Bassett Bulletin

GOOD AFTERNOON and welcome back to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this UHlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against Thornbury Town. A warm welcome to all the players, management team, club officials and supporters from Thornbury who have made the journey down the M4 from Bristol. We hope you all enjoy your short stay with us this afternoon and we wish you a safe journey home.

Last week we further extended our unbeaten run, making it now five games unbeaten, with four victories in that run, thanks to an excellent 2-1 win over an in-form Cinderford Town side. We rode our luck at times, particularly in the first half, but in the end in my view we fully deserved the three points based on the work rate alone. I think the Cinderford supporters expected to go home with three easy points and were vocal from the start, but we sent what must be the oldest group of ultras I have seen in a while back home disappointed.

Defensively we were solid throughout apart from the goal conceded and we dealt with the pressure that Cinderford put on the back four and Callum in the closing stages really well. Earlier in the season we would have probably conceded in those closing stages with that level of pressure but last Saturday demonstrated how well the side has developed over the season.

Today is another vital encounter against one of the other sides down at the bottom of the table. We lost to Thornbury on the opening day of the season at the end of July, but I understand we put in a decent performance and were unlucky to lose 2-0. Despite that defeat our overall record against Thornbury Town is a good one with eight wins and a draw and just two defeats in the previous eleven meetings with Thornbury. Hopefully this afternoon we can continue our good run of late and make it nine wins to continue our climb up the UHlsport Hellenic League Premier Division table.

The Development Team last Saturday picked up a useful point following a high scoring 3-3 draw away at near neighbours Purton Kingsdown. Bassett remain fifth in the table but, along with last Saturday's opponents, have played more games than anyone else in the division. Mark Simpkins side have just five games still to play but hopefully should ensure they finish the season in the top half of the table and certainly don't have to worry about any relegation concerns this season.

Unfortunately the women's side saw their cup encounter with Division One South side Appledore postponed with their scheduled opponents unable to raise a side meaning Bassett were given a walkover into the next round. Our Quarter Final opponents will be Bitton here at the GBSG, a tough draw with Bitton up there in the league table having, like ourselves, lost just once in the league so far this season. We also now know who our opponents will be in the Wiltshire FA County Cup final and it is no surprise that it will be cup favourites Swindon Town who will be our opponents at Melksham Town on April 19th, Swindon having beaten Bemerton Heath Harlequins 9-0 in their semi-final tie.

It is not long now until the highlight of the Youth Section's season, the annual tour to Holland. The tour party depart on Saturday 28th of March, returning on Tuesday 31st March and the three Bassett sides will play fixtures against SV Monster and FC 's-Gravenzande.

Enjoy the match here this afternoon and hopefully we can extend our five game unbeaten run against another side who themselves are on a good run, and secure three vital points to help ensure we keep climbing that league table.

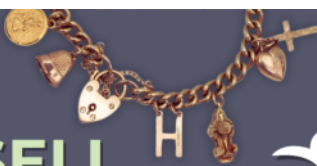

Today's Opponents

Thornbury Town

It is understood that football has been played in Thornbury from around 1898 and formerly known as Thornbury Sports became Thornbury Town FC in the early 1970's.

1968-69 we became founder members of the Gloucestershire County League and spectator figures in excess of 500 were regularly recorded. In 1971 the club finished third in the Gloucestershire County League and was accepted into the Western League. However, due to difficulties in bringing the facilities up to the leagues required standards were unable to take the next step up. Relegation to the Bristol Premier Combination League unfortunately followed in 1976-77.

The following 20+ years saw Thornbury Town strive to regain their former status, never really threatening to take the Premier Combination title. The only success during these lean years was reaching the final of the GFA Senior Amateur Cup in 1985-86 and 1989-90 unfortunately on both occasions loser's medals were received.

During the late 1990's, the Club maintained its strong focus on developing local talent and this eventually bore fruit in 1999 when the final of the Stroud Charity Cup was reached, losing narrowly to Dursley Town. 2001-02 season saw the management team of Dave Wiffill and Steve Burbage take the reins, which brought instant success winning the Bristol Premier Combination title by 13 points and a return to the Gloucestershire County League. This followed a run of thirteen consecutive league wins a club record, which still stands to this day. The league and cup double eluded the club when they were defeated by Sea Mills in the League Cup Final.

