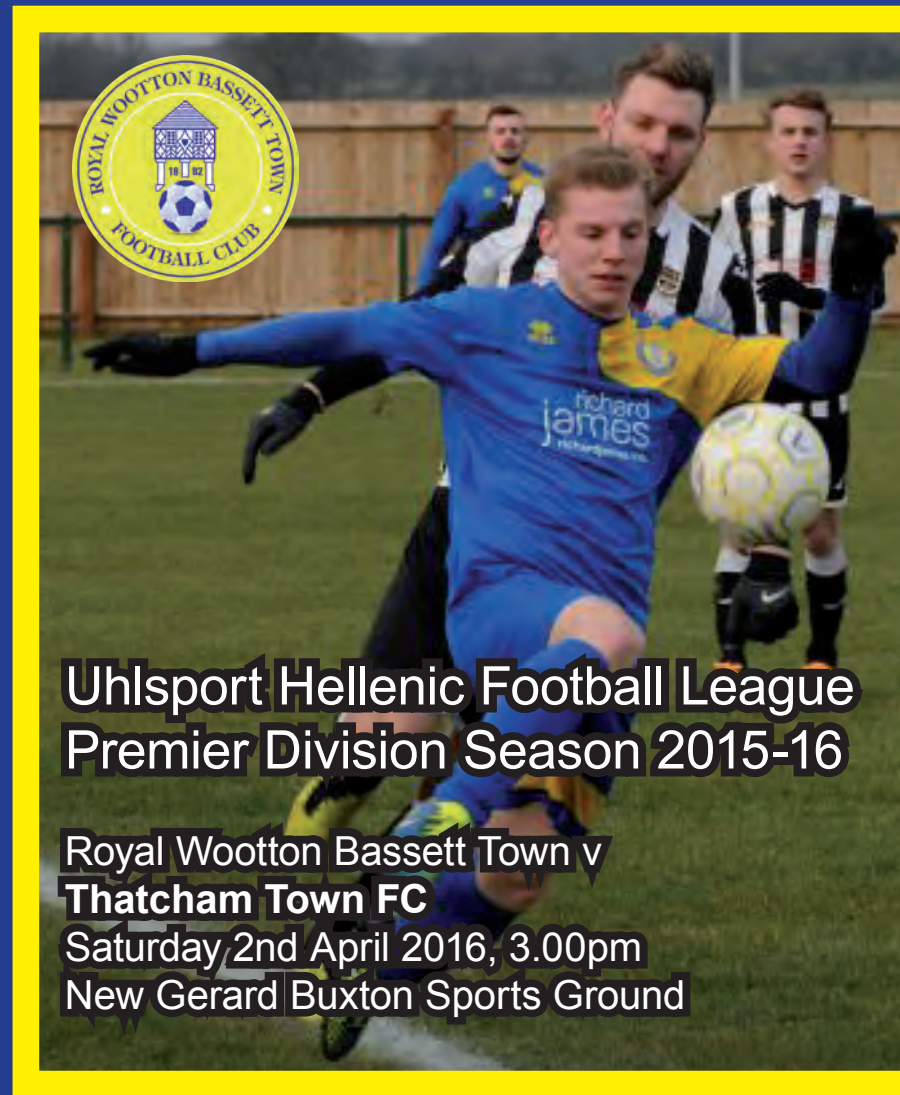

Welcome to Thatcham Town

This afternoon our visitors are Thatcham Town for this final home UHlsport Hellenic League Premier Division fixture of Season 2015-16. A warm welcome to all from Thatcham who have made the journey along the M4 to Royal Wootton Bassett for this league fixture, we hope you enjoy your first visit to our new ground and we wish you a safe journey home.

Earlier in the season against our opponents today, as I noted last week for the Ascot game, we put in another one of our better performances of the season to defeat our high flying opponents by 2 goals to 1 courtesy of a Harvey Scholes wonder goal and Steve Robertson's last gasp winner. Hopefully, unlike Ascot last week we will manage to do the double over one of the top sides to end our first season here at the New Gerard Buxton ground on a high note.

Thatcham Town currently sit 2nd in the table, four points behind leaders Kidlington with four games to play and having played one more game than Kidlington. With Kidlington playing four opponents at the bottom of the league in their final league games I do not see them slipping up but you can be sure that Thatcham will not want to drop any more points in the final run in. It will be a tough ask this afternoon to prevent our non-winning run extending into double figures but there again no one predicted that we would win at Thatcham earlier in the season. We have to end the wretched run sometime so why not this afternoon?

Last week's performance against Ascot was encouraging and the 2-0 defeat was somewhat harsh on the lads. Firstly we switched off on a corner in the closing minutes and allowed the Ascot player a free header and then the game was killed off by a lucky deflected goal. We had certainly had the better of things in the second half and if only we could have taken one of the chances that came our way it could have been a very different result. When you are on a run like we are at the moment you certainly do not get the luck.

