms of the number of teams of the required standard for a fully operational pyramid.

Enjoy the match here this afternoon and hopefully we can extend our four game unbeaten run against a side who themselves are on a good run, and secure three vital points to help ensure we keep climbing that league table.

From The Committee Room with Paul Gerrish (Chairman)

GOOD AFTERNOON. It's a pleasure to welcome our supporters along with the players, officials and supporters from Cinderford Town FC to the Gerard Buxton ground today for this Hellenic Premier League fixture.

Both teams come into today's game in a rich vein of form. The recent form guide over the last six games shows a top versus third with Cinderford pipping us on account of having won one more game.

The Forrester's season can be broken down into three distinct sections; they began with a very mixed group of results, but league form fell away between October and Christmas, possibly due to their continued participation in the FA Vase. Since Christmas, along with the arrival of their new manager and a few key signings, their form has been almost perfect with five wins and a draw that sees them in with a chance of making the play-offs (and we know from our own experience what they are capable of when they get there!).

Returning to my comments last week about postponed matches due to waterlogged pitches, I understand that Cinderford are looking to put down an artificial surface but are facing a good deal of resistance which doesn't make much sense given their rugby club were able to put one down last year. I am a big advocate of playing on grass but there are clubs where artificial surfaces make sense and Cinderford Town certainly fall into that category – I wish them every success with their efforts that can only benefit club and community.

Our last game resulted in another important 3-0 win against Westfields – dare I say it was a Valentine's Day Massacre!! The win moved us up to 14th in the league, passing neighbours Highworth and more importantly ten points from the drop zone. It was another performance full of character against a team that had clearly set out to intimidate.



Hopefully, most of you will have seen the social media posts of Mick Woolford presenting Rudi with his Player of the Month award for January. Mick is a Life Member of the club and managed the team from the mid 80's up until 1995. Under his leadership the club won the Wilts League (no mean feat back then) and established the club in the Hellenic League picking up a couple of Cup wins along the way. Mick can be seen at most home games sat in the back of the stand, often with Swindon legends Don Rogers and John Trollope. His presence and support is greatly appreciated.

Unfortunately, despite dominating the game, the Women fell to a 2-0 smash and grab defeat to Corsham Town last Sunday, losing their undefeated record. At the half way stage, the league is looking very competitive with probably six teams all in the mix. Tomorrow they take on Appledore from Devon in the League Cup 2nd Round.

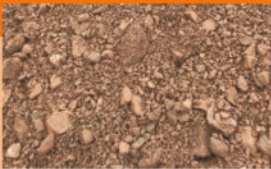

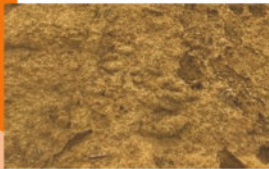

Today's Opponents

Cinderford Town

Cinderford Town was formed in 1922 and played in the Glos Northern Senior League until 1939. In that year they joined the newly formed Bristol Charity League, but this folded two weeks later at the outbreak of World War Two. They then joined the Western League Division 2, and in 1957 won the title. During the two seasons they spent in the top flight, they set a ground attendance record, when a home game with Minehead saw 4,850 people in attendance. Sadly, participation at this level put severe financial pressure on the Club, who were then forced to withdraw and return to the Glos Northern Senior League.

Three years later, the Club made the unusual decision to join the Warwickshire Combination, and won a League and Cup double in 1964, which saw them step up to the West Midlands (Regional) League. A very strong league at the time, with member clubs such as Kidderminster Harriers, Boston United, Tamworth and Hednesford. 1968-69 season was their last at this level, but they bowed out as Joint League Cup winners with Kidderminster. Both Clubs shared the Trophy for 6 months.

