Unfortunately, despite the wonders of the Internet it is not always easy to find information on Women's non-league historical league tables. What we do know is that Gloucester City Reserves were our opponents in the Gloucestershire County Women's League back in 2009-10 and that we were to play them seven times in the period from 2009-10 through to 2012-13. They were opponents in Division Three of that league for two seasons and then in DIvision One in 2012-13 season.

We have only played their first team since our elevation to the South West Regional League.

Season 2010-11 saw Gloucester City Reserves finish as champions of Division Three of the Gloucestershire County League with Wootton Bassett Town runners-up.

Gloucester City were last season playing in Divsion Two of that same league, once again having a championship winning season that saw them elevated two divisions to the South West Regional League. This is something that would not happen in the men's game but being involved in the Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League I can see why the FA were happy to allow this as the standard of sides at County League level is currently not at the level it needs to be for an effective pyramid.

Eleven Goal Thriller

Gloucester City Reserves 4 Wootton Bassett Town 7

Sunday 13 September 2009

An 11 goal thriller was in store on this first away trip, not the nicest changing facilities less said the better. The pitch was flat but open to the elements and on this occasion a stiff breeze blowing diagonally from corner to corner with the sun trying to warm the afternoon up.

The game started with Gloucester only having 10 players but as last week very tidy and composed on the ball. Even with ten players they were a threat going forward and were very much on top, after ten minutes panic in the Bassett defence when Leah Blanchard called and came for a cross but missed. She was let off when the Gloucester city forward failed to connect, no such luck 5 minutes later a good sharp turn on the edge of the box leaving the Bassett defence flat footed followed with a thumping a shot into the net, 1-0 Gloucester.

The lead only lasted 7 minutes a little bit of fortune in the build up, against the run of play a corner from Kate Bonser was only half cleared inside the box the ball fell to Joni Warner whose snap shot got deflected off a defender and looped over the keeper and was tapped into the net on the goal line by Alyson Lyons to make it one all.

Bassett had grown in confidence with the goal and went looking for another, a strong run up field by Amy Longo where she forced another corner, from the resulting corner Jenna McFadzean found herself unmarked on the edge of the six yard box and was able to stab the ball home to make it 2-1 Bassett.





Bassett ahead but not for long, Gloucester taking centre and four passes later Leah Blanchard was picking the ball out of the net after being left 1 on 1 with a Gloucester forward Almost on half time Bassett gained the lead again this time Katie Bonser letting fly from twenty yards a speculative shot that the keeper could only palm into her own net. 3-2 Bassett half time

Second half started with both sides having players caring knocks, Gwen Hopkins replaced Joni Warner in the centre of midfield. The game was still in the balance with no side having total control, the game was starting to get stretch, when on 55 minutes Gloucester won a free kick on the edge of the Bassett box, the result a powerful shot which took a slight deflection of a defender taking it past Leah Blanchard into the Bassett net to make it 3-3.

Game on again all to play for the next goal went to Bassett again on 59 minutes more luck than judgement a cross from Amy Longo found Alyson Lyons on the edge of the box who's missed timed pass caught the wind and looped over the keeper dropping into the net to make it 4-3 Bassett. Could Bassett hold the lead, the answer only for five minutes the Bassett defence were caught high and flat as a Gloucester forward broke away a calm finish giving Leah Blanchard no chance. 25 minutes left of the game both sides were looking tired Gloucester were pushing forward looking to take the lead but got caught when Gwen Hopkins won the ball in midfield releasing Jenna McFadzean who raced down field rounded the keeper to score from close range. This goal was the turning point of the game Gloucester's 10 players had run out of legs, and Jenna McFadzean went on a mini rampage scoring 2 more goals on 84 & 89 minutes to wrap up a pulsating game

Match Report v Forest Green Rovers

Deja vu as Bassett fall at final qualifying round stage again

Royal Wootton Bassett Town 1 Forest Green Rovers 3

Sunday 5 October 2025

Royal Wootton Bassett Town fell to defeat at the Adobe Women's FA Cup third qualifying round stage for a fourth year in a row as Forest Green Rovers secured a comfortable 3-1 triumph at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground.

