Thank you for your continued support and please get behind us as we get ever closer to that finish line!

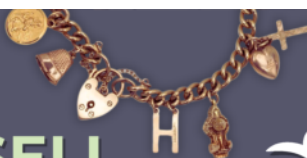

# Today's Opponents

## Mangotsfield United

Like a lot of women's sides, Mangotsfield United are part of a long-established club that initially was focused solely on men's football. Football has been played in the village of Mangotsfield since 1888, and four years later, Mangotsfield FC became a founding member of the Bristol & District League (which later evolved into the Western Football League in 1895), but the club ceased operations after a decade. From 1898 until the 1950s, Mangotsfield FC was disbanded and reformed multiple times.

In January 1951, the parent club scrapped the Reserves XI for financial reasons, leaving many local players without a team. These players chose to establish a new club in the village, and at the beginning of the 1951-52 season, the newly formed Mangotsfield United FC was entered into the Bristol & District League. They achieved five consecutive promotions and gained entry to the Bristol & District Premier Combination. The club remained in the league until the 1972-73 season when it was accepted into the Western League.

Mangotsfield United would spend the next 28 seasons in the Western League, 27 of which were in the top division of the league. The one season out of the Premier Division was in 1982-83 following relegation at the end of the 1981-82 Season when they had finished second from bottom. They were immediately promoted back to the Premier Division after just one season at the lower level and had much success during the rest of the 1980s and 1990. They finished third in both 1987-88 and 1989-90 and then the following season won the Premier Division for the one and only time in their history.

After finishing runners-up in Season 1999-2000 the club were promoted to the Southern League where they would remain for the next 22 seasons, four of which were spent in the Premier Division (Step 3) after winning the Western Division in Season 2004-05.

The remaining 18 divisions were spent in one of the regional divisions at Step 4. Unfortunately Season 2021-22 saw them relegated to the Hellenic League where they have remained ever since playing in the Hellenic Premier Division for four seasons now with their highest position being a fourth placed finish in Season 2024-25.

Mangotsfield United have had a women's side for a number of seasons now and during eight of the past nine seasons the team has been playing at Tier 6 of the Womens game in either the South West Regional League Division 1 North Division or the Eastern Division. The one exception was Season 2024-25 when they were back in the Gloucestershire County League Division 1 after finishing bottom of the South West Regional League Division 1 North at the end of the 2023-24 Season. They were promoted back to the South West Regional League after spending just one season back at County League level, finishing as runners-up to Whitchurch to secure an immediate return to Tier 6.

## Match Report v Bitton (H)

### Goal shy Bassett exit cup

If there's one thing that is most likely to prevent Royal Wootton Bassett Town from claiming honours in the South West Regional Women's Football League this season, it's their profligacy in front of goal.

That frustrating characteristic reared its head again in James Lally's side latest outing as they slipped to a 2-0 Divisional Cup quarter final defeat against Bitton - a team Bassett are also competing with in a congested title race in Division One North.

The result meant that over their last three games Bassett have scored just one goal - a record that will need to improve if they are to earn promotion at the end of the season.

Thankfully, defeat to Bitton in the cup will have no bearing on whether Bassett can seal a return to tier five. But it serves as a reminder as to where they need to focus their efforts as the business end of the season approaches.

At the other end of the pitch, Bassett's defence has been - and continues to be - a force with Bitton's strong attack the latest to find the going tough against a rock solid back line.

But they eventually found their way through twice, scoring from a set piece and then late on when the game was stretched.

This was only the fourth time in 19 competitive fixtures this season that Bassett have conceded multiple times in a game (two other times Bassett have conceded twice with just the one game where they have let in three goals). On all four occasions, Bassett have failed to win.

Fine margins decided the tie with Bitton.



After an opening period in which neither 'keeper was really threatened, Bassett had a big opportunity early in the second half to take the lead.

Bitton 'keeper Morgan Honeywell flapped at a Hannah Gulliver corner, and the ball fell to Alice Bowden whose sweeping effort was headed off the line.

The visitors would then take the lead in fortuitous circumstances. Niamh Hague struck a fierce 25 yard free kick that Millie Powell acrobatically tipped onto the bar. It was a fantastic save, however Powell could do nothing to prevent the rebound falling for Tia Mahadevan who nodded in from close range.

Chances remained at a premium after the opening goal, though Bitton's Skye Coole came close to adding a second for her team when she steered narrowly over from a tight angle.

Then with time winding down Bassett came inches away from an equaliser when Briony Hurd gambled to meet a towering Laura Jefferies cross at the far post. Hurd beat Honeywell to the ball, heading just off target from ten yard before being wiped out by the 'keeper, though no penalty was forthcoming.

