Welcome to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground. In the past season my normal programme notes, would have said its nice to take a break from league action, for this Second Round tie in the Wiltshire Women's cup, but so far this season we have played three FA cup games and only had

two league fixtures, so feel today's game is a bit more of a hindrance rather than a break. It would have been nice to get a couple more league fixtures in before this game, but that said we've been given a home tie to a side that play below us in the pyramid, and currently sit mid table in Corsham Print Wiltshire Senior League Premier Division.

This will be our first ever meeting with Calne Town Women who play their home games at Beversbrook and we are fortunate to be playing this fixture on the main stadium pitch and I feel grateful that the game was not moved to the AGP like the Development's league game last Saturday. I would like to welcome all that have travelled over from Calne, the coaches, players and any supporters, for their women's team who are experiencing their first visit with us here at the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground.

Today's cup game would normally be a nice distraction from the league fixtures, but with us winning both of our league games so far, it would have been nice to see if we could build on the wins and gain some momentum and climb up the table.

The Women's Wiltshire County Cup is a trophy we have won only once and have now had sixteen attempts with our only win coming in the 2018/19 season against Swindon Spitfires, having reached the final on three other occasions. We lost once to the now folded Warminster Town with the two other times losing to Swindon Town who again put us out last season at the semi-final stage, before going to win the final against a Purton team that folded after the final.

We go into the game today as clear favourites to win and advance to the next round, and I can only give my respect and appreciation to Calne Town for committing to play us in this cup fixture. For any team in Wiltshire to win this trophy they will need to beat favourites Swindon Town Women who have now been given permission with a rule change to play their contracted players in this competition. This to me is a slap in the face to all the other teams not just us at this club but also others around the county because for the last two seasons Swindon have won this competition quite comfortably without contracted players, and are now permitted to play a full 11 aside squad of players who are playing week in week out at Step 4 football with their nearest counterparts being ourselves, Corsham Town and Bemerton Heath Harlequins at Step 6.

As always thank you to everyone who comes along to support the women's team and I am hopeful you will enjoy the game today

Match Report v Gloucester City Reserves

Bassett double downs Gloucester

Royal Wootton Bassett Town still may not have found their scoring boots this season. But a stout defence that, in their 2-0 victory against Gloucester City Reserves, produced a fourth clean sheet in five competitive games to date means they are doing just fine.

At the other end, a goal in either half from Elle Scott and Hannah Gulliver meant that James Lally's side made it two wins from two to begin their South West Regional Women's Football League Division One North campaign.

And although behind on games and sitting in seventh, they are within three points of current leaders Whitchurch in a division that is shaping up to be highly competitive.

Against Gloucester's second string, Bassett were deserved winners, though will be looking to sharpen things up in front of goal in the coming weeks.

This was a game with plenty of chances - with Bassett's first coming as early as the fifth minute when Maddy Elliott guided a Briony Hurd pass just past the post.

After Alisha Kantorowicz shot straight at Bassett 'keeper Millie Powell, Elliott again came close but was denied by visiting shotstopper Sam Linteo who did well to parry for a corner.

Midway through the half though Bassett were ahead. Gloucester could only half clear from a corner and midfielder Elle Scott was on hand to fire home her third of the season from outside the area.



Bassett then had multiple chances from a series of corners in quick succession that should really have led to the second. But Kelly Nightingale headed narrowly wide, a Hurd pass across the face of goal was well cut out by Linteo, Laura Jefferies saw a shot saved by Linteo and two further corners resulted in goalmouth scrambles with Bassett unable to force the ball home.

Having rode their luck, the visitors then had two opportunities to level shortly before the interval but Powell was equal to Hannah Clarke's effort while a Hollie Handisides strike from beyond the area sailed just wide of the post.

Following the restart, Bassett created another string of openings that failed to yield another goal as Nat Goodright grazed the bar and Elliott and Tori Taylor both failed to locate the target.

Shortly after the hour though, there was finally some breathing space. And their second arrived in style as Hannah Gulliver opened her account for the season with an emphatic finish.

That second goal proved crucial as it seemed to knock the confidence out of their visitors. And for the remainder of the contest, Bassett were on top.

Yet a further half dozen openings didn't bring a third. Scott, Goodright, Elliott (on two occasions) and Hurd all had opportunities, while there was a further goalmouth scramble.

In the end, Bassett had to settle for just the two goals. Importantly though, that was plenty to secure another three points.

Millie Powell – Goalkeeper

A highly talented goalkeeper entering her fifth season in senior football. She has great shotstopping ability and is also confident with the ball at her feet. She has earned multiple awards including Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year.



Thea Hopkins – Goalkeeper

A goalkeeper who joined Bassett last season, featuring four times mainly in the Wiltshire County Cup. An all-round sportswoman, she captains RWB Cricket Club's women's side and has represented Wiltshire in cricket and played for RWB Hockey Club.



Briony Hurd – Defence

A strong defender who joined Bassett from Swindon Town in 2023-24. She made 16 appearances that season and has also played for the University of East London Women's First Team.