Cinderford returned to play in the newly formed Gloucestershire County League for the 1969-70 season and stayed for the next 5 years, finishing as runners-up on 3 occasions. They again sought a higher standard of football, and were accepted into the Midland Combination. Town played in this League for the next 10 seasons, achieving a best finish of 4th and also winning the League Cup, before being forced to return to the Glos County League following financial problems relating to the Social Club. A new Committee stabilised the Club, so much so that floodlights were purchased outright, and in the 1990-91 season, the Club gained admission to the Hellenic League, initially in Division 1, where they won the title at the first attempt. Four years later, the Club claimed an historic first by winning the Premier Division title, the League Cup and the Hellenic Floodlight Cup, and stepped up to the Southern League, with 28 years unbroken membership. The 1995-96 season saw Cinderford embark on an incredible FA Cup run, beating 2 Conference Clubs to reach the Second Round Proper, holding Gravesend & Northfleet to a 1-1 home draw before losing 3-0 in the replay in Kent. The winners were drawn with Aston Villa in the Third Round.

In the 2015-16 season, Cinderford were Champions of Southern League Div 1, South & West, but initially rejected promotion when undisclosed debts were discovered. However they accepted promotion following a series of appeals which affected the constitution of the League going into the new season. The Club were duly relegated in their first season in the Premier Division, returning to play in the Southern League First Division again.

Under the then leadership of Manager Paul Michael, the Club went from strength to strength, with a League Cup Final appearance, losing to a single goal at Premier Division side Stratford Town, and reaching a League play-off final, losing away at Yate Town, who persuaded Paul to join them for their promotion to the Premier Division.

Former Bishops Cleeve Manager Steve Cleal was appointed to replace Paul Michael but after an unsuccessful spell, he was succeeded as Manager by Alex Sykes, the former Gloucester City and Forest Green player, who was also unable to improve matters on the pitch.

After an incredible 28 consecutive seasons as members of the Southern League, the Club were relegated at the end of the 2022-2023 season, to rejoin the Hellenic League Premier Division.

Alex Sykes left the Club by mutual consent, and was replaced by former Merthyr Town player and former Manager at Welsh Club Aberbargoed, Matt Driscoll, who had the unenviable task of rebuilding the entire squad, with only one senior player remaining from the Southern League side.

Within a few months of the new season, the new squad was taking shape, and the early season of mixed results began to change, and the Club started it's climb up the table. The League title was never going to be achievable with Worcester City the dominant Club all season, but a successful run in saw us clinch 5th place, and into the playoffs.

An away trip to 2nd placed Corsham Town saw us claim a great 1-0 win, and a final away game in the playoff final to Royal Wootton Bassett Town, and an emphatic 4-0 win secured our place back in the Southern League after a one season break. Unfortunately, our return to the Southern League was short-lived with relegation back to the Hellenic Premier for 2025-26.



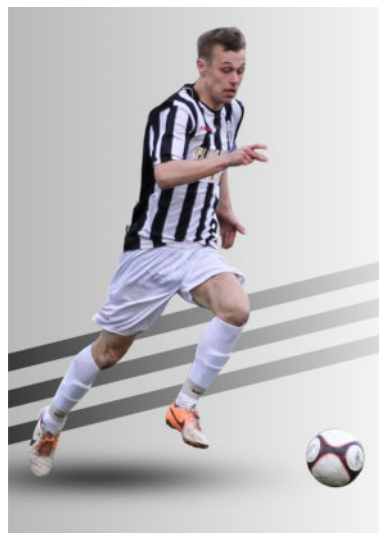

Penalties pain follows late agony

Saturday 23rd August 2025

Royal Wootton Bassett Town suffered a double dose of cup agony as they exited the Isuzu FA Vase at the first qualifying round stage with a penalty shootout defeat away at Hellenic League Premier Division rivals Cinderford Town.

A Jono Peachey-Score brace and Kye Williams strike had put Bassett 3-2 ahead in a back and forth tie.

While Cinderford were putting Bassett under a significant amount of pressure late on, Jonny Aitkenhead's side seemed set to seal a date with Wokingham Town in the second qualifying round too.

However, with just two minutes of time remaining Nathan Dennis salvaged an equaliser for the Foresters that forced the tie to penalties. And, after nine perfect spot kicks, Jack Smith denied Marcel Lewis to secure a 5-4 shootout win for Cinderford.