Moments later Bitton sealed their victory. There was a hint of offside as Hague delivered a ball over the top for Abbie Woodley-Marshall. But there was no doubting the finish as the Bitton forward coolly lobbed Powell.

It was an unfortunate defeat for Bassett in a game that could have gone either way - and a lesson in how important it is to take your chances.

### Crunch clash sees Bassett clinch crucial Corsham victory

Goals from Lauren Bulley and Laura Jefferies earned Royal Wootton Bassett Town a vital 2-0 derby victory away against Wiltshire rivals in the latest dramatic twist in the race for the South West Regional Women's Football League Division One North title.

Corsham had claimed a 2-0 victory against Bassett last month to break James Lally's side's unbeaten league record. And the Reds had then moved six points ahead of Bassett after winning last weekend when Lally and his team were on cup duty.

Although not do or die for Bassett, the return fixture was a game they could ill afford to lose. But with the pressure on - and fighting against atrocious conditions on a horrendously cut up pitch - Bassett delivered the goods.

What could have been a nine point deficit to leaders Corsham had they lost is now just a three point gap with two games in hand for Bassett to play.

There's still plenty of distance left to travel as the season enters its closing stages, with none of the five teams duking it out at the top yet to create any form of breathing room over their rivals.

But this result proved Bassett could get the job done in a high stakes setting.

They had led early on when Briony Hurd launched a long throw into the box and Bulley punished some slack defending from Alice Blackman, stealing possession from the Corsham centre half in the hosts' penalty area before crashing an emphatic drive into the back of the net via the underside of the crossbar.



Bulley almost grabbed a second midway through the half when seizing on an underhit back pass before dragging wide.

Sloppy defending at the other end then afforded the hosts a golden opportunity to equalise as Darcy Cox put too much on a pass back to Millie Powell, whose heavy touch fell to Ruby Hopkins but she steered over from the edge of the box.

The difficult conditions only got worse in the second half as the driving rain got harder. But neither defensive flinched as they battled on, with no real clear cut chances

Eventually the outcome was settled late on - and captain Jefferies delivered the decisive blow. Stepping up to take a free kick on the right touchline a good forty yards from goal, she sent in a trademark towering delivery that flew into the net over the head of despairing Corsham 'keeper Lily Lewis.

Corsham sought desperately to use what time remained to get back into the game. And they almost did as Anna Lyons guided a Charlie Cowper free kick onto the bar. The ball then bounced back off Jefferies, with Powell springing acrobatically to her right to claw away what appeared a certain goal with an outstanding one-handed save. The danger wasn't clear though and the ball ricocheted back off Hurd before Powell, reacting quickly again, parried and smothered.

That secured a twelfth clean sheet of the season for Bassett - providing the cherry on the top of a crucial victory.

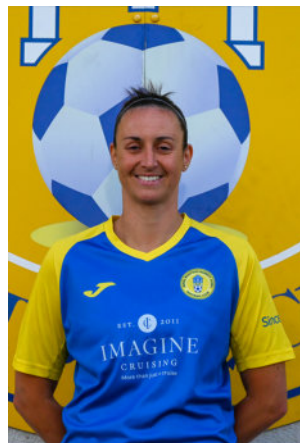
The experienced Taylor produced a peach of a goal - her eighth of the season from twenty yards out.

But the gulf in class between the tier four and six sides was evident in their County Cup final encounter.

Bassett gave a decent account of themselves. Yet that was not enough to prevent a heavy defeat as Swindon maintained their dominance of a competition that, barring a remarkable upset, they will likely continue to win year after year. The Robins were 6-0 in front by half time.

Izzy Cook got them going, finding the top corner from the edge of the box, before the prolific Annie Colston scored a quickfire double. Sky Bedwell soon made it 4-0 as she slotted home. Taylor MacDonald then curled in a free kick for 5-0. Bedwell would make it a half dozen for her side before the break, connecting with a Helena Diaz-Butcher cross from close range.

Within ten minutes of the restart, a MacDonald corner evaded everyone in the box, finding its way in for 7-0. But that would prove to be the end of the scoring as Bassett held out for the remainder of the match. A consolation goal proved beyond Bassett though as Swindon sealed a victory they would have expected. Both teams now revert to league action - and their own title tilts.

For Swindon it will come down to a final day battle with FA Women's National League Division One South West leaders Moneyfields - a game they must win.



For Bassett, six more games remain, beginning with a crucial visit to fellow contenders Bitton on Wednesday - a match that the teams enter level on points having played the same number of games (with Bassett boasting the better goal difference). 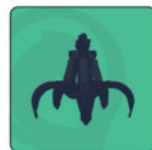
