and welcome back to the Gerard Buxton Sports Ground. And yes we finally got to play an away fixture last Sunday, after playing the last six games at home, and you guessed it we now have another run of three home fixtures in a row, starting with today's game in the Wiltshire

Women's County Cup Quarter Final tie against Highworth Town. We have only played Highworth on one other occasion way back in 2011/12 season. I was the Bassett manager on that day but could only remember that we won a very close game playing away at the Elms. I have been able to look back on our wonderful website, in the archive section to find the result with the game being played on Sunday 20th November 2011 where it finished 1-3 in our favour and on the score sheet that day was one player who will hopefully feature in today's game Madeline Elliott.

We go into the game today as clear favourites to win and advance to the Semi Finals which are due to be played in mid January next year, having already beaten Calne Town in the previous round, who have just recently beaten Highworth last Sunday 4-1.

As always I would like to give my respect and appreciation to Highworth Town for committing to play this cup fixture, with some sides in the Wiltshire County League giving their opponents walkovers. I did mention in the Calne Town programme notes that for any team in Wiltshire to win this trophy they will need to beat favourites Swindon Town Women. So far the draw has been kind to us, with both games being home ties against lower step teams, and it will be interesting to see how strong Swindon go against Corsham Town in one of the other ties today.

We have started the season very well winning four out of five league games, the home win over Bitton two weeks ago come at a cost, with Hannah Gulliver having to leave the pitch after a late challenge from their goalkeeper who was rightly sent off for the dangerous challenge. The goalkeeper was not the only person from Bitton to receive a red card in the game, with the Manager also being asked to leave the pitch receiving two yellows.

Credit to Bitton they played much better football after they had gone down to ten players but it wasn't enough to snatch the points from us.

Last Sunday's 2-2 draw away at Mangotsfield United will go down as two points dropped, the first half last week is the best football I have seen played in my opinion in over seven seasons, we controlled the first half from the start to the finish, and only leading 2-0 at the break would prove to be costly. Mangotsfield had the better of the second half and showed why they are top of the table with a spirited comeback taking the two chances they got. Looking at the current league table and results so far, this season will be full of twist and turns and could be won by any of the current top 5.

As always thank you to everyone who comes along to support the women's team and I am hopeful you will enjoy the game today.

Today's Opponents

Highworth Town

Highworth Town Football Club started life as just a men's club having been formed way back in 1893. The club joined the Cirencester & District league and it took some time to record their first honours, until 1909-10 in fact, when they won both the Swindon Junior Cup and the local Advertiser Cup, a cup they captured again in 1912-13. After winning the Cirencester & District league Division 2 championship in 1931-32, the club moved to the Swindon & District league, where they secured the Division 3 championship and Swindon Junior Cup double in 1933-34.

The 1950s saw Highworth make a dramatic rise through the local football ranks, winning the Swindon & District League Division 3 title again in 1954-55 and then the Division 2 title the following season. One more season was needed to clinch the Division 1 title and also the Wilts Junior Cup. They then went on to win the Premier Division title in 1957-58 and again the following season along with the Advertiser Cup. Highworth continued to dominate the Swindon & District Premier Division in the 1960s, winning four successive titles from 1960-61, and another three from 1965-66 to 67-68, making seven titles in eight seasons. They also reached the final of the Wilts Senior Cup for the first time in 1962-63 and won it the following season.

The 1970's saw Highworth move across to the new Wilts Combination League, where they finished as runners-up in Division 2 in 1970-71. 1972-73 saw another Wilts Senior Cup victory and all this success prompted the club to join the Hellenic league. Highworth achieved our first Hellenic League honours in 1988-89, winning the Division 1 Challenge Cup and also reached the final of the Wilts Senior Cup yet again. Season 1993-94 saw the club gain promotion to the Hellenic Premier Division after finishing third in Division 1. Since then they have been winners of the Wilts Senior Cup in 1995-96, 1997-98, 2008-09 and again in 2014-15, winners of the Hellenic Challenge Cup in 2011-12, runners-up in the Premier Division in 1999-00 and winners of the Premier Division title in 2004-05.

In more recent history, they reached the semi-final of the prestigious FA vase in 2014-15 where they were knocked out by eventual winners North Shields in a closely fought two-legged tie but had the consolation of winning the Wiltshire Senior Cup again that season. In the 2016-17 and 2017-18 seasons they were runners-up in the Wilts Senior Cup to Swindon Supermarine and Chippenham Town respectively, both of whom played at higher levels. Season 2017-18 season saw the club promoted to the Southern League Division 1 South, the highest level of football the club had ever played at. Season 2022-23 season saw the club move laterally into the Southern League Division 1 Central which entailed extensive travel and difficult journeys around the outskirts of London.

After a very difficult season with the circumstances forced on the club by the FA, they finished 17th which was a relegation play-off spot which meant they had to play against a team that finished second at Step and were beaten 4-1 by Malvern Town in the play-off which meant the club returned to the Hellenic League. Season 2023-24 saw the club nearly bounce back at the first attempt, finishing third but were beaten in the play-offs by near neighbours Royal Wootton Bassett Town. The club had another good run in the FA Vase reaching the quarter finals. They made the play-offs again the following season losing to Sporting Club Inkberrow in the final.

