Good Afternoon and welcome everyone to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for our last home game of the season. We welcome Bath City who have made the short journey along the M4. As always a warm welcome to all the visitors from Bath City, the players, coaches and supporters, I hope you enjoy your brief stay with us this afternoon and wish you a safe journey home.

We go into today's game top of the league on goal difference and have won and lost this league over the years. In Season 2017/18 we lost out on goal difference to Portishead Town as we finished joint top on 54 points however as they had the better goal difference +49 to our +40 they were promoted. We then won the league gaining promotion the following season in 2018 /19 getting the better of Frampton Rangers, this time finishing level on 53 points with us having +56 to their +45. This league has been the most competitive for many a season with three teams still in with a chance of the league win.

We played Bath back in early March at Twerton Park and were able to come away with a narrow one nil victory but were put under lots of pressure during the game. On the day a neutral could have said we had a large slice of luck go our way to take all three points. However, if we were lucky against Bath we had no luck away at Stockwood last week on a Thursday evening with a 7pm kick off. It felt like we were rushing to catch up on time all night long, from the warm up, until the moment we conceded an early penalty to fall behind, this was a goal that we never recovered from and credit to Stockwood they were fighting for the points to try and stay up. A draw would have been a fairer result but this league has shown me you have to be on your game all the time.

Sunday's game was billed as a local derby had everything, which included some late drama and saw us complete a fine comeback after being a goal down along with playing a large majority of the game with ten players.

The desire from this group was there for all to see and once again scoring the winner in the last minute was pleasing moment especially considering the events that unfolded just before the final whistle as a Cirencester player saw red, which then resulted in myself being called a cheat when I was only volunteering in the kiosk. It was rather bizarre!

As this is our last home game of the season I would like to take this opportunity to thank the management / coaching team of James, Gary and Steve who have worked tirelessly during training and match days in preparing this squad. The performance have been there for all to see, and a big thanks must also go to this group of players who have pushed each other all season giving up their time too. Thank you to the volunteers who make my duties much easier some working behind the scenes, Janice and Andy for their match day help with the kiosk, along with the support in putting up the nets. The turnstile has been covered by Craig Moreton this season and it's much appreciated. And the biggest thanks must go to Gareth who has covered for the referee position when we have not had one appointed, as well as running the line within most games. Further appreciation must go to Mark Smedley who puts together this wonderful programme for every home woman's game, as well as the men's first team programme, and it's been great to see Steve Green doing what he does best and snapping those photographs after illness. And my final thanks must go to Pete Tony and Roger for supporting with the cleaning of changing rooms and kit organisation.

We are also looking for supporters to vote for their player of the season, with the only criteria being that you must have watched a minimum of three games either home or away this season. Please get in contact with myself or Sam Wood or look to locate Laura Turnball who will be about with slips today allowing you the opportunity to vote during the match. I hope you all enjoy the game this afternoon and I hope the team can sign off with another win to take the season into the last game. See you in the bar after the game.

Expect a big performance from the girls today.

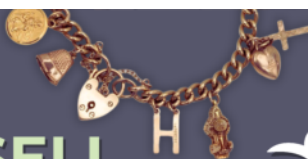

Bath City Women are only in their fourth season having been formed ahead of the 2022-23 Season. The first team play home games at Twerton Park and the Development Team will play there at least once during the season.

They started life in the Somerset County Women's Football League and had a very successful first season, finishing as runners-up to Pen Mill Ladies. This second place finish was enough to give them promotion to the South West Regional Women's League at the first attempt. Season 2023-24 saw them also running a Development Team in the Somerset County League.

Bath City's first season in the South West Regional Women's League saw them playing in the Eastern Division, finishing in a creditable fourth place winning seven and drawing six of their games, with just three defeats all season. If they could have turned some of those drawn games into victories they could well have been challenging for honours in their first season at this level.

The following season saw Bath City playing in what was now the North Division where they repeated that fourth place position in what was a division of 11 teams. As in the previous season their success was built on a mean defence that kept most of their games low scoring affairs.

