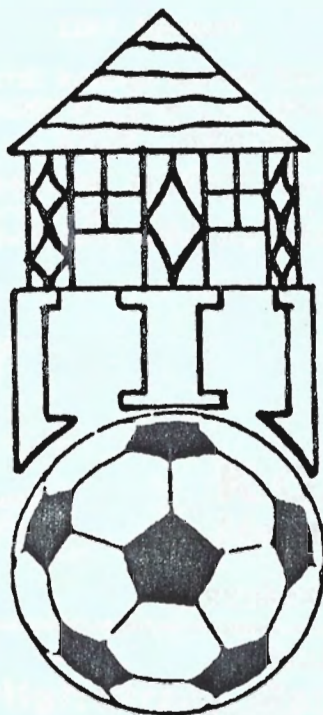

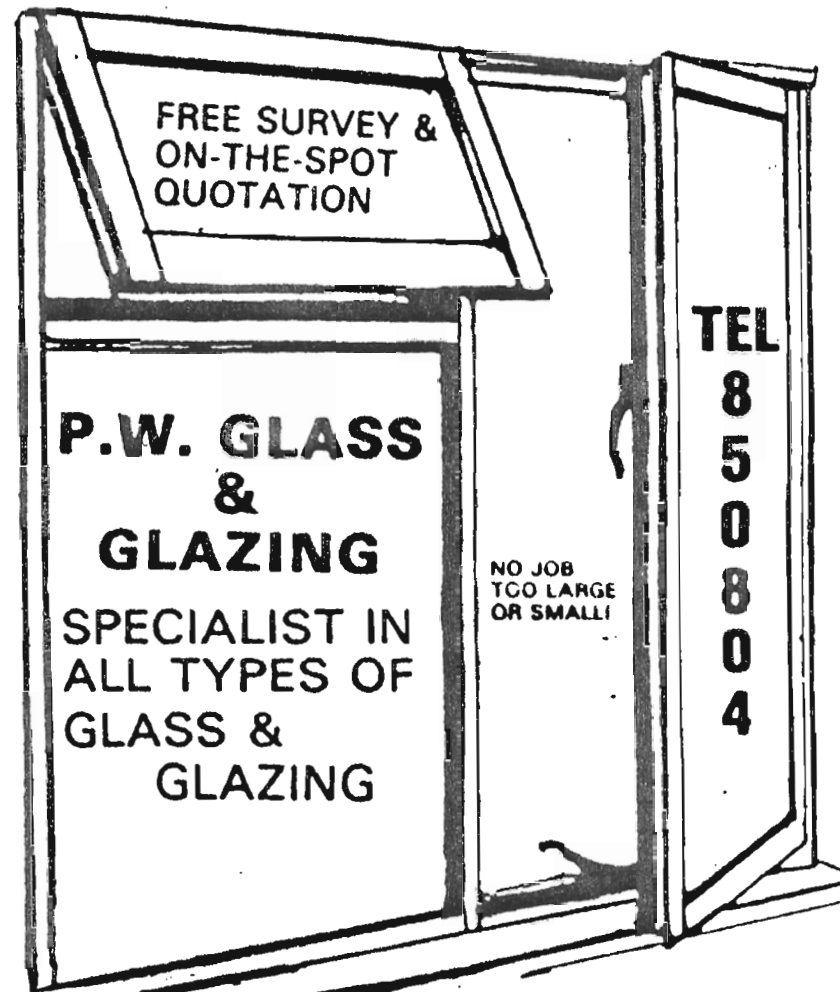

Good afternoon and welcome once again to the Gerrard Buxton Sports Ground for the visit today of Lambourn Sports, and to their players, management and supporters we extend a very warm welcome.

The past 2 weeks have been very successful for the Club. A 4-0 win over Kidlington on 7 April by the 1st XI, two 4-0 victories at home by the Reserves over Malmesbury Vic and Melksham Town, an away win 3-1 over The Herd by the 1st XI and then on Easter Monday an excellent 1-0 victory against Chipping Norton Town which put us into the final of the Division 1 Cup.

Back to the Kidlington game which was our last Federated Homes fixture here at Rylands Way. This 4-0 victory was particularly pleasing as valuable points had been dropped in our previous two outings, and with Kidlington being near the top of the Division it was always going to be a tough game, but Manager Mick Woolford had got the team sufficiently motivated for the game following their two previous disappointments and goals from Damon York, Neil Timbrell (2) and Colin Valters rounded off a fine team performance. Our next fixture was against The Herd, the fourth time the teams had met this season, and although The Herd took an early lead, goals from Damon York (pen), Colin Valters and a superb headed goal from Neil Timbrell was enough to give Bassett the victory and put them in the right frame of mind to face Chipping Norton in the semi-final of the Division 1 Cup played at Clanfield on Easter Monday.

