A half time score of 3-0 was a fair reflection on the half, with three more goals added within 20 minutes of the second half. The game was now over as a contest and most sides would have settled for a 6-0 win, but as I witnessed the competition for places is strong and the five substitutions added fresh energy to the side and pushed us on to score three more before the final whistle.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank anyone who gave so generously at last week's game. From that game alone the women's section raised over £100 to help support Mark Ellis, who is fundraising for a cure against Parkinson's, as said last week Mark is well on course to walk 62 miles in October, if you would still like to donate here is the link below.

Bitton Ladies were formed at the start of the 2007/2008 season with a mix of local girls wanting to keep fit and some younger girls looking for their first club in senior football. They joined the Gloucestershire County Womens Division 2 and appointed Steve Jones as Manager. They were quickly to learn some harsh lessons as they suffered heavy defeats in the opening few weeks of the season including 13-0 & 10-0 defeats. Results steadily improved over the season and they finished on a high with some positive results against the top sides in the division. They ended their first season in 5th position.

The 2008/2009 season saw the Ladies enter the Womens FA Cup for the first time and after a promising start they faded away to finish the season poorly once again ending up in 5th place. With the addition of several new faces over the summer Bitton Ladies would look to improve on the previous seasons finish and challenge for honours the following year.

After 2 years of struggle the 2009/10 season saw Bitton produce an incredible season winning the Division 2 title and reaching the league cup final only losing narrowly to Div 1 winners Swindon Supermarine.

Now in Division 1 of the County league Bitton made a promising start to the 2010/11 season but faded away as they lost several players to pregnancy and long term injuries and as a result struggled to raise a side on a few occasions meaning they eventually finished the season in 4th position. They saved some of their best performances for

the league cup however and once again managed to get to the final despite playing the quarters and semi with only 10 players. Unfortunately they lost the final 2-1 to league winners St Nicholas.

2012/13 was the most successful in the club's history. Now under the management of Paul Passaway they blitzed their way through the league to be crowned champions and also won the league cup. Bitton were promoted to the South West Womens league but unfortunately had to fold due to a lack of players.

After an 8 year break Bitton came back for the 22/23 season as they stormed to the Gloucester County womens league Division One and cup double under the management of Mike Strawford gaining promotion to the South West Regional Women's League.

The first season back at Tier 6 saw Bitton consolidate at the higher level, finishing in sixth place in the table.

Bitton's second season back at Tier 6 of Women's football was to prove a successful one with the team finishing as runners-up to Gloucester City, being one of just two sides to take points off the champions, although they were 14 points behind the runaway leaders in the end.

This season they will look to go one better and have made a good start to the current campaign.

Eventful contest somehow ends goalless

Royal Wootton Bassett Town's clash against fellow South West Regional Women's Football League Division One North high-flyers may have ended goalless. But the game certainly wasn't without incident.

Both teams will have finished the afternoon frustrated not to have found the net, with both 'keepers on form, the woodwork and a goalmouth clearance denying visitors Bitton and Bassett missing from the penalty spot.

Bassett had the first clear opportunity of the match as good build up play between Hannah Gulliver and Honor Fraser set up Nat Goodright, but her effort was kept out by a fine Zoe Hodgson save.

Whatever Hodgson could do, Millie Powell was also capable of and the Bassett stopper pulled off good saves to keep out Abbie Woodley-Marshall's low effort before turning Rebecca Sullivan's acrobatically around the woodwork. From the resulting corner, Bitton hit the post.

At the other end Kelly Nightingale struck narrowly over from a Laura Jefferies cross.

Early in the second half, another Bitton corner almost yielded the opener. However, a desperate goalline clearance from Darcy Cox spared Bassett.

Momentum then started to swing Bassett's way as Kat Bach shot just over. She then fed Gulliver whose shot was saved by Hodgson.

Bach continued to be tricky for the visitors to defend and drew a foul in the box. Gulliver stepped up to take the spot kick, but could only shoot straight at Hodgson as it was Bassett's turn to spurn a winner.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town made it three wins from three in the South West Regional Women's Football League Division One North with a thumping 9-0 victory against Stockwood Wanderers.

Six different scorers were on target as James Lally's side also did enough defensively to preserve a third clean sheet in as many league games (and their fifth in seven competitive fixtures).