Bassett, who acquitted themselves well, played their full part in an entertaining tie.

Aitkenhead's side were quick out of the blocks too, leading as early as the fifth minute when Peachey-Score produced a lovely finish to open his Bassett account.

But Cinderford were soon on level terms as Joe Cattermole guided home from a corner. And they led six minutes before the break, Kian Davies taking advantage to score what Bassett will feel was something of a soft goal.



They could have been further in front going into the break too but Fraser Needham in the Bassett goal did well to deny Jaxson Hundt.

Bassett would turn the tie around immediately after the restart though, catching their hosts - as well as some of those in attendance - by surprise with a pair of quickfire goals.

Williams was first to strike, doing so within less than a minute of the second half.

And Peachey-Score soon added his second to restore Bassett's lead.

Cinderford increasingly piled the pressure as the second half wore on but couldn't find a way through, Lewis Powell coming closest with quarter of an hour to go.

But frustration turned to relief for the hosts - with Bassett suffering their first agonising blow - when Dennis made it 3-3.

That meant penalties - and a shootout that was a masterclass in how to hold your nerve.

Cinderford went first with Powell scoring before Peachey-Score replied for Bassett. Davies, Cattermole and Ryan Hiller all found the net for the hosts, with Ben Cleary, Jordan Sykes and Kian McNally doing so for Bassett to keep the visitors on terms.

The final round of penalties began with Sam Hunt netting for Cinderford, meaning it was now sudden death. And Lewis was thwarted for Bassett as the hosts edged through.

Rampant Bassett set sights higher after thumping Fields

Saturday 14th February 2026

What a difference ten games can make.

Following a 6-3 defeat at Hallen in mid-November, Bassett seemed set to be in a fight for one thing only: their survival in the Hellenic League Premier Division.

Fast forward ten games though, and a run that has yielded six wins - the latest an emphatic 3-0 triumph against Westfields - as well as two draws has put Jonny Aitkenhead's side in contention for a top half finish.

Such a possibility seemed a world away three months ago. Now, however, that has to be the target thanks to a spell that has Bassett top of the form charts.

It's true that Bassett aren't yet secure of safety. But their eyes can now be more firmly set on chasing down the sides above them rather than being cast anxiously at those beneath them.

Against Westfields a vital goal on the stroke of half time and a strong showing after the restart sealed the points.

The opening period had been a rather cagey affair with neither 'keeper really being troubled.

The best opportunities of the half came at its midway point with Rudi Hopkins dragging just wide of the left post for Bassett, before an unmarked Raiyan Ahmed skewed a shot off target from Zac Powell's dangerous low ball across the box.

The game seemed destined to head into the interval deadlocked.

But with 44 minutes on the clock, Bassett got the breakthrough courtesy of leading scorer Ben Cleary.

Ollie Smith was first to a clearance from 'keeper Ryan Smallwood, heading into the feet of Nat Bell who, playing in a deeper role than usual, held off his man before delivering an outstanding ball forward that split the Westfields defence. Cleary was the beneficiary, latching onto the ball before bearing down on goal and producing a cool finish into the bottom right corner.

Bell then doubled Bassett's lead early in the second half. Hopkins swung in a free kick from the right wing that fell to Bell on the edge of the area, and his powerful half volley nestled in the corner with the aid of a slight deflection.

A brilliant counter attack soon made it 3-0. Gabe Reivers began the move, heading forward to Ed Taylor, who - despite his diminutive stature - showed his strength to help the ball on to Cleary. With his back to goal, Cleary played a clever pass into the left channel for an overlapping George Cook, and he squared into the box for an unmarked Hopkins who made no mistake.

Westfields were well beaten - and to compound matters were reduced to ten men with quarter of an hour remaining when Connor Davies-Austin saw red for a heavy tackle.

That helped Bassett see the game out and preserve a second consecutive clean sheet.

