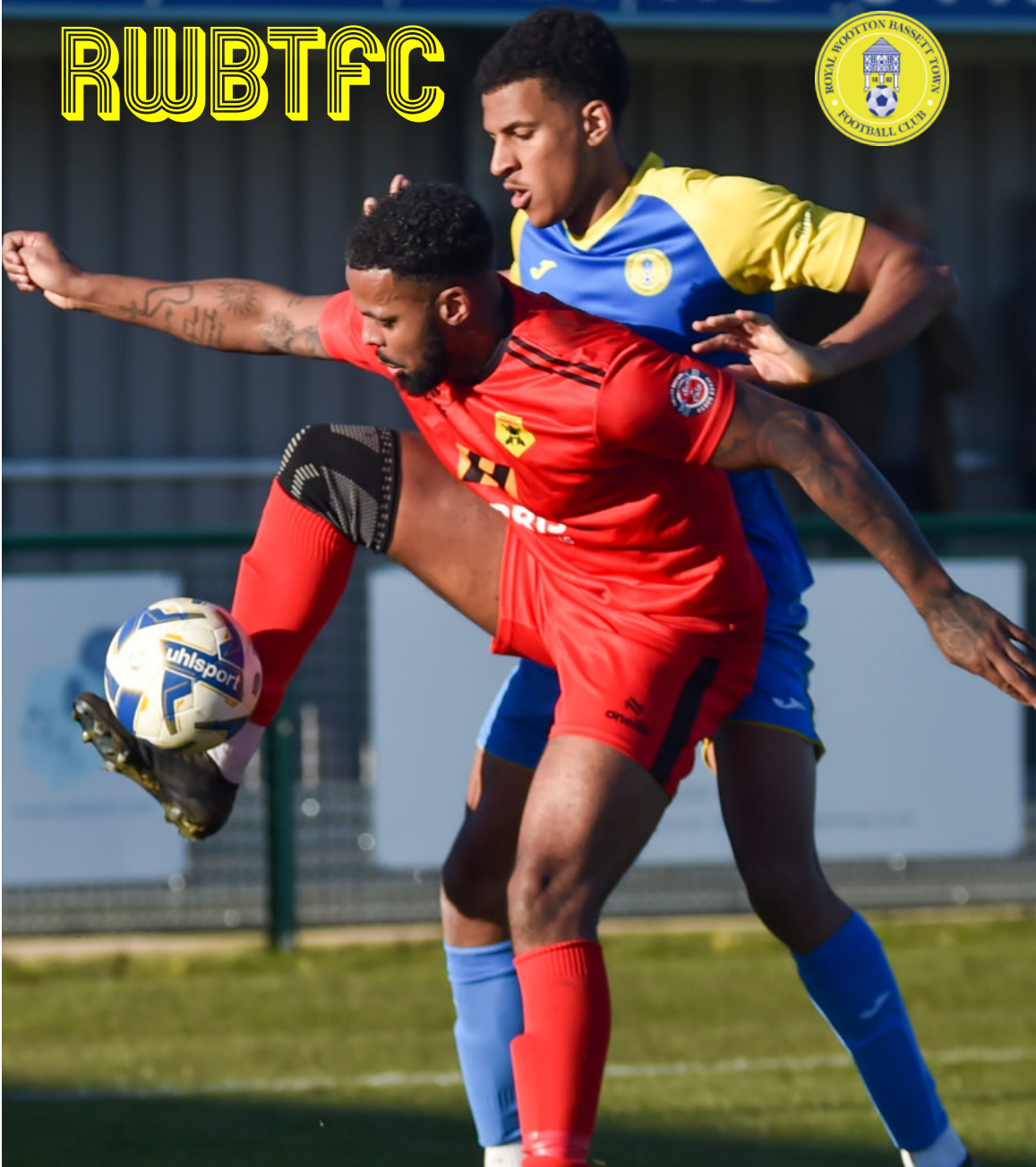

Men's First Team

Bassett Bulletin

GOOD AFTERNOON and welcome back to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Bank Holiday Monday UHlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture against near neighbours Highworth Town. A warm welcome to all the players, management team, club officials and supporters from Highworth who have made the short journey for today's game. We hope you all enjoy your short stay with us this afternoon, and we wish you a safe journey home.

