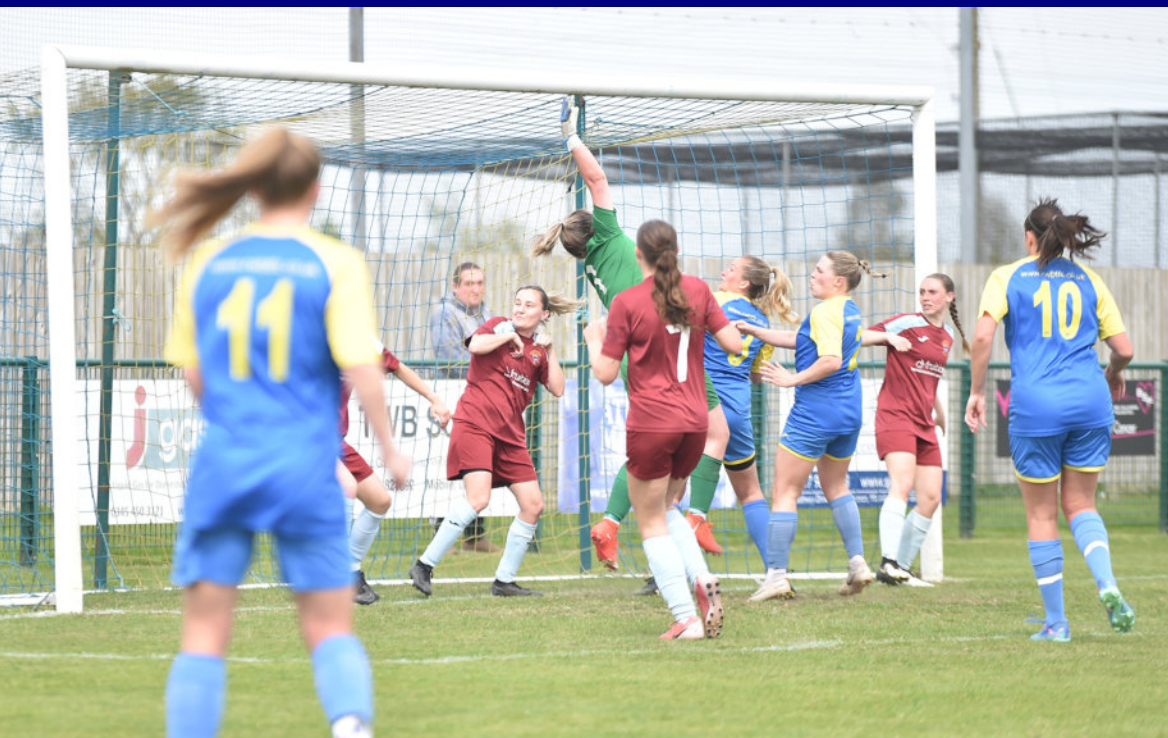

Good Afternoon and welcome to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground. This is our tenth home league fixture for this season, and today's fixture will be the second meeting this season after Cirencester agreed to switch the game to be their home game with both teams eager to play after the Christmas break. The freezing weather saw the teams agree to switch the fixture, originally scheduled to be at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground, to the Corinium Stadium - where the 3G pitch meant the game would definitely go ahead. A local derby is not the ideal game to play after three weeks without a game, and my memory of the game was Cirencester were clearly up for this fixture and started the better side as we were not at the races in the first half and it was no surprise that Cirencester took the lead with a wonderful long range strike from ex Bassett player Lani Dickinson. We did improve in the second half and were able get a deserved equaliser from Scotty and could have pinched all three points but had to settle for a point on the day.

I am writing these notes before we travel to Stockwood Wanderers on Thursday evening for a seven o'clock kick off to a ground with no floodlights and am fearful as to how this game will get ninety minutes played. Would not be a problem if both sides were mid table and you could probably agree to play a reduced amount of minutes to get the game played but with us looking to win to help gain promotion and them looking to avoid relegation so that option is not available. Planning fixtures is not an easy job given the wet weather we have had this season, but I feel we have not been given a fair deal on these evening fixtures.

There were a couple of changes that could have been looked at, with us potentially playing today's opponents Cirencester or even Bath City at home midweek under lights, this would have freed up a Sunday to fit in an away trip, so credit to James and Dan for getting the game switched earlier in the season.

The win at Bitton was an important win and moved us a step nearer to promotion. On the night we deserved the victory and could have won by a bigger margin, Mangotsfield at home last Sunday showed how all the squad need to be ready to step in and play to a high level to get us the points that are needed to get us over the line.

I hope you enjoy the game today and hopefully we can secure another league win today.