An unfortunate own goal from Kelly Nightingale as she headed a free kick from deep on the left into her own net gave higher level Forest Green the lead on the quarter hour mark.

Hattie Jones' near post header from an inswinging corner doubled their advantage ten minutes before half time.

That left Bassett with a lot to do in order to avoid the same fate they had suffered at this stage in each of the three previous campaigns after two defeats against Torquay United and a further loss against AFC Stoneham.

They were by no means out of the contest though.

The opening period had been relatively even - and it said much that both Forest Green goals came from set pieces.

And Bassett came close to snatching a goal back when Elle Scott narrowly shot over from twenty yards out as time wound up down.

But the tie was all but settled just before the hour mark when Leilani Ryder made it 3-0, squeezing a shot in from a tight angle after Bassett conceded possession deep in their own half.



Lauren Bulley did pull one back for Bassett with twenty minutes to go. Bulley initiated a move that saw Tori Taylor thread a through ball into the path of Hannah Gulliver. Gulliver saw her attempted blocked but the ball was knocked loose to Bulley who coolly slotted home.

Yet that proved only to be a consolation goal as Bassett once fell just short of a Women's FA Cup first round appearance.



Millie Powell - Goalkeeper

A highly talented goalkeeper entering her fifth season in senior football. She has great shotstopping ability and is also confident with the ball at her feet. She has earned multiple awards including Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year.



Briony Hurd - Defence

A strong defender who joined Bassett from Swindon Town in 2023-24. She made 16 appearances that season and has also played for the University of East London Women's First Team



Honor Fraser - Defence / Midfield

A strong, technically gifted full back entering her third season with Bassett. She made 27 appearances last season, scoring three goals and earning the Coaches' Player of the Year award.



Kelly Nightingale - Midfield

A versatile player entering her third season with Bassett. She has significant experience in the FA Women's National League, having played for Swindon Town, Forest Green Rovers, Swindon Supermarine, Kevnsham Town.



Holly Baker - Forward

A quick forward known for her ability to hold up the ball and combine well with teammates. She has been with Bassett since 2016-17, scoring 14 goals in 88 appearances prior to this season, and is known for her strong work ethic and reliability.



Emma Sykes - Midfield

A long serving, cultured central midfielder who came through Bassett's youth system. Prior to this season she has played 106 times for Bassett since 2016-17, scoring 13 goals, and has earned multiple awards, including Players' Player of the Year.



Caitlin Brooks - Midfield

A forward who joined Bassett last season from FC Chippenham Youth. She was Bassett's top scorer with 23 goals in 17 games, including four hat tricks. Previously, she was a prolific scorer in the Wiltshire County Women's League.



Maddy Elliott - Forward

A forward known for her work ethic and goalscoring ability. She has been with Bassett since 2012-13, scoring 43 goals in 124 appearances, and played a key role in the club's promotion and double-winning season.



Hannah Gulliver - Forward

A versatile forward who joined Bassett in the 2016-17 season. She has scored 53 goals in 136 appearances prior to this season, winning multiple awards including Manager's Player of the Year and Supporters' Player of the Year.



Thea Hopkins - Goalkeeper

A goalkeeper who joined Bassett last season, featuring four times mainly in the Wiltshire County Cup. An all-round sportswoman, she captains RWB Cricket Club's women's side and has represented Wiltshire in cricket and played for RWB Hockey Club.



Darcy Cox - Defence

A talented young centre back entering her third season with Bassett. Known for her physicality and strong challenges, she has earned multiple player of the year awards and was Bassett's leading outfield appearance maker in 2023-24.



Laura Jefferies - Defence

A loyal defender who has been with Bassett for 15 years now. She is the club's all-time leading Women's appearance maker, club captain, and has won multiple Player of the Year awards during her time at the club.