These local derby encounters always draw a large crowd and Highworth certainly had a big one for their final game on grass last Saturday against Fairford Town, with 267 the recorded crowd. I doubt we will get that many here this afternoon but we could well see our largest crowd of the season in what is our penultimate home game of the campaign.

Unfortunately, with these Bank Holiday fixtures, print deadlines mean that the statistics for the various leagues our sides play in that are included in today's programme do not include any games played after Tuesday night. Hopefully by the time you read these notes we have either secured the point we need to confirm our Premier Division status for next season or results elsewhere mean we are already safe without needing that point.

After going on a fine winning run of four games from January 31st to the end of February we now find ourselves on a run of five straight defeats. Both Jonny and Chairman Paul Gerrish touch on the fact that we should not be too disheartened by this run of results which were all games against the top sides and saw opponents get very late winners in a couple of the games. Hopefully we will have got something from the trip to Mangotsfield United as we tend to do well on 3G pitches ahead of today's encounter to end that run of defeats.

Going back to today's game, over the years the two clubs have met on 77 occasions with Highworth having the better of things with 40 wins to our 29 with eight games ending in draws. It would be nice if we could return to winning ways this afternoon and close that gap.

The Development Team are also on a bad run of late, they went into a tough looking encounter against title chasing Swindon Supermarine Development on Saturday without a win in four games and having lost their last three games. Last Saturday Swindon Supermarine failed to raise a side for a cup semi final for the second time in the month, prioritising an U18 game. With Supermarine struggling to raise a side for such an important game perhaps the Development side will have been able to end their disappointing run of results to go out on a high.

The women's side are going to be involved in an exciting end to the current season as they will be involved in a five-way battle for the South West Regional Women's League title. Last Sunday they came away with a point following a 0-0 draw at Whitchurch, another of the sides involved in the title race. Bassett currently sit five points behind leaders Corsham Town with two games in hand and seven games still to play. The other two sides involved in the title race are Mangotsfield United and Bitton although Mangotsfield who are level on points with Bassett only have four games to play, all tough games against the other sides at the top including two games with Bitton and one against Bassett. Bitton still have nine games to play and have dropped the least number of points along with Bassett.

Elsewhere in the club, the Youth Section returned from their annual tour to Holland having secured a great set of results and also returned home with the Friendship Trophy thanks to the victories over FC 's-Gravenzande.

Enjoy the match here this afternoon and hopefully we can return to winning ways against our near neighbours and improved our overall record against Highworth.

HAPPY EASTER. It's a pleasure to welcome our supporters along with the players, officials and supporters from Highworth Town FC to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground today for this penultimate home Hellenic Premier League fixture of the season.

There are always returning faces in the opposition squad and today will be no different. Manager Paul Braithwaite along with goalkeeper coach Jon Himple are no strangers to the club and former fan favourites Bailey Gallagher, Dan Comer and Will Davidson will certainly be amongst the starters. I am sure all of them will be looking for a repeat of the two earlier results this season where Highworth came out on top, although we probably deserved something from both games.

After a perfect February where we picked up four wins from four, we come in to today's game on the back of five straight losses in March although the results don't tell the full picture. Four of the games were against top five teams. Slimbridge and Roman Galss both secured victory with injury time goals, Corsham won by a single goal in a game that we dominated, Worcester took advantage of a poor first half display where they scored both of their goals and much improved Cinderford won with two goals in the last five minutes after we should have led. Unfortunately, near things do not get points!

Those results still leave us with the mathematical chance of being relegated although Cribbs and Lydney will need to win all their four remaining fixtures and rely on us not to pick up a point to catch us. Pershore could also get dragged in to the relegation mix with four tough games to come including what could be a winner takes all last day game against Cribbs.

Highworth sit just above us in the league and subject to results over the weekend a win today would see us move above them. They played their final game on grass at the Elms last Saturday, going down 1-0 to neighbours Fairford.

Work starts soon on laying a new artificial pitch at the Save-on-Tyres ground and the iconic slope will be a thing of the past.



More and more teams are now getting artificial pitches, I know the business model makes sense but to me you lose the essence of the game. Grass pitches help give a club it's character and are not just (literally) a level playing field.

The Development team's season is coming to an end with two final fixtures against Supermarine and Melksham Reserves to play. It looks likely they will finish in eighth place. I know Simmo will be disappointed but given the youthful team represents a solid season.