In preparation for the return to County League football the summer of 2002 saw a lot of hard work undertaken on the Mundy facilities with the building of dug-outs, improved drainage and revamping of the dressing rooms. All this work appeared to have been worth while with the club establishing itself back in the Gloucestershire County league with a creditable 7th league position for the next three seasons. Silverware did come our way in 2003-04 when we defeated Taverners on penalties, after a 2-2 draw, to lift the Stroud Charity Cup. The 2003-04 season, also saw the formation of an Under-18's side in order to maintain Youth development within the club and they gained entry to the Gloucester County Youth League.

Following a number of indifferent seasons when relegation back to the Bristol Premier Combination league was only just averted in 2006-07, a new management committee and first team management were appointed. Dave Lippiatt took over as first team manager, coming to the club from Sea Mills Park bringing with him Carl Derosa as his assistant. With an initial three / four year strategy, which came to fruition during the 2009-10 season when after a steady first half to the season a tremendous winning run of ten league games saw the Surridge Gloucestershire County League title won for the first time in the clubs history. 2010 also saw the milestone achievement of the long awaited coming together of the two local football clubs "Thornbury Town FC" and "Thornbury Falcons FC" now under one club management umbrella of Thornbury Town FC without losing the heritage and identity of Thornbury Falcons. This will further enhance the long term development within the local community for junior, youth and senior football.

In the 2010-11 season the final of the Les James Cup Final was reached, which resulted in a penalty shoot-out disappointment against Henbury Town. 2013-14 saw the U18's in their highest league position in the Gloucestershire County Youth League finishing runners-up, which was a tremendous achievement for the team and managers Simon Pirie and Mark Franklin. The 2014-15 season was a very successful season finishing 4th in the league and winning the Les James Cup for the first time in the Club's history. Andy Davies continued to produce a team of quality which resulted in a third 4th-place in a row in Season 2016-17. 2017-18 saw the club finally succeed in their quest win the Gloucestershire County League. After a lot of work behind the scenes to gain planning permission for the required ground improvements, the club were accepted into the Hellenic League for the first time in our history.

Our first season in the Hellenic League saw us finish a creditable 3rd in Div 1 West and win the Supplementary Cup. 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 seasons were ruled null and void due to the Coronavirus pandemic with the team poised to gain promotion. A restructuring of the football pyramid placed us in the Hellenic Premier Division where we are now competing for our fourth season.

With a management team of Richard Joyce and newly appointed assistant Tim Wilkins in place we look forward to the season ahead and wish all teams the best of luck in their endeavours.

Despite an energetic, positive performance, Royal Wootton Bassett Town's Hellenic League Premier Division opener ended in defeat as Callum Chalmers' brace earned hosts Thornbury Town a 2-0 victory.

And Jonny Aitkenhead's side had further chances with Lewis - who was forced to withdraw with a hamstring injury before the interval - and Jonathan Peachey-Score both dragging just wide of the post.



But Thornbury would get their noses in front as Chalmers drew and converted a penalty.

Playing from behind, Bassett enjoyed a lively start to the second half. But the closest they came was through Ed Taylor who shot just over on the hour.

Otherwise, Bassett could not unlock the Thornbury defence - and their route back into the game seemingly disappeared when Chalmers stole possession, bore down on goal and slotted home.

After a solid preseason, the real test for Jonny Aitkenhead's new look outfit was always going to be the first fixture that meant something.

And Bassett can certainly look beyond the result against a Thornbury side who are on the up after a strong finish to the previous campaign.

There are plenty of positives to take from a fixture whose outcome was in the balance most of the night and in which Aitkenhead's charges impressed those in attendance.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town's superb run of form continued with a hard fought and deserved 2-1 victory against Cinderford Town in the battle of the Hellenic League Premier Division's form sides.

Both teams entered the game looking to extend fantastic runs. Bassett came into the match with the best record in the league over their last ten games while Cinderford were unbeaten in six games since December, a change of manager having made a big difference for the Foresters.

It would end up being the hosts who maintained their hot streak though - much to the disappointment of the visitors who weren't happy with their defeat. After a stop-start opening to the game, Cinderford eventually got on top. But, as it had done in consecutive 3-0 wins against Lydney Town and Westfields, the home defence stood strong.

Bassett had a slice of luck on 15 minutes. Callum Godfrey and Ciaran Walsh both went for the same ball following right back Adam Davies' delivery into the box, leaving the 'keeper out of position. But Jack Watts' snap volley from ten yards out rattled the bar with Bassett eventually able to clear.

Aside from that moment though, Cinderford failed to convert their pressure into meaningful chances. And shortly after the half hour mark Bassett drew blood. The quick strike counter attack has been Bassett's forte in recent weeks - and it delivered success again.