On a cold and blustery afternoon at Clanfield, Bassett's early pressure playing into a rather difficult wind, was frequently halted by some rather crude challenges from the opposition, but Bassett showed good resilience to the Chipping Norton tactics and following prolonged pressure Damon York beat two players in the penalty box and scored from close range after about 20 minutes. Bassett continued to sustain the pressure and apart from the occasional attack by Chipping Norton which was dealt with well by the Bassett defence, in which Gary Bartlett, Steve Ackrill and Tony Woosnam were particularly prominent, Chipping Norton never really looked like scoring. In the second half with the wind behind them, Bassett showed great character with all players working hard to maintain the slender lead, any attack mounted by Chipping Norton was once again handled well by the Bassett defence. Apart from a good effort from Colin Valters late in the game, which was well saved by the Chipping Norton keeper, Bassett failed to increase their lead, and the early goal from Damon York proved enough to take the Club into the final where there opponents will be Milton United on 5 May. The venue and time of kick-off has yet to be announced, but rest assured it will be well publicised.

The Reserves have produced some fine results in their last three games, all here at Rylands Way having scored 10 goals with only 1 against. In the game against Malmesbury Vic on 11 Apr they were 4-0 winners and then last Saturday it was 4-0 again against a poor Melksham Town Res side, who are firmly cemented at the foot of Wilts Div 2, and then on Wednesday when the Reserves entertained neighbours Purton and in a game that was nearly all one way traffic, Bassett completed the double over Purton with a 2-1 victory with goals from Paul Burke (pen) and Roger Frost.

I am sorry to say that the U12s unfortunately lost their Cup Semi Final on 10 April. Although out of the Cup, the boys have had a good season in this their first full season of league competition.



Thanks for your support today and lets hope Bassett can continue their run of good results and complete the double over Lambourn Sports. The next game here at Rylands Way is next Wednesday when our visitors will be Highworth Town in a Federated Homes League fixture.

**OUR VISITORS**

Our visitors today, Lambourn Sports who are members of the Berks and Bucks FA who were, at the time of going to print, placed 4th from bottom of Division 1 on 21 points.

This is the second time we have met this season. In the fixture played at Lambourn on 13 January, Bassett were convincing winners 5-1, with goals from Gerry McKay, Neil Timbrell, Colin Valters (2) and Damon York to record Bassett's biggest win this season.

Lambourn have yet to gain a victory over Bassett. In our 2 encounters last season, the game at Lambourn on 17 Sep 88 ended in a 2-2 draw and then in the return fixture here at Bassett on 10 Dec 88, Bassett were 2-1 winners.

Last season was a relative success for Lambourn who finished 3rd in Division 1 on 49 points, and of their 28 games played they won 14, drew 7 and lost 7, scoring a total of 53 goals. Unfortunately they were not able to produce the same momentum this season and had to wait until 16 December to record their first league win, over Cheltenham Saracens 3-0. Two more victories followed in quick succession, 3-0 against Highworth on 23 Dec, the 1-0 away to Purton on 6 Jan, but this brief return to form ended there and they had to wait until 10 March to record their next victory, 1-0 at home to Wallingford and one further win on 17 Mar at home to Clanfield is their rather sad story this season so far. I am sure that Lambourn will be looking to avenge the heavy home defeat they suffered at the hands of Bassett back in January and will be looking to halt the good run Bassett is currently experiencing.

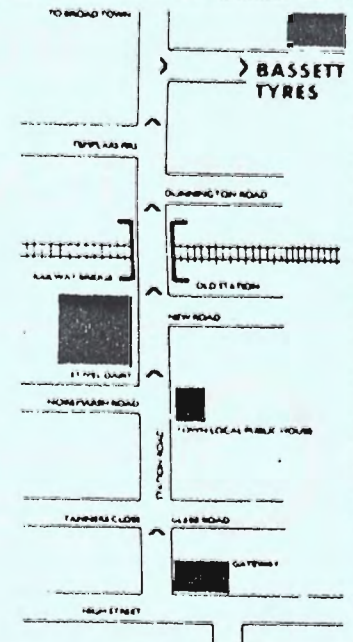

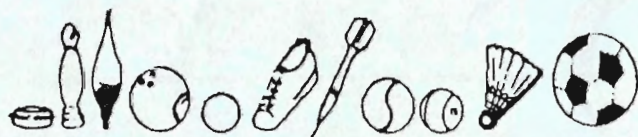