With eight games to go, the Women go into April in a five-way race to win the South West Division One North league. They currently sit second, two points behind Corsham with two games in hand but Mangotsfield, Bitton and Whitchurch are chasing just behind. They also have a County Cup final against Swindon Town to look forward to on 19th April.

Finally, massive congratulations to our Vice-Chairman Pete Yeardeley who was presented with a Civil Award by the Mayor last Friday for his 30+ years of voluntary service to the Sport's Association and Football Club – Pete is invaluable to both organisations.

Thanks for your support – I hope you enjoy the game.

Tonight's Opponents

Highworth Town



Highworth Town Football Club was formed in 1893. We joined the Cirencester & District league and it took us some time to record our first honours, until 1909-10 in fact, when we won both the Swindon Junior Cup and the local Advertiser Cup, a cup we captured again in 1912-13.

After winning the Cirencester & District League Division Two in 1931-32, we moved to the Swindon & District League, where we completed the Third Division championship and Swindon Junior Cup double in 1933-34.

The 1950s saw us make a dramatic rise through the local football ranks. We won the Swindon & District League Third Division title again in 1954-55 and then the Division Two title the following season. One more season was needed to clinch the Division One title and also the Wilts Junior Cup. We then went on to win the Premier Division title in 1957-58, along with the Faringdon Thursday Memorial Cup and the following season we were the Premier Division champions again, also winning the Swindon Advertiser Cup.

We continued to dominate the Swindon & District Premier Division in the 1960s, winning four successive titles from 1960-61 and another hat-trick from 1965-66 to 1967-68, making seven titles in eight seasons. We reached the final of the Wilts Senior Cup for the first time in 1962-63 and won it the following season.

There was a switch to the Wilts Combination League, where we finished as runners-up in Division Two in 1970-71. 1972-73 saw another Wilts Senior Cup victory and all this success prompted us to join the Hellenic League. We achieved our first honours in 1988-89, winning the First Division Challenge Cup and reached the final of the Wilts Senior Cup yet again.

We finally achieved Premier Division status in 1993-94 gaining promotion after finishing third in Division One. Since then we have been winners of the Wilts Senior Cup in 1995-96, 1997-98, 2008-09 and again in 2014-15, winners of the Hellenic Challenge Cup in 2011-12, winners of the Hellenic Supplementary Cup in 1998-99 and runners up in 2003-04, runners-up in the Premier Division in 1999-00 and winners of the Premiership title in 2004-05.

In more recent history, the club reached the semi-final of the FA vase in 2014-15 where we were knocked out by eventual winners North Shields in a closely fought two-legged tie. That season also saw us pick up the Wilts Senior Cup.

In the 2016-17 and 2017-18 seasons we were runners-up in the Wilts Senior Cup to Swindon Supermarine and Chippenham Town respectively, both of which played at higher levels than us.

Also in the 2017-18 season we saw promotion to the Southern League Division 1 South as we finished as the best third placed team across the whole country. This means we are now playing the highest level of football the club had seen.

The 2022-23 season saw the FA move us laterally into the Southern League Division 1 Central which meant a difficult season with the extra travelling time/distance, and we finished in 17th place, leading to a play-off against Malvern Twn, a team that finished 2nd at Step 5, which we unfortunately lost resulting in relegation back to the Hellenic League.

A management change was made for the 2023-24 campaign with Paul Braithwaite and his backroom staff replacing the outgoing Gareth Daviews and his backroom team. It was a successful first year in charge for Braithwaite as we made it to the FA Cup Second Round Qualifying where we hosted National League side Weymouth FC in a game where we gave them a good run for their money but ultimately lost 3-1. He also led the team to the Quarter Final of the FA Vase where, on another day, the result could have been very different.

League wise we finished 3rd in the Hellenic Premier Division but unfortunately lost the Play-off Semi Final to Royal Wootton Bassett Town - it was just a step too far at the end of a very hard and long season that ended with us playing seven games in the final two weeks.

Season 2024-25 was another successful league season, finishing in 4th place and only just missing out on promotion after losing 1-0 to Sporting Club Inkberrow in the Hellenic League Play-off Final.