A home fixture against fellow form side Cinderford Town is up next - with Bassett entering that clash full of confidence and with the intent to pull within two points of the eighth place Foresters.

Left-sided winger who joins this season. Over the past couple of seasons he has featured for the Swindon Town Foundation C6 team - including the 23-24 side that won the Community & Education Football Alliance Cup - and Fairford T U18s & making 1 Hellenic League appearance for Fairford.



Lewis Hayward - Midfield

Central midfielder who joins Bassett this season. Spent time in Southampton's Academy as a youth & is currently a member of Chippenham Town's Academy & was a part of their side who recently won the Copa Catalunya tournament, scoring in the final and voted club Player of the Tournament.



Lewis Thorne - Defender

An industrious, aggressive full back who joined Bassett part way through this season. A player who is capable of playing further forward in midfield. He began his career with Thame United and made his Northern League and has also played for North Leigh and Hungerford Town.



George Cook - Midfield

Promising young midfielder who signed for Bassett this season. A clever wide player, with skill and good pace, Cook made an impression with the Development team in the Wiltshire League Premier Division before making the step up to the Men's First Team squad..



Callum Godfrey - Goalkeeper

A gifted young goalkeeper who joined Bassett on loan from Forest Green Rovers in December. A member of Rovers' Under 18 side, Godfrey has featured on the bench for Forest Green in the National League Cup - demonstrating how highly rated he is by his parent club.



Ollie Smith – Defence



Whilst **Royal Wootton Bassett Town** were securing that impressive 3-0 win over **Westfields** last Saturday thanks to goals from Ben Cleary, Nat Bell and Rudi Hopkins (see elsewhere in today's programme for the match report from the game), due to cup competitions there were just two other league games played. One of those involved today's opponents **Cinderford Town** who made it six games unbeaten with an impressive 3-1 home win over **Corsham Town** who are in a play-off position. A goal on 12 minutes from Kian Davies set Cinderford on their way and two goals from Ben Watkins before the break saw Cinderford in control at the break with a 3-0 half time lead. Whilst Corsham pulled one back through Oliver Sulley the goal didn't come until two minutes from time and was nothing more than a consolation goal as Cinderford ran out comfortable winners.

The other league game played on Saturday was at **Pershore Town** where the home side entertained **Tuffley Rovers**. Pershore recent poor run which has seen them win just once in 17 games continued as they fell to a 3-0 defeat. On target for Tuffley were Karnell Chambers, Preston Mason and Elijah Simpson.

Hallen were involved in FA Vase action and, whilst they are struggling at the wrong end of the Premier Division table, they are clearly saving their best form for this prestigious national competition, and on Saturday made it through to the last eight of the competition thanks to a 3-0 home win over Gornal Athletic. A goal from Cory Thomas-Barker just before the break set them on their way and two second half goals from Harrison Fairman saw Hallen progress to the quarter final stage where they will meet West Didsbury & Chorlton at the end of the month.

There were also three games played in the League Cup on Saturday. A solitary goal from Jordan Williamson seven minutes from time was enough to see **Hereford Pegasus** progress at the expense of **Highworth Town**.

It was even closer between **Mangotsfield United** and **Worcester Raiders** with penalties being needed to decide matters after it finished 2-2 at the end of 90 minutes, Brandon Bak and James Byrne scoring for Mangotsfield with Jordan Murphy and Adam Taylor replying for Worcester Raiders. It was Raiders who held their nerve in the shoot out to win 5-3 on penalties.

Slimbridge also progressed to the next round thanks to a 3-1 away win over Division One side Stonehouse Town. On target for Slimbridge were Oliver Barnes, Joseph Shutt and Joseph Stokes.

There were two league games played in midweek and **Hereford Pegasus** made it two wins in the space of three days with a 2-1 away success at struggling **Lydney Town**, Joe Davis and Harry Pitman both scoring for Hereford Pegasus in the closing stages of the first half. **Westfields** poor run of recent results continued when they were beaten 2-0 at home by **Fairford Town**, Adam Mace and Harrison Edwards scoring the two Fairford Town goals that saw Sam Collier's side move up to eighth place in the table.