Walsh won possession on the edge of his own penalty area with a perfectly timed tackle. The ball broke for his central defensive partner Jack Coward who strode forward and clipped a fine pass over the top of the Cinderford defence for Ben Cleary to run onto. Cleary then chopped inside Ben Vine before coolly stroking past Lewis Adams.

Cinderford pulled level five minutes later as Watts delicately headed a Harry Leeson cross into the net via the underside of the bar from ten yards out.

Although parity was restored it didn't last long. George Cook teased in a corner from the right side and, stealing a march on his marker, Rudi Hopkins glanced a near post header that nestled into the bottom left corner for his tenth goal of the season - and eighth in as many games.

The second half saw Cinderford again frustrated by a stoic Bassett defence. They again applied plenty of pressure - even when briefly down to ten men as Watts was sin binned - but failed to really trouble the Bassett goal.

Their best opportunity fell to Kian Davies who stung Godfrey's palms with a free kick on the hour. And Bassett almost grabbed a third late on when TJ Bohane shot on the turn from the edge of the area, seeing his low effort tipped away by an outstretched Adams.

A professional, mature display enabled Bassett to see the game out as they continued on their upward trajectory.

From having appeared destined to be in a relegation scrap, the top half is now within touching distance for Jonny Aitkenhead's young guns.