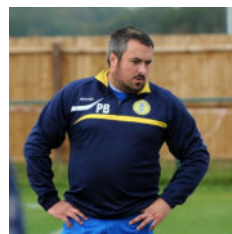

A strong first half performance from Worcester Raiders saw the Hellenic League Premier Division promotion chasers claim a 2-0 victory against Royal Wootton Bassett Town and seal a third win this season against Jonny Aitkenhead's side.

Bailey Fuller's well taken brace of goals proved the difference between the sides as Raiders kept in touch with fellow title contenders Slimbridge, Roman Glass St George and Droitwich Spa in what is proving to be an exciting four horse race for the title.

Knowing what was at stake, Raiders dominated in the opening period, staking out a two goal advantage before half time that they would maintain until the final whistle despite a spirited second half showing from the hosts.

The visitors had been on top in the game's early stages with Manu Olaloko bringing out a low save from Callum Godfrey.

They eventually took the lead midway through the half when Bassett failed to clear from a ball that was hooked forward and Fuller cut in from the right before curling a delicious effort into the net off the left post.

Five minutes later Raiders doubled their lead. A corner fell to Fuller on the edge of the box and he took one touch before arrowing a low drive into the bottom corner.

In fairness it was a masterclass in finishing from the Raiders man with both goals being of a high quality.

Bassett had failed to threaten up until that point - but they almost snatched a goal back when Rudi Hopkins' low drive forced a smart parry from an initially unsighted Charlie Emery.

The rebound dropped perfectly for Ben Cleary but he could only stab over from close range.

Fuller almost completed his hat trick shortly after the restart, forcing a punch from Godfrey with a tight angled effort after skilfully manoeuvring past Kian McNally.

But Bassett soon grew into the second half and matched their opponents the rest of the way.

They had good chances to get back into the game too. With Emery stranded, Cleary failed to connect properly with an Ed Taylor cross and headed off target. Gabe Reivers then forced a stop from Emery after Cleary set the ball back to him from Ollie Smith's hanging cross. Late on Emery was equal to a powerful 25 yard drive from Harry Messenger.

It was a decent second half effort from Bassett. But Raiders had done enough first half damage and held on to claim a potentially vital three points in the battle at the top.

League leaders **Slimbridge** opened up a nine point lead at the top of the table with a 3-0 home win over **Droitwich Spa** and could well have secured their promotion by the time you read these notes. A superb Olly Sully's solo effort opened the scoring late in the first half, before Shiyak Sutherland and Jack W Smith added a second and third late in the second to make it seven straight wins for Slimbridge to put one hand on the Hellenic Premier Division trophy.

Two days after lifting the League Cup **Hereford Pegasus** won again, returning from **Longlevens** with all three points after a 1-0 win.