First Postponement of the Season

I had already started writing this editorial just after the Ascot game noting that this was the first season in living memory that we had gone through the entire season without having a single game postponed, either home or away, and then lo and behold the Easter Monday game at Bracknell falls victim to Storm Katie. Cue editorial re-write. At the time of writing I have no idea when this Bracknell game will be re-scheduled. Bracknell are still involved in two cup competitions and are already playing 3 games a week to finish the season. I would have suggested that the game be re-scheduled for last Thursday, replacing Bracknell's second 'home' fixture of the season with Wokingham & Emmbrook but it is a little too late for that now. Frankly this sort of thing should not be happening at Step 5 football. Hope it does not matter in the final league tables come the end of the season. Rant over.

Reserves and Wiltshire County League

On Saturday the Reserves lost 3-0 away at title favourites Trowbridge Town. Fielding a side that included a number of our Under 18 Floodlit side the Reserves put in a good performance by all accounts and were unlucky to lose 3-0, the final score line flattering Trowbridge. The title race in the Wiltshire County League this season is between former Hellenic League Trowbridge, former Wessex League side Shrewton and another former Hellenic side in Malmesbury Vics. Both Shrewton and Malmesbury have floodlights and the facilities to play at Step 6 but it will be interesting to see which league they would go into. As for Trowbridge as their ground remains pretty much as it was the last time they were in the Hellenic League, and with the tightening up of the ground grading requirements, I doubt they would be able to progress should they finish as champions. The UHlsport Hellenic League could do with more sides but I suspect the winners of the Wiltshire League this season, if they move up, will be heading the way of the Western League. Let us see what develops.

Ladies Team

The Ladies were again without a game last weekend and fell down into 4th place in the table in the Gloucestershire Women's League following wins for both Almondsbury UWE and AEK Boco Ladies.

Opponents - History

Thatcham Town • Club History



Thatcham Town Football Club was founded in 1894. The club were originally known as Thatcham, with Town being added to its name in 1974. In the early years Thatcham played at The Marsh on Dunston Green, Brownsfield (home of the Cricket Club) and Station Road, before moving to Lancaster Close in 1949. Floodlights were erected in January 1983 with Fulham FC visiting for a friendly fixture to commemorate their switching on. In order to provide improved facilities the club moved to Waterside Park during the 1992/93 season.

The club joined the Reading Temperance League in 1896, winning the Division Two title in 1905/06. In 1953 Thatcham became founder members of the Hellenic League and won promotion to the Premier Division as Division One champions in 1958/59, 1964/65 and 1972/73. The club then won the Hellenic League Championship in 1974/75.

Following short spells in the Athenian and London Spartan Leagues, Thatcham joined the newly formed Wessex League in 1986 and won the title in 1995/96. After finishing second in 2005/06, FA ground requirements were met and promotion to step four was achieved.

The Kingfishers spent eight seasons in the Southern League Division One – seven in the South & West Division and one (2012/13) in the Central Division. After finishing sixth in 2006/07 and 2008/09, the club achieved its highest ever placing in 2010/11. Despite being in the bottom half of the table at new year, the club earned 38 points from the final 15 matches to finish in fifth place, however the Kingfishers were beaten at Sholing in the play-off semi-final.

Once safety was assured in 2013/14, the club announced its resignation from the Southern League to cut costs by playing at a lower level. In 2014/15 Town finished twelfth in their first season back in the Hellenic Premier, but with new sponsors on board and the rebuilding job underway, the club are optimistic of returning to the Southern League in the near future.

Thatcham completed league and cup doubles by winning the Hellenic First Division Cup in 1972/73 and the Premier Division Cup in 1974/75. The latter was the club's most successful season as Thatcham also claimed the Berks & Bucks Senior Cup. Thatcham were actually beaten in the cup final but were awarded the trophy due to a dispute between their opponents Wycombe Wanderers and the Berks & Bucks FA.

In 1989 Thatcham reached the last eight of the FA Vase having been drawn away six times before eventually losing to local rivals Hungerford Town. In the same competition, a record attendance of 1,400 was set when Aldershot Town won 1-0 at Waterside Park in 1993/94.

1996/97 saw the club's best ever FA Cup run as they reached the Fourth Qualifying Round. In 2012/13 Thatcham were narrowly beaten 2-1 by Gloucester City of the Conference North in the Second Qualifying Round, in a tie played at Cheltenham Town's Whaddon Road ground.

The club are yet to progress beyond the Second Qualifying Round of the FA Trophy though reached the Quarter-Finals of the Red Insure Cup in 2011/12. During the 1990s Thatcham won the Wessex League Cup four times, and more recently, success has been enjoyed in the Basingstoke Senior Cup.