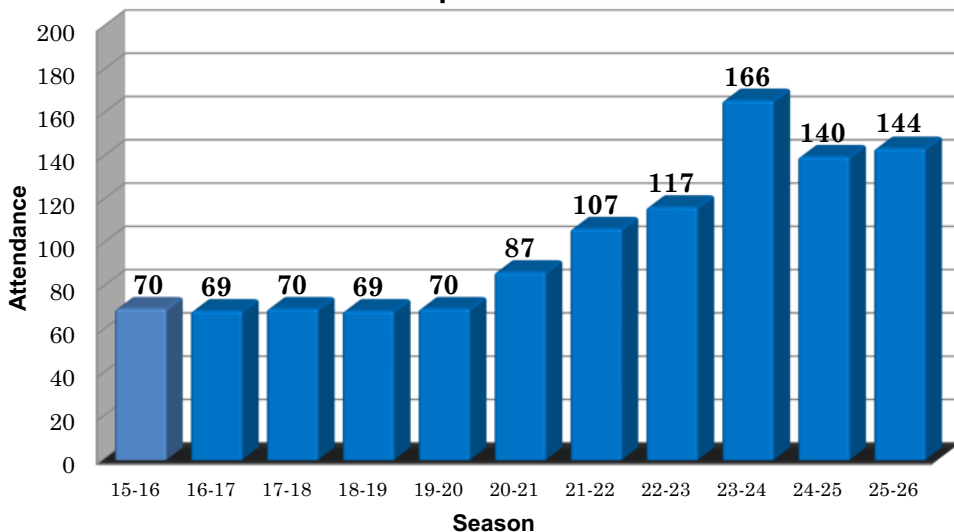

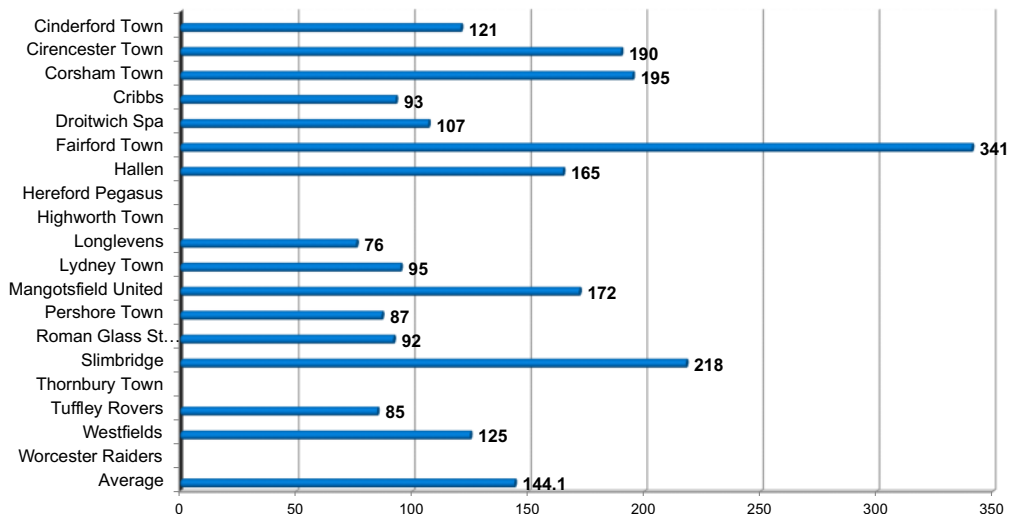

From Editor's Football Collection

Football Shirt Books

Over the years I have accumulated quite a collection of replica football shirts for my two favourite teams, Queens Park Rangers and Borussia Monchengladbach. For QPR shirts I stopped counting once I got to 50 and I think I have about 15 Borussia Monchengladbach shirts now. With the 'QPR Cash' you get for buying a season ticket and attending games you usually have enough to get your shirt each year effectively included in the price of the season ticket, especially if you time the purchase right when the club shop has a sale on.

In addition to the shirts themselves in recent seasons both my two clubs have brought out excellent books featuring their shirts and training kits over the years since formation at the end of the 19th century.

The first of the two to bring out such a book were the German side in 2021. The book entitled "Das Gladbach Trikot" is a large hardback book that runs to some 255 pages. It contains lots of great pictures, not only of the team kits but also the team and players over the years, most of which are high quality colour photos. There are lots of articles about the team and the kits, although my challenge is that it takes me a long time to read each one and usually I only get a rough idea of what is being said as my German still needs a lot of work on it. There are lots of interesting statistics throughout that are easily understood. This includes a table showing the price of a replica shirt from Season 1981-82 through to Season 2021-22. During that period Gladbach shirt supplier was either Puma, Asics, Reebok, Lotto or Kappa, with Puma being the supplier both at the start and end of the period. In 1981-82 the cost of a shirt was €17.90 but had risen to a staggering €84.95 by Season 2021-22.

At the end of the book there is a list of all the player squad numbers for each and every season from 1995-96 through to Season 2020-21 and I am assuming 1995-96 was the first season that player specific numbers were first introduced.

Another piece of fascinating information is the list of shirt sponsors over the years, and the amount of money paid to have the sponsors name on the shirt. The first sponsor was Ruhrgas with the brand name 'Erdgas' on the shirt back in Season 1975-76 for which Borussia were paid just DM750k. Whilst Datsun had been sponsor for three seasons, Erdgas picked it up again in Season 1983-84 and remained sponsor until 1989-90 but the cost remained at DM750k. The amount paid by sponsors started to escalate in subsequent seasons with the names of a few beer brands appearing on the shirts and a computer company. Season 2009-10 was when serious money started to be paid with Deutsche Postbank AG taking over as sponsor and paying €4.5m for the privilege. By Season 2019-20 this had risen to between €6.5 to €9.0m presumably based on final league position. When Flatex took over as sponsor in Season 2020-21 the figure was €9.0m.

It is also interesting to see how the adverts for the club shop merchandise have changed over the years. Whilst the catalogue for 1982 is certainly optically pleasing, I am not sure they would get away with some of the pictures these days!

The book can be purchased in the UK on Amazon for just £24.38 and is highly recommended to any fans of German football and Borussia Monchengladbach in particular.

Going back to the shirts themselves, a lot of my shirts are picked up from the excellent Classic Football Shirts website (<https://www.classicfootballshirts.com>), where you can often purchase a brand-new shirt at very low prices come the end of a particular season. Be warned though that there are also lots of older shirts, usually second hand, that go for a lot of money! They cover shirts from clubs all over the world and the service is always first class.

I will feature the QPR book of kits that came out this season in a subsequent programme.



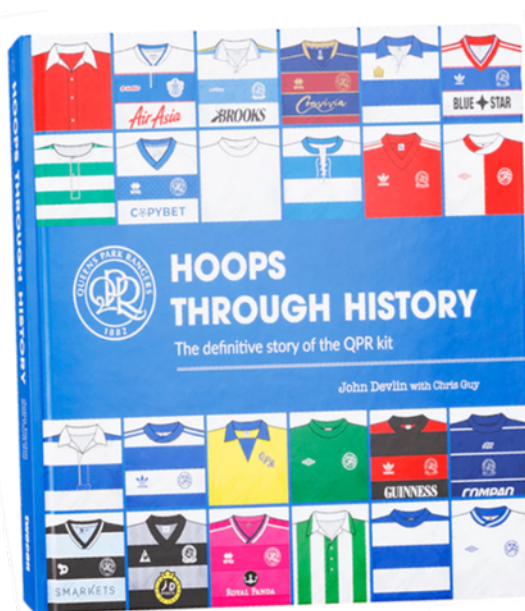

Only problem for me is that at the moment my German is not sufficient to be able to read all the features. Hopefully when I step away from my league duties I can spend my time on German lessons.