Darcy Cox – Defence

A talented young centre back entering her third season with Bassett. Known for her physicality and strong challenges, she has earned multiple player of the year awards and was Bassett's leading outfield appearance maker in 2023-24.



Honor Fraser – Defence / Midfield

A strong, technically gifted full back entering her third season with Bassett. She made 27 appearances last season, scoring three goals and earning the Coaches' Player of the Year award.



Laura Jefferies – Defence

A loyal defender who has been with Bassett for 15 years now. She is the club's all-time leading Women's appearance maker, club captain, and has won multiple Player of the Year awards during her time at the club.



Kelly Nightingale – Midfield

A versatile player entering her third season with Bassett. She has significant experience in the FA Women's National League, having played for Swindon Town, Forest Green Rovers, Swindon Supermarine, and Keynsham Town.



Amber Egerton – Midfield

A versatile midfielder who joined Bassett in 2014-15. She has won multiple awards, including Players' Player and Manager's Player of the Year. Despite injuries, prior to this season she has made 126 appearances and scored 14 goals.



Holly Baker – Forward

A quick forward known for her ability to hold up the ball and combine well with teammates. She has been with Bassett since 2016-17, scoring 14 goals in 88 appearances prior to this season, and is known for her strong work ethic and reliability.



Natalie Goodright – Midfield

A dynamic midfielder entering her third season with Bassett. She scored five goals in 22 appearances in her first season and added three goals in 27 games last season. Significant experience at a higher level, including the FA Women's National League.



Emma Sykes – Midfield

A long serving, cultured central midfielder who came through Bassett's youth system. Prior to this season she has played 106 times for Bassett since 2016-17, scoring 13 goals, and has earned multiple awards, including Players' Player of the Year.



Mia Sanghara – Midfield

A young full back who joined Bassett last season from Swindon Town. She made 15 appearances in her debut campaign, including four starts, and has experience playing for Swindon Spitfires and the University of Sussex Women's team.



Caitlin Brooks – Midfield

A forward who joined Bassett last season from FC Chippenham Youth. She was Bassett's top scorer with 23 goals in 17 games, including four hat tricks. Previously, she was a prolific scorer in the Wiltshire County Women's League.



Alice Bowden – Defence

A versatile defender who joined Bassett midway through the 2024-25 season, making ten appearances. Known for her tough tackling and leadership, she previously captained Swindon Town and has also played for Abingdon United and Bristol Rovers.



Maddy Elliott – Forward

A forward known for her work ethic and goal-scoring ability. She has been with Bassett since 2012-13, scoring 43 goals in 124 appearances, and played a key role in the club's promotion and double-winning season.



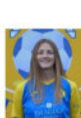
Lucy Goodright – Midfield

An attack-minded midfielder who joined Bassett part way through the 2023-24 season. That year she featured thirteen times - with ten appearances coming from the bench - made the same number of appearances last season, adding nine goals.



Hannah Gulliver – Forward

A versatile forward who joined Bassett in the 2016-17 season. She has scored 53 goals in 136 appearances prior to this season, winning multiple awards including Manager's Player of the Year and Supporters' Player of the Year.



Alice Telling – Midfield

An intelligent midfielder who joined Bassett in 2024. She made 18 appearances and scored once in her debut season. Previously, she played for Swindon Town, making 21 appearances in the FA Women's National League, and is also a qualified coach.

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Kathryn Bach - Forward

Kathryn Bach is an aggressive, hard-working forward who joined Bassett last season. She scored ten goals in 27 games, including a brace in a 3-0 win at Stockwood Wanderers. Previously, she played for Cheltenham Town and Swindon Town, impressing at both clubs.



Tori Taylor - Midfield

An experienced forward who joined Bassett this season. She previously played for Forest Green Rovers, scoring 12 goals in 29 games, and has also featured for West Ham United and Swindon Town in the FA Women's National League.



Elle Scott

An experienced midfielder who joined Bassett this season. She previously played for Swindon Town, Missouri Valley College in the USA, and Forest Green Rovers, making ten first team appearances in the FA Women's National League Southern Premier Division.



Lauren Bulley - Forward

A forward with an impressive goal-scoring record at County League level. She joins Bassett this season, having previously played for Highworth Town and Corsham Town, scoring 21 goals in her debut season and continuing to register impressive hauls in subsequent seasons.



James Lally - Manager

A UEFA B qualified coach appointed as Bassett's Women's First Team manager in May. He has managed in the FA Women's National League, including stints with Swindon Town and Cheltenham Town Reserves, and most recently with Southampton Women.



Dave Tomlinson - Coach

Joins Bassett's Women's First Team as goalkeeper coach this season. A former coach in Bassett's youth section, who has significant experience in Women's football having served as Swindon Town's goalkeeper coach for the past five years.



Steve Kennedy - Coach

A specialist defensive coach with more than ten years' experience, Kennedy joined Bassett's Women's First Team last season.



Gary Clarke - Coach

Joins Bassett's as a coach this season. He brings significant prior coaching experience in the Women's game, including with Swindon Town's Development side, and has also spent time coaching in the Men's game, most notably at New College in the Hellenic League.
