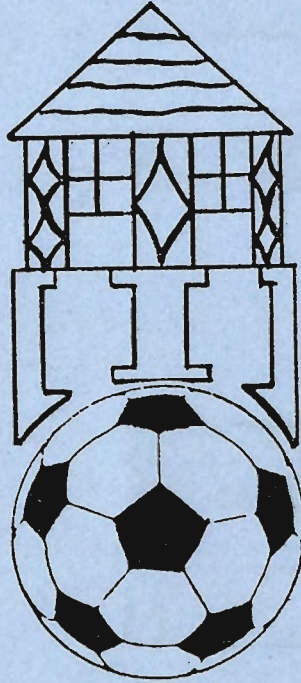

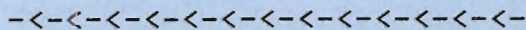

I have again located my pen and paper and it's a pleasure to be able to welcome you all once again to Rylands Way for the visit this afternoon of our near neighbours Purton, and to their players, officials and supporters we extend a warm welcome and offer our congratulations on reaching the Wilts Senior Cup final again this year.

It is now some weeks since our last home game in the League - against Almondsbury on 31 Dec 88. In fact it is our first game at all since we travelled to Chipping Norton to pick up three valuable points in difficult conditions on a day when nearly all soccer in the region was the victim of waterlogged pitches.

Anyway we are back to the league programme and our game today against Purton is not going to be an easy one. There is always a certain amount of pride at stake when we meet. Apart from being a local derby, Bassett has a score to settle with Purton to avenge the Wilts Senior Cup Final defeat from last season. We nearly made it when we travelled to Purton earlier in the season when we managed a 2-2 draw, so today we will be going all out for a win to collect 3 more valuable points in the league.

It is not possible for Bassett to achieve any league honours this season, but a final run of favourable results could well see them finish in the top placings. Had it not been for numerous injuries earlier in the season, I am sure that Bassett would have been in with a good chance of honours. That said, the team has done remarkably well in their first season in the Federated Homes League, and have proved that they can more than hold their own at the higher level of competition.

Rather than give you a resume of matches played since I last put pen to paper, I have produced all the results together with current league tables.

The reserves continue to do well. Having set aside two disappointing results over the Christmas period, they are now back into winning ways and over the last 4 games have scored 26 goals with only 6 against. In a 16 goal match last weekend at Marlborough, Bassett scored 11 goals, and with games against bottom placed Denbar Willstwo week running, they will be looking for maximum points, and if gained will still be in with a chance of league honours, having beaten Bemerton to reach the semi-final of the Ghia Junior Cup, this season has the makings of being very successful for the reserves.

Our congratulations to Damon York on being selected for the Wilts County B side, and I am sure that you will join me in wishing Damon the very best of luck in the match against the Dorset FA at Calne on 22 Mar 89.

Thanks again for your support today and lets hope we have a good competitive game against Purton to recommence our home league programme after such a long lay-off.

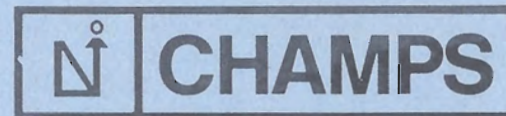
