Bassett Bulletin

GOOD EVENING and welcome back (finally) to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground for this Wiltshire Premier Shield First Round home cup tie against Highworth Town.

A warm welcome to all our visitors who have made the short journey from Highworth, we hope you enjoy your brief stay with us this evening and wish you a safe journey home.

It is so long since we were last at home this feels a bit like the start of a new season and pulling a programme together after such a long gap was more difficult than anticipated as I had not been updating all the stats since that Tuffley Rovers game last month.

We reached the semi-final of this competition last season, helped massively by "an assist" from Rob Brown and hopefully we will get through the First Round of this cup in a more conventional way this season.

Like ourselves Highworth Town are struggling at the wrong end of the table at the moment and both teams will no doubt welcome the break from league action with tonight's game and then a league cup fixture on Saturday. Both teams will be looking to get a couple of cup wins to build confidence ahead of their next league fixture.

Highworth currently sit five points above us although they have played one more game. The two sides have met once this season at Highworth with Highworth edging a close encounter by a single goal, former Bassett player Harvey Scholes getting the winner 21 minutes from time. The result could easily have gone the other way and if it had the two teams league positions would have seen Bassett above tonight's visitors, fine margins and all that.

Over the years the two clubs have met on 76 occasions with Highworth having the better of things with 39 wins to our 29 with eight games ending in draws. It would be nice if we could return to winning ways tonight and close that gap.

Since that last home game against Tuffley Rovers we have played four away games in the North of England against Droitwich Spa, Westfields, Worcester Raiders and Pershore Town. Whilst we did not win any of the four games, we picked up useful points away at Westfields and Pershore and pushed the then league leaders Droitwich all

the way before narrowly losing 2-1. Hopefully the heavy defeat at Worcester Raiders was just a minor blip. Those sort of results happen sometimes when you have a young inexperienced side and the important thing is how the team bounce back from such a setback and the point at Pershore last Saturday was certainly encouraging and we nearly took all three points back home.

Whilst the First Team have been on their travels, the Development side have played three of their last four games at the Gerard Buxton Ground and are currently on a four-game unbeaten run. An impressive 3-1 away win over Melksham Town Reserves in the County Cup has been followed by three home games which has seen Mark Simpkins side draw with Pewsey Vale and Shrivenham and defeat Faringdon Town to sit seventh in the table. They are now just seven points short of the total points they accumulated the whole of last season, and they are yet to reach the halfway point of the season. In the County Cup the Development Team will be home to Western League side Warminster Town at the beginning of December.

Another side who has made a good start to the season are the Women's side who followed their recent 11-1 win in the County Cup over Calne Town with a 9-0 league win on Sunday over Stockwood Wanderers. The Women's side have won all three of their league games played so far and are yet to concede a goal in the league. Mangotsfield United and Corsham Town also have a 100% winning record with Mangotsfield top of the table with five straight wins and it looks like those three sides plus Bitton will be fighting it out for promotion. In the County Cup the Women have drawn Highworth Town in the Quarter Final and will be hoping to progress to the last four but will certainly not take it as a given against a decent Wiltshire Senior League side who also won 11-1 in the last round.

Back to this evening's game, I hope you all enjoy the game and hopefully we will be celebrating a win to maintain our interest in this county cup competition.

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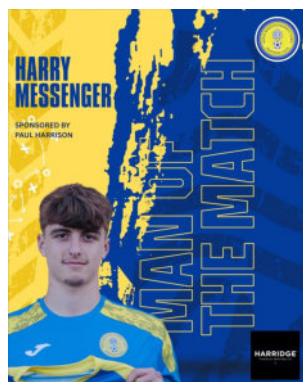
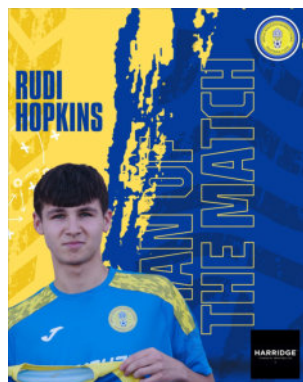

Tonight's Opponents

Highworth Town



Highworth Town Football Club was formed in 1893. We joined the Cirencester & District league and it took us some time to record our first honours, until 1909-10 in fact, when we won both the Swindon Junior Cup and the local Advertiser Cup, a cup we captured again in 1912-13.

After winning the Cirencester & District League Division Two in 1931-32, we moved to the Swindon & District League, where we completed the Third Division championship and Swindon Junior Cup double in 1933-34.

The 1950s saw us make a dramatic rise through the local football ranks. We won the Swindon & District League Third Division title again in 1954-55 and then the Division Two title the following season. One more season was needed to clinch the Division One title and also the Wilts Junior Cup. We then went on to win the Premier Division title in 1957-58, along with the Faringdon Thursday Memorial Cup and the following season we were the Premier Division champions again, also winning the Swindon Advertiser Cup.

