Today's Opponents Downend Flyers



Downend Flyers are a female-only football club founded in Bristol in 1992. Operating three adult senior teams with a large thriving youth section they are one of the largest women's clubs in the South West.

They are now in their sixth season in the South West Regional League Division One North, having been relegated from the Premier Division at the end of Season 2018-19. Since being relegated to Division One the highest they have finished was in fifth place in Season 2020-21 which they repeated again the following season. Last season they finished in seventh place avoiding the relegation positions by two points.

After a challenging start to the season, they found their form in the second half, picking up four wins and four draws to climb out of the relegation zone and secure their place at Tier 6 in the South West Women's Regional Division 1 North for this season.

They have made a good start to the current season defeating Cheltenham Saracens in the First Qualifying Round of the FA Cup 1-0 to open the season. They followed that up with a win in their opening league game of the season, defeating newly promoted AFC Brislington 4-2. Last Sunday they exited the FA Cup losing 6-1 to Premier Division side Forest Green Rovers, who will now be our opponents in the next round.

Six hitters Bassett off to a Flyer

Royal Wootton Bassett Town's winning start to the season continued as Adam Wood's side thumped Downend Flyers 6-0 in their opening home game of the South West Regional Women's Football League Division One North campaign.

The victory made it three wins from three games in all competitions - with another strong attacking display and a second consecutive clean sheet leaving Bassett as one of only teams (the other being Gloucester City) to possess a 100% record in the early reckoning.

A quickfire three goal salvo in the final stages of the opening period proved decisive, allowing Bassett to be comfortably ahead at the break despite the opening half hour having been relatively even.

Club stalwart Amber Egerton broke the deadlock - and the floodgates - though. Good play from Holly Baker allowed Maddy Elliott to recycle a Laura Jefferies corner, and an unmarked Egerton was on hand to head home.

Elliott quickly doubled Bassett's advantage, firing home after good build up play from Emma Sykes.

And, almost instantly, two became three. Honor Fraser darted pasted two Downend defenders before teeing up Elliott. The forward's initial shot was blocked, but she was quickest to react to the rebound and coolly slotted in.





Downend did almost pull one back on the stroke of half time, but 'keeper Millie Powell did brilliantly to tip a free kick onto the bar before instinctively smothering the rebound.

After the restart Bassett then pulled away.

Just after the hour Kat Bach drew a foul in a dangerous area and Jefferies fired the free kick off the underside of the bar and into the back of the net.

Ten minutes later Sykes was brought down on the edge of the box. And this time new signing Cara Sommerville stepped up to take the free kick and duly curled a fine effort in off the left post.

Shortly after Lucy Goodright completed the scoring. Bach did well to keep the ball alive after an Elliott delivery into the box and she picked out Goodright who, with her first touch after entering the field of play, steered in.

Bassett's clean sheet did come under threat late on but a last ditch Jasmine Kennedy block and a composed Powell save in a one-on-one situation kept that intact.

Goodright then almost added a seventh at the other end, but her shot rattled the woodwork after she had latched onto Darcy Cox's through ball.

Many happy returns as birthday girl Goodright gets Bassett going

Royal Wootton Bassett Town advanced to the second qualifying round of the Adobe Women's FA Cup with a hard fought 2-0 victory away at Frimley Green.

First half goals from birthday girl Nat Goodright and Kat Bach and a fine display from 'keeper Millie Powell made it five straight seasons in which Bassett have progressed at least one round in the national competition.

And they'll now be looking to make it four straight trips to at least the third qualifying round when.

Frimley Green proved strong opponents in an all tier-six tie that could have gone either way. But Bassett's first half showing ultimately proved the difference.

Playing against a strong wind in the opening period, attacking forays were at a premium for Bassett - but they made the most of them.

The deadlock was broken on 20 minutes when Goodright found the net - though there was a spot of fortune in the opener with Bassett lucky not to have been penalised for what appeared to be a foul in the build up.

Bach then doubled the advantage shortly before the interval, with there being no question about the goal's validity.



At 2-0 down and having not had a sniff against Bassett could have been three to the good shortly after the restart but a good save from Frimley Green 'keeper Nicole Spittle denied Maddy Elliot.

From there onwards the hosts were actually the better of the teams - and they should really have halved the deficit when Leah Robertson raced onto a long ball over the top that caught out the Bassett defence. However an outstanding save from Powell - one of a handful that she made - kept it 2-0.

Robertson and Dulcie Gray - both tricky players with speed - were causing particular problems for the visitors. And Frimley Green came close again, hitting the post as the game entered its closing stages.

There was some respite for Bassett with Goodright coming close to adding her second, though Spittle was not in the giving mood as she turned a low effort around the post.

That was to be the last real opportunity of the match as Bassett closed out the game, their clean sheet adding added gloss to a welcome cup win that gets their season off to a positive start.

FA Cup 2nd Qualifying Round

Sunday 21 September 2025

Royal Wootton Bassett Town booked their place in the third qualifying round of the Adobe Women's FA Cup as they edged out Bristol Brunel 1-0 courtesy of Elle Scott's early penalty.

A professional performance from James Lally's side helped Bassett see off the threat posed by tier seven Brunel, who gave a solid account of themselves - and will take plenty of confidence from having pushed Bassett all the way as they embark on a promotion push in the league.

Scott's twelfth minute penalty - tucked away with confidence as she sent the 'keeper the wrong way - was all that ultimately separated the teams in a tight encounter in Bristol.

Brunel had been among the goals in the two previous rounds in which they had seen off Gloucestershire County League rivals Long Acton and Longlevens.

