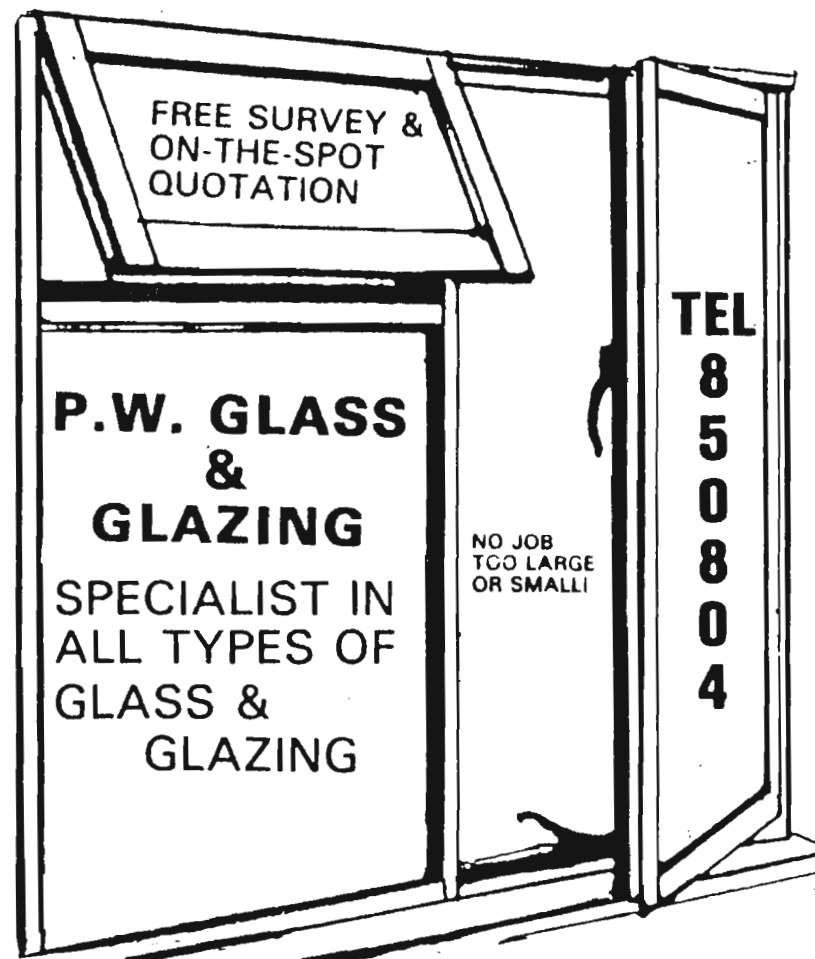

Good afternoon everyone and welcome once again to the Gerrard Buxton Sports Ground for a Federated Homes League Division 1 fixture, and this afternoon we entertain Clanfield and to their, players and supporters we extend a warm welcome. We also extend a welcome to Clanfield's new manager, Mick Pethick, who up until recently was a playing member of Wootton Bassett Town - good luck Mick with your new Club and we hope that your venture into the management field will prove to be successful for you.

This is the second time we have entertained Clanfield at home this season. The first time was on 21 October in the first round of the Division 1 Cup when we beat them convincingly 4-1 with goals from Damon York (3) and Terry Davies (1) to put us into the second round.

Since that 4-1 win over Clanfield, Bassett have not won a match. They have lost at home to Oldacre 0-1 in the Wilts Snr Cup, lost at home again to Chipping Norton 0-1 in the League, but last Saturday away to Cheltenham Town Reserves they managed a 1-1 draw, with the goal coming from Warwick Burnett after 15 minutes in what on all accounts was a good team performance, with Mark Ayres, Warwick Burnett and Terry Davies having particularly good games. Having played so well at Cheltenham, perhaps the run of poor results is behind them and they can get back into winning ways again today, although having said that, their new manager will I am sure have his team well and truly "fired up" in an attempt to avenge the Cup defeat back in October.

Since I last wrote the Reserves have played at Malmesbury Vic and earned a 1-1 draw in a match where Paul Burke had a very good game. The Reserves were unlucky not to have won the game as they had most of the play. The following week they travelled away to lowly placed Warminster Town Res to earn yet another draw 1-1 with a last minute goal from Andy Bryant, his first for 3 years with the Club. This was a result they must be very grateful for as the team did not play too well at all. Last week saw them at home to unbeaten Pinehurst, and a goal in each half from Pinehurst saw the Reserves well and truly beaten.

On Tuesday of this week I attended a 'Personal Hearing' of a disciplinary case heard by the Wilts FA. The reasons for attendance and the outcome are immaterial but what I would like to stress is, if any player is any doubt about asking for a personal hearing in a case brought against them by the Wilts FA and I they think that they have a case to answer they really must ask for the hearing because the hearing I attended was extremely well organised and the disciplinary committee really did give the individual a very fair hearing. What I am trying to get across is, don't think that the case is prejudged before you attend - because that could not be further from the truth - every portion of evidence is heard, and then, and only then will the Committee make up their mind and pronounce judgement.

I am sorry that I have not been able to include any other item of interest this week, but finding something different to print is becoming rather difficult. I want to keep the content of the programme reasonably interesting so if any of our regular supporters have any ideas, I would welcome your suggestions - clean ones only entertained.

Thanks for your support this afternoon and lets hope that Bassett can produce the same result over Clanfield as they did back in October.

Clanfield (April 85) to give them their full title have travelled to us today from eight miles West of Witney in Oxfordshire.

We have always been successful against Clanfield and in all our outings since Wootton Bassett were elected into the Federated Homes League, they have failed to beat us.

In our 2 league meetings last season we beat them 6-2 at home in October 1988 and at their own ground in April of this year, we managed a 1-1 draw.

Last season was not too successful for Clanfield who finished 6th from bottom of the league having gained 35 points from the 28 games played (W9, D8, L11), scoring 49 goals and conceding 55 in the process.

They come to us today 5th from bottom of the league on 10 points, 1 point behind Wootton Bassett but having played 2 games more. Of the 11 games they have played so far they have wone only one, drawn 7 and lost 3 - so they appear to be the draw specialists of the league.

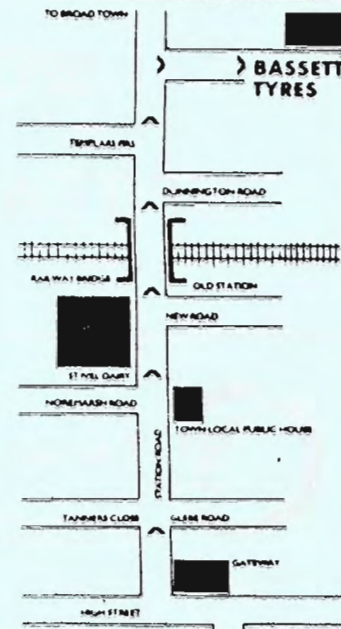
