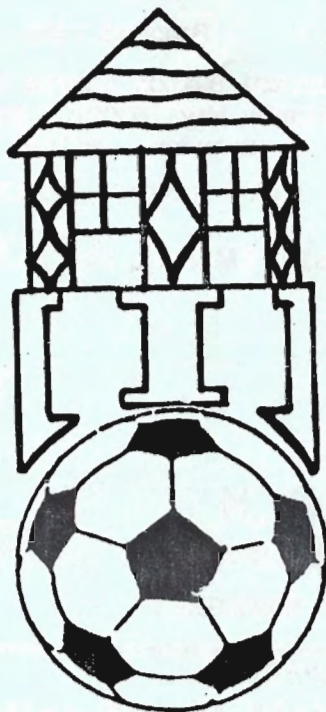

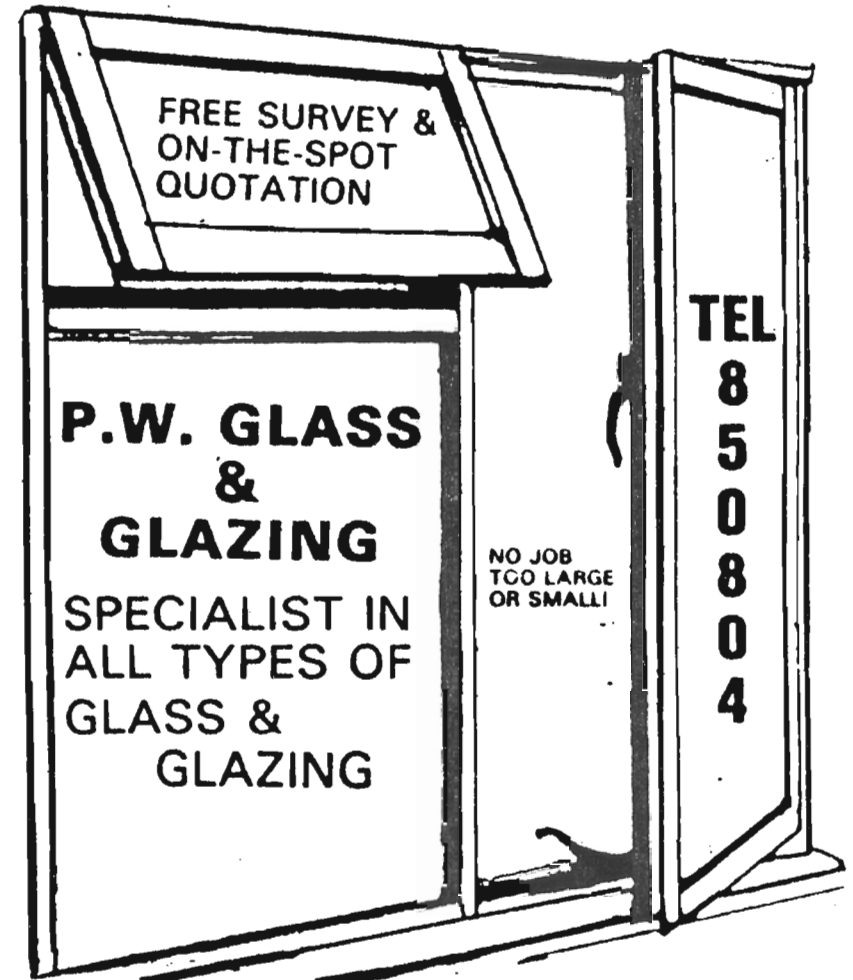

Good afternoon everyone and welcome once again to the Gerrard Buxton Sports Ground for the first game to be played here for almost a month - the atrocious weather having claimed all the games due to be played.

This afternoon we entertain Cirencester Town in a Division 1 fixture, and to their players, management and supporters we extend a very warm welcome.

The last game to be played here was against The Herd in the Division 1 League Cup. Bassett entered this game on a high note having won their previous 3 games and were looking to continue that run with a good win over The Herd, but it was not to be. A 1-1 draw was the outcome, so they will have to replay the game, and as yet, no date has been fixed.