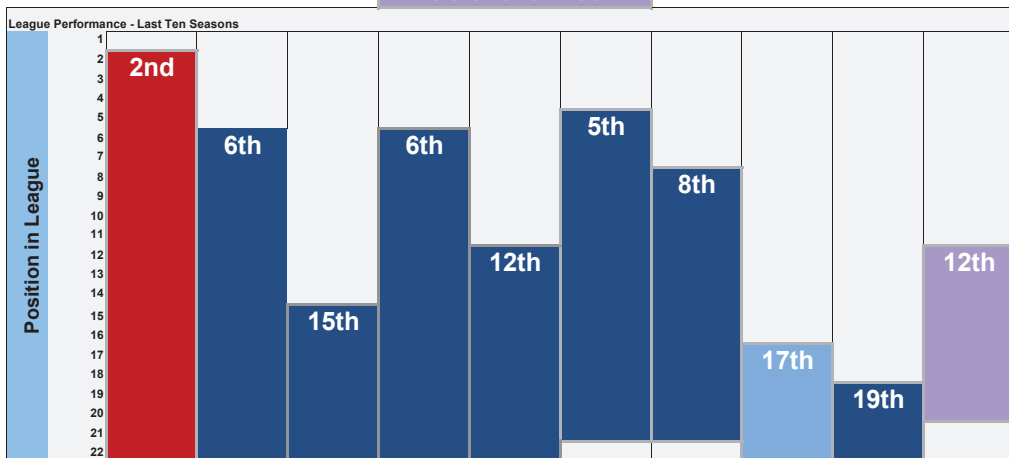

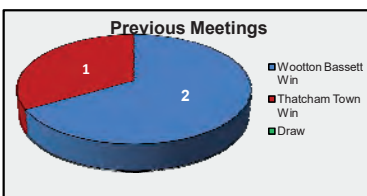
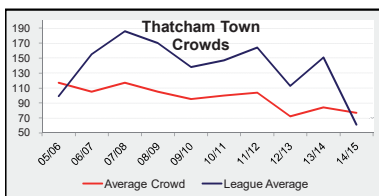

Bassett bang on the money as they stun leaders

Waterside Park, 14th November 2015

There are few feelings in football more satisfying than toppling the league leaders. Apart from when you do so with a dramatic last minute winner. And that's exactly what Royal Wootton Bassett Town did, Steve Robertson's low deflected strike in injury time – coming moments after his team had conceded an equaliser - sealing a stunning 2-1 away victory at Thatcham Town.

The Kingfishers entered the contest having dropped just four points since an opening day league defeat at the hands of Kidlington. Riding that imperious run of form and with recent reinforcements added to an already high calibre squad, they'd not have expected Bassett, lingering in 13th in the Hellenic League Premier Division, to have offered too much in the way of resistance as they sought to maintain their lead at the top of the table. Especially so considering Paul Braithwaite's squad had slipped to defeat in their previous three league outings.

However, with undoubtedly their best performance of the season so far, Bassett made sure that the form book was of no relevant value on this afternoon. Defensively, bodies were thrown on the line in the face of a heap of Thatcham pressure, meanwhile the Bassett midfield ran their legs off on a heavy pitch to offer the necessary support both at the back and up front, where Steve Robertson and Sam Packer combined to cause frequent difficulties for their hosts' backline.

Singling out any player for specific praise on this afternoon would be wrong; instead it was a total team performance that underlay this odds defying triumph.

There was a frenetic nature to the match throughout, a feature partially encouraged by the fact both teams were forced to play for over an hour with ten men.

The game's opening stages were especially fast-paced. On six minutes Adam Morris lifted a shot over from the edge of the area while unmarked before Curtis Meare tipped around the post from an awkward Josh Helmore effort after Tom Browne's free kick had been blocked but not cleared.

Then at the other end, Packer flicked Meare's long goal kick onto Robertson, who had beaten the offside trap. With 'keeper Chris Rackley charging off his line, Bassett's leading marksmen sought to beat him with a powerful lob from 30 yards and missed only by a whisker.

Thatcham's Josh Baines was next to narrowly miss, finding the side netting with a sharp arrowing drive on the turn. Helmore again came close as the period neared its mid-point, but his delicate attempt to lift the ball over a sprawling Meare was brilliantly clawed wide by the Bassett stopper.

Having survived those early scares and also come close to snatching the lead, Bassett could feel encouraged. And that confident mood was rewarded by Harvey Scholes on the half hour mark.

Receiving a George Drewitt throw just inside the home side's half, Scholes turned, effortlessly glided past an attempted sliding tackle and proceeded to bend a sublime 25 yard curler into the top right corner to send the visitors in front.

The playmaker was quickly at the heart of the action prior to both teams seeing one of their contingent dismissed. His reaction to a heavy tackle from behind on the right wing sparked a brief skirmish, the result of which was red cards for Thatcham right back Danny Lachacz and Bassett midfielder Matt Cheetham for their part in the conflagration.