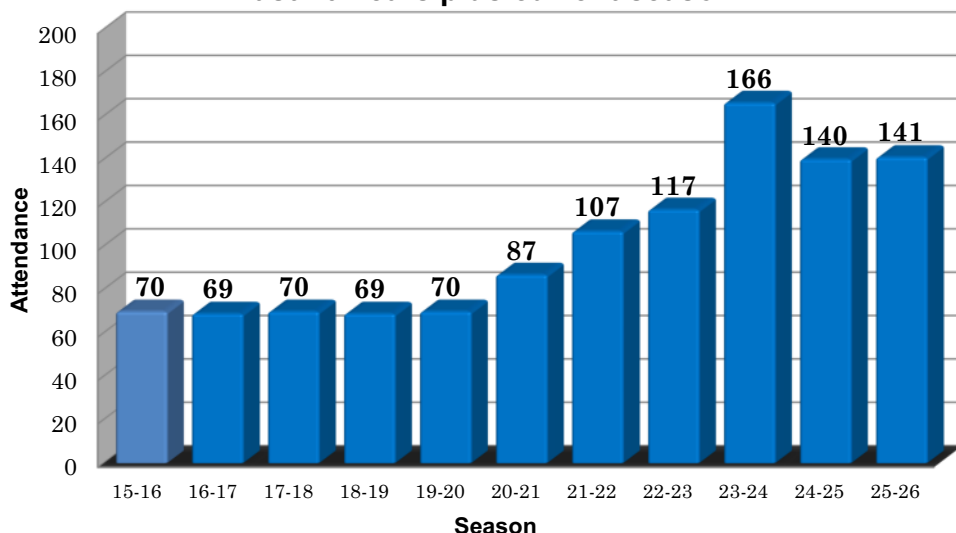

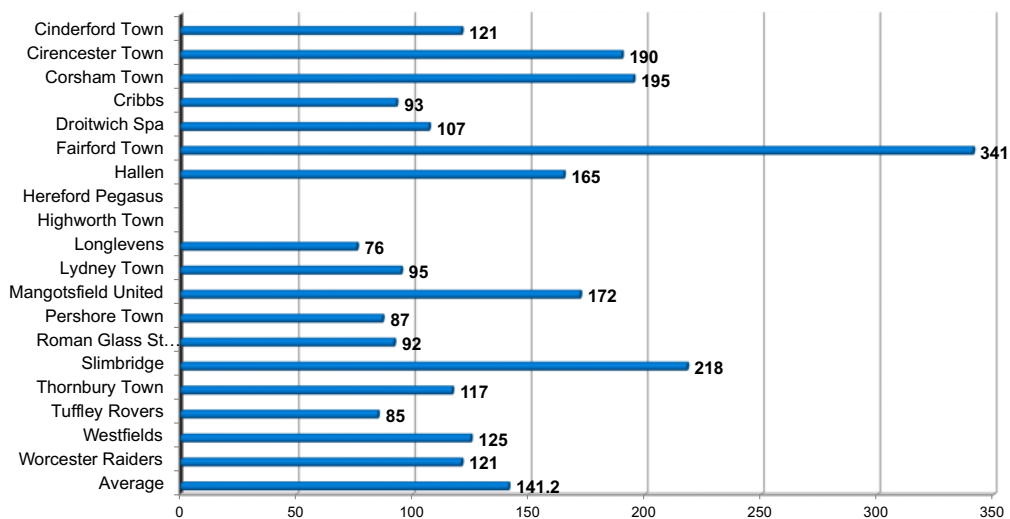

Glass shatter hopes with late winner

Five games, four of which were against Hellenic League Premier Division promotion contenders, have seen Bassett suffer five defeats - despite Jonny Aitkenhead's side giving a strong account of themselves.

Four of those five losses have come in agonising fashion too. Bassett conceded two stoppage time goals in a 2-1 defeat at Slimbridge before a pair of late goals denied them a point at Cinderford Town.

Away at Corsham Town, Bassett bettered their opponents and did everything but score as they were beaten 1-0.

After last week's 2-0 reverse at home against Worcester Raiders, Bassett were hoping their trip to Roman Glass St George would yield the reward their effort and performances have arguably deserved.

But despite being on course for a point, Bassett wound up empty-handed again as Roman Glass conjured up an injury time winner to claim a 2-1 victory.

Roman Glass had initially been in front, going ahead midway through the first half when Chris Lines sent Callum Godfrey the wrong way from the penalty spot after Kian McNally had brought down Conor Hartley.

In a high tempo game, Bassett sought to be on the front foot as much as possible against quality opposition. That left them vulnerable on the break though as two counter attacks late in the first half almost saw Roman Glass double their lead, with Godfrey forced into a pair of composed saves.

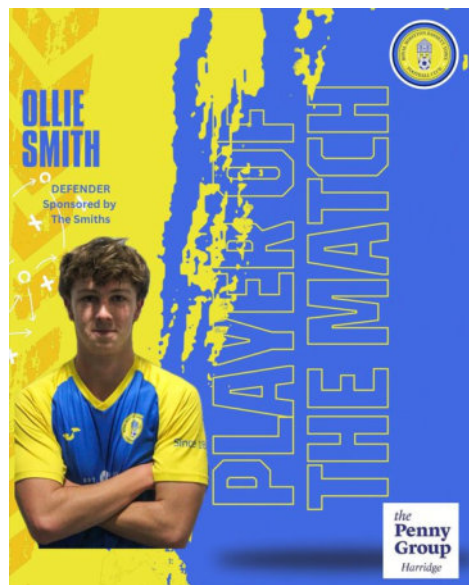
A strong spell midway through the second half eventually produced an equaliser though. After Rudi Hopkins' low drive was tipped around the post, the resulting corner was headed into the bottom left of the net by Jack Coward.

And the visitors almost added a quickfire second as Ed Taylor flashed narrowly over.

The closing stages then saw both teams go close. Bassett had a scare when David Ward headed a corner onto the crossbar with five minutes remaining.

Then at the other end Ben Cleary was played in behind the Roman Glass defence but stumbled as he prepared to shoot with just the keeper to beat.

