

Good afternoon everyone and welcome to the Gerrard Buxton Sports Ground for our first Federated Homes League fixture of the decade and I would like to wish you all a very happy, healthy and successful New Year.

To get the New Year off to a flying start we entertain Cheltenham Town Reserves, and to their players, management and supporters we extend a very warm welcome.

Our fixtures over the Christmas period met with mixed success. On 23 December when we entertained our near neighbours Purton, we lost 2-1, the Bassett goal coming from Damon York. A disappointing game for Bassett considering it was a local derby and in front of what was a relatively good crowd. Bassett never really go going and were well beaten by a Purton side who approached the game in a far more positive way and played in a manner that all local derbies should be played in and their victory gave them their first win over us in this league.

On 30 December we made the relatively short trip to Highworth to win 2-0 with the goals coming from Roger Frost and Damon York in what was an altogether better team performance. Manager Mick Woolford was well pleased with this result as Bassett showed a good attitude towards the game and had the appetite that was lacking against Purton the previous week. A good performance yet again from Mark Ayres in goal and from Tony Woosnam and Frank Serretore, and to quote the manager "Neil Timbrell was outstanding playing as sweeper". This game saw the introduction into the Bassett side of Andy Bryant, who up until recently was playing regularly with the Reserves. A difficult game for Andy to cut his teeth on as he was up against some good players, but he played well enough to get the call again today.

The Reserves have had only one game since I last wrote. Their scheduled away fixture at Purton on 23 December was a victim of a waterlogged pitch but on 30 December they entertained Avebury at home. This match saw a Bassett first. The first time for many years, if at all ever, that Bassett has fielded a father and son in the same match - brought about because manager Mal Baker had to don his boots and play. His son of course is Steve Baker playing his first full season in the Reserves. Steve has settled well and looks to be a good prospect for many years to come.

The first half of this game was disappointing for Bassett who allowed Avebury to dominate them completely, and with the first half almost at an end were 2-0 down, but a goal from Bob Bright close on half time gave the Reserves some to aim for. A complete turn about in the second half. The Reserves returned to field more determined and played really well, and goals from Mick Karn and Steve Thomas gave the Reserves a 3-2 victory. If the Reserves could produce the type of spirited comeback they showed in the second half of this match in all their games, they would have few problems in Div 2 of the Wilts League. A stern test will be this afternoon when they play Stratton Red Eagles.

#### OUR VISITORS

Our visitors Cheltenham Town Reserves come to us today currently placed joint second in the League on 25 points and along with Kidlington are the leagues leading scorers, and having scored 29 goals in their 12 games - they certainly know where the net is.

This is our second meeting of the current season. On 18 November, when we travelled to Cheltenham we managed to share the points in a very closely contested game - 1-1.

Our introduction into the Federated Homes League on 20 August 1988 was against Cheltenham Town Reserves when they beat us quite convincingly 3-0, and then on 2 Jan 89 when we travelled to Cheltenham they managed a 1-0 victory. They also defeated us in last season's Division 1 Cup fixture in the first round, so we are still looking for our first win over them.

At the end of last season, Cheltenham Town Reserves finished in 7th place on 39 points, just one point behind Bassett. Of the 28 league games played they won 12, drew 3 and lost 13, scoring a total of 53 goals and conceding 50.

As most of you will know, the Cheltenham senior side, who play in the GM Conference League are also having a good season so far and no doubt some of their players here today will have either had some GM Conference league experience or will be trying to make the step up, so they should provide us with a good entertaining contest this afternoon, and following Bassett's fine showing against Highworth last week we should be in for a good game.