A one-sided affair saw defender Honor Fraser open the scoring for Bassett. More familiar goal-getters Maddy Elliott and Hannah Gulliver made it 3-0 before the break.

And Bassett then pulled away after the restart.

Midfielder Elle Scott - who has been among the goals in the season's early reckoning - added her fourth of the campaign. Elliott and Gulliver completed their braces before Lauren Bulley added two and Kat Bach got in on the act to make it nine.

Lally will be pleased by the victory, its size and the defensive display that denied Stockwood even a consolation.

All three were vital ingredients that maintained Bassett's positive start - and made a clear statement ahead of an important run of fixtures in November which see Lally's team square off against Bitton (last season's runners-up), current leaders Mangotsfield United and Whitchurch.

Those three teams have all made strong starts - and over the course of November, it will start to become clear who among them will likely be the main sides in the title race.

Millie Powell – Goalkeeper

A highly talented goalkeeper entering her fifth season in senior football. She has great shot stopping ability and is also confident with the ball at her feet. She has earned multiple awards including Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year.



Alice Bowden - Defender

A versatile defender who joined Bassett midway through the 2024-25 season, making ten appearances. Known for her tough tackling and leadership, she previously captained Swindon Town and has also played for Abingdon United and Bristol Rovers.



Briony Hurd – Defence

A strong defender who joined Bassett from Swindon Town in 2023-24. She made 16 appearances that season and has also played for the University of East London Women's First Team.



Darcy Cox – Defence

A talented young centre back entering her third season with Bassett. Known for her physicality and strong challenges, she has earned multiple player of the year awards and was Bassett's leading outfield appearance maker in 2023-24.



Honor Fraser – Defence / Midfield

A strong, technically gifted full back entering her third season with Bassett. She made 27 appearances last season, scoring three goals and earning the Coaches' Player of the Year award.



Laura Jefferies - Defence

A loyal defender who has been with Bassett for 15 years now. She is the club's all-time leading Women's appearance maker, club captain, and has won multiple Player of the Year awards during her time at the club.



Kelly Nightingale – Midfield

A versatile player entering her third season with Bassett. She has significant experience in the FA Women's National League, having played for Swindon Town, Forest Green Rovers, Swindon Supermarine, and Keynsham Town.



Amber Egerton - Midfield

A versatile midfielder who joined Bassett in 2014-15. She has won multiple awards, including Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year. Despite injuries, prior to this season she has made 126 appearances and scored 14 goals.



Holly Baker – Forward

A quick forward known for her ability to hold up the ball and combine well with teammates. She has been with Bassett since 2016-17, scoring 14 goals in 88 appearances prior to this season, and is known for her strong work ethic and reliability.



Natalie Goodright - Midfield

A dynamic midfielder entering her third season with Bassett. She scored five goals in 22 appearances in her first season and added three goals in 27 games last season. Significant experience at a higher level, including the FA Women's National League.



Emma Sykes - Midfield

A long serving cultured central midfielder who came through Bassett's youth system. Prior to this season she has played 106 times for Bassett since 2016-17, scoring 13 goals, and has earned multiple awards, including Players' Player of the Year.



Mia Sanghara - Midfield

A young full back who joined Bassett last season from Swindon Town. She made 15 appearances in her debut campaign, including four starts, and has experience playing for Swindon Spitfires and the University of Sussex Women's team.



Maddy Elliott - Forward

A forward known for her work ethic and goal-scoring ability. She has been with Bassett since 2012-13, scoring 43 goals in 124 appearances, and played a key role in the club's promotion and double-winning season.



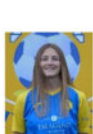
Lucy Goodright - Midfield

An attack-minded midfielder who joined Bassett part way through the 2023-24 season. That year she featured thirteen times - with ten appearances coming from the bench - made the same number of appearances last season, adding nine goals.



Hannah Gulliver - Forward

A versatile forward who joined Bassett in the 2016-17 season. She has scored 53 goals in 136 appearances prior to this season, winning multiple awards including Manager's Player of the Year and Supporters' Player of the Year.



Alice Telling - Midfield

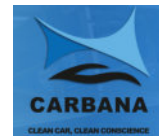