It therefore seemed as though the game was destined for a draw. But when Lines delivered a corner into the box in the 93rd minute, Harvey Tierney beat Godfrey to the punch and flicked a header home to cruelly deny Bassett a point that their efforts had deserved.

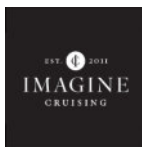

None of the teams vying for the title have a favourable run in.

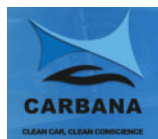
Indeed all teams have at least two games to play against each other.

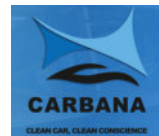

IN a perfect world, a life-saving defibrillator will hang up on the wall on every sports club or facility in the world and simply gather dust.

Sadly, though, there are occasions when these remarkable bits of kit are brought into use – and they might just save a life!

Take last weekend for example when The NLP became aware of three separate medical emergencies, including one where the life of an assistant referee was saved by a hero team captain

Martin Weedon, 73, - an official of more than 40 years - was running the line for Desborough Town's Spartan South Midlands League Division One Cup semi-final against Belstone when he twice collapsed during the early stages of the game.

The match was immediately abandoned while Mr Weedon was treated on the pitch by Belstone captain Mitchell Swain – a firefighter by day – and the two team physios, Desborough's Carl Mallett and Alan Dunphy, of Belstone.

The heroics trio deployed the defibrillator kept at the ground to restart his heart and bring him back to life before Mr Weedon was rushed from Desborough's VPK Stadium to Kettering General Hospital, less than five miles away, to undergo treatment.

"If Desborough hadn't had a defibrillator, Martin would have died 100%," Mr Weedon's son-in-law Andy Hobbs told BBC Sport after learning of the incident from Desborough manager Neil Healey.

"It's so important that sports venues of all sizes have them because they save lives."

"Neil called me to say Martin had collapsed and had stopped breathing and they were going to use a defibrillator on him.

"Apparently he collapsed once but tried to carry on. One of the players from the opposing team was worried and told the referee he didn't like the look of him and within a few seconds, he had fallen again.

"I believe their captain is medically trained and he and the others did an amazing job, they followed the right procedures."

Sadly, Desborough wasn't the only place to be thrown into an emergency situation last Saturday.

Coventry United also revealed on Sunday that their chairman Raymond Nowack collapsed suddenly after their home United Counties League match with Northampton ON Chenecks.

A statement read: "Thanks to the incredible work of our staff, especially our physio Lucy Stead, as well as assistance from manager Terry Anderson, Serena from the Butts Park Arena, the Northampton physio and assistant referee Kieron Large, plus the speedy response of the ambulance crew, Ray received immediate treatment and was swiftly taken to hospital. He has since been released and is now resting at home."

And there was a further incident nearby, at Midland League Division Three side Leamington Hibernian, where the club revealed that an unnamed player had suffered a "heart attack" during their game with AFC Balsall.

The Step 8 club said on X: "It is in times like this that put things into perspective and shows the togetherness of the football family in coming together to help and support each other."

While it is unclear what medical procedures were deployed on the patients at Coventry and Leamington, it only serves as a fitting reminder, if one was ever needed, of the importance of installing a defibrillator at your local club's facility as a matter of priority and urgency.

In his NLP column last April, Francis Duku, a former Non-League defender and founder of The Sports Circle - a movement that aims to make communities healthier using the medium of sports & exercise - told how there are more than 30,000 out-of-hospital cardiac arrests in the UK every year – with a survival rate of less than one in ten.

The Sports Circle are successfully working alongside the JE3 Foundation, set up to honour the legacy of former professional footballer and National League winning manager Justin Edinburgh, who went into cardiac arrest at his local gym in June 2019 and passed away five days later.

Founder of the JE3 Foundation, Edinburgh's son Charlie, is leading calls for legislative change on the installation of Automated External Defibrillators within health and sports facilities, while raising awareness of cardiac arrest, delivering CPR training and empowering every person to act fast, with the right skills and access to life-saving resources.

"Early CPR and defibrillation can significantly improve survival chances," Duku said.

"If something happened near you at a game or just in the street, would you know what to do?"

"Through the JE3 Foundation, Justin's legacy shines brightly."

The events of Desborough last weekend are certainly testament to that.