Back to the League. Bassett continue to make good progress in Division 1 and on 27 Jan when most of the games were postponed because of the weather, Bassett travelled to Cheltenham Saracens and notched up an excellent 3-0 win, with goals from Kenny Regan, Damon York and an own goal. The following week, 3 Feb, saw Bassett without a game. Our scheduled away fixture that day, against today's opposition Cirencester Town, was yet again the victim of a waterlogged pitch. In fact all games in the Division 1 were cancelled.

Last Saturday saw the return fixture with our close neighbours Purton, and on a Red House pitch, which can only be described as only just playable, Bassett earned a 2-2 draw. Having held a 1-0 lead at half time through Colin Valters the second half opened with Bassett under relentless pressure from Purton and through their persistence managed to score twice. But when a Purton victory looked on the cards, Colin Valters managed to squeeze the ball into the net from the most acute angle to level the score at 2-2. Not a bad game played under very trying conditions, but nonetheless a valuable point for Bassett.

The Reserves have not been so lucky with their fixtures. Their last three games, all at home, have been cancelled because of a waterlogged pitch, so there is little to report on their progress in the Wilts league. Its disappointing to have lost so many games, because the Reserves were going well and their inactivity may well prove to have a detrimental effect on their progress in the League. Hopefully, they can resume their fixtures with a win this afternoon when they visit Avebury.

With the first team travelling to Milton (Didcot) and the Reserves travelling to Corsham there is no game for any Bassett team here next week, because the Club is hosting the Semi Final of the Wiltshire Senior Cup between Highworth Town from Division 1 of Federated Homes League and Swindon Athletic from Premier Division of Federated Homes League so why not come along to watch what could well be a very good game. Incidentally this is the second year running that Highworth have been in the Semi Final, on that occasion they defeated Pinehurst 1-0.

Thanks for your support today, and lets hope that the weather will again allow us to get on with our scheduled fixtures - otherwise we could find ourselves having a build-up of games at the end of the season.

OUR VISITORS

Today is the first time of the current season that we have met Cirencester - our scheduled fixture on 3 Feb was the victim of a waterlogged pitch.

Last season for Cirencester was a bit of a disaster. It was not until 9 Nov that they earned their first point, ironically it was against Bassett when the outcome of the evening fixture was a 2-2 draw. Then shortly afterwards on 19 Nov when Cirencester visited Bassett, the outcome was a 2-1 victory for the home side. Cirencester then had to wait until 10 Dec to collect their second point of the season with a very good 3-3 draw at Cheltenham Town Reserves, but it was not until 11 Feb 89 that they recorded their first win - 3-1 away to Lambourn Sports. Two more victories to the end of the season saw them finish at the foot of the table on 14 points

However, they are now under new management and they have certainly made a better start to the current campaign. They come to us today currently placed 12th in the League on 16 points, but they do have quite a few games in hand, and with 3 points for a win in this League, (although they still have to earn them), Cirencester should finish this season fairly well placed.

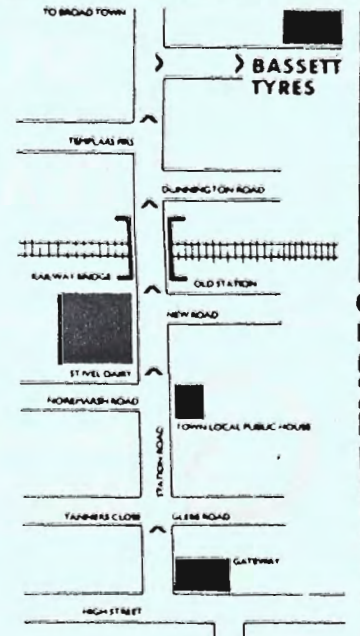

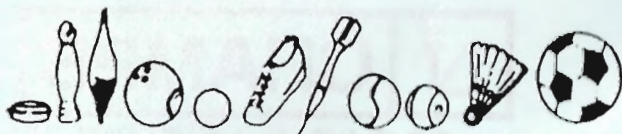