There were also two games played in the Floodlit Cup. **Highworth Town** bounced back from that League Cup defeat on Saturday by scoring five unanswered goals away to Alcester Town with former Bassett player Bensa Teshome scoring a hat-trick with another ex-Bassett player Bailey Gallagher also getting on the score sheet, Cheldon Valere with the other Highworth goal. Highworth will now be away to Hungerford Town Reserves, conquerors of Bassett, in the quarter final.

Longlevens AFC joined Worcester Raiders and Malmesbury Vics in the semi-finals with a 3-1 away win at **Cribbs**. Longlevens will now be away to Worcester Raiders in those semi-finals with Malmesbury Vics set to be at home to the winner of the Hungerford v Highworth quarter final tie.

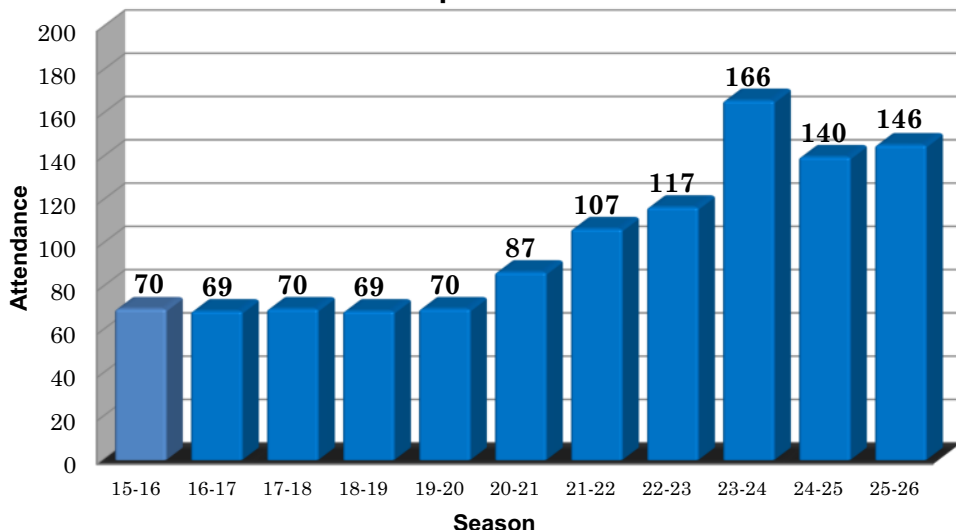

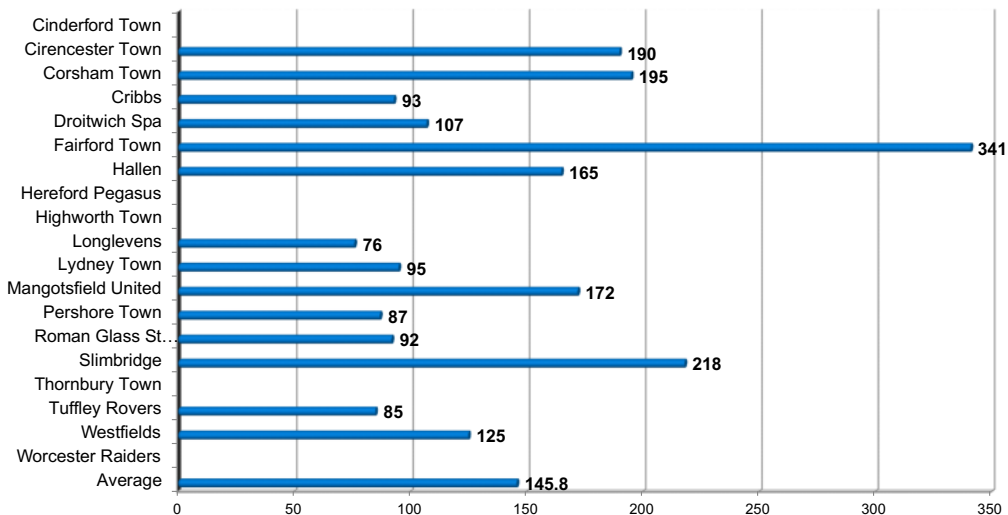

From Editor's Football Collection

European Football Yearbooks

The European Football Yearbook was first published in 1988 by Facer Books, edited by Mike Hammond, and the first edition ran to 608 pages. I purchased that first edition – featuring Euro '88-winning duo Ruud Gullit and Marco van Basten in that infamous orange 'pyramid-effect' kit on the front cover. The book was launched, to some fanfare, by Facer Books at Wembley Stadium before an England Italia '90 World Cup qualifier against Sweden. That first edition contained colour team photos and colour team badges, but subsequent issues were not quite so grand.

The history of the publication has been something of a rollercoaster ride, with three of its editions, though compiled and completed, for one reason or another having never seen the light of day. In the late 1990s and early 2000s – before the internet really got going – it regularly used to top the best seller charts of Sportspages, a book shop specialising in sports books and based in London's West End.

After the initial publication, the book was subsequently published by Birmingham based publisher Sports Projects Limited and whilst the team photos were no published there were still colour team badges and team kits for all the countries featured.

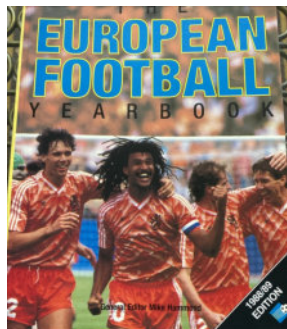
After 13 years with Sports Projects, the book underwent a two-year makeover during which it was obliged to change its name to the European Book of Football, but its big break came in 2007 when UEFA generously decided to take the publication under their wing. The original name was restored, official statistics from all UEFA competitions were added, and it also became a lot more colourful (see extract from 2013-14 Edition below left).