Previous Meetings

A crucial moment, the reduction in players on the pitch served to ratchet up the end-to-end nature of the game.

At the beginning of the second period Thatcham exerted a significant amount of pressure but only came close to equalising once when a George Drewitt block denied Adam Morris after patient build up play on the left enabled Callum Willmoth to get into the box and cut back for his teammate.

Although determined to maintain their slender advantage, Bassett were willing to press for a second too. And, while their opponents appealed spuriously for a penalty, they got on with matters, breaking decisively through Dan Comer as the right back burst forward into an ocean of space. He darted inside and slipped through Robertson on the left, but the forward could only must a weak shot from a tight angle, which Rackley parried around the near post.

On the hour Thatcham left back Browne got in on the attacking action, pouncing on a loose ball following Comer's attempted clearing header, before unleashing a left-footed thunderbolt that rattled the crossbar.

Soon afterwards, pinball in the box after Bassett failed to clear from a corner eventually saw the ball drop for Willmoth. He sought to guide a sidefoot shot into the opposite bottom corner, yet saw his attempt wind up an inch or so wide.

Wave after wave of desperate Thatcham attacks continued. Yet their reluctance to shoot and desire to pass the ball into the net allowed their visitors to consistently soak this pressure up and launch counter drives of their own.

Twice more they almost led to a second of the game. A daring Dan Bailey strike from the halfway line had Rackley racing back onto his goalline to punch over before Scholes twisted his way towards goal from the left touchline only to fire across the face of goal from an angle.

Thatcham were no doubt thankful that both efforts failed to increase their deficit. And they eventually grabbed the equaliser they were agitating for when an unmarked Helmore steered in from close range from Willmoth's corner with two minutes remaining.

Back on level terms, their thoughts now turned to finding a winner. Bassett had other ideas though.

With the ninety minutes elapsed, they won a throw in inside Thatcham territory, which Robertson received into his feet on the right wing. He then rolled his marker, drove into the area and fired low, with the aid of a slight deflection, beyond Rackley.

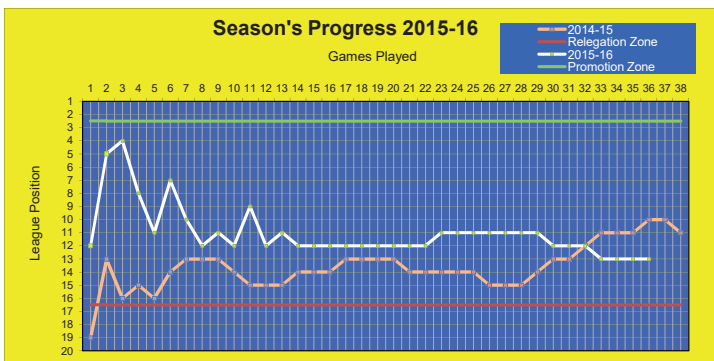
Game, set and match. What a feeling. What a win.

Joe Hiscock Forward
Skilful and hard working player who returns to Bassett after starting the season with Division One West side Purton. Ex-New College player who broke into our First Team last season.



Dan Bailey Forward
Strong powerful player who can play in midfield or up front and was our top scorer last season with 18 goals from 46 appearances. Previously with Fairford Town.



Adam Corcoran Defence
This will be his 4th season with Bassett having re-joined the Club from Shrivenham. Previously with Calne Town a player who gives 100% every game.



George Drewitt Defence
Classy defender, product of the Club's Youth Section. Both Manager and Players player of the season in 2014-15 when he made 36 appearances and scored 1 goal.



Dale Richards Defence
A product of the Club's youth section, a classy defender who made the step-up to adult football in style last season making 45 appearances.



Jamie Richards Defence
Recent signing from Purton. Usually plays left back but can also play in the middle of defence. Looking to make step up to Premier Division football.



Harvey Scholes Midfield
Attack minded midfielder player with great technical ability who joins us from New College where he was a regular but now keen to step-up to the Premier.



Callum Wright Midfield
Former Swindon Town and Chelsea Academy player who joined us from Chippenham Town. Classy midfielder player who can also play at the back if needed.



Sam Packer Midfield
Returning to the Club from Shrivenham. Hard working and talented midfielder player who played for the Club in season 2010-11 and 2013-14.



Josh Fowler Forward
Pacy striker who recently joined the club from Purton. Formed a lethal partnership with Steve Robertson when at Shrivenham.



Tyler Sheppard Forward
Another product of Bassett's youth section. Former Swindon Town Centre of Excellence player who then joined Yeovil Town. Previously also with Highworth Town and Calne Town.



Steve Robertson Forward
Free scoring forward who re-joined the Club from Shrivenham last season. Despite joining part way through the season he netted an impressive 12 times in just 16 games.