But, facing their biggest test yet, they were unable to find a way past the stubborn Bassett defence who made it consecutive clean sheets to begin the season.

Bassett now find themselves in the third and final qualifying round for the fourth consecutive season.

Now the task is to avoid exiting at that stage for a fourth year in a row - and to make history by advancing to the first round proper.

Forest Green Rovers in Next Round

Royal Wootton Bassett Town have been handed a home tie against Forest Green Rovers in the Adobe Women's FA Cup third qualifying round.

The tie is set to take place at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground on Sunday 5 October (2pm kick off).

Bassett will be pleased to have received home advantage, after winning away at Frimley Green (3-0) and Bristol Brunel (1-0) in the two previous rounds to reach the final qualifying round for a fourth consecutive season.

Bassett have fell to defeat the last three years in the third qualifying round, losing twice away to Torquay United (2-5 in 2022-23 and 1-3 last season) and at home against AFC Stoneham (0-1 in 2023-24).

And James Lally's side will need to beat higher level opponents if they are to make it to first round proper for the first time ever, with Forest Green plying their trade at tier five in the South West Regional Women's Football League Premier Division.

Forest Green, who beat Bassett's Division One North rivals Downend Flyers 6-1 in their second qualifying round fixture, will be aiming to reach the first round for the first time since the 2015-16 campaign (when they entered at the second round stage).

Like Bassett, they have made a habit of falling just short of the first round proper, having exited at the third qualifying round stage in each of the last four years, including consecutive defeats against Bridgwater United. Rovers' best ever run came in 2007-08 when they reached the fourth round before losing to Liverpool.

It promises to be an exciting tie at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground between the two teams who are plenty familiar with one another. Please do come along to cheer Bassett on as they seek to make history!

Millie Powell - Goalkeeper

A highly talented goalkeeper entering her fifth season in senior football. She has great shotstopping ability and is also confident with the ball at her feet. She has earned multiple awards including Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year.



Briony Hurd - Defence

A strong defender who joined Bassett from Swindon Town in 2023-24. She made 16 appearances that season and has also played for the University of East London Women's First Team.



Honor Fraser - Defence / Midfield

A strong, technically gifted full back entering her third season with Bassett. She made 27 appearances last season, scoring three goals and earning the Coaches' Player of the Year award.



Kelly Nightingale - Midfield

A versatile player entering her third season with Bassett. She has significant experience in the FA Women's National League, having played for Swindon Town, Forest Green Rovers, Swindon Supermarine, Keynsham Town.



Holly Baker - Forward

A quick forward known for her ability to hold up the ball and combine well with teammates. She has been with Bassett since 2016-17, scoring 14 goals in 88 appearances prior to this season, and is known for her strong work ethic and reliability.



Emma Sykes - Midfield

A long serving, cultured central midfielder who came through Bassett's youth system. Prior to this season she has played 106 times for Bassett since 2016-17, scoring 13 goals, and has earned multiple awards, including Players' Player of the Year.



Caitlin Brooks - Midfield

A forward who joined Bassett last season from FC Chippenham Youth. She was Bassett's top scorer with 23 goals in 17 games, including four hat tricks. Previously, she was a prolific scorer in the Wiltshire County Women's League.



Maddy Elliott - Forward

A forward known for her work ethic and goalscoring ability. She has been with Bassett since 2012-13, scoring 43 goals in 124 appearances, and played a key role in the club's promotion and double-winning season.



Hannah Gulliver - Forward

A versatile forward who joined Bassett in the 2016-17 season. She has scored 53 goals in 136 appearances prior to this season, winning multiple awards incl Manager's Player of the Year Supporters' Player of the Year. including



Thea Hopkins - Goalkeeper

A goalkeeper who joined Bassett last season, featuring four times mainly in the Wiltshire County Cup. An all-round sportswoman, she captains RWB Cricket Club's women's side and has represented Wiltshire in cricket and played for RWB Hockey Club.



Darcy Cox - Defence

A talented young centre back entering her third season with Bassett. Known for her physicality and strong challenges, she has earned multiple player of the year awards and was Bassett's leading outfield appearance maker in 2023-24.



Laura Jefferies - Defence

A loval defender who has been with Bassett for 15 years now. She is the club's all-time leading Women's appearance maker, club captain, and has won multiple Player of the Year awards during her time at the club.



Amber Egerton - Midfield A versatile midfielder who joined Bassett in 2014-15. She has won multiple awards, including Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year. Despite injuries, prior to this season she has made appearances and scored 14 goals.



Natalie Goodright - Midfield

A dynamic midfielder entering her third season with Bassett. She scored five goals in 22 appearances in her first season and added three goals in 27 games last season. Significant experience at a higher level, including the FA Women's National League.



Mia Sanghara - Midfield

A young full back who joined Bassett last season from Swindon Town. She made 15 appearances in her debut campaign, including four starts, and has experience playing for Swindon Spitfires and the University of Sussex Women's team.



Alice Bowden - Defence

A versatile defender who joined Bassett midway through the 2024-25 season, making ten appearances. Known for her tackling and leadership, she previously captained Swindon Town and has also played for Abingdon United and Bristol Rovers.



Lucy Goodright - Midfield

An attack-minded midfielder who joined Bassett part way through the 2023-24 season. That year she featured thirteen times - with ten appearances coming from the bench - made the same number of appearances last season, adding nine



Alice Telling - Midfield

An intelligent midfielder who joined Bassett in 2024. She made 18 appearances and scored once in her debut season. Previously, she played for Swindon Town, making 21 appearances in the FA Women's National League, and is also a qualified coach