We continued to dominate the Swindon & District Premier Division in the 1960s, winning four successive titles from 1960-61 and another hat-trick from 1965-66 to 1967-68, making seven titles in eight seasons. We reached the final of the Wilts Senior Cup for the first time in 1962-63 and won it the following season.

There was a switch to the Wilts Combination League, where we finished as runners-up in Division Two in 1970-71. 1972-73 saw another Wilts Senior Cup victory and all this success prompted us to join the Hellenic League. We achieved our first honours in 1988-89, winning the First Division Challenge Cup and reached the final of the Wilts Senior Cup yet again.

We finally achieved Premier Division status in 1993-94 gaining promotion after finishing third in Division One. Since then we have been winners of the Wilts Senior Cup in 1995-96, 1997-98, 2008-09 and again in 2014-15, winners of the Hellenic Challenge Cup in 2011-12, winners of the Hellenic Supplementary Cup in 1998-99 and runners up in 2003-04, runners-up in the Premier Division in 1999-00 and winners of the Premiership title in 2004-05.

In more recent history, the club reached the semi-final of the FA vase in 2014-15 where we were knocked out by eventual winners North Shields in a closely fought two-legged tie. That season also saw us pick up the Wilts Senior Cup.

In the 2016-17 and 2017-18 seasons we were runners-up in the Wilts Senior Cup to Swindon Supermarine and Chippenham Town respectively, both of which played at higher levels than us.

Also in the 2017-18 season we saw promotion to the Southern League Division 1 South as we finished as the best third placed team across the whole country. This means we are now playing the highest level of football the club had seen.

The 2022-23 season saw the FA move us laterally into the Southern League Division 1 Central which meant a difficult season with the extra travelling time/distance, and we finished in 17th place, leading to a play-off against Malvern Twn, a team that finished 2nd at Step 5, which we unfortunately lost resulting in relegation back to the Hellenic League.

A management change was made for the 2023-24 campaign with Paul Braithwaite and his backroom staff replacing the outgoing Gareth Daviews and his backroom team. It was a successful first year in charge for Braithwaite as we made it to the FA Cup Second Round Qualifying where we hosted National League side Weymouth FC in a game where we gave them a good run for their money but ultimately lost 3-1. He also led the team to the Quarter Final of the FA Vase where, on another day, the result could have been very different.

League wise we finished 3rd in the Hellenic Premier Division but unfortunately lost the Play-off Semi Final to Royal Wootton Bassett Town - it was just a step too far at the end of a very hard and long season that ended with us playing seven games in the final two weeks.

Season 2024-25 was another successful league season, finishing in 4th place and only just missing out on promotion after losing 1-0 to Sporting Club Inkberrow in the Hellenic League Play-off Final.

Late rally falls short as Rovers hold on

For the best part of an hour against Tuffley Rovers, Royal Wootton Bassett Town lacked a real attacking spark despite a display full of effort. Only one outcome seemed likely too as goals from Karnell Chambers and Jamie Creed put the visitors 2-0 ahead.

However in the final quarter of the match Bassett jumped into life. A Rudi Hopkins goal got Jonny Aitkenhead's side on the scoresheet on 66 minutes. And from that point on only one team - Bassett - seemed likely to net again. Yet, despite multiple good chances falling their way, an equaliser proved elusive on another ultimately frustrating afternoon for Bassett.

Bassett were seeking a response following Wednesday's 6-2 thrashing at the hands of Longlevens. And this was a positive, improved display. Again though Bassett ended the match empty-handed.

Neither side produced much in a first half of very limited chances. While Tuffley found themselves on the front foot more than their hosts, they were unable to fashion a shot on goal. A counter attack from a Bassett corner finally changed that - and produced the opening goal. Lewis Hayward was unable to snuff out the danger, allowing a ball to be played into the left channel for Chambers who comfortably beat the offside trap before cutting inside Harry Messenger and sweeping home from close range.

Chambers could have had a second ten minutes later when he raced onto a long ball from 'keeper Luke Merchant. Fortunately for Bassett, Lewis Clark was quick off his line, producing a fine parry at point blank range to avert another avoidable goal.



At the other end Bassett were limited to just half chances as they found the Rovers back line difficult to breach. And their task was made harder on the hour. A loose ball fell to Chambers on the edge of the box and he produced a low, deflected drive that Clark did brilliantly to divert onto the woodwork. The rebound fell kindly for Creed though and he guided home first time.

The introduction of Kye Williams then helped usher in a swing in momentum that almost saw Bassett claim a point. Bassett came close to re-establishing a foothold in the match following a Marcel Lewis' cross the from the right. Ollie Smith and Finn Hopkins both had bites at the cherry but they were denied by fine goalline blocks from Harley Mustoe and Macaulay Herbert.