Royal Wootton Bassett Town FC • Club History



Wootton Bassett Town formed in 1882 and are one of the oldest Clubs in Wiltshire. Bassett's early success came in the Wiltshire Senior Cup, making the final in both 1902-3 and 1903-4, losing to Warminster 3-1 in a replay before going down 3-0 to Swindon Town the following season. Bassett folded for a period pre World War 1 before re-forming in the Calne & District League. After finishing runners-up in 1930-31 they went one better the following year winning the championship. A short unsuccessful spell in the Swindon & District League saw the team return to the Calne League where they were champions again in 1934-35.

Having won the Calne League for the second time Bassett moved up into Wiltshire League Division 2. Promotion was achieved in the first season and the team remained in the top division until the start of World War II. After the war Bassett recommenced in the County Senior League but struggled. In 1956-57 a reorganisation of football in Wiltshire saw the creation of a Premier Division and Bassett found themselves in the second tier. Season 1958-59 saw the first title secured when Bassett finished top of Division 1. Back in the top tier the highest place finish was 8th in Season 1967-68. Then, following another reorganisation, Bassett found themselves in the Wiltshire Combination where they were to remain until 1976-77 when the current Wiltshire County Football League was formed. The second season in the new league saw Bassett relegated but they were to bounce straight back in 1978-79 when they finished runners-up. Unfortunately momentum could not be maintained and they were immediately relegated to Division 2 where they remained for 5 seasons. A second league title was secured in 1984-85 when Bassett were promoted back to Division 1. This time the team were able to hold their own and after finishing 6th and 4th they then achieved their greatest success in 1987-88 when they won the Division 1 title, elevating the Club into the Hellenic League, where they have remained since.

Throughout their first eleven seasons Bassett kept a steady mid table position. In 1999-2000 they finished 3rd in Division One West and gained promotion to the Hellenic top flight. First season in the Premier resulted in a respectable twelfth position and a County Cup triumph. The next season they made the first round of the FA Vase but just avoided relegation. The next two seasons saw Bassett finish mid table but the following season they were relegated, this after making their first venture into the FA Cup since 1950-51. Bassett missed immediate promotion back to the Premier by one point in 2005-06 and went close again in 2008-09, finishing fourth. Meanwhile Bassett became the first club in Wiltshire to be awarded Charter Community Club status by the FA. Promotion back to the Premier Division was secured at the end of 2009-10 as Bassett finished level on points with champions Slimbridge.

Bassett finished in a credible 15th place in their first season back in the Premier. However, they harshly found themselves demoted back to Division One on a ground grading technicality. They did well to finish in 5th place the following season after such heartbreak. In 2012-13 Bassett were never out of the top 3 as they marched towards promotion, finishing 2nd. In addition they reached the FA Cup 2nd Qualifying Round for the first time. At the end of the season manager Dave Turner decided to move on after 5 years in charge. The Club were devastated when shortly after the fixture with his new club Shrivenham Dave tragically passed away.

With plans for the club's and Sports Association's new facility finally moving ahead, the first team began a two year ground share with Cirencester Town in 2013-14, a year in which Bassett finished a comfortable 14th in the Hellenic Premier Division. That performance was bettered in 2014-15 under new manager Paul Braithwaite, Bassett's final year playing its games in Cirencester, with an 11th place finish – the club's highest ever in the non-league pyramid – and record points haul in the division. This season sees the club playing at the New Gerard Buxton Sports Ground, which was opened in the summer of 2015 and with the Royal title now included within the club name.














Match Reports

Victory again proves elusive as Ascot pip Bassett at the post

New Gerard Buxton Ground, 26th March 2016

Defensively strong and probing when in attack, Royal Wootton Bassett Town produced one of their most polished performances in a long while against an Ascot United side who appear destined for a top four finish in the Hellenic League Premier Division.

However, despite the genuine quality that Bassett showed in a game played for long periods in an atrocious rainstorm and typically strong winds, they were unable to bring their luckless run of games without a win to an end. A pair of late goals from the visitors determined the outcome of the game. Tristram Dennis broke the deadlock with six minutes remaining, steering a header from Steven Deverall's corner into the bottom corner, before Jamie West scored with a deflected shot in the final minute.

Bassett's winless streak now stands perilously close to hitting double figures. And Easter Monday's trip to a resurgent Bracknell Town provides no easy opportunity to prevent that. Yet if the team play as they did against Ascot they'll have more than a fighting chance of finally tasting victory again. At the back, Paul Braithwaite's team were resolute for the majority of the game and the late lapse at the set piece from which Ascot went ahead was not representative of the defensive performance as a whole. Then going forward, wide men Dale Richards and Dan Comer posed problems for the visitors' full backs, frontmen Dan Bailey and Steve Robertson harried the centre halves, while Sam Packer and Harvey Scholes sought to build attacks with intelligent link-up play.

