Stockwood Wanderers joined the South West Regional Womens League from the Somerset County League. Season 2020-21 saw them go unbeaten in their eight games in Division 2 of that league to finish top of the five team division and promotion to Division 1 for the following season.

They were to have another successful season in Season 2021-22 finishing in third place in division of eight teams and securing promotion to the South West Regional League Eastern Division for Season 2022-23.

The first season at the higher level was to prove a difficult one with just two wins in their 14 league fixtures which saw them finish bottom of the division.

The following season, Season 2023-24 saw them move across to the Northern Division, the same one as Royal Wootton Bassett Town. Stockwood Wanderers were to have a much more successful season winning more games than they lost and finishing in mid-table in fifth spot in a nine team division.

Season 2024-25 saw them once again at the bottom end of the table but in the end they finished two places above the relegation zone to retain their status at Tier 6 of the Women's National League System.

Maddy Elliott was the star of the show for James Lally's side. Scoring for the first time this season, she netted five teams in all and moved to the top of the goalscoring chart for Bassett.

Six other scorers - Kat Bach, Amber Egerton, Honor Fraser, Hannah Gulliver, Laura Jefferies and Alice Telling - found the net for Bassett.

The one slight frustration for Bassett was that they were unable to make it a fifth clean sheet of the season in just their sixth competitive fixture as Issy Satchell grabbed a consolation for Calne.

Tougher tests await in the competition with fellow tier six sides Corsham Town and Bemerton Heath Harlequins, as well as tier four Swindon Town also represented in the last eight.

Bassett will be hoping that it will at least be another round before they have to face one of these teams though.

Millie Powell - Goalkeeper

A highly talented goalkeeper entering her fifth season in senior football. She has great shotstopping ability and is also confident with the ball at her feet. She has earned multiple awards including Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year.



Briony Hurd - Defence

A strong defender who joined Bassett from Swindon Town in 2023-24. She made 16 appearances that season and has also played for the University of East London Women's First Team



Honor Fraser - Defence / Midfield

A strong, technically gifted full back entering her third season with Bassett. She made 27 appearances last season, scoring three goals and earning the Coaches' Player of the Year award.



Kelly Nightingale - Midfield

A versatile player entering her third season with Bassett. She has significant experience in the FA Women's National League, having played for Swindon Town, Forest Green Rovers, Swindon Supermarine, Kevnsham Town.



Holly Baker - Forward

A quick forward known for her ability to hold up the ball and combine well with teammates. She has been with Bassett since 2016-17, scoring 14 goals in 88 appearances prior to this season, and is known for her strong work ethic and reliability.



Emma Sykes - Midfield

A long serving, cultured central midfielder who came through Bassett's youth system. Prior to this season she has played 106 times for Bassett since 2016-17, scoring 13 goals, and has earned multiple awards, including Players' Player of the Year.



Caitlin Brooks - Midfield

A forward who joined Bassett last season from FC Chippenham Youth. She was Bassett's top scorer with 23 goals in 17 games, including four hat tricks. Previously, she was a prolific scorer in the Wiltshire County Women's League.



Maddy Elliott - Forward

A forward known for her work ethic and goalscoring ability. She has been with Bassett since 2012-13, scoring 43 goals in 124 appearances, and played a key role in the club's promotion and double-winning season.



Hannah Gulliver - Forward

A versatile forward who joined Bassett in the 2016-17 season. She has scored 53 goals in 136 appearances prior to this season, winning multiple awards including Manager's Player of the Year and Supporters' Player of the Year.



Thea Hopkins - Goalkeeper

A goalkeeper who joined Bassett last season, featuring four times mainly in the Wiltshire County Cup. An all-round sportswoman, she captains RWB Cricket Club's women's side and has represented Wiltshire in cricket and played for RWB Hockey Club.



Darcy Cox - Defence

A talented young centre back entering her third season with Bassett. Known for her physicality and strong challenges, she has earned multiple player of the year awards and was Bassett's leading outfield appearance maker in 2023-24.



Laura Jefferies - Defence

A loyal defender who has been with Bassett for 15 years now. She is the club's all-time leading Women's appearance maker, club captain, and has won multiple Player of the Year awards during her time at the club.

Tori Taylor - Midfield

An experienced forward who joined Basest this season. She previously played for Forest Green Rovers, scoring 12 goals in 29 games, and has also featured for West Ham United and Swindon Town in the FA Women's National League.



Lauren Bulley - Forward

A forward with an impressive goal-scoring record at County League level. She joins Bassett this season, having previously played for Highworth Town and Corsham Town, scoring 21 goals in her debut season and continuing to register impressive hauls in subsequent seasons.



James Lally - Manager



Wiltshire Senior League Ladies Divisions 2025-26

Wiltshire FA County Cup

There was a break from league action last Sunday with the Second Round of the Wiltshire FA Women's County Cup and the First Round of the Plate competition for sides who played their game in Round One of the County Cup and were defeated.

Four teams had been drawn against higher league opposition in the main County Cup with Salisbury having been given the toughest tie of the round with the Division One side up against cup holders Swindon Town, who are also the highest placed side in the competition playing at Tier 4, four levels higher than Salisbury. Swindon Town currently top Division One South West of the FA Women's National League although they fielded their development side who play in the Reserve South West Division of the National League in this round of the competition.