Bath City currently sit in sixth place in the table with ten wins and three draws and seven defeats from their opening 20 games. Once again they have a good defensive record, conceding the fourth lowest number of goals. At the other end of the pitch Madeleine Brown, Adella Clarke and Jasmine Rennie are frequently amongst the goals.

Previous Meetings

The two teams have met on six previous occasions and all six games have been tight affairs. Bassett have had the better of things with four wins, including a penalty shootout win in the cup, to one for Bath City, with one game being drawn.

Bassett shock Stockwood setback

Royal Wootton Bassett Town suffered a setback in the race for the South West Regional Women's Football League Division One North title as they fell to a shock 3-2 defeat away against Stockwood Wanderers.

Facing a Stockwood side fighting to escape the bottom three, Bassett's midweek visit to Bristol was always going to be a challenging one.

But having kept seven consecutive league clean sheets, James Lally's team entered the game as clear favourites.

Yet they ultimately fell victim to an upset defeat - and missed out on the opportunity to take over top spot from leaders Corsham Town.

Stockwood took the lead from the penalty spot courtesy of Izzy Marsh before Hannah Gulliver equalised with a well taken goal.

However, Maddie Stadde headed a second to restore Stockwood's lead - an advantage her team took into the break after 'keeper Ava Vowles saved from a Lauren Bulley penalty.

Bassett's evening went from bad to worse after the restart when Stockwood captain Toni Blenkinsopp capitalised on a defensive error to make it 3-1.

Alice Bowden did pull one back for Bassett, slotting home after Elle Scott collected a Gulliver corner and squared to the experienced defender.

But, despite a late rally and throwing everything they could at Stockwood, an equaliser was not forthcoming, with Bassett enduring the added frustration of seeing a goal disallowed.



Despite the result, Bassett can still go top - but to do so they now must beat local rivals Cirencester Town at home on Sunday. Fail to win that game, and Bassett will be playing catchup with two games to go.

That added pressure is something that Bassett could have done without.

All three title challengers - Bassett, Corsham and Bitton - can now achieve a maximum of 54 points if they win all their remaining games, with Bassett currently holding the tiebreaker on goal difference should that come into play.

With Bitton and Corsham due to play each other next weekend, one or both are guaranteed to not reach that number.

Here's hoping Bassett stay the course to get there.

Late derby drama takes Bassett top

With two games to go in the South West Regional Women's Football League Division One North, Royal Wootton Bassett Town are in top spot.

How they reached the summit was eventful and drama-filled though as Bassett - playing the majority of the match with ten players - came from behind to earn a 2-1 victory in a feisty derby against Cirencester Town.

Megan Young's last minute goal snatched victory, ensuring Bassett finished a tumultuous few days on a high and with their fate in their own hands. Just.

Thursday's shock defeat against Stockwood Wanderers turned this game into one Bassett had to win to avoid having to rely on results elsewhere in their final two games to overtake Corsham Town.

And it looked as though Bassett's afternoon was destined to end in what would have been a disappointing, dispiriting draw too.

Bassett didn't make things easy for themselves after Poppy Wannell was dismissed in the first half. The young forward let her emotions in the heat of the battle get the better of her, with the referee initially sending her to the sin bin for her language before upgrading that to a red card after Wannell did not back down.

Bassett then saw what seemed to be a perfectly legitimate goal from Hannah Gulliver ruled out for offside when she bundled in the rebound after a Mia Mugford shot was saved. To compound matters, Cirencester quickly went up the other end and took the lead through Annie Martin. Bassett now had to chase the game short-handed.



The hosts eventually levelled when player of the match Briony Hurd found the net following an Elle Scott free kick delivery.

Then, in the final minute, a Scott corner fell to Young, who - much to the delight (and relief) of her team - put the ball away.

It was all too much for Cirencester too as defender Sarah Rayworth decided to deliver an elbow to the ribs of Bassett's Lauren Bulley.

That massively unspotting act earned her a deserved straight red card - with the referee also calling time.

Bassett had snared the victory they needed.