Chances were at a premium, though the conditions certainly played a part in that and hindered the visitors as well. Bassett's best opportunity in the opening period came as a result of a decisive switch of play that helped open up the visitors' defence. After receiving a pass played around the corner by Bailey, Comer delivered a searching ball into the path of Richards on the opposite wing. Richards proceeded to run at goal, but could only drag his shot from twenty yards across the face of goal and wide. With the strong wind at their backs, Ascot could only muster one chance of note prior to the break, James Goodey's curling effort forcing Luke Kuczynski to turn the ball around the right post.

The meteorological advantages bestowed to them for the second half, Bassett proceeded to put Ascot under a significant amount of pressure in its early stages. Racing onto a Bailey flick-on less than sixty seconds after play resumed, Robertson found himself unmarked with only an onrushing Chris Grace to beat, but, dealing with an awkward bounce, he could only hook the ball narrowly over. Matt Cheetham then demonstrated both his strength and guile, standing firm in the tackle to recover possession before threading a through ball to Robertson, who stung Grace's palms with a stinger from the left edge of the box. Comer was next to keep the Ascot stopper alert, curling a thirty-yard free kick inches over.

At the other end, a brave block from Jamie Richards helped keep the scores level after Goodey beat the offside trap and forced Kuczynski to tip an attempted cutback from the byline into the heart of the penalty area where West was looking to pounce. As evenly matched as the sides appeared, it was nevertheless the hosts who appeared the more likely to take the lead, and with just over quarter of an hour remaining Packer shifted a pass to Robertson, who forced Grace into an awkward fingertip save. Yet ultimately it was to be the visitors who grabbed the decisive goal. Ascot had numerous corners earlier in the game, which had come to nothing, and Deverall's delivery from the right with six minutes remaining appeared not to have been well struck. However, despite its low trajectory an unmarked Dennis was able to glance a header at the near post into the opposite bottom corner. Bassett almost answered immediately, but Bailey could only guide his header from a Comer cross wide of the left post. Then in the final minute West killed the game off. Bassett gave away possession from their own throw in, and the powerful frontman saw his shot from just outside the area take a wicked deflection and wrong foot Kuczynski. The final score was harsh on Bassett, but in the predicament they find themselves in, that slice of luck required always appears elusive.

Man of the match: Matt Cheetham – deployed at centre half rather than in his usual central midfield station, Cheetham produced another robust, assured display. A consistent strong performer, he will certainly be in the frame for a player of the year award when the season concludes next weekend.



Championship Winners and Contenders

IT was an extremely good Good Friday for Folkestone Invicta as they wrapped up the Ryman South title - and it looks like there will be plenty of drama to come as clubs up and down the country fight for promotion. Invicta did it in style, thrashing poor Walton & Hersham 6-0 at the Fullicks Stadium in front of a bumper crowd of over 1,500 to become the first club from Steps 1-4 to be named champions.

It's hard not to be pleased (unless you support one of their Ryman South rivals!) for a club that has stumbled in the play-offs the previous four years. The fact they lost the previous two finals show they've been among the best in the league for some time now and boss Neil Cugley finally got his squad over the line. Cugley and chairman Jim Pellatt led the club out of a Company Voluntary Arrangement which threatened the club's very existence but no doubt Friday was payback enough for all of their hard work. Chief Pellatt said: "It was probably three years or so of 'will we survive?' And we were still really struggling.

"Suddenly the work you've put in during those three years seems to come to fruition."

Skipper Liam Friend, who was part of the last Folkestone side to win promotion back in 2009-10, added: "It's been a long process, being here so many years, getting relegated and the going into the play-offs.

"It feels amazing. It was a relief to get my hands on the trophy, knowing I haven't got to play in the play-offs!"

AFC Sudbury and Warrington Town look likely to follow Invicta as the next to have their names engraved as champions. The Yellows were 11 points clear atop the Ryman North at the time of writing with just five games left while Warrington - who have scored over 100 league goals this term - are 12 ahead with the same amount of matches remaining in the Evo-Stik NPL North. Apart from those two, the rest of the divisions from Steps 1-4 could go right down to the wire which is great news for the neutral and not so good news for fans of the clubs involved!

It's a Gloucestershire throwdown in the National League between Cheltenham Town and Forest Green Rovers and with just two points separating them, the final month of the season is going to be massive. Solihull Moors are firmly in the driving seat in National League North with North Ferriby and AFC Fylde challenging but in the South, it could go any of three ways. Long-time leaders Ebbsfleet United have struggled as of late while Maidstone United and Sutton United have crept up behind them. Both clubs can overtake the Fleet if they win their games in hand but with the pressure ramped up at this stage of the season, who knows what will happen?