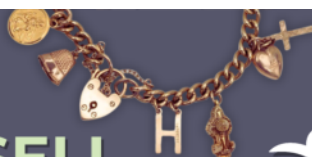

Today's Opponents

Cirencester Town

Cirencester Town Ladies were one of the inaugural member clubs of the Gloucestershire County Women's League which was established in 1998. As usual with women's football it has not been possible to trace league tables before the FA Full-Time era. The earliest league table we have been able to trace is Season 2014-15 when they were in the same division as Wootton Bassett Town finishing in 3rd spot with Bassett two places below. Season 2016-17 was one of struggle for Cirencester and after losing all of their opening 12 league games they withdrew from the league and appear not to have re-formed until Season 2018-19 in Division Two of the Gloucestershire County League.

The first season back saw them finish in a creditable fourth place in a division of 12 teams in the Gloucestershire County League. The following season, Season 2019-20 is the season that has been expunged from the record books as Covid brought a premature end to the season. The following season was again cut short due to Covid with Cirencester sat in fifth place in a division of nine teams.

Season 2021-22 saw Cirencester Town again playing in Division 2 of the Gloucestershire County League with a gradual improvement with a fourth-place finish in a division of eight teams with Cirencester winning half their league games and drawing two others, with just five defeats.

Season 2022-23 saw that gradual improvement continue, as Cirencester Town once again climbed one place in the table, finishing in third spot which was enough to achieve promotion to Division One of the County League. Season 2023-24 was to prove to be a highly successful season for Cirencester Town as they achieved back-to-back promotions, finishing the season as Division One champions winning 16 of their 18 league games with just the one league defeat all season.

The title win secured promotion to the South West Regional Women's League Division One North for Season 2024-25.

Cirencester Town had a good first season at the higher level, winning more games than they lost to finish the season in the top half of the table, ending the season in fifth spot. The two games against Royal Wootton Bassett Town were both close affairs, the two sides sharing the points following a 2-2 draw at the Gerard Buxton Ground in October, Hannah Gulliver getting both the Bassett goals and Libberty Messenger and Clare Hill replying for Cirencester. The return fixture on Cirencester's 3G pitch in March was to go Bassett's way, goals from Caitlin Brooks, Madeline Elliott, Hannah Gulliver (who seems to like playing Cirencester) and Kelly Nightingale for Bassett, Shannon King and Phoebe McGouran getting the Cirencester goals.

Cirencester made a great start to the current league season winning their opening three games against Paulton Rovers, Bath City and Stockwood Wanderers. However, this was then followed by three defeats in a row against Whitchurch, Mangotsfield United and Gloucester City Reserves. They bounced back with a 5-0 win against AFC Brislington and then pushed then league leaders Whitchurch all the way in the return fixture, eventually losing a tight game 2-1. A comfortable win in the County Cup against Hartpury has been followed by back-to-back league wins over Paulton Rovers and Stockwood Wanderers meaning Cirencester come into today's game in good form, winning all three of their recent games in all competitions. We will certainly need to be at our best to get a positive result here today. Their leading scorer this season in the league is Annie Martin with 21 goals with former Bassett player Lani Dickinson having scored 14 and former Highworth Town striker Bethan Harris getting five goals so far this season.

Bassett edge a step closer to the top

Two goals. Another clean sheet. Three more points. And - most importantly- one step closer to taking over top spot in the South West Regional Women's Football League Division One North.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town's 2-0 triumph against Mangotsfield United saw them pull within three points of leaders Corsham Town with two games in hand still to play.

Top spot could therefore belong to Bassett by this time next weekend if James Lally's side can claim victory against either Stockwood Wanderers or Cirencester Town - their opponents on Thursday and next Sunday.

Victory in both games would see Bassett, barring any huge shifts in goal difference, require just one win from their final two fixtures to seal the title.

While claiming their latest victory and another clean sheet, Bassett were not quite at their best against Mangotsfield.

Indeed they were rather lucky to have not fallen behind in an opening period that saw the visitors squander a series of gilt-edged chances.

Mangotsfield should really have been ahead when Adele Elliott shrugged off the attentions of Alice Bowden to get on the end of a long throw in behind the defence but she could only find the side netting.

After Bassett gave the ball away in their own half, Elliott teed up an unmarked Brooke Moore who skied over the bar.



Their best opportunity to go ahead then fell to Moore after Mangotsfield won a penalty but she dragged her spot pick onto the left post.

Bassett had their moments too with Poppy Wannell dragging wide and Honor Fraser firing over when through one-on-one.

But they wound up going ahead shortly before the half time. Lauren Bulley's finish wasn't the prettiest but it was a vital goal as she steered in from a Fraser cut back after good work to win back the ball from Tori Taylor and Elle Scott's pass into the right channel.

Bassett then doubled their lead shortly after the restart as captain Laura Jefferies swung in a corner that evaded everyone and found its way in at the far post. The second goal seemed to settle Bassett. And Wannell was inches away from making it three after picking off a pass before narrowly dragging wide of the post. A third goal wasn't needed though as Mangotsfield created little in the second period - and Bassett sealed another crucial three points in a thrilling title race.

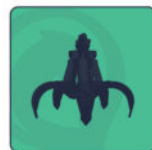