Highworth Town formed a Ladies side in Season 2019 competing in the Wiltshire Women's & Girls League but that first season was to prove a difficult one with the season brought to a premature end due to Covid. The following season was also impacted by Covid with Highworth top of the table, unbeaten in their opening eight league games at the time the season was brought to a premature end. The first full season back was to prove a difficult one for Highworth, with the Ladies side finishing second from bottom with just two wins in their 18 league games. Since then Highworth have shown continual improvement season on season, finishing ninth in Season 2022-2, seventh in Season 2023-24 and third place last season.

Bassett battle to big Bitton win

November is set to be a vitally important month in the South West Regional Women's Football League Division One North for Royal Wootton Bassett Town. And James Lally's side got off to the perfect start, recording an impressive 3-1 victory against last season's runners-up Bitton.

Bitton got the better of Bassett in 2024-25. But goals from Briony Hurd, Maddy Elliott and Lauren Bulley ensured it's advantage Bassett this time round in what is shaping up to be a very open title race.

Bassett took the lead on the stroke of half time when Hurd bundled the ball home after a towering Hannah Gulliver corner led to a brief scramble in the six yard box.

The second goal - and the lead up to it - would be critical in determining the game's final outcome.

After racing onto an Elle Scott through ball, Gulliver knocked the ball past 'keeper Hayley Honeywell, who scythed the Bassett forward down with a heavy, cynical lunge just outside the box.

Honeywell was duly dismissed, sparking protestations from the Bitton bench and forcing the visitors to put an outfield player in goal.

Elliott stepped up to take the free kick and steered a precise low strike into the bottom left corner to make it 2-0.

It was soon 3-0. After receiving possession on the left wing, player of the match Elliott burst inside before feeding a pass to Bulley. Two touches took Bulley into the box where she arrowed a clever toe poke into the bottom right corner.

A speculative long range effort from Bella Twaddle that looped in over the head of Millie Powell did pull one back for Bitton with quarter of an hour to go.

But, with the man advantage, Bassett weren't really threatened for the rest of the match, and claimed an important victory.

The tough fixtures continue - next up Bassett visit early leaders Mangotsfield United, who - like Bassett, are still unbeaten.

But Lally and his team will go into the game full of confidence after this triumph.

Match Report v Mangotsfield United

All square after Bassett squander lead

A contest pitting first against third in the South West Regional Women's Football League Division One North ended all square after Royal Wootton Bassett Town surrendered a 2-0 lead against Mangotsfield United.

James Lally's side seemed on course to make it five wins from five league games - and to move up to second in the table - at half time after a pair of early goals from Tori Taylor and Maddy Elliott.

Instead, however, Mangotsfield clawed their way back onto level terms to cap off a closely fought encounter.

Bassett made a furious start and were 2-0 up inside ten minutes.

Taylor opened the scoring, demonstrating her strength and finishing ability as she started and finished the goalscoring move.

Receiving a pass thirty yards from goal, Taylor did well to shield the ball before freeing Honor Fraser in the right channel. Fraser's cross into the box was then cleared only as far as the edge of the box where Taylor was lurking and she arrowed a precise first time drive into the bottom left corner.

Elliott quickly doubled the visitors' lead. Laura Jefferies seized possession before feeding Elliott on the left wing. Elliott then burst inside, outpaced two defenders and poked past the onrushing 'keeper, with the ball going in off the right post.

Taking a leaf out of Bassett's book, Mangotsfield scored shortly after the restart to restore a foothold in the game. And their first arrived in fortuitous fashion as Millie Powell was unable to come up with Adele Elliott's left wing cross, with the ball trickling over the line.

Shortly after the hour the scores were level. Bassett were guilty of overplaying at the back and Olivia Goozee seized upon a stray Powell pass before firing in from the edge of the box.

Neither side was then able to find a winner despite both teams having chances.

The result, combined with wins for Whichurch, Bitton and Corsham Town, saw Mangotsfield drop from top spot and Bassett slip to fifth.

But it's shaping up to be a thrilling, wide open title race as the top five in the division remains exceptionally close.

Bassett, Mangotsfield and Corsham all remain unbeaten too.

Those records will come under serious threat after next week's break for County Cup action. A week later Mangotsfield and Corsham go at it while November ends for Bassett with a fixture against Whitchurch.

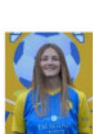

Salisbury were comfortable 9-0 winners over Stratton, whilst FC Chippenham brought their impressive league form into the cup winning 5-1 at home against Bishops Cannings. The final tie of the Preliminary Round saw two teams who had met in the league the week before, Marlborough Town Reserves and Ferndale Rodbourne up against each other. In the league encounter at Marlborough the home side had run out 3-0 winners and they repeated that score line once again.

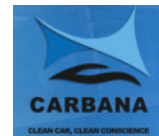