Darlington 1883 and Blyth Spartans are battling it out to see where in the north east the Evo-Stik NPL Premier title will be heading - with the former having three games in hand. The other two Step 3 divisions are also up for grabs as Hampton & Richmond Borough and East Thurrock United sit in the top two positions in the Ryman Premier. FA Trophy semi-finalists Bognor Regis Town have five games in hand but will their crowded schedule get the better of them? Redditch United lead the way in the Evo-Stik League Southern Premier but with arguably six teams still having a shot at the title, it's sure to be an enthralling end to the campaign. Stafford Rangers' recent dip in form, meanwhile, has allowed Shaw Lane Aquaforce into the champions' conversation in Evo-Stik NPL South.

In the Evo-Stik Southern Central, Royston Town are in pole position but Kings Langley, Egham Town and St Ives Town are still in with a shot while the South & West division looks to be a shootout between Banbury United, Cinderford Town and Taunton Town.

We've always said that there's plenty of entertainment in Non-League football and the month of April is shaping up to be quite something!

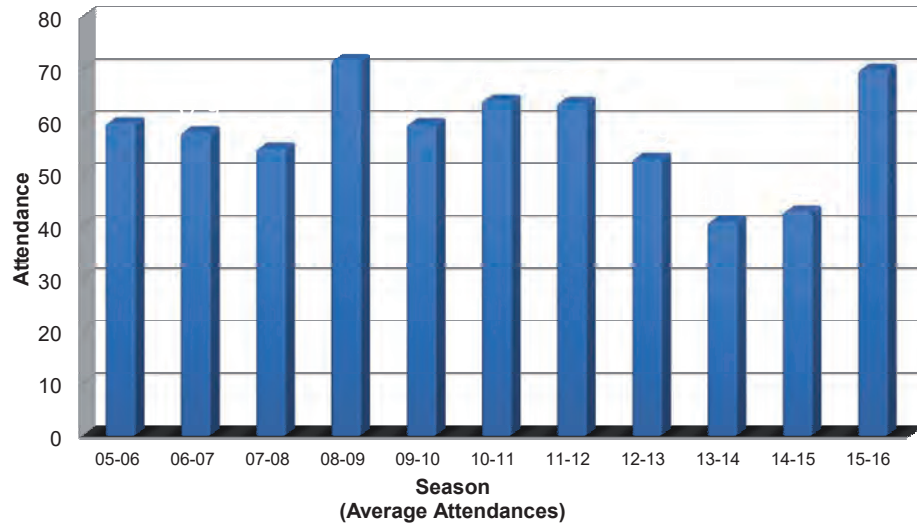

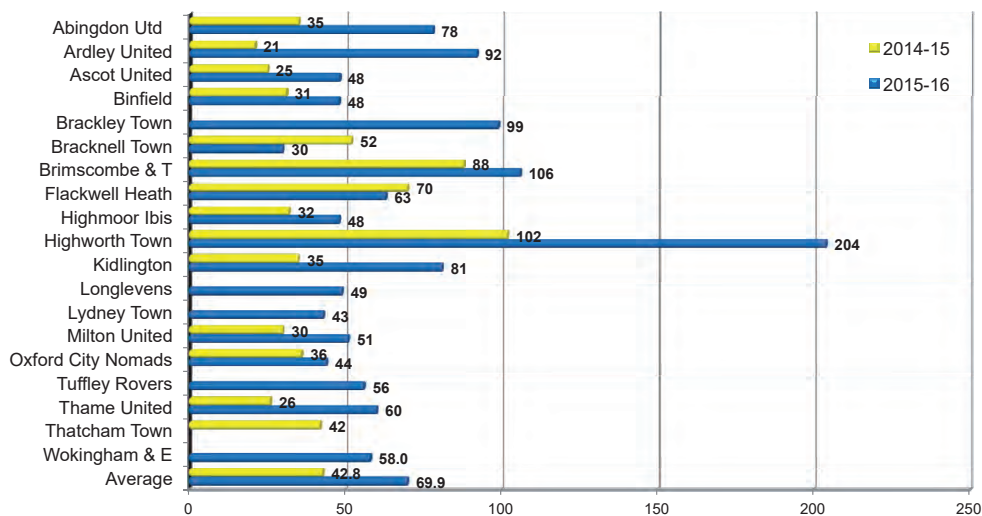

Wiltshire Football Round-up

Chippenham Town are now in real danger of missing the end of season play-offs. On Saturday they drew 2-2 with Leamington, after leading 2-0 and conceding the equaliser just 4 minutes from time. An own goal and an Alan Griffin strike had put Chippenham in the ascendancy but two goals from Jason Edwards rescued a point for Leamington. Then on Monday Chippenham played host to near neighbours Cirencester Town and the Centurions put a major dent in Chippenham's promotion hopes with a 1-0 win. Cirencester had defended doggedly against Chippenham and then popped up with the winner in the 5th minute of added time to shock promotion chasing Chippenham. As a result of this defeat Chippenham have slipped out of the play-off places, Hungerford Town replacing them in the top 5.