I have 24 editions of what became known as the 'the Bible of European football' including every season from 2007-08 to the final edition in 2017-18. However, UEFA decided that 30 years was enough and withdrew their support, bringing one of football's longest-running annual publications to an end. In its place Soccer Books Limited now publish 'The Yearbook of European Football' which includes the statistical information that was previously included in the European Football Yearbook but does not contain any team pictures, kit pictures or pictures of badges. I have the first seven editions in the new format but have yet to purchase the 2025-26 Edition (see picture below) as I normally pick up a copy towards the end of the season when the price is discounted. It is packed with fantastic statistical information but is not as good as that very first edition and the editions produced by Sports Projects Limited.

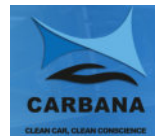

Alfie's dad Mark picked up the Unsung Hero award at our NGAs back in 2016 in recognition of all the family were doing in raising awareness of a rare life-limiting condition.

Apart from being an amazing story about a dad and lad's connection to the beautiful game, it was touching to see the impact they were having.

What started at the local park grew into father and son travelling to games throughout the steps to collect enough items to surround a football pitch if tied together.

Mark arrived at Chelsea's Stamford Bridge – where we held the awards back in 2016 – with rolls of scarves he unfurled to decorate the room. It was quite the talking point among guests as they scoured the colourful display looking for clubs they knew.

Shirts donated along the way were later sold, with the funds raised going to MECP2 Duplication Syndrome UK, supporting families with respite breaks, long hospital stays, sensory equipment and, sadly, funeral costs.

Since then, Alfie's scarf haul has passed 3,438 and the ESL are hoping to help them reach a huge milestone with clubs already donating their own colours.

"There is now a new target in sight, we at Essex Senior League would like to help get Alfie to 5,000 scarves!" the ESL said. "If any level of the game can help make that happen, it's Non-League football."

"If any club, supporters or league can donate a scarf, old or new, you can help Alfie take another step towards that incredible milestone."

While Alfie isn't able to travel as far any more, the duo can often be seen out and about at Non-League grounds in the north west or at their Wigan Athletic.

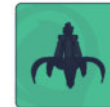