Bassett wouldn't have to wait long for their goal though. Williams played a first time pass to Rudi Hopkins who danced his way past two defenders before producing an assured finish into the bottom corner.

The home side were now firmly on top. Hopkins almost had a second with a fierce 25 yard drive that Merchant did well to tip away at full stretch. Lewis then received a Hopkins pass, cut inside from the right and flashed a shot inches wide of the post.

It was soon Williams' turn to come close. With ten minutes to go he fired just over on the turn from the edge of the box. Then in the closing minutes Lewis fizzed in a low cross from the left that fell to Williams who guided narrowly over from 15 yards. Bassett's comeback attempt thus fell agonisingly short with Rovers breathing a sigh of relief when the final whistle came.

An impressive performance in an entertaining contest saw Royal Wootton Bassett Town push Hellenic League Premier Division pacesetters Droitwich Spa all the way. However that was not enough to prevent a third straight loss for Jonny Aitkenhead's side as the Saltmen prevailed 2-1.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town were finally rewarded for an impressive, resilient display as Jonny Aitkenhead's side drew 1-1 away at high-flying Westfields.

Bassett went into the match on the back of three straight losses - including consecutive 2-1 defeats in games against Tuffley Rovers and Droitwich Spa in which they more than merited a point.

On this occasion Bassett got the positive outcome that their endeavour deserved. And, rather than feeling unfortunate to come away empty handed, this time Aitkenhead and his team will feel as though they merited all three points having been the better side throughout a tense contest.

The opening quarter of the game had seen relatively little goalmouth action.

But Bassett were to take the lead on 27 minutes. 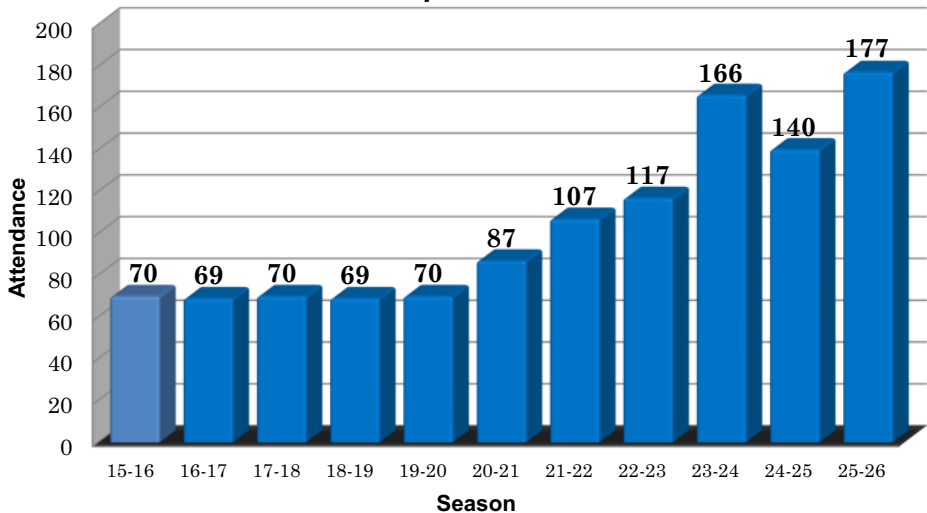

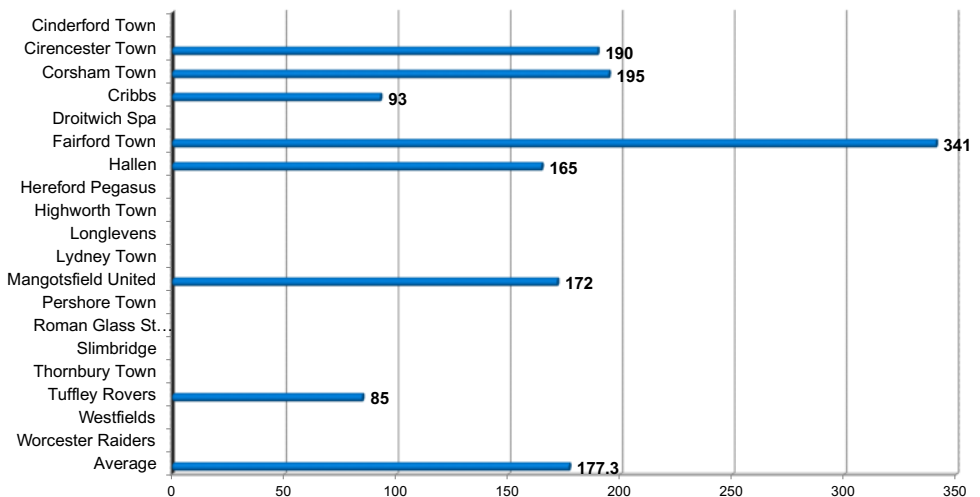