In the Southern League Division One South-West Swindon Supermarine had a mixed weekend. On Saturday they ran out comfortable 5-0 winners over the league's whipping boys Bashley. In the UHlsport Hellenic League Division One West Cheltenham Saracens went above Fairford in the table on Monday following a 3-2 away win at Cirencester Town Development. 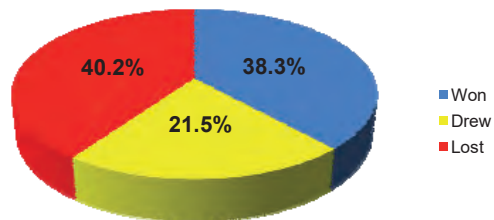

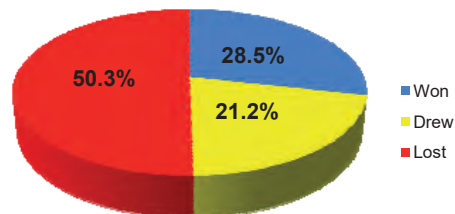

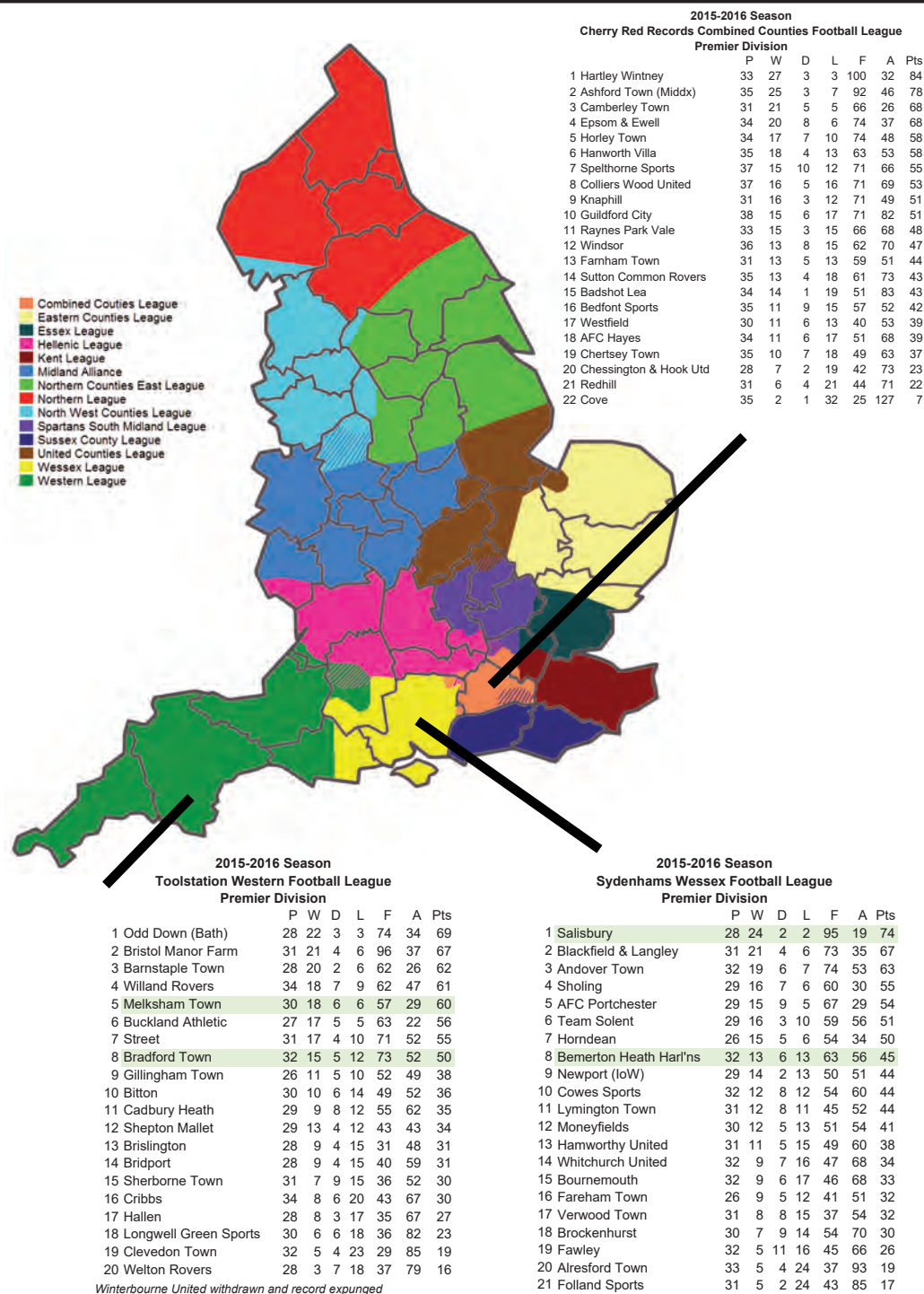