The definitive story of the QPR kit from 1882 to 2026 and they were not always blue and white hoops! The book also features all the away kits and goalkeeper kits as well. The book even includes the famous Shellsuit from the early 1990's (I am sure there is a picture of me in one of them somewhere). More on this book in a subsequent programme.

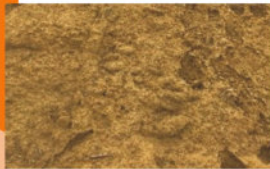

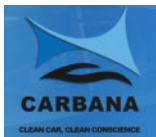

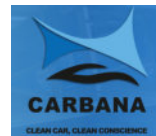

CHARLIE Wyke must be the bravest, but also unluckiest, footballer going.

Four years ago, the striker, now at Carlisle United, suffered a heart-attack during a training session for Wigan Athletic and actually died for four minutes.

But that traumatic experience was nothing compared to the physical and mental anguish the 33-year-old has endured over the last 16 months.

In October 2024, shortly after coming on as a substitute for Carlisle in a League Two match against Cheltenham, Wyke was felled by a heavy tackle from Luke Young.

"I broke my leg, dislocated my ankle, tore every ligament, damaged the cartilage - it was like six or seven different injuries in one," the former Bradford City, Sunderland and Rotherham striker exclusively told The NLP last week.

"I had multiple operations, screws and pins put in my leg. And the pain - I honestly can't describe it.

"Everybody knows about my cardiac arrest, and objectively that's 100 times worse. But there was no pain with that. I had to have a lot of tests, missed a lot of football. Day to day, though, it didn't really bother me.

"This was so much harder. I was battling the pain literally every day. I had to call an ambulance like three times because the pot on my ankle was too tight. At one point, I didn't sleep for six nights straight and started hallucinating.

"I'd been watching Black Mirror on Netflix and there was an episode where somebody turns into a werewolf. One night, I thought the werewolf was in my bedroom. I was screaming and shouting. I felt like I was going mad.

"On top of that, I had the surgeon telling me I was done. I went up to see him five or six times, and the message was always the same. He said 'You're 33, it's a massive injury - my advice is to retire immediately'.

"He said that nobody fully recovers from something like this, and even if I did get back to running and playing football then I'd struggle badly with arthritis for the rest of my life. You hear that, and your whole life just stops. It's been horrendous, absolutely horrendous."

Wyke defied his doctor's orders to continue a 14-year career that saw him score 130 goals in 358 EFL appearances, featuring in last month's 3-1 National League victory over Altrincham at Brunton Park. Or at least, it should have been emotional. Unfortunately for Wyke, part of the medication for managing his heart condition includes an adrenalin suppressant.

"The reception I got coming on, I should have been absolutely buzzing," he says. "But it's just a bit... different. It's the same when you score a goal. There isn't that rush.

"I think if I went on a rollercoaster these days, I'd just be sitting there bored, waiting for it to finish! It's a very strange feeling."

Sadly, he won't be back for long. Wyke may have won the battle, but acknowledges that the war is lost. He can barely train, suffers constant swelling and can't even manage half an hour of competitive action.

"I'll never be able to start a game again," he admits. "If you ask anyone who has been to the last few games, I can't even warm up properly.

"Coming on for five or ten minutes is just about alright. I could do 25 at a push. But if I did that my knee and ankle would swell up massive and I wouldn't be able to train for the rest of the week.

"So yeah, it goes without saying that my days are numbered. I'll probably go until the end of the season, then that will be me.

"It's not ideal. Nobody wants to retire, especially at 33. But as the surgeon said, you have to look at the bigger picture.

"My son Albie is six and he's mad into football. I've already missed a good 14 months of taking him to training, playing with him in the garden, all that sort of stuff. I don't want to be a 40-year-old dad who can't run around and can't play with my kids.

"Practically, as well, who is going to touch me? The gaffer here has been great, really understanding and supportive. But nobody is going to sign a player who can only play for ten minutes, especially with all the problems I've had."

So, a sad end to a promising career, but making that sacrifice for the sake of his son serves as a reminder to us all of the important things in life.

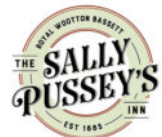

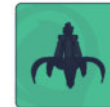
